Game Overview:

St. Norbert hosts a semifinal-round game in the NCHA Peters Cup Playoffs when it entertains UW-River Falls. The Green Knights had a quarterfinal-round bye while the sixth-seeded Falcons toppled third-seeded UW-Stout in a mini-game to advance.

The Series:

St. Norbert leads the series with UW-River Falls 35-16-2. The Green Knights are 31-4-1 against River Falls in their last 36 meetings. St. Norbert is 19-0 against the Falcons at home during that stretch. River Falls is 1-20 all-time at the Cornerstone Community Center, and is 0-17 all-time there against St. Norbert. The Falcons' last road against St. Norbert came in a 2-1 overtime triumph on Feb. 7, 1998 at the De Pere Ice Arena.

1999-2000 but was eliminated in the semifinals at the De Pere Ice Arena in a mini-game by UW-Superior. The Green Knights were seeded second in 2007 but hosted the championship after top-seeded River Falls lost in the semifinals.

Including Saturday's game with UW-River Falls, St. Norbert has played 36 of the last 38 NCHA Peters Cup Playoff rounds it has played in on home ice. The Green Knights are 48-12-1 all-time in the NCHA Peters Cup Playoffs, and are 47-7 at home all-time in the Peters Cup tournament. St. Norbert has played only away series against UW-River Falls (twice) and UW-Stevens Point and UW-Superior on the all-time in Peters Cup play - going 1-5-1 in those games.

Iron Men:

Senior forward Scott Pulak became the 20th skater in St. Norbert history to appear in at least 110 career games for the Green Knights when he took the ice against UW-Eau Claire on Jan. 29. Pulak has played in 114 games.

Senior defenseman Nick Tabisz became the 21st skater to reach the 110-games mark for his career against UW-Superior on Feb. 4. Tabisz has played in 112 games. Fellow senior blueliner Adam Hammerbeck is one games short of becoming the 22nd member of the club at 109 career games.

Rob Smillie, Shane Dickson and Jason Deitsch hold the school record with 122 games played. Steven Sleep just missed tying the mark at 121.

Only 11 skaters have reached 115 games played in St. Norbert history.

Passing Peters:

St. Norbert head coach Tim Coghlin has achieved a historic milestone - the winningest coach in Northern Collegiate Hockey Association history.

Coghlin enters this weekend with a 375-99-39 record with the Green Knights as members of the NCHA. St. Norbert went 10-9-1 as an independent in Coghlin's first year.

Coghlin's record passed the previ-

ous NCHA mark of Bemidji State's Bob Peters, who went 370-134-36 in 1982 and 1984-99. Peters is the namesake of the NCHA's post-season championship trophy - the Peters Cup.

Coghlin, who set the record with a 5-4 win over UW-Superior on Jan. 21, was honored by the NCHA and St. Norbert College on the ice prior to a 2-1 win over UW-Stevens Point on Jan. 27 at the Cornerstone Community Center.

Only five other coaches have at least 200 wins while coaching in the NCHA: River Falls' Steve Freeman is third at 276-134-31, former UW-Stevens Point coach Joe Baldarotta is fourth at 265-171-38, Superior's Steve Nelson is fifth at 249-168-21 while his successor, Dan Stauber, recently joined the 200-win club and is 207-74-42 in 11 seasons. Mankato State's Don Brose seventh at 200-110-34.

Mr. Clutch:

Junior forward Johan Ryd netted the game-winning goal on a marker with 41 seconds remaining in a 2-1 win over UW-Stevens Point on Jan. 27 at the Cornerstone Community Center.

That score was Ryd's then-seventh goal of the season, but was his sixth game-winning goal of the year. His six game-winning goals currently leads NCAA Division III skaters.

The game-winning goal matched the St. Norbert season record and joins some select company in doing so. Rob Smillie set the mark in 1997-98 and Connor Hughes tied the record in 2005-06. Smillie and Hughes are second and sixth on St. Norbert's career scoring list, respectively.

Ryd's other game-winning goals this season came against UW-Stout (Oct. 30), UW-Stevens Point (Nov. 12 and 13), Concordia-Moorhead (Jan. 8) and UW-Superior (Jan. 21).

The NCAA Division III record for game-winning goals in a season is nine, set by UW-Stevens Point's Paul Caufield in 1990-91 and matched by St. Thomas' Steve Aronson in 1999-2000.

Ryd has eight career game-winners out of 20 total career goals. Smillie and Hughes hold the St. Norbert career record in that category at 13.

Poll Position:

St. Norbert has been ranked in the USCHO.com Division III Poll for 168 consecutive weeks. The Green Knights had been ranked third in the first four USCHO polls this season before moving up to second for three weeks. St. Norbert, which had been ranked No. 1 for two weeks, moved back to No. 2 the last six weeks. The Green Knights have been ranked in 206 of 210 polls conducted since its inception at the start of the 1998-99 season - the most of any school in Division III.

The Green Knights are 2-1 against ranked teams this season after losing 4-3 to then-No. 15 Hamline on Nov. 5. St. Norbert then swept No. 10 UW-Stevens Point 3-2 and 2-0 on Nov. 12-13.

During the 168-week stretch of being ranked, St. Norbert has been No. 1 for 45 weeks - second only to Norwich's 48. St. Norbert was rated No. 1 in the 2003, 2004, 2005, 2007 and 2008 final polls. The Green Knights are 65-12-5 all-time when ranked No. 1.

St. Norbert was 4-7-1 against ranked foes in 2008-09 but finished 10-2-1 against ranked teams in 2009-10. St. Norbert is 87-36-13 against teams ranked in the USCHO.com Poll under Tim Coghlin. The Green Knights are 0-4 all-time against the No. 1-ranked team and are 3-5 all-time against the No. 2-ranked team.

One-Goal Observations:

St. Norbert is 7-2 this season in one-goal games after beating UW-Stevens Point 2-1 on Jan. 27 at the Cornerstone Community Center. Under Tim Coghlin, St. Norbert is 62-51 in one-goal games.

The Green Knights finished 4-2 in one-goal games last season, including going 2-1 in three nailbiters in the NCAA Division III Tournament.

St. Norbert had 11 one-goal games in 2008-09, going 6-5 in those situations en route to a 19-8-1 sea-

son. During the national championship season with a record of 27-1-4 in 2008, the Green Knights were an unblemished 8-0 in one-goal games.

St. Norbert's two one-goal losses this year came 4-3 at Hamline on Nov. 5 and 2-1 at St. Scholastica on Dec. 4.

Home Sweet Cornerstone:

When 14th century poet Dante Alighieri was penning his masterwork *The Divine Comedy* and the immortal line, "All hope abandon ye who enter here," he could have easily been referring to visiting hockey teams at the Cornerstone Community Center.

St. Norbert is 129-8-6 in its last 143 games at the Cornerstone Community Center.

In the last nine seasons, the Green Knights are a sparkling 142-11-8 at the Cornerstone, with three losses and one tie coming to national champion UW-Superior during the 2001-02 season.

All-time, St. Norbert is 151-15-9 at

the Cornerstone Community Center, which includes a 9-4-1 mark there its first season in the building in 2000-01. Under Tim Coghlin, St. Norbert is 229-37-15 at home, which includes games at Brown County Arena, Resch Center and De Pere Ice Arena.

Gimme Five:

St. Norbert is unbeaten in its last 233 games when scoring five goals or more with a 228-0-5 mark since a 7-5 loss to Bemidji State in De Pere on Jan. 12, 1996.

St. Norbert is 5-19-4 in its last 28 games when allowing five goals or more dating back to the 1996-97 season. The only five wins came in a 9-5 win over St. Scholastica on Feb. 20, 1999, a 7-5 win over UW-Stout on Nov. 30, 2001, an 8-5 win over UW-Stout on Jan. 14, 2005, a 7-5 win over UW-Stevens Point on Feb. 3, 2007 and a 7-5 win over Gustavus Adolphus on Oct. 31, 2008.

The Green Knights have allowed five goals just 14 times in their last 287 games.

Ice Chips:

* - St. Norbert's scoring defense of 1.80 goals per game is leading the NCAA Division III. The Green Knights have allowed 45 goals in 25 games. Milwaukee School of Engineering and Oswego State are tied for second at 1.84 goals per game.

* - Goaltender B.J. O'Brien leads the NCAA Division III in goals against average at 1.59. MSOE's Connor Toomey is second in Division III at 1.75.

* - St. Norbert is 16-1 this season when scoring first and is 4-3-1 when it does not.

* - St. Norbert (11-0-0) and Yale (14-0-0) are the only two teams in all of collegiate hockey who are unbeaten and untied at home this season.
