St. Norbert enters the third round of the Northern Collegiate Hockey Association's triple round-robin schedule with a Thursday home game against UW-Stevens Point and a Saturday trip to UW-Eau Claire.

The Series:

St. Norbert leads the series with UW-Stevens Point by a 37-18-5 margin. St. Norbert is 37-10-2 in the last 49 games against the Pointers after opening the series 0-8-3. St. Norbert is also 19-2-1 in the last 22 games in the series.

St. Norbert leads the UW-Eau Claire series by a 40-4-2 margin. St. Norbert is 40-1-2 in the series since Eau Claire topped the Green Knights 5-4 in overtime on Jan. 21, 1995 at Hobbs Ice Arena.

The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Tim Coghlin (UW-Stevens Point, 1989) is 381-107-39 in his 18th season in De Pere. The Green Knights are 237-38-22 in the last nine-plus seasons. Coghlin's 371 wins as a coach in the NCHA has passed Bemidji State's Bob Peters' previous record of 370 (St. Norbert did not play in the NCHA in Coghlin's first year).

UW-Stevens Point coach Wil Nichol (UW-Stevens Point, 1998) is 50-44-7 in his fourth season in Stevens Point.

UW-Eau Claire coach Matt Loen (UW-Eau Claire, 1995) is 44-51-6 in his fourth season in Eau Claire.

This Year:

St. Norbert swept UW-Stevens Point 3-2 and 2-0 on Nov. 12-13 at Willett Arena in Stevens Point. Johan Ryd and Brandon Longley scored a goal in each game, and B.J. O'Brien made 19 and 25 saves, respectively. UW-Stevens Point's Nick Graves made 17 and 24 stops, respectively.

St. Norbert swept UW-Eau Claire 6-3 and 3-2 on Jan. 14-15 at the Cornerstone Community Center in Green Bay. Cody Keefer had two goals in the second game and Seth Soley had four assists on the weekend. B.J. O'Brien had outings of 25 and 26 saves, respectively.

About the Green Knights:

St. Norbert is 16-3 overall and 10-2 in the NCHA after a split with UW-Superior at Amsoil Arena in Duluth, Minn. The Green Knights lost the opener 3-0 before taking the back end of the series 5-4. The Green Knights, who are No. 2 in the USCHO.com Division III Poll, have won 14 of their last 16 games.

Junior forwards Johan Ryd and Seth Soley now share the team scoring lead, each registering six goals and 13 assists for 19 points. Sophomore forward Cody Keefer shares the team lead in goals with nine and has nine assists for 18 points. Junior forward Alain Joannette has seven goals and nine assists for 16 points, and sophomore forward Kyle Stroh has six

goals and nine assists for 15 points. Senior forward Brandon Longley shares the team lead in goals at nine with Keefer and has four assists for 13 points.

Senior goaltender B.J. O'Brien owns a 13-2 record with 1.74 goals against average and .926 save percentage. Freshman Mike Martin is 3-1 with a 1.25 goals against average and .947 save percentage.

St. Norbert is 18-for-74 (24.3 percent) on the power play and is 65-for-74 (87.8 percent) on the penalty kill.

About the Pointers:

UW-Stevens Point enters the weekend with a 9-10 overall record and a 5-7 ledger in the NCHA. The Pointers have won their last four games, which have all come at Willett Arena. Stevens Point is coming off a series sweep of UW-River Falls, winning 3-1 and 4-3 this past weekend.

Senior defenseman Garrett Suter leads the Pointers in scoring with five goals and nine assists for 14 points. Freshman forward Max Bobrow has six goals and six assists for 12 points, and junior forward Harrison Niemann has four goals and eight assists for 12 points. Sophomore forward Johnny Meo has six goals and four assists for 10 points, while freshman forward Jon Madden has four goals and six assists for 10 points.

Sophomore goaltender Nick Graves has seen most of the action in net for the Pointers. Graves is 9-7 with a 2.43 goals against average and .908 save percentage. Freshman Randy Wilcott is 0-3 with a 4.30 GAA and .861 save percentage.

Stevens Point is 19-for-92 (20.7 percent) on the power play and is 88-for-104 (84.6 percent) on the penalty kill.

About the Blugolds:

UW-Eau Claire enters Friday's game at UW-Stevens Point with a 12-7 record and a 6-6 mark in the NCHA. The Blugolds swept St. Scholastica 5-3 and 5-2 on the road last weekend. Eau Claire, which is 9-3 in its last 12 games, has scored

at least two goals in every game during that stretch.

Sophomore forward Jordan Singer leads the Blugolds in scoring with 13 goals and 11 assists for 24 points. Seven of Singer's markers have come on the power play. Sophomore forward Kurt Weston has nine goals and nine assists for 18 points, while junior forward Tyler Romasco has eight goals and nine assists for 17 points. Senior forward Ross Janecyk has eight goals and eight assists for 16 points.

Sophomore Brandon Stephenson is 9-3 in net for the Blugolds, posting a 3.00 goals against average and .899 save percentage. Junior Scott Pederson is 3-4 with a 2.31 goals against average and .920 save percentage.

Eau Claire is 22-for-106 (20.8 percent) on the power play and is 81-for-97 (83.5 percent) on the penalty kill.

Passing Peters:

St. Norbert head coach Tim Coghlin has achieved a historic milestone - the winningest coach in Northern Collegiate Hockey Association history.

Coghlin enters the weekend with a 371-98-38 record with the Green Knights as members of the NCHA. St. Norbert went 10-9-1 as an independent in Coghlin's first year.

Coghlin's record passed the previous NCHA mark of Bemidji State's Bob Peters, who went 370-134-36 in 1982 and 1984-99. Peters is the namesake of the NCHA's post-season championship trophy - the Peters Cup.

Only five other coaches have at least 200 wins while coaching in the NCHA: River Falls' Steve Freeman is third at 271-133-30, former UW-Stevens Point coach Joe Baldarotta is fourth at 265-171-38, Superior's Steve Nelson is fifth at 249-168-21 while his successor, Dan Stauber, recently joined the 200-win club and is 204-69-42 in 11 seasons. Mankato State's Don Brose seventh at 200-110-34.

Poll Position:

St. Norbert has been ranked in the

USCHO.com Division III Poll for 164 consecutive weeks. The Green Knights had been ranked third in the first four USCHO polls this season before moving up to second for three weeks. St. Norbert, which has been ranked No. 1 for the last two weeks, moved back to No. 2 the last two weeks. The Green Knights have been ranked in 202 of 206 polls conducted since its inception at the start of the 1998-99 season - the most of any school in Division III.

The Green Knights are 2-1 against ranked teams this season after losing 4-3 to then-No. 15 Hamline on Nov. 5. St. Norbert then swept No. 10 UW-Stevens Point 3-2 and 2-0 on Nov. 12-13.

During the 164-week stretch of being ranked, St. Norbert has been No. 1 for 45 weeks - second only to Norwich's 48. St. Norbert was rated No. 1 in the 2003, 2004, 2005, 2007 and 2008 final polls. The Green Knights are 65-12-5 all-time when ranked No. 1.

St. Norbert was 4-7-1 against ranked foes in 2008-09 but finished 10-2-1 against ranked teams in 2009-10. St. Norbert is 87-36-13 against teams ranked in the USCHO.com Poll under Tim Coghlin. The Green Knights are 0-4 all-time against the No. 1-ranked team and are 3-5 all-time against the No. 2-ranked team.

One-Goal Observations:

St. Norbert is 5-2 this season in one-goal games after beating UW-Superior 5-4 on Jan. 21 at Amsoil Arena in Duluth, Minn. Under Tim Coghlin, St. Norbert is 60-51 in one-goal games.

The Green Knights finished 4-2 in one-goal games last season, including going 2-1 in three nailbiters in the NCAA Division III Tournament.

St. Norbert had 11 one-goal games in 2008-09, going 6-5 in those situations en route to a 19-8-1 season. During the national championship season with a record of 27-1-4 in 2008, the Green Knights were an unblemished 8-0 in one-goal games.

St. Norbert is 126-8-6 in its last 140 games at the Cornerstone Community Center.

In the last nine seasons, the Green Knights are a sparkling 139-11-8 at the Cornerstone, with three losses and one tie coming to national champion UW-Superior during the 2001-02 season.

All-time, St. Norbert is 148-15-9 at the Cornerstone Community Center, which includes a 9-4-1 mark there its first season in the building in 2000-01. Under Tim Coghlin, St. Norbert is 226-37-15 at home, which includes games at Brown County Arena, Resch Center and De Pere Ice Arena.

Gimme Five:

St. Norbert is unbeaten in its last 232 games when scoring five goals or more with a 227-0-5 mark since a 7-5 loss to Bemidji State in De Pere on Jan. 12, 1996.

St. Norbert is 5-19-4 in its last 28 games when allowing five goals or more dating back to the 1996-97 season. The only wins were a 9-5 win over St. Scholastica on Feb. 20, 1999, a 7-5 win over UW-Stout on Nov. 30, 2001, an 8-5 win over UW-Stout on Jan. 14, 2005, a 7-5 win over UW-Stevens Point on Feb. 3, 2007 and a 7-5 win over Gustavus Adolphus on Oct. 31, 2008.

The Green Knights have allowed five goals just 13 times in their last 281 games.
