St. Norbert heads out on their final road weekend of the regular season when it goes to the Twin Ports to face UW-Superior on Friday and the College of St. Scholastica in a key game on Saturday.

The Series:

St. Norbert leads the hotly contested series with UW-Superior 31-21-11. St. Norbert and Superior have met 37 times in the past 11 seasons, with St. Norbert holding a 20-8-9 edge. The Green Knights are 18-5-7 against Superior since a 2002 loss in the NCAA Tournament quarterfinals in Green Bay. The Green Knights are 8-9-8 all-time at Wessman Arena, the only NCHA venue where they do not own a winning record.

St. Norbert is 41-10-3 all-time against St. Scholastica. St. Norbert holds a

slim 5-4-1 series edge in its last 10 meetings with the Saints. The Green Knights are 3-1-1 in their last five games in Duluth.

The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Tim Coghlin (UW-Stevens Point, 1989) is 402-113-44 in his 19th season in De Pere. The Green Knights are 258-44-27 in the last ten-plus seasons. Coghlin's 392 wins as a coach in the NCHA is the league record, 22 more than Bemidji State's Bob Peters' 370 wins. Coghlin's five NCAA championship game appearances are the second most in Division III history. Coghlin became just the 37th coach in college hockey history (all divisions) to win 400 games when St. Norbert beat UW-Stout 4-2 on Jan. 20.

UW-Superior coach Dan Stauber (UW-Superior, 1988) is 217-84-47 in his 12th season in Superior.

St. Scholastica coach Mark Wick (St. Scholastica, 1985) is 103-86-27 in his eighth season in Duluth.

About the Green Knights:

St. Norbert enters the road trip with a 12-5-4 overall record and a No. 6 ranking in this week's USCHO.com Division III Poll. The Green Knights, 9-4-1 in the Northern Collegiate Hockey Association, hold a one-point lead on St. Scholastica atop the league standings. The Green Knights lost a 4-3 overtime heartbreaker to UW-River Falls on Friday before rallying to beat UW-Eau Claire 5-4 on Saturday.

Senior forward Johan Ryd leads the team in scoring with 12 goals and 18 assists for 28 points. Junior forward Kyle Stroh has eight goals and 15 assists for 23 points. Freshman forward Cullen Bradshaw has five goals and a team-high 17 assists for 22 points. Senior forward Seth Soley has 11 goals and eight assists for 19 points, while senior forward Alain Joannette has five goals and 14 assists for 19 points. Junior forward Cody Keefer has 10 goals and seven assists for 17

points, including six power-play goals.

Freshman goaltender David Jacobson owns a 10-2-2 record this season with a 1.92 goals against average and .921 save percentage. Sophomore Travis Bosch is 2-3-1 with a 3.61 GAA and .840 save percentage.

St. Norbert is 23-for-101 (22.8 percent) on the power play and is 82-for-94 (87.2 percent) on the penalty kill.

About the Yellowjackets:

UW-Superior enters the weekend with a 9-8-4 record and a 4-6-4 mark in the Northern Collegiate Hockey Association. The Yellowjackets tied St. Scholastica 3-3 last Thursday before going on the road to top UW-Stout 4-2 on Friday.

Sophomore forward Pat Dalbec leads the Yellowjackets in scoring with 13 goals and nine assists for 22 points. Junior forward Kyle Leahy has five goals and nine assists for 14 points, while sophomore forward Joey Massingham has three goals and 10 assists for 13 points. Sophomore defenseman Jeff Forsythe has five goals and six assists for 11 points.

Sophomore goaltender Drew Strandberg is 8-7-2 with a 2.22 goals against average and .899 save percentage. Sophomore Ben Waalkens is 1-1-1 with a 3.21 goals against average and .861 save percentage.

Superior is 11-for-76 (14.5 percent) on the power play and is 54-for-70 (77.1 percent) on the penalty kill.

About the Saints:

St. Scholastica enters Friday's game with UW-Stevens Point with a 12-5-4 record and a 7-3-4 mark in the Northern Collegiate Hockey Association. The Saints, ranked No. 13 in this week's USCHO.com Division III Poll, are 5-0-2 in their last seven games. St. Scholastica rallied to tie UW-Superior 3-3 last Thursday before beat UW-Stout 3-2 last Saturday.

Junior forward Brett Corcoran

leads the Saints and the NCHA in scoring with 15 goals and 14 assists for 29 points. Senior forward Jeremy Dawes has nine goals and 13 assists for 22 points, while junior forward Tyler Miller has seven goals and 15 assists for 22 points. Senior forward Carter Davis owns eight goals and 13 assists for 21 points.

Sophomore goaltender Colin Rundell is 9-5-4 overall with a 2.68 goals against average and .905 save percentage.

St. Scholastica is 29-for-99 (29.3 percent) on the power play and 75-for-87 (86.2 percent) on the penalty kill. The Saints' power play is tied for fourth in the NCAA Division III national statistics entering the week.

Ryd Ravishings:

Senior forward Johan Ryd netted game-winning goals in both wins over UW-Stout on Jan. 20-21. The total boosted his season total to three.

Ryd's seven game-winning goals last season led NCAA Division III and set a new St. Norbert season record.

Ryd has 12 career game-winners out of 34 total career goals. Rob Smillie and Connor Hughes hold the St. Norbert career record in that category at 13.

Ryd's 28 overall points is second among NCHA skaters and his 19 conference points leads the NCHA.

Tough After Two:

St. Norbert improved to 8-1-1 this season when leading after two periods following 4-1 win over UW-Stout on Jan. 20 at the Dunn County Ice Arena

Under Tim Coghlin, St. Norbert is an astounding 215-1-2 at home when up after two periods. The Green Knights were 13-0 at the Cornerstone Community Center last season when leading after 40 minutes.

St. Norbert had a home unbeaten streak when leading after two periods of 200 games (197-0-3) before it

was snapped by UW-Stout in a 4-3 overtime loss on Feb. 7, 2009 - Coghlin's only home setback when leading after two.

At home, St. Norbert is 233-2-3 in school history when leading after two periods. The Green Knights' lone other loss when up after two periods on their own ice came on Nov. 18, 1989 in a 3-1 loss to Augsburg when St. Norbert lost a 1-0 lead.

The Green Knights are 2-3-1 this season when trailing after two periods and 2-1-2 when tied after two periods. St. Norbert was 0-3 last season when trailing after two periods. It was 6-0 when tied after two.

Tough After Two II:

St. Norbert's last two victories have come with the Green Knights trailing after two periods. The Green Knights trailed 1-0 to UW-Stout on Jan. 21 before winning 2-1 at the Xcel Energy Center. St. Norbert then rallied from down 4-3 to UW-Eau Claire to win 5-4 on Jan. 28 at the Cornerstone Community Center.

St. Norbert could have had three straight games with third-period rallies. The Green Knights trailed 2-1 in the third period to UW-River Falls on Jan. 27 to take a 3-2 lead. The Falcons scored an extra-attacker goal with 22.8 seconds left in regulation and then scored an overtime game winner to prevail 4-3.

The Green Knights are 2-3-1 when trailing after two periods this season. Last year's national championship season saw St. Norbert go 0-3 when trailing after two periods.

St. Norbert hasn't had a year when it has had two wins when trailing after two periods since the 2008-09 season. The Green Knights went 2-5 in that situation, with one of those coming on an overtime empty-net goal in the NCHA Quarterfinals against UW-Stevens Point.

Those two seasons are the only times in the last decade St. Norbert has had two wins in the same year when trailing after two periods.

Gimme Five:

St. Norbert is unbeaten in its last 243 games when scoring five goals or more with a 236-0-7 mark since a 7-5 loss to Bemidji State in De Pere on Jan. 12, 1996.

St. Norbert is 5-21-6 in its last 32 games when allowing five goals or more dating back to the 1996-97 season. The only five wins came in a 9-5 win over St. Scholastica on Feb. 20, 1999, a 7-5 win over UW-Stout on Nov. 30, 2001, an 8-5 win over UW-Stout on Jan. 14, 2005, a 7-5 win over UW-Stevens Point on Feb. 3, 2007 and a 7-5 win over Gustavus Adolphus on Oct. 31, 2008.

The Green Knights have allowed five goals just 18 times in their last 311 games.

Poll Position:

St. Norbert has been ranked in the USCHO.com Division III Poll for 184 consecutive weeks. The Green Knights have been ranked in 222 of 228 polls conducted since its inception at the start of the 1998-99 season - the most of any school in Division III.

The Green Knights were 6-1 against ranked teams last season, but had a six-game winning streak against nationally ranked foes snapped with its loss and tie at UW-River Falls Nov. 11-12. St. Norbert swept UW-Eau Claire on Nov. 18-19. The Green Knights 4-3 overtime loss to River Falls on Jan. 27 moved the Green Knights to 2-2-1 against nationally ranked teams this season.

During the 184-week stretch of being ranked, St. Norbert has been No. 1 for 49 weeks - trailing Norwich's 59 for most all-time. St. Norbert was rated No. 1 in the 2003, 2004, 2005, 2007, 2008 and 2011 final polls. The Green Knights are 71-13-6 all-time when ranked No. 1.

St. Norbert is 93-38-14 against teams ranked in the USCHO.com Poll under Tim Coghlin. The Green Knights are 0-4 all-time against the No. 1-ranked team and are 4-5 all-time against the No. 2-ranked team.
