#### Series Overview:

St. Norbert hosts UW-River Falls at the Cornerstone Community Center in another important early-season NCHA two-game series. The Green Knights are up two games in the league standings on the Falcons.

#### **Broadcast:**

St. Norbert coverage is on the WSNC radio Webcast with Tim Derozier on the call. The audio Webcast is available at http://www.snc.edu/athletics/hockey/webcast.htm.

#### The Series:

St. Norbert leads the series with UW-River Falls 32-16-2. The Green Knights are 28-4-1 against River Falls in their last 33 meetings. St. Norbert is 17-0 against the Falcons at home during that stretch. River Falls is 1-18 all-time at the Cornerstone Community Center, and is 0-15 all-time there against St. Norbert. River Falls' last win in Brown County came in a 2-1 overtime triumph on Feb. 7, 1998 at the De Pere Ice Arena.

#### The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Tim Coghlin (UW-Stevens Point, 1989) is 370-105-39 in his 18th season in De Pere. The Green Knights are 226-36-22 in the last nine-plus seasons. Coghlin's 360 wins as a coach in the NCHA is 10 short of Bemidji State's Bob Peters' record of 370 (St. Norbert did not play in the NCHA in Coghlin's first year).

UW-River Falls coach Steve Freeman (UW-Stevens Point, 1981) is 267-125-30 in his 15th season in River Falls.

#### **Last Year:**

St. Norbert swept the three-game regular-season series with UW-River Falls by scores of 4-2 and 8-3 on Nov. 20-21 in River Falls and by a 4-0 score on Feb. 13 in Green Bay. The eight goals allowed by River Falls was the most it had given up in a game at Hunt Arena since 1997. Nick Tabisz and Shane Wheeler each scored three goals during the two-game series at River Falls for St. Norbert. B.J. O'Brien made 20 and 22 saves, respectively.

In the game at the Cornerstone Community Center, St. Norbert scored two goals by Tyler Allen and Johan Ryd in the first period to take the lead. B.J. O'Brien made 23 saves for the Green Knights.

The Green Knights also picked up a 7-1 win over River Falls last March 6 for the NCHA Peters Cup Championship. St. Norbert outshot the Falcons 42-11. Seven different St. Norbert players scored goals B.J. O'Brien made 10 saves.

#### **About the Green Knights:**

St. Norbert, ranked third in this week's USCHO.com Division III Poll, is 5-1 overall and 4-0 in the NCHA after sweeping UW-Stevens Point 3-2 and 2-0 in a league series at Willett Arena.

Junior forward Johan Ryd paces the Green Knights offensively with four goals and five assists for nine points. Ryd's two goals against the Pointers were both game-winning goals. Senior forward Scott Pulak has nine assists for nine points, while senior forward Brandon Longley has a team-high six goals for six points. Senior defenseman Nick Tabisz has three goals and three assists for six points.

Senior goaltender B.J. O'Brien owns a 4-1 record with 2.02 goals against average and .905 save percentage, and registered his fifth career shutout with 25 saves Saturday. Freshman Mike Martin is 1-0 with a 2.00 goals against average and .920 save percentage.

St. Norbert is 5-for-24 (20.8 percent) on the power play and is 17-for-22 (77.3 percent) on the penalty kill.

#### **About the Falcons:**

UW-River Falls heads into the Cornerstone Community Center with a 3-3-1 overall record and a 2-2 ledger in the NCHA. The Falcons split with UW-Eau Claire last weekend, winning 3-2 and losing 6-3. River Falls is 1-3-1 in its last five games.

Senior forward Josh Calleja has three goals and six assists for nine points, including two shorthanded goals. Junior forward Justin Brossman has four goals and four assists for eight points, while freshman forward Alec Hagaman has four goals and two assists for six points. Junior forward Ben Beaudoin shares the team lead in goals with four to go along with one assist for five points.

Freshman goaltender Scott Lewan has seen the majority of the action thus far, going 1-2-1 with a 2.85 goals against average and .924 save percentage. Junior Eric Babcook is 2-1 with a 2.48 goals against average and .896 save percentage.

River Falls is 7-for-35 (20.0 percent) on the power play and 39-for-47 (83.0 percent) on the penalty kill.

#### **Chasing Peters:**

St. Norbert head coach Tim Coghlin is just 11 wins away from achieving a historic milestone - the winningest coach in Northern Collegiate Hockey Association history.

Coghlin enters the weekend with a 360-96-38 record with the Green

Knights as members of the NCHA. St. Norbert went 10-9-1 as an independent in Coghlin's first year.

Coghlin's record trails the all-time NCHA mark of Bemidji State's Bob Peters, who went 370-134-36 in 1982 and 1984-99. Peters is the namesake of the NCHA's post-season championship trophy - the Peters Cup.

Only four other coaches have at least 200 wins while coaching in the NCHA: River Falls' Steve Freeman is third at 267-125-30, former UW-Stevens Point coach Joe Baldarotta is fourth at 265-171-38, Superior's Steve Nelson is fifth at 249-168-21 and Mankato State's Don Brose sixth at 200-110-34.

#### **Ryd Report:**

Junior forward Johan Ryd has picked up where he left off from his breakout sophomore campaign from a year ago.

Ryd has scored four goals and five assists for nine points so far this season. Last year, Ryd helped the Green Knights reach the NCAA championship game after pumping in 11 goals and 17 assists for 28 points.

Ryd's three game-winning goals this year are already halfway to the St. Norbert school record of six, shared by Connor Hughes (2005-06) and Rob Smillie (1997-98).

#### **One-Goal Observations:**

St. Norbert is 2-1 this season in one-goal games after beating UW-Stevens Point 3-2 this past Friday.

The Green Knights finished 4-2 in one-goal games last season, including going 2-1 in three nailbiters in the NCAA Division III Tournament.

St. Norbert had 11 one-goal games in 2008-09, going 6-5 in those situations en route to a 19-8-1 season. During the national championship season with a record of 27-1-4 in 2008, the Green Knights were an unblemished 8-0 in one-goal games.

Under Tim Coghlin, St. Norbert is 57-50 in one-goal games.

St. Norbert was 7-0 last season in games decided by two goals, and was 12-2 in games decided by at least three goals.

#### **Home Sweet Cornerstone:**

When 14th century poet Dante Alighieri was penning his masterwork *The Divine Comedy* and the immortal line, "All hope abandon ye who enter here," he could have easily been referring to visiting hockey teams at the Cornerstone Community Center.

St. Norbert is 120-8-6 in its last 134 games at the Cornerstone Community Center.

In the last nine seasons, the Green Knights are a sparkling 133-11-8 at the Cornerstone, with three losses and one tie coming to national champion UW-Superior during the 2001-02 season.

All-time, St. Norbert is 142-15-9 at the Cornerstone Community Center, which includes a 9-4-1 mark there its first season in the building in 2000-01. Under Tim Coghlin, St. Norbert is 221-37-15 at home, which includes games at Brown County Arena, Resch Center and De Pere Ice Arena.

#### **Tough After Two:**

St. Norbert has continued its long-standing tradition of being tough to beat when leading after two periods. The Green Knights are 3-0 this season after going 20-0-1 last year when leading after the first 40 minutes of action.

Under Tim Coghlin, St. Norbert is 201-1-2 at home when up after two periods.

St. Norbert had a home unbeaten streak when leading after two periods of 200 games (197-0-3) before it was snapped by UW-Stout in a 4-3 overtime loss on Feb. 7, 2009.

At home, St. Norbert is 219-2-3 in school history when leading after two periods. The Green Knights' lone other loss when up after two periods on their own ice came on Nov. 18, 1989 in a 3-1 loss to Augsburg when St. Norbert lost a 1-0 lead.

St. Norbert had an overall 247-game unbeaten streak (240-0-7) when leading after two periods stretching over almost 12 years until St. Scholastica beat the Green Knights 3-2 on Jan. 19, 2007. It was

the Green Knights' first loss in such a situation since a 5-4 overtime loss at UW-Eau Claire on Jan. 21, 1995.

#### **Poll Position:**

St. Norbert has been ranked in the USCHO.com Division III Poll for 159 consecutive weeks. The Green Knights have been ranked third in all three USCHO polls conducted this season.

The Green Knights are 2-1 against ranked teams this season after losing 4-3 to then-No. 15 Hamline on Nov. 5. St. Norbert then swept No. 10 UW-Stevens Point 3-2 and 2-0 on Nov. 12-13.

St. Norbert entered the 2009-10 season at No. 11 before rising to No. 1 on Nov. 9, and remained there for three weeks. The Green Knights are 61-12-5 all-time when ranked No. 1.

During the 159-week stretch of being ranked, St. Norbert has been No. 1 for 43 weeks. St. Norbert was rated No. 1 in the 2003, 2004, 2005, 2007 and 2008 final polls.

St. Norbert was 4-7-1 against ranked foes in 2008-09 but finished 10-2-1 against ranked teams in 2009-10. St. Norbert is 87-36-13 against teams ranked in the USCHO.com Poll under Tim Coghlin. The Green Knights are 0-4 all-time against the No. 1-ranked team and are 3-5 all-time against the No. 2-ranked team.

#### **Gimme Five:**

St. Norbert is unbeaten in its last 226 games when scoring five goals or more with a 221-0-5 mark since a 7-5 loss to Bemidji State in De Pere on Jan. 12, 1996.

St. Norbert is 5-19-4 in its last 28 games when allowing five goals or more dating back to the 1996-97 season. The only wins were a 9-5 win over St. Scholastica on Feb. 20, 1999, a 7-5 win over UW-Stout on Nov. 30, 2001, an 8-5 win over UW-Stout on Jan. 14, 2005, a 7-5 win over UW-Stevens Point on Feb. 3, 2007 and a 7-5 win over Gustavus Adolphus on Oct. 31, 2008.

The Green Knights have allowed five goals just 13 times in their last 269 games.
