Game Overview:

St. Norbert continues on the NCAA Division III Tournament trail when it hosts Gustavus Adolphus in a national quarterfinal game. The winner advances to the NCAA Division III Frozen Four next weekend in Lake Placid, N.Y.

The Series:

St. Norbert leads Gustavus Adolphus in the all-time series 13-11-1, with the Green Knights a commanding 13-1-1 under Tim Coghlin. St. Norbert has outscored the Gusties 80-35 in the last 15 games. Gustavus handed St. Norbert its only loss in the 2007-08 national championship season with a 4-2 win on Nov. 3, 2007 at the Cornerstone Community Center. The Green Knights also claimed a 3-1 win in the 2010 NCAA Division III national

quarterfinals on March 12, 2010 at the Cornerstone. The two teams skated to a 2-2 tie earlier this season on Nov. 4 at the Cornerstone. The Gusties took a 2-0 lead on goals by Gustav Bengtson and Zach May before St. Norbert rallied for the tie with goals by Cody Keefer and Justin Favreau. St. Norbert outshot the Gusties 41-20.

The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Tim Coghlin (UW-Stevens Point, 1989) is 408-113-45 in his 19th season in De Pere. The Green Knights are 264-44-28 in the last ten-plus seasons. Coghlin's 398 wins as a coach in the NCHA is the league record, 28 more than Bemidji State's Bob Peters' 370 wins. Coghlin's five NCAA championship game appearances are the second most in Division III history. Coghlin became just the 37th coach in college hockey history (all divisions) to win 400 games when St. Norbert beat UW-Stout 4-2 on Jan. 20.

Gustavus Adolphus coach Brett Petersen (Denver, 1992) is 165-132-25 in his 12th season in St. Peter.

NCAA Tournament Appearances:

St. Norbert is making its 13th overall NCAA Division III Tournament appearance, all coming within in the last 16 years. The Green Knights are 19-10-1 all-time in NCAA competition and have made seven Frozen Fours, and have won 10 of their last 11 NCAA Tournament games. St. Norbert won national championships in 2008 and 2011, and was the national runner-up in 2004, 2006 and 2010. Seven of St. Norbert's last eight losses in the NCAA Tournament have come at the hands of the eventual national champion (1999 - Middlebury, 2002 - UW-Superior, 2003 - Norwich, 2004 - Middlebury, 2006 - Middlebury, 2007 - Oswego State, 2010 - Norwich). Every team that has eliminated St. Norbert from an NCAA Tournament has reached the national championship game.

Gustavus Adolphus is making its sixth NCAA Division III Tournament appearance, and its third in the last four years. The Gusties are 4-6-2 all-time in the tournament, and finished as the national runner-up in 2009.

About the Green Knights:

St. Norbert enters the national quarterfinals with an 18-5-5 overall record and a No. 5 ranking in this week's USCHO.com Division III Poll. The Green Knights topped St. Thomas 3-1 in a first-round NCAA Tournament game on Wednesday. St. Norbert is 11-1-1 since Jan. 13 following a 7-4-4 start to the season. The Green Knights have allowed just one goal so far this post-season, outscoring its opponents 9-1 in three games.

Senior forward Johan Ryd, the 2012 NCHA Player of the Year, picked up two assists against St. Thomas - his second-straight two-assist game - to increase his team scoring lead to 15 goals and 23 assists for 38 points. Freshman forward Cullen Bradshaw has six goals and 22 assists for 28 points. Junior forward Kyle Stroh has 10 goals and 17 assists for 27 points. Senior forward Seth Soley has 13 goals and 12 assists for 25 points. Junior forward Cody Keefer netted a pair of goals against St. Thomas and has 15 goals and nine assists for 24 points, with nine power-play markers. Senior forward Alain Joannette has seven goals and 16 assists for 23 points. Sophomore forward Joe Perry has eight goals and 14 assists for 22 points.

Freshman goaltender David Jacobson owns a 16-2-3 record this season with a 1.64 goals against average and .931 save percentage along with four shutouts. Sophomore Travis Bosch is 2-3-1 with a 3.61 GAA and .840 save percentage.

St. Norbert is 34-for-127 (26.8 percent) on the power play and is 103-for-116 (88.8 percent) on the penalty kill.

About the Gusties:

Gustavus Adolphus enters the national quarterfinals with a 17-6-5 overall record. The Gusties finished in second place in the Minnesota Intercollegiate Athletic Conference with an 8-5-3 record before winning the MIAC Tournament with a 4-2 win over St. Olaf. Gustavus opened the NCAA Tournament with a 3-1 first-round win Wednesday over Milwaukee School of Engineering.

Senior forward Ross Ring-Jarvi, the MIAC Player of the Year, leads the Gusties in scoring with 11 goals and 21 assists for 32 points. Sophomore forward Zach May has 10 goals and 12 assists for 22 points, and also has 25 penalties for 77 minutes. Junior forward Ryan Johnson has 10 goals and 10 assists for 20 points. Freshman forward Andy Pearson has five goals and 14 assists for 19 points. Sophomore forward Adam Smyth has a team-high 14 goals with four assists for 18 points.

Freshman goaltender John McLean has a 15-4-2 overall record with a 2.07 goals against average and .924 save percentage. Junior Tyler Venne is 2-2-3 with a 2.62 goals against average and .907 save percentage.

Gustavus Adolphus is 23-for-115 (20.0 percent) on the power play and is 90-for-112 (80.4 percent) on the penalty kill.

Tourney Tidbits:

St. Norbert enters the NCAA quarterfinals with a glittering 10-1 record in its last 11 NCAA Tournament games. The stretch covers its last three NCAA Tournament appearances.

The Green Knights went 3-0 in both 2008 and 2011 en route to winning NCAA Division III national championships both years. St. Norbert was 3-1 during the 2010 tournament, losing 2-1 in double overtime to Norwich in the national title game. St. Norbert is 1-0 so far in 2011.

St. Norbert, 19-10-1 all-time in the tournament, has suffered overtime losses in its last two NCAA

Tournament eliminations. Including the aforementioned Norwich game, St. Norbert lost to Oswego State 4-3 in overtime in a national semifinal game in the 2007 Frozen Four at UW-Superior.

The Green Knights are 9-2-1 all-time at the Cornerstone Community Center in the NCAA Division III Tournament, and have a seven-game winning streak there during NCAA competition. St. Norbert tied and lost to UW-Superior in a 2002 quarterfinal series and also fell to St. Thomas in the 2005 quarterfinals.

Power Play Ponderings:

St. Norbert's power play has been clicking in its last five games. The Green Knights have connected for 12 goals in 24 power-play chances over their last four outings, a lusty percentage of 50.0.

The Green Knights were 5-for-9 against UW-Stevens Point on Feb. 9, 2-for-3 against UW-Stout on Feb. 10, 1-for-2 against UW-Eau Claire on Feb. 25, 3-for-5 against Stevens Point on March 3 and 1-for-5 against St. Thomas on March 7.

The power-play goal against St. Thomas snapped a streak of 41 consecutive penalties killed for the Tommies.

Jacobson Jottings:

St. Norbert freshman goaltender David Jacobson has enjoyed a banner rookie season between the pipes for the Green Knights, posting a record of 16-2-3 with a 1.64 goals against average and .931 save percentage.

Jacobson has posted four shutouts this season, including back-to-back shutouts of UW-Eau Claire and UW-Stevens Point in the NCHA Peters Cup Playoffs. His shutout total trails Amherst's Jonathon LaRose's five for the national lead.

Jacobson had a consecutive shutout sequence of 151 minutes 24 seconds, which is 14th best all-time in NCAA Division III history and sixth-best in St. Norbert history.

Jacobson, a Janesville native, is the first Wisconsinite to play between the pipes for St. Norbert since Chippewa Falls' Neil Schimmel appeared in one game during the 2002-03 season.

Coghlin Count:

St. Norbert head coach Tim Coghlin brings a record of 408-113-45 into this Saturday's game against Gustavus Adolphus.

St. Norbert's 3-1 win over St. Thomas on Wednesday moved him out of tie for 33rd on the all-time NCAA hockey coaching wins list with John "Gino" Gasparini of North Dakota, Mike Gilligan of Salem State and Vermont and Craig Dahl - most notably of St. Cloud State.

Retired St. Thomas coach Terry Skrypek is 32nd on the list with an all-time record of 418-197-46 from 1988 to 2010.

POTY Parsings:

St. Norbert senior forward Johan Ryd was honored on Feb. 16 when he was named the 2012 Northern Collegiate Hockey Association Player of the Year.

Ryd's accolade marks the eighth time among seven players a St. Norbert skater has been honored. Roby Gropp was the first St. Norbert NCHA Player of the Year in 1997. Rob Smillie followed in 1998, Adam Sedgwick in 2001, Maris Ziedins in 2002, Kyle Jones in both 2006 and 2008 and B.J. O'Brien in 2011.

Ryd, a Sodertalje, Sweden native, leads St. Norbert in goals (15), assists (23) and points (38). He also has taken just five penalties for 10 minutes this season. In 87 career games, Ryd has 37 goals and 59 assists for 96 points.

Home Sweet Cornerstone:

St. Norbert could probably think of no place else it would rather be playing this week than the

Cornerstone Community Center.

St. Norbert is 144-9-7 in its last 160 games at the Cornerstone Community Center.

The Green Knights had a 25-game home winning streak - the second-longest in NCAA Division III history - snapped with a 2-2 tie to Gustavus Adolphus on Nov. 4. St. Norbert also owns the NCAA Division III record with a 36-game home winning streak set Oct. 25, 2002 to Oct. 29, 2004.

In the last nine-plus seasons, the Green Knights are a sparkling 157-12-9 at the Cornerstone, with three losses and one tie coming to national champion UW-Superior during the 2001-02 season.

All-time, St. Norbert is 165-17-10 at the Cornerstone Community Center,

which includes a 9-4-1 mark there its first season in the building in 2000-01. Under Tim Coghlin, St. Norbert is 243-39-16 at home, which includes games at Brown County Arena, Resch Center and De Pere Ice Arena.

Tough After Two:

St. Norbert improved to 14-1-1 this season when leading after two periods following a 4-0 win over UW-Stevens Point on March 3 at the Cornerstone Community Center.

Under Tim Coghlin, St. Norbert is an astounding 220-1-2 at home when up after two periods. The Green Knights were 13-0 at the Cornerstone Community Center last season when leading after 40 minutes.

St. Norbert had a home unbeaten

streak when leading after two periods of 200 games (197-0-3) before it was snapped by UW-Stout in a 4-3 overtime loss on Feb. 7, 2009 - Coghlin's only home setback when leading after two.

At home, St. Norbert is 238-2-3 in school history when leading after two periods. The Green Knights' lone other loss when up after two periods on their own ice came on Nov. 18, 1989 in a 3-1 loss to Augsburg when St. Norbert lost a 1-0 lead.

The Green Knights are 2-3-1 this season when trailing after two periods and 2-1-3 when tied after two periods. St. Norbert was 0-3 last season when trailing after two periods. It was 6-0 last season when tied after two after two periods.

St. Norbert is unbeaten in its last 244 games when scoring five goals or more with a 237-0-7 mark since a 7-5 loss to Bemidji State in De Pere on Jan. 12, 1996.

St. Norbert is 5-21-6 in its last 32 games when allowing five goals or more dating back to the 1996-97 season. The only five wins came in a 9-5 win over St. Scholastica on Feb. 20, 1999, a 7-5 win over UW-Stout on Nov. 30, 2001, an 8-5 win over UW-Stout on Jan. 14, 2005, a 7-5 win over UW-Stevens Point on Feb. 3, 2007 and a 7-5 win over Gustavus Adolphus on Oct. 31, 2008.

The Green Knights have allowed five goals just 18 times in their last 318 games.

Poll Position:

St. Norbert has been ranked in the USCHO.com Division III Poll for 189 consecutive weeks. The Green Knights have been ranked in 227 of 233 polls conducted since its inception at the start of the 1998-99 season - the most of any school in

Division III.

Against ranked teams this season, St. Norbert had a loss and tie at UW-River Falls Nov. 11-12. St. Norbert swept UW-Eau Claire on Nov. 18-19. The Green Knights lost to River Falls on Jan. 27 4-3 but then beat St. Scholastica 3-1 on Feb. 4 and UW-Stevens Point 8-3 on Feb. 9 and 4-0 on March 3. The Green Knights then topped St. Thomas 3-1 on March 7 to improve to 6-2-1 against nationally ranked teams this season.

During the 189-week stretch of being ranked, St. Norbert has been No. 1 for 49 weeks - trailing Norwich's 61 for most all-time. St. Norbert was rated No. 1 in the 2003, 2004, 2005, 2007, 2008 and 2011 final polls. The Green Knights are 71-13-6 all-time when ranked No. 1.

St. Norbert is 97-38-14 against teams ranked in the USCHO.com Poll under Tim Coghlin. The Green Knights are 0-4 all-time against the No. 1-ranked team and are 4-5 all-time against the No. 2-ranked team.
