Game Overview:

The winner of this NCAA Division III Tournament quarterfinal game will head to the Frozen Four on March 25-26 in Minneapolis. The Green Knights are searching for their seventh Frozen Four appearance, while Hamline is aiming for its first.

The Series:

St. Norbert leads the series with Hamline 8-3-1. The Green Knights and Pipers split weekend series in 1990-91 and 1991-92. St. Norbert had won the last six games before a 1-1 tie last season. The Pipers then claimed a 4-3 win at Drake Arena over the Green Knights earlier this season on Nov. 5. Brian Arrigoni and Chris Berenguer scored twice for the Pipers, who were outshot 41-18. Beau Christian made 38 saves for Hamline.

The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Tim Coghlin (UW-Stevens Point, 1989) is 387-108-40 in his 18th season in De Pere. The Green Knights are 243-39-23 in the last nine-plus seasons. Coghlin's 377 wins as a coach in the NCHA has passed Bemidji State's Bob Peters' previous record of 370 (St. Norbert did not play in the NCHA in Coghlin's first year).

Hamline coach Scott Bell (Minnesota, 1995) is 76-66-17 in his sixth season in St. Paul.

NCAA Tournament Appearances:

St. Norbert is making its 12th overall NCAA Division III Tournament appearance, all coming within in the last 15 years. The Green Knights are 15-10-1 all-time in NCAA competition and have made six Frozen Fours. St. Norbert won its first national championship in 2008, and was the national runner-up in 2004, 2006 and 2010. Seven of St. Norbert's last eight losses in the NCAA Tournament have come at the hands of the eventual national champion (1999 - Middlebury, 2002 - UW-Superior, 2003 - Norwich, 2004 - Middlebury, 2006 - Middlebury, 2007 - Oswego State, 2010 - Norwich).

Hamline is making its first NCAA Division III Tournament appearance. The Pipers are 1-0 in the tournament after topping UW-Superior 3-2 in overtime in a first-round game on Wednesday night.

About the Green Knights:

St. Norbert is 22-4-1 overall after topping UW-Superior 2-1 last Saturday for the NCHA Peters Cup championship. The Green Knights, ranked No. 1 in the final USCHO.com Division III Poll for the 2011 season, are making their 12th NCAA Division III Tournament appearance.

Junior forward Johan Ryd picked up his seventh game-winning goal of the year against Superior and boosted his team scoring lead to 25 points, owning nine goals and 16 assists. Sophomore forward Cody Keefer has 11 goals and 11 assists for 22 points. Junior forward Seth

Soley has seven goals and 15 assists for 22 points while sophomore forward Kyle Stroh has 11 goals and nine assists for 20 points.

Senior goaltender B.J. O'Brien, the NCHA Player of the Year, owns a 19-2-1 record with 1.62 goals against average and .930 save percentage. Freshman Mike Martin is 3-2 with a 2.18 goals against average and .917 save percentage.

St. Norbert is 25-for-106 (23.6 percent) on the power play and is 92-for-104 (88.5 percent) on the penalty kill.

About the Pipers:

Hamline enters the NCAA Division III Quarterfinals with a 17-6-5 overall record after a 3-2 overtime win over UW-Superior on Wednesday. The Pipers, five years removed from a four-win season, won the Minnesota Intercollegiate Athletic Conference with a 9-3-4 record. Hamline is 5-3-2 in its last 10 games but has won its last four.

Junior forward Brian Arrigoni leads the Pipers in scoring with 19 goals and 18 assists for 37 points. Senior defenseman Chris Berenguer has 13 goals with 19 assists for 32 points, including six game-winning goals. Senior forward Ryan Kupperman has nine goals and 23 assists for 32 points, while senior forward Alex Lundbohm has nine goals and 20 assists for 29 points. Junior forward Jordan VanGilder rounds out the top scorers with 13 goals and 15 assists for 28 points.

Junior goaltender Beau Christian has a 15-4-3 overall record with a 2.37 goals against average and .923 save percentage. Freshman Matt Hemingway is the backup, and he is 2-2-2 with a 2.47 goals against average and .914 save percentage.

Hamline is 20-for-121 (16.5 percent) on the power play and is 110-for-131 (84.0 percent) on the penalty kill.

Iron Men:

Senior forward Scott Pulak became the 12th skater in St. Norbert history to appear in at least 115 career games for the Green Knights when he took the ice

against UW-River Falls on Feb. 26. Pulak has played in 116 games, and in his next game will be tied for ninth on St. Norbert's games played list with Faron Duthie and Maris Ziedins at 117.

Senior defenseman Nick Tabisz became the 13th skater to reach the 115-games mark for his career against UW-Superior on March 5. Fellow senior blueliner Adam Hammerbeck became the 22nd player to reach 110 career games against UW-River Falls on Feb. 26. Hammerbeck has played in 111 games.

Rob Smillie, Shane Dickson and Jason Deitsch hold the school record with 122 games played. Steven Sleep just missed tying the mark at 121.

Only 13 skaters have reached 115 games played in St. Norbert history.

MIAC Minutiae:

St. Norbert has a solid 74-9-4 record against Minnesota Intercollegiate Athletic Conference competition since Tim Coghlin took over the Green Knights' helm in 1993. Two of the losses came in a sweep at St. Mary's in Coghlin's first year of 1993-94.

Since then, the Green Knights are 74-7-4 against the MIAC. The losses came in a 4-3 decision at St. John's on Nov. 24, 2000 and a pair of losses to St. Thomas in the 2004-05 season. The Green Knights also dropped a 7-4 contest to Augsburg during 2005-06, to Gustavus Adolphus in 2007-08, to St. Thomas in 2008-09 and at Hamline earlier in 2010-11. St. Norbert has tied St. Thomas twice and Augsburg and Hamline each once.

At home under Coghlin, St. Norbert is a remarkable 40-2-2 against MIAC foes. The losses came in a 3-2 defeat to St. Thomas in the 2005 NCAA Division III Tournament and to Gustavus Adolphus 4-2 on Nov. 3, 2007.

Passing Peters:

St. Norbert head coach Tim Coghlin has achieved a historic milestone - the winningest coach in Northern Collegiate Hockey

Association history.

Coghlin enters this weekend with a 377-99-39 record with the Green Knights as members of the NCHA. St. Norbert went 10-9-1 as an independent in Coghlin's first year.

Coghlin's record passed the previous NCHA mark of Bemidji State's Bob Peters, who went 370-134-36 in 1982 and 1984-99. Peters is the namesake of the NCHA's post-season championship trophy - the Peters Cup.

Coghlin, who set the record with a 5-4 win over UW-Superior on Jan. 21, was honored by the NCHA and St. Norbert College on the ice prior to a 2-1 win over UW-Stevens Point on Jan. 27 at the Cornerstone Community Center.

Only five other coaches have at least 200 wins while coaching in the NCHA: River Falls' Steve Freeman is third at 276-135-31, former UW-Stevens Point coach Joe Baldarotta is fourth at 265-171-38, Superior's Steve Nelson is fifth at 249-168-21 while his successor, Dan Stauber, recently joined the 200-win club and is 208-76-42 in 11 seasons. Mankato State's Don Brose seventh at 200-110-34.

Mr. Clutch:

Junior forward Johan Ryd netted the game-winning goal in a 2-1 win over UW-Superior for the NCHA Peters Cup championship on March 5 at the Cornerstone Community Center.

That score was Ryd's ninth goal of the season, but was his seventh game-winning goal of the year. His six game-winning goals currently leads NCAA Division III skaters.

The game-winning goal set a new St. Norbert season record and passed some select company in doing so. Rob Smillie set the previous mark of six in 1997-98 and Connor Hughes tied the record in 2005-06. Smillie and Hughes are second and sixth on St. Norbert's career scoring list, respectively.

Ryd's other game-winning goals this season came against UW-Stout (Oct. 30), UW-Stevens Point (Nov. 12 and 13), Concordia-Moorhead (Jan. 8), UW-Superior (Jan. 21) and

The NCAA Division III record for game-winning goals in a season is nine, set by UW-Stevens Point's Paul Caufield in 1990-91 and matched by St. Thomas' Steve Aronson in 1999-2000. Only seven players in Division III history have at least eight game-winning goals in a season, with the last to achieve the feat being Oswego State's Mike Lukajic in 2004.

Ryd has nine career game-winners out of 21 total career goals. Smillie and Hughes hold the St. Norbert career record in that category at 13.

Tough After Two:

This season, St. Norbert has continued its long-standing tradition of being tough to beat when leading after two periods. The Green Knights are 18-1-1 this year when leading after the first 40 minutes of action. St. Norbert had a 1-0 lead turn into a 2-1 loss at on Dec. 4 at St. Scholastica and a 3-2 edge end in a 3-3 stalemate on Jan. 29 at UW-Eau Claire.

Under Tim Coghlin, St. Norbert is an astounding 211-1-2 at home when up after two periods. The Green Knights are 12-0 at the Cornerstone Community Center this season when leading after 40 minutes.

St. Norbert had a home unbeaten streak when leading after two periods of 200 games (197-0-3) before it was snapped by UW-Stout in a 4-3 overtime loss on Feb. 7, 2009 - Coghlin's only home setback when leading after two.

At home, St. Norbert is 229-2-3 in school history when leading after two periods. The Green Knights' lone other loss when up after two periods on their own ice came on Nov. 18, 1989 in a 3-1 loss to Augsburg when St. Norbert lost a 1-0 lead.

St. Norbert had an overall 247-game unbeaten streak (240-0-7) when leading after two periods stretching over almost 12 years until St. Scholastica beat the Green Knights 3-2 on Jan. 19, 2007. It was the Green Knights' first loss in such

a situation since a 5-4 overtime loss at UW-Eau Claire on Jan. 21, 1995.

St. Norbert is 0-3 this season when trailing after two periods. It is 4-0 when tied after two.

Poll Position:

St. Norbert has been ranked in the USCHO.com Division III Poll for 170 consecutive weeks. The Green Knights had been ranked third in the first four USCHO polls this season before moving up to second for three weeks. St. Norbert, which had been ranked No. 1 for two weeks, moved back to No. 2 the last six weeks and has now moved back into the No. 1 spot the final two weeks of the season. The Green Knights have been ranked in 208 of 212 polls conducted since its inception at the start of the 1998-99 season - the most of any school in Division III.

The Green Knights are 3-1 against ranked teams this season after losing 4-3 to then-No. 15 Hamline on Nov. 5. St.

Norbert then swept No. 10 UW-Stevens Point 3-2 and 2-0 on Nov. 12-13 and beat No. 15 UW-Superior 2-1 on March 5.

During the 170-week stretch of being ranked, St. Norbert has been No. 1 for 47 weeks - second only to Norwich's 48. St. Norbert was rated No. 1 in the 2003, 2004, 2005, 2007, 2008 and 2011 final polls. The Green Knights are 66-12-5 all-time when ranked No. 1.

St. Norbert was 4-7-1 against ranked foes in 2008-09 but finished 10-2-1 against ranked teams in 2009-10. St. Norbert is 88-36-13 against teams ranked in the USCHO.com Poll under Tim Coghlin. The Green Knights are 0-4 all-time against the No. 1-ranked team and are 3-5 all-time against the No. 2-ranked team.

One-Goal Observations:

St. Norbert is 8-2 this season in one-goal games after beating UW-Superior 2-1 on March 5 at the Cornerstone

Community Center. Under Tim Coghlin, St. Norbert is 63-51 in one-goal games.

The Green Knights finished 4-2 in one-goal games in 2010, including going 2-1 in three nailbiters in the NCAA Division III Tournament.

St. Norbert had 11 one-goal games in 2008-09, going 6-5 in those situations en route to a 19-8-1 season. During the national championship season with a record of 27-1-4 in 2008, the Green Knights were an unblemished 8-0 in one-goal games.

St. Norbert's two one-goal losses this year came 4-3 at Hamline on Nov. 5 and 2-1 at St. Scholastica on Dec. 4.

Home Sweet Cornerstone:

When 14th century poet Dante Alighieri was penning his masterwork *The Divine Comedy* and the immortal line, "All hope abandon ye who enter here," he could have easily been referring to visiting hockey teams at the
