St. Norbert leads the series with Bethel 19-1 in a series that began during the 1988-89 season. St. Norbert has won the last 19 games, with Bethel's only win an 8-4 triumph in the first series meeting on Feb. 10, 1989.

The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Tim Coghlin (UW-Stevens Point, 1989) is 367-104-39 in his 18th season in De Pere. The Green Knights are 223-35-22 in the last nine-plus seasons. Coghlin's 357 wins as a coach in the NCHA is 13 short of Bemidji State's Bob Peters' record of 370 (St. Norbert did not play in the NCHA in Coghlin's first year).

Hamline coach Scott Bell (Minnesota, 1995) is 61-60-12 in his sixth season in St. Paul.

Bethel coach Charlie Burggraf (North Dakota, 1979) is 0-2 in his first season in Arden Hills.

Last Year:

St. Norbert tied Hamline 1-1 last Nov. 7 at the Cornerstone Community Center in Green Bay. Matt Boyd for St. Norbert and Taylor Vichorek for Hamline had second period goals. B.J. O'Brien made 30 saves for St. Norbert, while Beau Christian made 33 saves for Hamline.

St. Norbert beat Bethel 8-2 last Nov. 6 at the Cornerstone Community Center in Green Bay. Cody Keefer registered four goals and Shane Wheeler had two for the Green Knights, who led 7-1 after two periods. St. Norbert outshot Bethel 45-21.

About the Green Knights:

St. Norbert opened the 2010-11 season last weekend with a two-game sweep of UW-Stout by scores of 3-1 and 6-3 in a Northern Collegiate Hockey Association series at the Cornerstone Community Center.

Senior forward Scott Pulak posted five assists in the series to lead the team in scoring and was named the NCHA Player of the Week in the process. Junior forward Johan Ryd had two goals and two assists for four points, while junior forward Seth Soley had three assists. Senior forward Brandon Longley and sophomore forward Cody Keefer each had a pair of goals.

Senior goaltender B.J. O'Brien played both games in net for the Green Knights and owns a 2-0

record with a 2.00 goals against average and .902 save percentage.

St. Norbert is 2-for-10 (20.0 percent) on the power play and is 4-for-6 (66.7 percent) on the penalty kill.

About the Pipers:

Hamline enters the St. Norbert game with a 2-0 overall record. The Pipers topped St. John's 3-0 and St. Olaf 3-2 in a pair of non-conference games this past Friday and Sunday, respectively. The Pipers were 16-6-4 last season.

Senior defenseman Chris Berenguer, the son of former Minnesota Twins pitcher Juan Berenguer, was a first-team All-America selection last year and has one goal and two assists for three points this season. Senior forward Austun Tavis has two goals for two points, while senior forward Alex Lundbohm has one goal and one assists for two points. Senior forward Kyle Mattson and junior forward Brett Burgau have two assists apiece.

Freshman goaltender Matt Hemingway has played in both games this season, posting a 2-0 record with a 1.00 goals against average and .962 save percentage.

Hamline is 1-for-8 (12.5 percent) on the power play and 15-for-15 (100 percent) on the penalty kill.

About the Royals:

Bethel enters Friday's game with UW-Stevens Point with an 0-2 overall record. The Royals lost to St. Thomas 7-2 and Concordia-Moorhead 6-4 this last weekend at the MIAC Showcase. Bethel was 10-15 last season.

Sophomore forward Jack Paul was Bethel's bright spot last weekend, registering four goals and one assists for five points to factor in on five of the Royals' six goals. Senior forward Christian Fogerty has one goal and one assist for two points, while junior defenseman Mason Swenson has two assists for two points.

Junior goaltender Cary Wood is 0-1 with a 6.02 goals against average and .793 save percentage.

Sophomore Zac Bush is 0-1 with a 7.00 goals against average and .788 save percentage.

MIAC Minutiae:

St. Norbert has a solid 71-8-4 record against Minnesota Intercollegiate Athletic Conference competition since Tim Coghlin took over the Green Knights' helm in 1993. Two of the losses came in a sweep at St. Mary's in Coghlin's first year of 1993-94.

Since then, the Green Knights are 71-6-4 against the MIAC. The losses came in a 4-3 decision at St. John's on Nov. 24, 2000 and a pair of losses to St. Thomas in the 2004-05 season. The Green Knights also dropped a 7-4 contest to Augsburg during 2005-06, to Gustavus Adolphus in 2007-08 and to St. Thomas in 2008-09. St. Norbert has tied St. Thomas twice and Augsburg and Hamline each once.

At home under Coghlin, St. Norbert is a remarkable 38-2-2 against MIAC foes. The losses came in a 3-2 defeat to St. Thomas in the 2005 NCAA Division III Tournament and to Gustavus Adolphus 4-2 on Nov. 3, 2007.

Tough After Two:

St. Norbert has continued its long-standing tradition of being tough to beat when leading after two periods. The Green Knights were 20-0-1 last year when leading after the first 40 minutes of action.

Under Tim Coghlin, St. Norbert is 201-1-2 at home when up after two periods.

St. Norbert had a home unbeaten streak when leading after two periods of 200 games (197-0-3) before it was snapped by UW-Stout in a 4-3 overtime loss on Feb. 7, 2009.

At home, St. Norbert is 219-2-3 in school history when leading after two periods. The Green Knights' lone other loss when up after two periods on their own ice came on Nov. 18, 1989 in a 3-1 loss to Augsburg when St. Norbert lost a 1-0 lead.

St. Norbert had an overall 247-game unbeaten streak (240-0-7) when leading after two periods

stretching over almost 12 years until St. Scholastica beat the Green Knights 3-2 on Jan. 19, 2007. It was the Green Knights' first loss in such a situation since a 5-4 overtime loss at UW-Eau Claire on Jan. 21, 1995.

One-Goal Observations:

St. Norbert had a six one-goal games during the 2009-10 season.

The Green Knights finished 4-2 in one-goal games last season. St. Norbert topped Lawrence 2-1 on Nov. 27 and UW-Eau Claire 3-2 on Jan. 15 while losing to St. Scholastica 4-3 in overtime on Dec. 4. St. Norbert then beat Adrian 4-3 in a first-round NCAA Tournament game on March 10 and topped Oswego State in another 4-3 thriller in the national semifinals. Norwich beat St. Norbert 2-1 in double overtime in the national title game.

St. Norbert had 11 one-goal games in 2008-09, going 6-5 in those situations en route to a 19-8-1 season. During the national championship season with a record of 27-1-4 in 2008, the Green Knights were an unblemished 8-0 in one-goal games.

Under Tim Coghlin, St. Norbert is 55-49 in one-goal games.

St. Norbert was 7-0 last season in games decided by two goals, and was 12-2 in games decided by at least three goals.

Home Sweet Cornerstone:

When 14th century poet Dante Alighieri was penning his masterwork *The Divine Comedy* and the immortal line, "All hope abandon ye who enter here," he could have easily been referring to visiting hockey teams at the Cornerstone Community Center.

St. Norbert is 120-8-6 in its last 134 games at the Cornerstone Community Center.

In the last nine seasons, the Green Knights are a sparkling 133-11-8 at the Cornerstone, with three losses and one tie coming to national champion UW-Superior during the 2001-02 season.

All-time, St. Norbert is 142-15-9 at the Cornerstone Community Center, which includes a 9-4-1 mark

there its first season in the building in 2000-01. Under Tim Coghlin, St. Norbert is 221-37-15 at home, which includes games at Brown County Arena, Resch Center and De Pere Ice Arena.

Poll Position:

St. Norbert has been ranked in the USCHO.com Division III Poll for 157 consecutive weeks.

St. Norbert entered the 2009-10 season at No. 11 before rising to No. 1 on Nov. 9, and remained there for three weeks. The Green Knights are 61-12-5 all-time when ranked No. 1.

During the 157-week stretch of being ranked, St. Norbert has been No. 1 for 43 weeks. St. Norbert was rated No. 1 in the 2003, 2004, 2005, 2007 and 2008 final polls.

St. Norbert was 4-7-1 against ranked foes in 2008-09 but finished 10-2-1 against ranked teams in 2009-10 - going 4-0 against UW-River Falls, 2-0 against UW-Stout, 1-0 against Oswego State, Adrian and Gustavus Adolphus, 1-1-1 versus St. Scholastica and 0-1 against Norwich. St. Norbert is 85-35-13 against teams ranked in the USCHO.com Poll under Tim Coghlin. The Green Knights are 0-4 all-time against the No. 1-ranked team and are 3-5 all-time against the No. 2-ranked team.

Gimme Five:

St. Norbert is unbeaten in its last 226 games when scoring five goals or more with a 221-0-5 mark since a 7-5 loss to Bemidji State in De Pere on Jan. 12, 1996.

St. Norbert is 5-19-4 in its last 28 games when allowing five goals or more dating back to the 1996-97 season. The only wins were a 9-5 win over St. Scholastica on Feb. 20, 1999, a 7-5 win over UW-Stout on Nov. 30, 2001, an 8-5 win over UW-Stout on Jan. 14, 2005, a 7-5 win over UW-Stevens Point on Feb. 3, 2007 and a 7-5 win over Gustavus Adolphus on Oct. 31, 2008.

The Green Knights have allowed five goals just 13 times in their last 265 games.
