Weekend Overview:

St. Norbert has its final home weekend of the regular season when it hosts UW-Superior and St. Scholastica. A St. Norbert win over Superior on Friday clinches the NCHA regular-season championship.

The Series:

St. Norbert leads the hotly contested series with UW-Superior 27-21-11. St. Norbert and Superior have met 33 times in the past nine-plus seasons, with St. Norbert holding a 16-8-9 edge. The Green Knights are 14-5-7 against Superior since a 2002 loss in the NCAA Tournament quarterfinals in Green Bay. At home in the series, St. Norbert holds an 18-11-3 mark - including a 10-1-2 mark in the last 13 meetings at the Cornerstone Community Center.

St. Norbert is 39-9-3 all-time against St. Scholastica. The two teams are 3-3-1 in their last seven meetings.

The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Tim Coghlin (UW-Stevens Point, 1989) is 382-107-40 in his 18th season in De Pere. The Green Knights are 238-38-23 in the last nine-plus seasons. Coghlin's 372 wins as a coach in the NCHA has passed Bemidji State's Bob Peters' previous record of 370 (St. Norbert did not play in the NCHA in Coghlin's first year).

UW-Superior coach Dan Stauber (UW-Superior, 1988) is 204-71-42 in his 11th season in Superior.

St. Scholastica coach Mark Wick (St. Scholastica, 1985) is 91-75-23 in his seventh season in Duluth.

This Year:

St. Norbert split with UW-Superior on Jan. 20-21 at Amsoil Arena in Duluth, Minn. Superior took the opener 3-0 behind 33 saves from Drew Strandberg and a pair of goals from Justin Faryna. The Green Knights salvaged a split with a 5-4 win the next day. Johan Ryd's shorthanded goal was the gamewinner and B.J. O'Brien made 21 saves for St. Norbert.

St. Norbert split with St. Scholastica on Dec. 3-4 at Mars Lakeview Arena in Duluth, Minn. The Green Knights took the opener 6-1 with two goals from Alain Joanette. The Saints took the second game 2-1 with two third-period goals and 26 saves from Patrick Sullivan.

About the Green Knights:

St. Norbert is 17-3-1 overall and 11-2-1 in the NCHA following a three-point weekend. The Green Knights beat UW-Stevens Point 2-1 at home last Thursday before tying UW-Eau Claire 3-3 on the road on Saturday. The Green Knights can extend their league record to a 12th NCHA regular-season championship with a win over UW-Superior on Friday.

Junior forward Johan Ryd owns the team scoring lead with eight goals and 14 assists for 22 points, and also holds the NCAA Division III lead with six game-winning goals. Junior forward Seth Soley has six goals and 14 assists for 20 points. Sophomore forward Cody Keefer has nine goals and 10 assists for 19 points. Senior forward Scott Pulak also shares in the team assists lead with 14 and adds three goals for 17 points.

Senior goaltender B.J. O'Brien owns a 14-2-1 record with 1.76 goals against average and .925 save percentage. Freshman Mike Martin is 3-1 with a 1.25 goals against average and .947 save percentage.

St. Norbert is 20-for-83 (24.1 percent) on the power play and is 74-for-83 (89.2 percent) on the penalty kill

About the Yellowjackets:

UW-Superior comes into the weekend with a 12-8-1 overall record and a 9-5 mark in the NCHA. The Yellowjackets' return to Wessman Arena last weekend was a tough one, losing 1-0 in overtime to UW-River Falls on Friday before falling 1-0 to UW-Stout on Saturday.

Sophomore forward Justin Faryna leads the Yellowjackets in scoring with 10 goals and 10 assists for 20 points. Senior forward Talon Berlando has eight goals and 11 assists for 19 points. Freshman defenseman Jeff Forsythe has six goals and seven assists for 13 points, while freshman forward Tyler Klein has five goals and eight assists for 13 points.

Freshman Drew Strandberg, who suffered both 1-0 losses in net for the Yellowjackets, owns a 6-6-1 overall record with a 2.36 goals against average and .908 save percentage. Sophomore Garrett Tinkham is 6-2 with a 2.38 goals against average and .921 save percentage.

Superior is 16-for-105 (15.2 percent) on the power play and is 75-for-87 (86.2 percent) on the penalty kill.

About the Saints:

St. Scholastica enters Friday's game at UW-Stevens Point with a 9-

11-1 overall record and a 4-10 mark in the NCHA. The Saints are coming off a split at home last weekend, beating UW-Stout 4-1 on Friday before losing to UW-River Falls 5-3 on Saturday.

Senior forward Riley Riddell leads the Saints in scoring with five goals and 17 assists for 22 points. Junior forward Carter Davis has nine goals and 10 assists for 19 points, while freshman forward Alex Valenti has six goals and nine assists for 15 points. Sophomore forward Tyler Miller adds six goals and eight assists for 14 points.

Sophomore goaltender Patrick Sullivan has a 6-7-1 record with a 3.34 goals against average and .886 save percentage. Junior Brennan Poderzay is 3-4 with a 4.14 goals against average and .869 save percentage.

St. Scholastica is 17-for-90 (18.9 percent) on the power play and is 71-for-93 (76.3 percent) on the penalty kill.

Mr. Clutch:

Junior forward Johan Ryd netted the game-winning goal on a marker with 41 seconds remaining in a 2-1 win over UW-Stevens Point on Jan. 27 at the Cornerstone Community Center.

That score was Ryd's then-seventh goal of the season, but was his sixth game-winning goal of the year. His six game-winning goals currently leads NCAA Division III skaters.

The game-winning goal matched the St. Norbert season record and joins some select company in doing so. Rob Smillie set the mark in 1997-98 and Connor Hughes tied the record in 2005-06. Smillie and Hughes are second and sixth on St. Norbert's career scoring list, respectively.

Ryd's other game-winning goals this season came against UW-Stout (Oct. 30), UW-Stevens Point (Nov. 12 and 13), Concordia-Moorhead (Jan. 8) and UW-Superior (Jan. 21).

The NCAA Division III record for game-winning goals in a season is nine, set by UW-Stevens Point's Paul Caufield in 1990-91 and

matched by St. Thomas' Steve Aronson in 1999-2000.

Ryd has eight career game-winners out of 20 total career goals. Smillie and Hughes hold the St. Norbert career record in that category at 13.

Passing Peters:

St. Norbert head coach Tim Coghlin has achieved a historic milestone - the winningest coach in Northern Collegiate Hockey Association history.

Coghlin enters this weekend with a 372-98-39 record with the Green Knights as members of the NCHA. St. Norbert went 10-9-1 as an independent in Coghlin's first year.

Coghlin's record passed the previous NCHA mark of Bemidji State's Bob Peters, who went 370-134-36 in 1982 and 1984-99. Peters is the namesake of the NCHA's post-season championship trophy - the Peters Cup.

Coghlin, who set the record with a 5-4 win over UW-Superior on Jan. 21, was honored by the NCHA and St. Norbert College on the ice prior to a 2-1 win over UW-Stevens Point on Jan. 27 at the Cornerstone Community Center.

Only five other coaches have at least 200 wins while coaching in the NCHA: River Falls' Steve Freeman is third at 273-133-30, former UW-Stevens Point coach Joe Baldarotta is fourth at 265-171-38, Superior's Steve Nelson is fifth at 249-168-21 while his successor, Dan Stauber, recently joined the 200-win club and is 204-71-42 in 11 seasons. Mankato State's Don Brose seventh at 200-110-34.

Iron Men:

Senior forward Scott Pulak became the 20th skater in St. Norbert history to appear in at least 110 career games for the Green Knights when he took the ice against UW-Eau Claire on Jan. 29.

Senior defenseman Nick Tabisz will become the 21st in his next game, as he currently has 109 career games. Fellow senior blueliner Adam Hammerbeck can also join the select club, heading into this

Rob Smillie, Shane Dickson and Jason Deitsch hold the school record with 122 games played. Steven Sleep just missed tying the mark at 121.

Only 11 skaters have reached 115 games played in St. Norbert history.

Poll Position:

St. Norbert has been ranked in the USCHO.com Division III Poll for 165 consecutive weeks. The Green Knights had been ranked third in the first four USCHO polls this season before moving up to second for three weeks. St. Norbert, which has been ranked No. 1 for two weeks, moved back to No. 2 the last three weeks. The Green Knights have been ranked in 203 of 207 polls conducted since its inception at the start of the 1998-99 season - the most of any school in Division III.

The Green Knights are 2-1 against ranked teams this season after losing 4-3 to then-No. 15 Hamline on Nov. 5. St. Norbert then swept No. 10 UW-Stevens Point 3-2 and 2-0 on Nov. 12-13.

During the 165-week stretch of being ranked, St. Norbert has been No. 1 for 45 weeks - second only to Norwich's 48. St. Norbert was rated No. 1 in the 2003, 2004, 2005, 2007 and 2008 final polls. The Green Knights are 65-12-5 all-time when ranked No. 1.

St. Norbert was 4-7-1 against ranked foes in 2008-09 but finished 10-2-1 against ranked teams in 2009-10. St. Norbert is 87-36-13 against teams ranked in the USCHO.com Poll under Tim Coghlin. The Green Knights are 0-4 all-time against the No. 1-ranked team and are 3-5 all-time against the No. 2-ranked team.

One-Goal Observations:

St. Norbert is 7-2 this season in one-goal games after beating UW-Stevens Point 2-1 on Jan. 27 at the Cornerstone Community Center. Under Tim Coghlin, St. Norbert is 62-51 in one-goal games.

The Green Knights finished 4-2 in one-goal games last season, including going 2-1 in three nailbiters in the NCAA Division III Tournament. St. Norbert had 11 one-goal games in 2008-09, going 6-5 in those situations en route to a 19-8-1 season. During the national championship season with a record of 27-1-4 in 2008, the Green Knights were an unblemished 8-0 in one-goal games.

Home Sweet Cornerstone:

When 14th century poet Dante Alighieri was penning his masterwork *The Divine Comedy* and the immortal line, "All hope abandon ye who enter here," he could have easily been referring to visiting hockey teams at the Cornerstone Community Center.

St. Norbert is 127-8-6 in its last 141games at the Cornerstone Community Center.

In the last nine seasons, the Green Knights are a sparkling 140-11-8 at the Cornerstone, with three losses and one tie coming to national champion UW-Superior during the 2001-02 season.

All-time, St. Norbert is 149-15-9 at the Cornerstone Community Center, which includes a 9-4-1 mark there its first season in the building in 2000-01. Under Tim Coghlin, St. Norbert is 227-37-15 at home, which includes games at Brown County Arena, Resch Center and De Pere Ice Arena.

Gimme Five:

St. Norbert is unbeaten in its last 232 games when scoring five goals or more with a 227-0-5 mark since a 7-5 loss to Bemidji State in De Pere on Jan. 12, 1996.

St. Norbert is 5-19-4 in its last 28 games when allowing five goals or more dating back to the 1996-97 season. The only wins were a 9-5 win over St. Scholastica on Feb. 20, 1999, a 7-5 win over UW-Stout on Nov. 30, 2001, an 8-5 win over UW-Stout on Jan. 14, 2005, a 7-5 win over UW-Stevens Point on Feb. 3, 2007 and a 7-5 win over

Gustavus Adolphus on Oct. 31, 2008.

The Green Knights have allowed five goals just 13 times in their last 283 games.

Ice Chips:

- * St. Norbert's scoring defense of 1.71 goals per game is still tied for the NCAA Division III lead with Oswego State.
- * Goaltender B.J. O'Brien is fourth in the NCAA Division III in goals against average at 1.76. Castleton State's Erick Cinotti currently leads Division III at 1.36.
- * St. Norbert's penalty kill of 89.2 percent this season is currently fourth in Division III. Milwaukee School of Engineering leads with a 91.8 percent kill.
- * In the eight games since returning from the holiday break, St. Norbert's power play is 8-for-28 (28.6 percent).
