Game Overview:

St. Norbert opens its 13th NCAA Division III Tournament appearance with a first-round matchup with St. Thomas. The Green Knights won the Northern Collegiate Hockey Association regular-season and Peters Cup championships, while the Tommie claimed the Minnesota Intercollegiate Athletic Conference regular-season title.

The Series:

St. Norbert leads St. Thomas in the series 5-3-2. St. Thomas won the last meeting 3-2 on Jan. 9, 2009 in Mendota Heights, Minn. The two teams have met twice in the NCAA Division III Tournament - with both games "instant classics" at the Cornerstone Community Center. St. Thomas won a 3-2 decision in the 2005 NCAA quarterfinals, with the Tommies taking a 3-0 lead

after two periods before holding off a furious St. Norbert rally in the third period. The Green Knights then tipped the Tommies 2-1 in overtime in the 2008 national quarterfinals, with Ryan Petersen's goal proving the difference.

The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Tim Coghlin (UW-Stevens Point, 1989) is 407-113-45 in his 19th season in De Pere. The Green Knights are 263-44-28 in the last ten-plus seasons. Coghlin's 397 wins as a coach in the NCHA is the league record, 27 more than Bemidji State's Bob Peters' 370 wins. Coghlin's five NCAA championship game appearances are the second most in Division III history. Coghlin became just the 37th coach in college hockey history (all divisions) to win 400 games when St. Norbert beat UW-Stout 4-2 on Jan. 20.

St. Thomas coach Jeff Boeser (St. Thomas, 1975) is 32-15-4 in his second season in St. Paul.

NCAA Tournament Appearances:

St. Norbert is making its 13th overall NCAA Division III Tournament appearance, all coming within in the last 16 years. The Green Knights are 18-10-1 all-time in NCAA competition and have made seven Frozen Fours, and have won nine of their last 10 NCAA Tournament games. St. Norbert won national championships in 2008 and 2011, and was the national runner-up in 2004, 2006 and 2010. Seven of St. Norbert's last eight losses in the NCAA Tournament have come at the hands of the eventual national champion (1999 - Middlebury, 2002 - UW-Superior, 2003 - Norwich, 2004 - Middlebury, 2006 - Middlebury, 2007 - Oswego State, 2010 - Norwich). Every team that has eliminated St. Norbert from an NCAA Tournament has reached the national championship game.

St. Thomas making its 15th NCAA Division III Tournament appearance, and is 9-17-4 all-time in

the tournament. The Tommies finished as the national runner-up in 2000 and 2005. St. Thomas last appeared in the NCAA Tournament in 2010, when it lost 3-1 to Gustavus Adolphus in a first-round game.

About the Green Knights:

St. Norbert enters the NCAA Division III Tournament with a 17-5-5 overall record and a No. 5 ranking in this week's USCHO.com Division III Poll. The Green Knights shutout UW-Stevens Point 4-0 in the championship game of the NCHA Peters Cup Playoffs this past Saturday. St. Norbert is 10-1-1 since Jan. 13 following a 7-4-4 start to the season.

Senior forward Johan Ryd, the 2012 NCHA Player of the Year, picked up two assists against Stevens Point to increase his team scoring lead to 15 goals and 21 assists for 36 points. Junior forward Kyle Stroh has 10 goals and 17 assists for 27 points. Freshman forward Cullen Bradshaw has six goals and 21 assists for 27 points. Senior forward Seth Soley has 13 goals and 11 assists for 24 points. Senior forward Alain Joannette has seven goals and 16 assists for 23 points. Junior forward Cody Keefer has 13 goals and nine assists for 22 points, with eight power-play markers. Sophomore forward Joe Perry has eight goals and 14 assists for 22 points.

Freshman goaltender David Jacobson owns a 15-2-3 record this season with a 1.64 goals against average and .931 save percentage along with four shutouts. Sophomore Travis Bosch is 2-3-1 with a 3.61 GAA and .840 save percentage.

St. Norbert is 34-for-127 (26.8 percent) on the power play and is 103-for-116 (88.8 percent) on the penalty kill.

About the Tommies:

St. Thomas enters the NCAA Tournament with an 18-5-2 record.

The Tommies won the regular-season championship of the Minnesota Intercollegiate Athletic Conference with a 13-2-1 record but lost in a MIAC Tournament semifinal to St. Olaf 4-3 on Feb. 25. St. Thomas had an 11-game winning streak until losing 4-3 at Augsburg on Feb. 17. The Tommies have lost two of their last three games. St. Thomas has played 13 one-goal games - going 8-5 in those - and is 4-0-2 in overtime affairs.

Junior forward Riley Horgan leads the Tommies in scoring with five goals and 27 assists for 32 points. Senior forward Rob Philipp has 13 goals and 14 assists for 27 points, while freshman forward Chris Cass has seven goals and 15 assists for 22 points. Junior forward Travis Baker has 10 goals and 11 assists for 21 points. Junior forward Brandon Bahnemann is second on the team with 12 goals and also has two assists for 14 points.

Junior goaltender Tyrone Simcoe is 8-3-1 with a 2.64 goals against average and .905 save percentage. Freshman Drew Fielding is 9-2 with a 1.99 goals against average and .921 save percentage.

St. Thomas is 29-for-118 (24.6 percent) on the power play and is 106-for-120 (88.3 percent) on the penalty kill.

Tourney Tidbits:

St. Norbert enters the 2012 NCAA Division III Tournament with a glittering 9-1 record in its last 10 NCAA Tournament games. The stretch covers its last three NCAA Tournament appearances.

The Green Knights went 3-0 in both 2008 and 2011 en route to winning NCAA Division III national championships both years. St. Norbert was 3-1 during the 2010 tournament, losing 2-1 in double overtime to Norwich in the national title game.

St. Norbert, 18-10-1 all-time in the tournament, has suffered overtime losses in its last two NCAA Tournament eliminations. Including the aforementioned

Norwich game, St. Norbert lost to Oswego State 4-3 in overtime in a national semifinal game in the 2007 Frozen Four at UW-Superior.

The Green Knights are 8-2-1 all-time at the Cornerstone Community Center in the NCAA Division III Tournament, and have a six-game winning streak there during NCAA competition. St. Norbert tied and lost to UW-Superior in a 2002 quarterfinal series and also fell to St. Thomas in the 2005 quarterfinals.

Power Play Ponderings:

St. Norbert's power play has been clicking in its last four games. The Green Knights have connected for 11 goals in 19 power-play chances over their last four outings, a lusty percentage of 57.9.

The Green Knights were 5-for-9 against UW-Stevens Point on Feb. 9, 2-for-3 against UW-Stout on Feb. 10, 1-for-2 against UW-Eau Claire on Feb. 25 and 3-for-5 against Stevens Point on March 3.

Interestingly, St. Thomas has killed off 39 consecutive penalties dating back over its last nine games.

Jacobson Jottings:

St. Norbert freshman goaltender David Jacobson has enjoyed a banner rookie season between the pipes for the Green Knights, posting a record of 15-2-3 with a 1.64 goals against average and .931 save percentage.

Jacobson has posted four shutouts this season, including back-to-back shutouts of UW-Eau Claire and UW-Stevens Point in the NCHA Peters Cup Playoffs. His shutout total trails Amherst's Jonathon LaRose's five for the national lead.

Jacobson enters the NCAA Division III Tournament with a consecutive shutout sequence of 142 minutes 52 seconds, which is 18th best all-time in NCAA Division III history and sixth-best in St. Norbert history. Kyle Jones has five streaks longer and Roby Gropp has one.

Jacobson, a Janesville native, is

Coghlin Count:

St. Norbert head coach Tim Coghlin brings a record of 407-113-45 into this Wednesday's game against St. Thomas.

St. Norbert's 4-0 win over UW-Stevens Point this past Saturday moved him into a tie for 33rd on the all-time NCAA hockey coaching wins list with John "Gino" Gasparini of North Dakota, Mike Gilligan of Salem State and Vermont and Craig Dahl - most notably of St. Cloud State.

Retired St. Thomas coach Terry Skrypek is 32nd on the list with an all-time record of 418-197-46 from 1988 to 2010.

POTY Parsings:

St. Norbert senior forward Johan Ryd was honored on Feb. 16 when he was named the 2012 Northern Collegiate Hockey Association Player of the Year.

Ryd's accolade marks the eighth time among seven players a St. Norbert skater has been honored. Roby Gropp was the first St. Norbert NCHA Player of the Year in 1997. Rob Smillie followed in 1998, Adam Sedgwick in 2001, Maris Ziedins in 2002, Kyle Jones in both 2006 and 2008 and B.J. O'Brien in 2011.

Ryd, a Sodertalje, Sweden native, leads St. Norbert in goals (15), assists (21) and points (36). He also has taken just three penalties for six minutes this season. In 86 career games, Ryd has 37 goals and 57 assists for 94 points.

Home Sweet Cornerstone:

St. Norbert could probably think of no place else it would rather be playing this week than the Cornerstone Community Center.

St. Norbert is 143-9-7 in its last 159 games at the Cornerstone Community Center.

The Green Knights had a 25-game home winning streak - the second-longest in NCAA Division III history - snapped with a 2-2 tie to Gustavus Adolphus on Nov. 4. St. Norbert also owns the NCAA Division III record with a 36-game home winning streak set Oct. 25, 2002 to Oct. 29, 2004.

In the last nine-plus seasons, the Green Knights are a sparkling 156-12-9 at the Cornerstone, with three losses and one tie coming to national champion UW-Superior during the 2001-02 season.

All-time, St. Norbert is 164-17-10 at the Cornerstone Community Center, which includes a 9-4-1 mark there its first season in the building in 2000-01. Under Tim Coghlin, St. Norbert is 242-39-16 at home, which includes games

at Brown County Arena, Resch Center and De Pere Ice Arena.

Tough After Two:

St. Norbert improved to 13-1-1 this season when leading after two periods following a 4-0 win over UW-Stevens Point on March 3 at the Cornerstone Community Center.

Under Tim Coghlin, St. Norbert is an astounding 219-1-2 at home when up after two periods. The Green Knights were 13-0 at the Cornerstone Community Center last season when leading after 40 minutes.

St. Norbert had a home unbeaten streak when leading after two periods of 200 games (197-0-3) before it was snapped by UW-Stout in a 4-3 overtime loss on Feb. 7, 2009 - Coghlin's

only home setback when leading after two.

At home, St. Norbert is 237-2-3 in school history when leading after two periods. The Green Knights' lone other loss when up after two periods on their own ice came on Nov. 18, 1989 in a 3-1 loss to Augsburg when St. Norbert lost a 1-0 lead.

The Green Knights are 2-3-1 this season when trailing after two periods and 2-1-3 when tied after two periods. St. Norbert was 0-3 last season when trailing after two periods. It was 6-0 when tied after two.

Gimme Five:

St. Norbert is unbeaten in its last 244 games when scoring five goals or more with a 237-0-7 mark since a 7-5 loss to

St. Norbert is 5-21-6 in its last 32 games when allowing five goals or more dating back to the 1996-97 season. The only five wins came in a 9-5 win over St. Scholastica on Feb. 20, 1999, a 7-5 win over UW-Stout on Nov. 30, 2001, an 8-5 win over UW-Stout on Jan. 14, 2005, a 7-5 win over UW-Stevens Point on Feb. 3, 2007 and a 7-5 win over Gustavus Adolphus on Oct. 31, 2008.

The Green Knights have allowed five goals just 18 times in their last 317 games.

Poll Position:

St. Norbert has been ranked in the USCHO.com Division III Poll for 189 consecutive weeks. The Green Knights have been ranked in 227 of 233 polls conducted since its inception at the start of the 1998-99 season - the most of any school in Division III.

The Green Knights were 6-1 against ranked teams last season,

but had a six-game winning streak against nationally ranked foes snapped with its loss and tie at UW-River Falls Nov. 11-12. St. Norbert swept UW-Eau Claire on Nov. 18-19. The Green Knights lost to River Falls on Jan. 27 4-3 but then beat St. Scholastica 3-1 on Feb. 4 and UW-Stevens Point 8-3 on Feb. 9 and 4-0 on March 3 to improve to 5-2-1 against nationally ranked teams this season.

During the 189-week stretch of being ranked, St. Norbert has been No. 1 for 49 weeks - trailing Norwich's 61 for most all-time. St. Norbert was rated No. 1 in the 2003, 2004, 2005, 2007, 2008 and 2011 final polls. The Green Knights are 71-13-6 all-time when ranked No. 1.

St. Norbert is 96-38-14 against teams ranked in the USCHO.com Poll under Tim Coghlin. The Green Knights are 0-4 all-time against the No. 1-ranked team and are 4-5 all-time against the No. 2-ranked team.

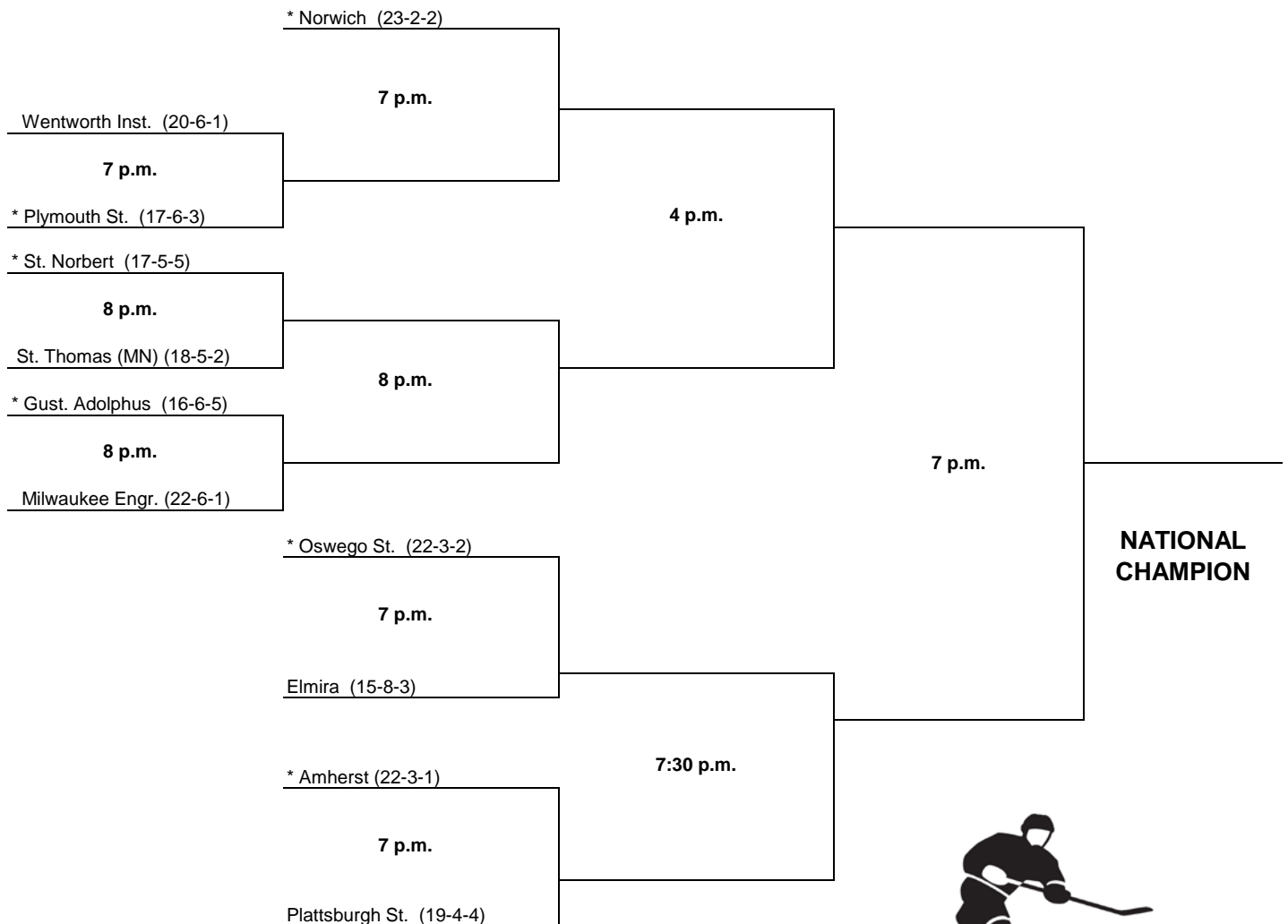
