Weekend Overview:

St. Norbert has control of its own destiny in the Northern Collegiate Hockey Association championship race heading into the final two games of the regular season. The Green Knights need three points to collect their 13th NCHA title and clinch the No. 1 seeding for the NCHA Peters Cup Playoffs.

St. Norbert leads the series with UW-Stevens Point by a 39-19-5 margin. St. Norbert is 39-11-2 in the last 51 games against the Pointers after opening the series 0-8-3. St. Norbert is also 21-3-1 in the last 25 games in the series. The Green Knights are 13-0-2 in their last 15 games against the Pointers at the Cornerstone Community Center.

St. Norbert leads the series with UW-Stout 35-9-4. The Green Knights are 33-4-3 in the last 40 games with the Blue Devils. St. Norbert is 22-3 all-time at home against Stout under Tim Coghlin.

The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Tim Coghlin (UW-Stevens Point, 1989) is 403-113-45 in his 19th season in De Pere. The Green Knights are 259-44-28 in the last ten-plus seasons. Coghlin's 393 wins as a coach in the NCHA is the league record, 23 more than Bemidji State's Bob Peters' 370 wins. Coghlin's five NCAA championship game appearances are the second most in Division III history. Coghlin became just the 37th coach in college hockey history (all divisions) to win 400 games when St. Norbert beat UW-Stout 4-2 on Jan. 20.

UW-Stevens Point coach Chris Brooks (Western Michigan, 1996) is 11-8-4 in his first season in Stevens Point.

UW-Stout coach Terry Watkins (UW-Stout, 1972) is 196-214-25 in his 16th season in Menomonie.

About the Green Knights:

St. Norbert enters the weekend with a 13-5-5 overall record and a No. 6 ranking in this week's USCHO.com Division III Poll. The Green Knights are 10-4-2 in the Northern Collegiate Hockey Association and need three points this weekend to ensure their 13th NCHA regular-season title. St. Norbert, which tied UW-Superior 0-0 and beat St. Scholastica 3-1 last weekend, leads UW-River Falls by two points in the league standings.

Senior forward Johan Ryd leads the team in scoring with 13 goals and 16 assists for 29 points. Junior forward Kyle Stroh has eight goals and 15 assists for 23 points. Freshman forward Cullen Bradshaw has five goals and a team-high 17 assists for 22 points. Senior forward Alain Joanette has five goals and 15 assists for 21 points, while senior forward Seth

Soley has 11 goals and eight assists for 19 points. Junior forward Cody Keefer has 10 goals and seven assists for 17 points, including six power-play goals. Sophomore forward Joe Perry has six goals and 11 assists for 17 points in only 18 games.

Freshman goaltender David Jacobson owns a 11-2-3 record this season with a 1.73 goals against average and .929 save percentage. Sophomore Travis Bosch is 2-3-1 with a 3.61 GAA and .840 save percentage.

St. Norbert is 23-for-108 (21.3 percent) on the power play and is 87-for-99 (87.9 percent) on the penalty kill.

About the Pointers:

UW-Stevens Point enters Thursday's game with an 11-8-4 overall record and a 7-5-4 mark in the Northern Collegiate Hockey Association. The Pointers have surged into a third-place tie in the league behind a 6-1-2 stretch in their last nine games. Stevens Point beat St. Scholastica 2-1 on Friday and then tied UW-Superior 2-2 last Saturday.

Sophomore forward Kyle Heck leads the Pointers in scoring with 16 goals and seven assists for 23 points. Senior forward Luke Nesper has six goals and 10 assists for 16 points, while junior forward Johnny Meo has four goals and nine assists for 13 points. Sophomore forward Ryan Politz owns seven goals and five assists for 12 points.

Freshman goaltender Brandon Jaeger is 6-2-2 with a 1.87 goals against average and a .925 save percentage. Junior Nick Graves is 5-6-2 with a .901 save percentage and .250 goals against average.

Stevens Point is 15-for-107 (14.0 percent) on the power play and is 112-for-128 (87.5 percent) on the penalty kill.

About the Blue Devils:

UW-Stout enters Friday's game with an 8-14-1 record and a 4-11-1 mark in the Northern Collegiate

Hockey Association to sit in seventh place. The Blue Devils, who are 1-5 in their last six games, beat UW-Eau Claire 2-0 on Friday before losing a 7-6 overtime decision to UW-River Falls on Saturday.

Senior forward Branden Gay has 12 goals and 13 assists for 25 points. Sophomore forward Mike Hartviksen has 10 goals and 10 assists for 20 points. Sophomore forward Kevin O'Donnell has six goals and 12 assists for 18 points, while junior forward Sam Carr has three goals and 15 assists for 18 points.

Junior goaltender Tom Lescovich has a 5-8 record with a 3.30 goals against average and .895 save percentage. Junior Nick Hopper is 3-6-1 with a 3.40 goals against average and .904 save percentage.

UW-Stout is 17-for-93 (18.3 percent) on the power play and 91-for-114 (79.8 percent) on the penalty kill.

All Tied Up:

St. Norbert set a school record when it recorded its fifth tie of the season in a scoreless draw last Friday at UW-Superior.

It was the Green Knights' second scoreless tie in school history. St. Norbert and UW-Stevens Point skated for 65 minutes without a goal on Jan. 27, 1995 at the De Pere Ice Arena.

St. Norbert has had two previous seasons with four ties. The Green Knights went 9-14-4 in 1994-95 and 27-1-4 during its national championship season of 2007-08.

Home Sweet Cornerstone:

St. Norbert could probably think of no place else it would rather be playing this week than the Cornerstone Community Center.

St. Norbert is 139-9-7 in its last 155 games at the Cornerstone Community Center.

The Green Knights had a 25-game home winning streak - the second-longest in NCAA Division III history - snapped with a 2-2 tie to Gustavus Adolphus on Nov. 4. St.

Norbert also owns the NCAA Division III record with a 36-game home winning streak set Oct. 25, 2002 to Oct. 29, 2004.

In the last nine-plus seasons, the Green Knights are a sparkling 152-12-9 at the Cornerstone, with three losses and one tie coming to national champion UW-Superior during the 2001-02 season.

All-time, St. Norbert is 160-17-10 at the Cornerstone Community Center, which includes a 9-4-1 mark there its first season in the building in 2000-01. Under Tim Coghlin, St. Norbert is 238-39-16 at home, which includes games at Brown County Arena, Resch Center and De Pere Ice Arena.

Tough After Two:

St. Norbert improved to 9-1-1 this season when leading after two periods following a 3-1 win over St. Scholastica this past Saturday in Duluth, Minn.

Under Tim Coghlin, St. Norbert is an astounding 215-1-2 at home when up after two periods. The Green Knights were 13-0 at the Cornerstone Community Center last season when leading after 40 minutes.

St. Norbert had a home unbeaten streak when leading after two periods of 200 games (197-0-3) before it was snapped by UW-Stout in a 4-3 overtime loss on Feb. 7, 2009 - Coghlin's only home setback when leading after two.

At home, St. Norbert is 233-2-3 in school history when leading after two periods. The Green Knights' lone other loss when up after two periods on their own ice came on Nov. 18, 1989 in a 3-1 loss to Augsburg when St. Norbert lost a 1-0 lead.

The Green Knights are 2-3-1 this season when trailing after two periods and 2-1-3 when tied after two periods. St. Norbert was 0-3 last season when trailing after two periods. It was 6-0 when tied after two.

St. Norbert is 5-21-6 in its last 32 games when allowing five goals or more dating back to the 1996-97 season. The only five wins came in a 9-5 win over St. Scholastica on Feb. 20, 1999, a 7-5 win over UW-Stout on Nov. 30, 2001, an 8-5 win over UW-Stout on Jan. 14, 2005, a 7-5 win over UW-Stevens Point on Feb. 3, 2007 and a 7-5 win over Gustavus Adolphus on Oct. 31, 2008.

The Green Knights have allowed five goals just 18 times in their last 313 games.

Poll Position:

St. Norbert has been ranked in the USCHO.com Division III Poll for 185 consecutive weeks. The Green Knights have been ranked in 223 of 229 polls conducted since its inception at the start of the 1998-99 season - the most of any school in Division III.

The Green Knights were 6-1 against ranked teams last season, but had a six-game winning streak against nationally ranked foes snapped with its loss and tie at UW-River Falls Nov. 11-12. St. Norbert swept UW-Eau Claire on Nov. 18-19. The Green Knights lost to River Falls on Jan. 27 4-3 but then beat St. Scholastica 3-1 on Feb. 4 to improve to 3-2-1 against nationally ranked teams this season.

During the 185-week stretch of being ranked, St. Norbert has been No. 1 for 49 weeks - trailing Norwich's 60 for most all-time. St. Norbert was rated No. 1 in the 2003, 2004, 2005, 2007, 2008 and 2011 final polls. The Green Knights are 71-13-6 all-time when ranked No. 1.

St. Norbert is 94-38-14 against teams ranked in the USCHO.com Poll under Tim Coghlin. The Green Knights are 0-4 all-time against the No. 1-ranked team and are 4-5 all-time against the No. 2-ranked team.
