The Series:

St. Norbert is 37-6-3 all-time against St. Scholastica. The Green Knights are 34-1-3 in the last 38 meetings, and have outscored the Saints 132-23 in the last 25 games. Eight of the last 12 games have been shutout wins in St. Norbert's favor.

his 18th season in De Pere. The Green Knights are 231-36-22 in the last nine-plus seasons. Coghlin's 365 wins as a coach in the NCHA is six shy of passing Bemidji State's Bob Peters' record of 370 (St. Norbert did not play in the NCHA in Coghlin's first year).

St. Scholastica coach Mark Wick (St. Scholastica, 1985) is 86-69-22 in his seventh season in Duluth.

Last Year:

St. Norbert and St. Scholastica split its three games last year, both going 1-1-1.

St. Scholastica beat St. Norbert 4-3 last Dec. 4 at the Cornerstone Community Center, with Jordan Chong's shorthanded goal 1:27 into overtime the difference. St. Norbert forced overtime with a pair of extraattacker goals by Matt Boyd and Tyler Allen.

St. Norbert beat the Saints 4-2 the next night as Johan Ryd's two third-period goals allowed St. Norbert to pull away. B.J. O'Brien made 21 sayes.

The two teams skated to a 1-1 draw on Feb. 5 at Mars Lakeview Arena. Kyle Stroh's goal 1:19 into the game was St. Norbert's lone marker, and O'Brien made 20 saves.

About the Green Knights:

St. Norbert, ranked second in this week's USCHO.com Division III Poll, is 10-1 overall and 6-0 in the NCHA. The Green Knights won a trio of games this past week: topping Lake Forest 2-1 last Tuesday, Marian 4-1 on Friday and Lawrence 5-0 on Saturday. St. Norbert is the first Division III team in the country to reach 10 wins this season.

Junior forward Johan Ryd leads St. Norbert in scoring with 13 points, scoring four goals and nine assists. Senior forward Scott Pulak has two goals and 10 assists for 12 points, while senior defenseman Nick Tabisz has four goals and six assists for 10 points. Senior forward Brandon Longley has a team-high seven goals with two assists for nine points.

Senior goaltender B.J. O'Brien owns an 8-1 record with 1.45 goals

against average and .935 save percentage. Freshman Mike Martin is 2-0 with a 1.50 goals against average and .942 save percentage.

St. Norbert is 11-for-50 (22.0 percent) on the power play and is 39-for-44 (88.6 percent) on the penalty kill.

About the Saints:

St. Scholastica enters the weekend at 4-5 overall and 0-4 in the NCHA. The Saints split a pair of games at the NCHA/MCHA Thanksgiving Showdown this past weekend, losing to Lawrence 4-2 Friday and beating Marian 6-5 in overtime on Saturday.

The Saints are led offensively by senior forward Riley Riddell, who has five goals and eight assists for 13 points. Junior forward Carter Davis has four goals and five assists for nine points. Sophomore forward Paul Marcoux has three goals and three assists for six points.

Sophomore goaltender Patrick Sullivan is 2-4 with a 3.46 goals against average and .880 save percentage. Junior Brennan Poderzay has a 2-1 mark with a 5.66 goals against average and .843 save percentage.

St. Scholastica is 9-for-42 (21.4 percent) on the power play and 29-for-39 (74.4 percent) on the penalty kill.

Chasing Peters:

St. Norbert head coach Tim Coghlin is just six wins away from achieving a historic milestone - the winningest coach in Northern Collegiate Hockey Association history.

Coghlin enters the weekend with a 365-96-38 record with the Green Knights as members of the NCHA. St. Norbert went 10-9-1 as an independent in Coghlin's first year.

Coghlin's record trails the all-time NCHA mark of Bemidji State's Bob Peters, who went 370-134-36 in 1982 and 1984-99. Peters is the namesake of the NCHA's post-season championship trophy - the Peters Cup.

Only four other coaches have at least 200 wins while coaching in the NCHA: River Falls' Steve Freeman

is third at 267-127-30, former UW-Stevens Point coach Joe Baldarotta is fourth at 265-171-38, Superior's Steve Nelson is fifth at 249-168-21 and Mankato State's Don Brose sixth at 200-110-34.

Poll Position:

St. Norbert has been ranked in the USCHO.com Division III Poll for 161 consecutive weeks. The Green Knights had been ranked third in the first four USCHO polls this season before moving up to second this week. St. Norbert's 161 straight weeks in the poll is now the longest in Division III after Middlebury fell out of the poll for the first time in 179 weeks, and only for the second time in the 13-year, 200-week history of the ranking.

The Green Knights are 2-1 against ranked teams this season after losing 4-3 to then-No. 15 Hamline on Nov. 5. St. Norbert then swept No. 10 UW-Stevens Point 3-2 and 2-0 on Nov. 12-13.

During the 161-week stretch of being ranked, St. Norbert has been No. 1 for 43 weeks. St. Norbert was rated No. 1 in the 2003, 2004, 2005, 2007 and 2008 final polls. The Green Knights are 61-12-5 all-time when ranked No. 1.

St. Norbert was 4-7-1 against ranked foes in 2008-09 but finished 10-2-1 against ranked teams in 2009-10. St. Norbert is 87-36-13 against teams ranked in the USCHO.com Poll under Tim Coghlin. The Green Knights are 0-4 all-time against the No. 1-ranked team and are 3-5 all-time against the No. 2-ranked team.

One-Goal Observations:

St. Norbert is 3-1 this season in one-goal games after beating UW-River Falls 2-1 on Nov. 20.

The Green Knights finished 4-2 in one-goal games last season, including going 2-1 in three nailbiters in the NCAA Division III Tournament.

St. Norbert had 11 one-goal games in 2008-09, going 6-5 in those situations en route to a 19-8-1 season. During the national championship season with a record of 27-1-4 in 2008, the Green Knights were an unblemished 8-0 in one-goal

games.

Under Tim Coghlin, St. Norbert is 58-50 in one-goal games.

St. Norbert was 7-0 last season in games decided by two goals, and was 12-2 in games decided by at least three goals.

Tough After Two:

St. Norbert has continued its long-standing tradition of being tough to beat when leading after two periods. The Green Knights are 8-0 this season after going 20-0-1 last year when leading after the first 40 minutes of action.

Under Tim Coghlin, St. Norbert is 203-1-2 at home when up after two periods.

St. Norbert had a home unbeaten streak when leading after two periods of 200 games (197-0-3) before it was snapped by UW-Stout in a 4-3 overtime loss on Feb. 7, 2009.

At home, St. Norbert is 221-2-3 in school history when leading after two periods. The Green Knights' lone other loss when up after two periods on their own ice came on Nov. 18, 1989 in a 3-1 loss to Augsburg when St. Norbert lost a 1-0 lead.

St. Norbert had an overall 247-game unbeaten streak (240-0-7) when leading after two periods stretching over almost 12 years until St. Scholastica beat the Green Knights 3-2 on Jan. 19, 2007. It was the Green Knights' first loss in such a situation since a 5-4 overtime loss at UW-Eau Claire on Jan. 21, 1995.

Home Sweet Cornerstone:

When 14th century poet Dante Alighieri was penning his masterwork *The Divine Comedy* and the immortal line, "All hope abandon ye who enter here," he could have easily been referring to visiting hockey teams at the Cornerstone Community Center.

St. Norbert is 122-8-6 in its last 136 games at the Cornerstone Community Center.

In the last nine seasons, the Green Knights are a sparkling 135-11-8 at the Cornerstone, with three losses and one tie coming to national champion UW-Superior during the

All-time, St. Norbert is 144-15-9 at the Cornerstone Community Center, which includes a 9-4-1 mark there its first season in the building in 2000-01. Under Tim Coghlin, St. Norbert is 222-37-15 at home, which includes games at Brown County Arena, Resch Center and De Pere Ice Arena.

Gimme Five:

St. Norbert is unbeaten in its last 227 games when scoring five goals or more with a 221-0-5 mark since a 7-5 loss to Bemidji State in De Pere on Jan. 12, 1996.

St. Norbert is 5-19-4 in its last 28 games when allowing five goals or more dating back to the 1996-97 season. The only wins were a 9-5 win over St. Scholastica on Feb. 20, 1999, a 7-5 win over UW-Stout on Nov. 30, 2001, an 8-5 win over UW-Stout on Jan. 14, 2005, a 7-5 win over UW-Stevens Point on Feb. 3, 2007 and a 7-5 win over Gustavus Adolphus on Oct. 31, 2008.

The Green Knights have allowed five goals just 13 times in their last 273 games.

Ice Chips:

- * Senior forward Scott Pulak was a healthy scratch last Tuesday against Lake Forest. The night off snapped a streak of 97 consecutive games played for Pulak.
- * St. Norbert did not allow Marian a power-play opportunity in last Friday's 4-1 win. It marked the first time St. Norbert has not allowed an opposing power-play chance. The Green Knights have allowed one on several occasions, the last in a 3-1 win over Gustavus Adolphus last Mar. 13 in the NCAA Division III Tournament.
- * St. Norbert's eight-game winning streak is its longest since a school-record 16-game skein from Feb. 16-Nov. 21, 2008.
- *- St. Norbert has allowed four goals in its last six games. The Green Knights had an eight-game stretch last season from Jan. 28-Mar. 6 when they allowed just seven goals.
