St. Norbert College Green Knights Hockey Preview NCAA DIVISION III FROZEN FOUR

Frozen Four Overview:

The hockey hotbed of Minnesota hosts the NCAA Division III Frozen Four for the first time since 1993 as four teams collide at Ridder Arena to determine the 2011 NCAA Division III champion. St. Norbert is aiming for its second national title in four years, capturing the crown in Lake Placid, N.Y., in 2008. The final four teams are all teams ranked in the top five in the final U.S. College Hockey Online Division III Poll for 2011. St. Norbert, Norwich and Oswego State all played in the 2010 Frozen Four, while Adrian is making its first Frozen Four appearance.

The Series:

Norwich leads St. Norbert 3-1 in the all-time series. The Green Knights' only win came in a 3-0 triumph in the 2008 NCAA national semifinals at Herb Brooks Arena. The Cadets picked up a 5-2 win at the Cornerstone Community Center on Dec. 1, 2000. Norwich also won a NCAA national semifinal game by a 6-3 score on March 21, 2003 at Kreitzberg Arena. Norwich won the 2010 national championship game 2-1 in double overtime despite St. Norbert goaltender B.J. O'Brien turning away 70 shots.

Oswego State leads St. Norbert in the all-time series 2-1. The Lakers topped the Green Knights 4-3 in overtime in a NCAA Division III Frozen Four semifinal on March 17, 2007 at Wessman Arena in Superior. Oswego also topped St. Norbert 4-3 on Nov. 28, 2008 at the Cornerstone Community Center in Green Bay. The Green Knights topped the Lakers for the first time in a thrilling 4-3 NCAA semifinal on March 19, 2010 in Lake Placid, N.Y., on a goal by Cody Keefer with 39 seconds left.

St. Norbert leads Adrian 1-0 in the all-time series. The Green Knights topped the Bulldogs 4-3 in a NCAA Division III first-round game on March 10, 2010 at the Cornerstone Community Center in Green Bay.

The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Tim Coghlin (UW-Stevens Point, 1989) is 388-108-40 in his 18th season in De Pere. The Green Knights are 244-39-23 in the last nine-plus seasons. Coghlin's 378 wins as a coach in the NCHA has passed Bemidji State's Bob Peters' previous record of 370 (St. Norbert did not play in the NCHA in Coghlin's first year). He was the captain of UW-Stevens Point's 1989 national champion.

Oswego State coach Ed Gosek (Oswego State, 1983) is 163-46-14 in his eighth season in Oswego. His 2007 team won the NCAA Division III championship.

Norwich coach Mike McShane

(New Hampshire, 1971) is 342-95-24 in his 16th season in Northfield. In 30 years of collegiate coaching he is 584-313-55 overall. He spent six years at St. Lawrence with two NCAA Division I tournament berths and was at Providence for nine years with three NCAA tournament bids. His 2000, 2003 and 2010 teams won NCAA Division III championships.

Adrian coach Ron Fogarty (Colgate, 1995) is 101-12-2 in his fourth season in Adrian.

NCAA Tournament Appearances:

St. Norbert is making its 12th overall NCAA Division III Tournament appearance, all coming within in the last 15 years. The Green Knights are 16-10-1 all-time in NCAA competition and have made seven Frozen Fours. St. Norbert won its first national championship in 2008, and was the national runner-up in 2004, 2006 and 2010. Seven of St. Norbert's last eight losses in the NCAA Tournament have come at the hands of the eventual national champion (1999 - Middlebury, 2002 - UW-Superior, 2003 - Norwich, 2004 - Middlebury, 2006 - Middlebury, 2007 - Oswego State, 2010 - Norwich). Every team that has eliminated St. Norbert from an NCAA Tournament has reached the national championship game.

Norwich is making its 12th NCAA Division III Tournament appearance and its ninth trip to the Frozen Four. Norwich is 21-9-2 all-time in the NCAA Tournament. The Cadets won national championships in 2000, 2003 and 2010.

Oswego State is making its tenth NCAA Division III Tournament appearance and its fifth trip to the Frozen Four. The Lakers are 10-13 all-time in the tournament and won the national championship in 2007.

Adrian is making its seconds NCAA Division III Tournament appearance and its first visit to the Frozen Four. The Bulldogs are 1-1 all-time in the tournament.

About the Green Knights:

St. Norbert enters the Frozen

Four at 23-4-1 overall, the ninth time in 10 seasons the Green Knights have won at least 23 games. The Green Knights, ranked No. 1 in the final USCHO.com Division III Poll for the 2011 season, are making their seventh NCAA Division III Frozen Four appearance after dispatching Hamline 4-0 on March 12 at the Cornerstone Community Center.

Junior forward Johan Ryd owns the team scoring lead with 25 points, netting nine goals and 16 assists. Seven of his goals have gone for game-winning scores. Sophomore forward Cody Keefer has 11 goals and 13 assists for 24 points, while junior forward Seth Soley has eight goals and 15 assists for 23 points. Sophomore forward Kyle Stroh has 11 goals and nine assists for 20 points, and senior forward Scott Pulak has four goals and 16 assists for 20 points.

Senior goaltender B.J. O'Brien, the NCHA Player of the Year, owns a 20-2-1 record with 1.55 goals against average and .933 save percentage. Freshman Mike Martin is 3-2 with a 2.18 goals against average and .917 save percentage.

St. Norbert is 26-for-110 (23.6 percent) on the power play and is 95-for-107 (88.8 percent) on the penalty kill.

with a 22-5-3 record and ranked No. 2 in the final USCHO.com Division III Poll. The Cadets have won 10 straight games and are 16-1-2 in their last 19 outings since a 6-4-1 start. Norwich topped Curry 5-1 in a NCAA Division III Tournament first-round game on March 9 before knocking off Plattsburgh State 3-2 in overtime on the road in a quarter-final game on March 12.

Sophomore forward Scott Schroeder leads Norwich in scoring with 20 goals and 19 assists for 39 points. Freshman forward Travis Janke has 11 goals and 26 assists for 37 points, and has not taken a penalty this season. Sophomore forward Pier-Olivier Cotnoir, who scored the game-winning goal in last year's national championship game, has 20 goals and 16 assists for 36 points. Senior forward Chad Anderson adds 11 goals and 20 assists for 31 points.

Freshman goaltender Parker Carroll is unbeaten on the year at 14-0-2 with a 1.75 goals against average and .903 save percentage. Sophomore Alex Dubois is 8-5-1 with a 2.40 goals against average and .892 save percentage.

Norwich is 33-for-129 (25.6 percent) on the power play and is 84-for-104 (80.8 percent) on the penalty kill.

NCAA Tournament Winning Streaks

Norwich enters the 2011 NCAA Division III Frozen Four with an active six-game winning streak in NCAA Tournament play, tied for the fourth-longest in the 28-year history of the tournament. St. Norbert had a six-game winning streak snapped by the Cadets in the 2010 national title game. Only eight winning streaks of at least six games have occurred in NCAA history play, and only three since the advent of single-elimination play in 2003. Four of the previous seven streaks have been stopped by West Region schools, including Middlebury's record 16-game skein in a 4-2 loss to St. Norbert on March 12, 1999 in De Pere.

Four with a 23-4 record and ranked No. 3 in the final USCHO.com Division III Poll. The Lakers, who beat Bowdoin 7-5 in NCAA Division III Tournament quarterfinal game on March 12, are 3-2 in their last five games. Oswego lost to Fredonia State 2-1 in overtime in the semifinals of the SUNYAC Playoffs on Feb. 26.

Junior forward Ian Boots leads Oswego in scoring with 14 goals and 23 assists for 37 points. Senior forward Justin Fox has 10 goals and 22 assists for 32 points, with eight of his goals coming on the power play. Sophomore forward Luke Moodie has 14 goals and 16 assists for 30 points. Sophomore forward Jon Whitelaw adds 12 goals and 16 assists for 28 points.

Junior goaltender Paul Beckwith is 19-2 this season with a 1.93 goals against average and .929 save percentage. Sophomore Dan Jones is the backup, going 3-1 with a 1.68 goals against average and .944 save percentage.

Oswego is 37-for-147 (25.2 percent) on the power play and is 112-for-131 (85.5 percent) on the penalty kill.

About the Bulldogs:

In just its fourth season of varsity hockey, Adrian finds itself in the Frozen Four. The Bulldogs own a 24-3-1 record and are ranked fifth in the final USCHO.com Division III Poll. Adrian topped Elmira 5-3 in a NCAA Division III quarterfinal on March 12.

Senior forward Shawn Skelly has 19 goals and 26 assists for 45 points, and he has 100 goals and 126 assists for 226 points in his career. Senior forward Eric Miller has exactly 200 career points (88-112-200) and has 18 goals and 26 assists for 44 points this season. Sophomore forward Zach Graham and senior forward Brad Houston each have 14 goals and 21 assists for 35 points, while senior forward Mike Dahlinger has 12 goals and 23 assists for 35 points.

Senior goaltender Brad Fogal passed St. Norbert's Kyle Jones as the winningest goaltender in NCAA Division III history with 92

career wins to Jones' 87. Fogal is 24-3-1 this season with a 2.13 goals against average and .924 save percentage.

Adrian is 44-for-148 (29.7 percent) on the power play and is 151-for-169 (89.3 percent) on the penalty kill.

1 vs. 2:

This year's national semifinal game against Norwich marks the fifth time since the start of the USCHO.com Division III Poll in 1998-99 that St. Norbert will be involved in a No. 1 vs. No. 2 matchup. All five have come in the NCAA Division III Frozen Four. St. Norbert is 1-3 in the four games.

The St. Norbert-Norwich game marks the fourth time the Green Knights will be the No. 1-ranked team played the No. 2. The Green Knights are 1-2 in those games. St. Norbert beat Plattsburgh State 2-0 for the 2008 national championship in its most recent 1-2 battle. St. Norbert lost to Middlebury 1-0 in overtime in the 2004

national title game at Norwich. The Green Knights also lost at Norwich 6-3 in a 2003 national semifinal game.

In its only time ranked No. 2 taking on No. 1, St. Norbert lost to Middlebury 3-0 in the 2006 national title game at First Arena in Elmira, N.Y.

Eastern Eavesdroppings:

St. Norbert is 22-17-4 all-time against East Region opponents. The Green Knights have played at least one game a season against an eastern foe for the past 16 years.

The Green Knights are 9-3-1 all-time against the State University of New York Athletic Conference, including a 2-0 mark against Plattsburgh State and an 1-2 ledger against Oswego State.

St. Norbert is 6-5-3 all-time against ECAC West opposition (including games against now-Division I RIT and Mercyhurst), and is 3-5 all-time against the NESCAC.

The Green Knights are 2-0 all-time

against the ECAC Northeast, also beating Fitchburg State in the 1994-95 season.

St. Norbert is 2-3 against the ECAC East, going 1-3 against Norwich and 1-0 against Southern Maine.

Western Wonders:

The Northern Collegiate Hockey Association has placed a representative in the NCAA Division III championship game 17 out of a possible 27 times. St. Norbert has made four title game appearances, in 2004, 2006, 2008 and 2010. Bemidji State did it twice (1985-86), UW-River Falls three times (1988, '93, '94), UW-Stevens Point six times (1989-93, '98), Mankato State once (1991) and UW-Superior four times (1994, '97, '99, 2002). NCHA teams have squared off for the national championship three times (1991 - Stevens Point vs. Mankato State, 1993 - Stevens Point vs. River Falls, 1994 - River Falls vs. Superior).

UW-Stevens Point (1989, '90, '91, '93), UW-River Falls (1988, '94), Bemidji State (1986), UW-Superior (2002) and St. Norbert (2008) have all won Division III national titles while members of the NCHA.

In 27 NCAA Division III Frozen Fours, the NCHA has placed a team among the final four 25 years - the most of any league. The NCHA did not advance a team through to the Frozen Four in 1984 and 2005. River Falls lost to Union in the 1984 quarterfinals and St. Norbert lost to St. Thomas in the 2005 quarterfinals.

Twenty Talk:

St. Norbert's 3-1 win at UW-Stevens Point on Feb. 11 marked the 13th time in 15 years the Green Knights have won at least 20 games in a season. Saturday's NCAA Tournament win over Hamline marked the ninth time in ten years the Green Knights have won at least 23 games.

The Green Knights' first 20-win season came in a 21-9-1 campaign in 1996-97. The only two seasons since then where St. Norbert hasn't won at least 20 games were near-miss years of 18-8-3 in 2000-01 and 19-8-1 in 2008-09.

Go West, Young Man:

For only the eighth time in the 28-year history of the Division III Frozen Four, the NCAA is following Horace Greeley's advice and locating the championship in the West Region.

This year's tournament marks the first time since 1993 the Division III Frozen Four will be played in Minnesota, and only the second time ever in the Gopher State. Aldrich Arena in Maplewood hosted the event as a neutral site, with UW-Stevens Point beating UW-River Falls in overtime for the national title.

UW-Superior's Wessman Arena hosted the last two Frozen Fours out west in 2000 and 2007. Wessman Arena also hosted the tournament in 1994.

UW-River Falls' Hunt Arena hosted the 1996 Frozen Four, and Bemidji State's Glas Field House

Iron Men:

Senior forward Scott Pulak became the 12th skater in St. Norbert history to appear in at least 115 career games for the Green Knights when he took the ice against UW-River Falls on Feb. 26. Pulak has played in 117 games, tied for ninth on St. Norbert's games played list with Faron Duthie and Maris Ziedins. St. Norbert would have to reach the national championship game to reach a tie for sixth all-time in games played with Marc Belanger, Scott Jewitt and Ryan Petersen.

Senior defenseman Nick Tabisz became the 13th skater to reach the 115-games mark for his career against UW-Superior on March 5. Fellow senior blueliner Adam Hammerbeck became the 22nd player to reach 110 career games

against UW-River Falls on Feb. 26. Hammerbeck has played in 112 games.

Rob Smillie, Shane Dickson and Jason Deitsch hold the school record with 122 games played. Steven Sleep just missed tying the mark at 121.

Only 13 skaters have reached 115 games played in St. Norbert history.

Passing Peters:

St. Norbert head coach Tim Coghlin has achieved a historic milestone - the winningest coach in Northern Collegiate Hockey Association history.

Coghlin enters this weekend with a 378-99-39 record with the Green Knights as members of the NCHA. St. Norbert went 10-9-1 as an independent in Coghlin's first year.

Coghlin's record passed the previous NCHA mark of Bemidji State's Bob Peters, who went 370-134-36 in 1982 and 1984-99. Peters is the namesake of the NCHA's post-season championship trophy - the Peters Cup.

Coghlin, who set the record with a 5-4 win over UW-Superior on Jan. 21, was honored by the NCHA and St. Norbert College on the ice prior to a 2-1 win over UW-Stevens Point on Jan. 27 at the Cornerstone Community Center.

Only five other coaches have at least 200 wins while coaching in the NCHA: River Falls' Steve Freeman is third at 276-135-31, former UW-Stevens Point coach Joe Baldarotta is fourth at 265-171-38, Superior's Steve Nelson is fifth at 249-168-21 while his successor, Dan Stauber, recently joined the 200-win club and is 208-76-42 in 11 seasons. Mankato State's Don Brose seventh at 200-110-34.

O'Brien Observations:

Senior goaltender B.J. O'Brien has fashioned another stellar season and was named the Player of the Year in the Northern Collegiate Hockey Association as a result.

O'Brien has appeared in 23 of St. Norbert's 28 games this season, allowing only 35 goals on 520 shots for a .933 save percentage. His goals against average is 1.55 and he is 20-2-1 overall.

O'Brien, a Lakeville, Minn., native, has fashioned four shutouts this season, blanking UW-Stevens Point (25 saves), Lawrence (31), UW-Superior (19) and Hamline (21). O'Brien has also lost three shutouts in the final minutes of games this season.

In the NCAA Division III national statistical rankings heading into the Frozen Four, O'Brien leads three major categories. His 1.55 goals against average is well ahead of Norwich's Parker Carroll, whose 1.75 is second. Oswego State's Paul Beckwith, also in the tournament, is third at 1.93.

O'Brien, who made an NCAA Division III Tournament-record 70 saves in last year's 2-1 double-overtime title game loss to Norwich in Lake Placid, N.Y., also has the top save percentage nationally at .933. Fitchburg State's Bobby Leiser is second at .931. Elmira's Darren McDonald is third at .930 and Beckwith fourth at .929.

O'Brien is part of a four-way tie for the national lead in shutouts with four. Carroll, UW-Stout's Tom Lescovich and Milwaukee School of Engineering's Connor Toomey all share the top spot.

Ryd Ravishings:

Junior forward Johan Ryd netted the game-winning goal in a 2-1 win over UW-Superior for the NCHA Peters Cup championship on March 5 at the Cornerstone Community Center.

That score was Ryd's ninth goal of the season, but was his seventh game-winning goal of the year. His seven game-winning goals currently leads NCAA Division III skaters, and he has clinched the national statistical title in that category for 2011.

The seven game-winning goals set a new St. Norbert season record and passed some select company in doing so. Rob Smillie set the previous mark of six in 1997-98 and Connor Hughes tied the record in 2005-06. Smillie and Hughes are second and sixth on St. Norbert's career scoring list, respectively.

Ryd's other game-winning goals this season came against UW-Stout (Oct. 30), UW-Stevens Point (Nov. 12 and 13), Concordia-Moorhead (Jan. 8), UW-Superior (Jan. 21) and UW-Stevens Point (Jan. 27).

The NCAA Division III record for game-winning goals in a season is nine, set by UW-Stevens Point's Paul Caufield in 1990-91 and matched by St. Thomas' Steve Aronson in 1999-2000. Only seven players in Division III history have at least eight game-winning goals in a season, with the last to achieve the feat being Oswego State's Mike Lukajic in 2004.

Ryd has nine career game-winners out of 21 total career goals. Smillie and Hughes hold the St. Norbert career record in that category at 13.

Ryd also has St. Norbert's longest consecutive game scoring streak this year at 11. Ryd scored four goals and 10 assists for 14 points from the 3-1 season-opening win against UW-Stout to a 6-1 win over St. Scholastica on Dec. 3.

D is for Defense:

St. Norbert enters the Frozen Four leading the NCAA Division III in scoring defense at 1.75 goals per game. The Green Knights have yielded just 49 goals in 28 games this season. Oswego State is second at 1.96 goals per game (53 in 27).

If the Green Knights again lead the country in defense this season, it will mark the third time in the last five years they have been the stingiest defensive team in the nation. The Green Knights allowed 1.81 goals per game in 2007 (56 in 31) and set a Division III record the next season with a miserly 1.34 (43 in 32).

St. Norbert has allowed three or more goals just nine times this season and four or more only three times.

Tough After Two:

This season, St. Norbert has continued its long-standing tradition of being tough to beat when leading after two periods. The Green Knights are 19-1-1 this year when leading after the first 40 minutes of action. St. Norbert had a 1-0 lead turn into a 2-1 loss at on Dec. 4 at St. Scholastica and a 3-2 edge end in a 3-3 stalemate on Jan. 29 at UW-Eau Claire.

Under Tim Coghlin, St. Norbert is an astounding 212-1-2 at home when up after two periods. The Green Knights are 13-0 at the Cornerstone Community Center this season when leading after 40 minutes.

St. Norbert had a home unbeaten streak when leading after two periods of 200 games (197-0-3) before it was snapped by UW-Stout in a 4-3 overtime loss on Feb. 7, 2009 - Coghlin's only home setback when leading after two.

At home, St. Norbert is 230-2-3 in school history when leading after two periods. The Green Knights' lone other loss when up after two periods on their own ice came on Nov. 18, 1989 in a 3-1 loss to Augsburg when St. Norbert lost a 1-0 lead.

St. Norbert had an overall 247-game unbeaten streak (240-0-7) when leading after two periods stretching over almost 12 years until St. Scholastica beat the Green Knights 3-2 on Jan. 19, 2007. It was the Green Knights' first loss in such a situation since a 5-4 over-

time loss at UW-Eau Claire on Jan. 21, 1995.

St. Norbert is 0-3 this season when trailing after two periods. It is 4-0 when tied after two.

Poll Position:

St. Norbert has been ranked in the USCHO.com Division III Poll for 170 consecutive weeks. The Green Knights had been ranked third in the first four USCHO polls this season before moving up to second for three weeks. St. Norbert, which had been ranked No. 1 for two weeks, moved back to No. 2 the last six weeks and has now moved back into the No. 1 spot the final two weeks of the season. The Green Knights have been ranked in 208 of 212 polls conducted since its inception at the start of the 1998-99 season - the most of any school in Division III.

The Green Knights are 4-1 against ranked teams this season after losing 4-3 to then-No. 15 Hamline on Nov. 5. St. Norbert then swept No. 10 UW-Stevens Point 3-2 and 2-0 on Nov. 12-13, beat No. 15 UW-Superior 2-1 on March 5 and No. 9 Hamline 4-0 on March 12.

During the 170-week stretch of being ranked, St. Norbert has been No. 1 for 47 weeks - second only to Norwich's 48. St. Norbert was rated No. 1 in the 2003, 2004, 2005, 2007, 2008 and 2011 final polls. The Green Knights are 66-12-5 all-time when ranked No. 1.

St. Norbert was 4-7-1 against ranked foes in 2008-09 but finished 10-2-1 against ranked teams in 2009-10. St. Norbert is 89-36-13 against teams ranked in the USCHO.com Poll under Tim Coghlin. The Green Knights are 0-4 all-time against the No. 1-ranked team and are 3-5 all-time against the No. 2-ranked team.

One-Goal Observations:

St. Norbert is 8-2 this season in one-goal games after beating UW-Superior 2-1 on March 5 at the Cornerstone Community Center. Under Tim Coghlin, St. Norbert is 63-51 in one-goal games.

The Green Knights finished 4-2 in one-goal games in 2010, including going 2-1 in three nailbiters in the NCAA Division III Tournament.

St. Norbert had 11 one-goal games in

2008-09, going 6-5 in those situations en route to a 19-8-1 season. During the national championship season with a record of 27-1-4 in 2008, the Green Knights were an unblemished 8-0 in one-goal games.

St. Norbert's two one-goal losses this year came 4-3 at Hamline on Nov. 5 and 2-1 at St. Scholastica on Dec. 4.

Home Sweet Cornerstone:

Although St. Norbert will not have the benefit of home ice at the Frozen Four, it still has a decided advantage over visiting hockey teams at the Cornerstone Community Center.

St. Norbert is 132-8-6 in its last 146 games at the Cornerstone Community Center.

In the last nine seasons, the Green Knights are a sparkling 145-11-8 at the Cornerstone, with three losses and one tie coming to national champion UW-Superior during the 2001-02 season.

All-time, St. Norbert is 154-15-9 at the Cornerstone Community Center, which includes a 9-4-1 mark there its first season in the building in 2000-01. Under Tim Coghlin, St. Norbert is 232-37-15 at home, which includes games at Brown County Arena, Resch Center and De Pere Ice Arena.

Gimme Five:

St. Norbert is unbeaten in its last 234 games when scoring five goals or more with a 229-0-5 mark since a 7-5 loss to Bemidji State in De Pere on Jan. 12, 1996.

St. Norbert is 5-19-4 in its last 28 games when allowing five goals or more dating back to the 1996-97 season. The only five wins came in a 9-5 win over St. Scholastica on Feb. 20, 1999, a 7-5 win over UW-Stout on Nov. 30, 2001, an 8-5 win over UW-Stout on Jan. 14, 2005, a 7-5 win over UW-Stevens Point on Feb. 3, 2007 and a 7-5 win over Gustavus Adolphus on Oct. 31, 2008.

The Green Knights have allowed five goals just 14 times in their last 290 games.
