St. Norbert College Green Knights Hockey Preview NCAA DIVISION III FROZEN FOUR

Game Overview:

New York's North Country hosts the Frozen Four as four teams converge on Lake Placid to determine the 2012 NCAA Division III champion. St. Norbert is aiming for its third national title in five years, capturing the crown in Lake Placid in 2008 and last year in Minneapolis. Norwich most recently won the title in 2010, while Oswego State won its only title in 2007. Amherst is making its first Frozen Four appearance.

become the Green Knights' best rivalry. The winners of the last four meetings have all gone on to claim the national championship. The Green Knights' first win in the series came in a 3-0 triumph in the 2008 NCAA national semifinals at Herb Brooks Arena. St. Norbert also picked up a national semifinal win over the Cadets last season by a 3-2 at Ridder Arena in Minneapolis, with all the goals coming in the third period. Scott Pulak's goal with 7:33 remaining was the game-winning score. The Cadets picked up a 5-2 win at the Cornerstone Community Center on Dec. 1, 2000. Norwich also won a NCAA national semifinal game by a 6-3 score on March 21, 2003 at Kreitzberg Arena. Norwich won the 2010 national championship game 2-1 in double overtime despite St. Norbert goaltender B.J. O'Brien turning away 70 shots.

Oswego State leads St. Norbert in the all-time series 2-1. The Lakers topped the Green Knights 4-3 in overtime in a NCAA Division III Frozen Four semifinal on March 17, 2007 at Wessman Arena in Superior. Oswego also topped St. Norbert 4-3 on Nov. 28, 2008 at the Cornerstone Community Center in Green Bay. The Green Knights topped the Lakers for the first time in a thrilling 4-3 NCAA semifinal win on March 19, 2010 in Lake Placid, N.Y., on a goal by Cody Keefer with

39 seconds left.

St. Norbert leads the series with Amherst 1-0. The Green Knights topped the Lord Jeffs 3-1 on Dec. 30, 2007 in the championship game of the Pathfinder Bank Classic in Oswego, N.Y. Marc Belanger, Matt Boyd and Ryan Petersen all scored third-period goals for the Green Knights in the win.

The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Tim Coghlin (UW-Stevens Point, 1989) is 409-113-45 in his 19th season in De Pere. The Green Knights are 265-44-28 in the last ten-plus seasons. Coghlin's 399 wins as a coach in the NCHA is the league record, 29 more than Bemidji State's Bob Peters' 370 wins. Coghlin's five NCAA championship game appearances are the second most in Division III history. Coghlin became just the 37th coach in college hockey history (all divisions) to win 400 games when St. Norbert beat UW-Stout 4-2 on Jan.

Norwich coach Mike McShane (New Hampshire, 1971) is 366-98-26 in his 17th season in Northfield. In 30 years of collegiate coaching he is 608-316-57 overall. He spent six years at St. Lawrence with two NCAA Division I tournament berths and was at Providence for nine years with three NCAA tournament bids. His 2000, 2003 and 2010 teams won NCAA Division III

NCAA Championship Coaching Appearances

Only seven coaches in NCAA Division III history have coached in at least three NCAA Division III championship games/series since the start of the NCAA Division III Tournament in 1984. Two will be coaching teams in the tournament this weekend in St. Norbert's Tim Coghlin and Norwich's Mike McShane. A third will be an assistant on the St. Norbert bench, Mark Mazzoleni, who won three straight national titles at UW-Stevens Point from 1989-91.

Oswego State coach Ed Gosek (Oswego State, 1983) is 186-48-16 in his ninth season in Oswego. His 2007 team won the NCAA Division III championship.

Amherst coach Jack Arena (Amherst, 1983) is 374-290-50 in his 29th season in Amherst.

NCAA Tournament Appearances:

St. Norbert is making its 13th NCAA Division Tournament appearance, all coming within in the last 16 years. The Green Knights are 20-10-1 all-time in NCAA competition and have made eight Frozen Fours, and have won 11 of their last 12 NCAA Tournament games. St. Norbert won national championships in 2008 and 2011, and was the national runner-up in 2004, 2006 and 2010. Seven of St. Norbert's last eight losses in the NCAA Tournament have come at the hands of the eventual national champion (1999)Middlebury, 2002 - UW-Superior, 2003 - Norwich, 2004 - Middlebury, 2006 - Middlebury, 2007 - Oswego State, 2010 - Norwich). Every team that has eliminated St. Norbert from an NCAA Tournament has reached the national championship game.

Norwich is making its 13th NCAA Division III Tournament appearance and its 10 trip to the Frozen Four. Norwich is 22-10-2 alltime in the NCAA Tournament. The Cadets won national championships in 2000, 2003 and 2010.

Oswego State is making its 11th NCAA Division III Tournament appearance and its sixth trip to the Frozen Four. The Lakers are 11-14 all-time in the tournament and won the national championship in 2007.

Amherst is making its third NCAA Division III Tournament appearance and its first trip to the Frozen Four. The Lord Jeffs are 2-3 all-time in the tournament.

About the Green Knights:

St. Norbert enters the Frozen Four with a 19-5-5 overall record and a No. 5 ranking in this week's USCHO.com Division III Poll. The Green Knights topped Gustavus Adolphus 4-1 in a first-round NCAA Tournament game on this past Saturday. St. Norbert is 12-1-1 since Jan. 13 following a 7-4-4 start to the season. The Green Knights have allowed just two goal so far this post-season, outscoring its opponents 13-2 in four games.

Senior forward Johan Ryd, the 2012 NCHA Player of the Year, holds the team scoring lead with 15 goals and 23 assists for 38 points. Freshman forward Cullen Bradshaw has eight goals and 22

assists for 30 points. Junior forward Kyle Stroh has 10 goals and 17 assists for 27 points. Senior forward Seth Soley has 13 goals and 14 assists for 27 points. Sophomore forward Joe Perry has eight goals and 16 assists for 25 points. Junior forward Cody Keefer has 15 goals and nine assists for 24 points, with nine power-play markers. Senior forward Alain Joanette has eight goals and 16 assists for 24 points.

Freshman goaltender David Jacobson owns a 17-2-3 record this season with a 1.58 goals against average and .933 save percentage along with four shutouts. Sophomore Travis Bosch is 2-3-1 with a 3.61 GAA and .840 save per-

St. Norbert is 36-for-139 (25.9 percent) on the power play and is 112for-126 (88.9 percent) on the penalty kill.

About the Cadets:

Norwich enters the Frozen Four with a 24-2-2 overall record. The Cadets, who have been ranked No. 1 in the USCHO.com Poll for most of the season, won the ECAC East title with a 15-2-1 record. Norwich opened the NCAA Tournament with a 3-0 win over Wentworth in a quarterfinal-round game at home on Sunday. The Cadets' lone losses this season came 2-1 to UMass-Boston on Jan. 14 and 3-2 to Skidmore on Feb. 10.

Pier-Olivier Junior forward Cotnoir, who scored the game-winning goal in the Cadets' 2-1 doubleovertime win over St. Norbert in the 2010 national title game, leads Norwich in scoring with 21 goals and 20 assists for 41 points Cotnoir also has 12 of the Cadets' 40 powerplay goals. Sophomore forward Travis Janke has 11 goals and 28 assists for 39 points. Junior forward Kyle Thomas has 16 goals and 21 assists for 37 points, while freshman forward Doug Lindensmith has 14 goals and 10 assists for 24 points along with six power-play goals.

Sophomore goaltender Parker Carroll has seen most of the action

in net for the Cadets, going 16-1-1 with a 1.91 goals against average and .891 save percentage. Sophomore Chris Czarnota is 8-1-1 with a 1.14 goals against average and .940 save percentage.

Norwich is 40-for-130 (30.8 percent) on the power play and is 70-for-86 (81.4 percent) on the penalty kill.

About the Lakers:

Oswego State enters the Frozen Four with a 23-3-2 overall record. The Lakers went 14-0-2 in the SUNYAC regular season but fell to Plattsburgh State 3-2 in the league title game, snapping a 12-game winning streak. Oswego State won its NCAA Tournament quarterfinal game by a 5-0 count over Elmira on Saturday.

Junior forward Jon Whitelaw leads Oswego State in scoring with 19 goals and 22 assists for 41 points, including seven power-play goals. Junior forward Paul Rodrigues has 13 goals and 23 assists for 36 points, including eight power-play goals. Junior forward Luke Moodie has 14 goals and 19 assists for 33 points, while senior forward Ian Boots has 12 goals and 15 assists for 27 points. Junior forward Chris Muise adds seven goals and 17 assists for 24 points.

Junior goaltender Andrew Hare owns a 20-3-2 record with a 1.69 goals against average and .932 save percentage. Junior Dan Jones is 3-0 with a 1.68 goals against average and .938 save percentage.

Oswego State is 41-for-151 (27.2 per-

cent) on the power play and is 120-for-139 (86.3 percent) on the penalty kill.

About the Lord Jeffs:

Amherst enters the Frozen Four with a 24-3-1 overall record. The Lord Jeffs claimed the NESCAC championship with a 4-3 win over Middlebury on March 4, and went 17-1 during the NESCAC regular season. Amherst won its NCAA Tournament quarterfinal game with a 3-1 win over Plattsburgh State.

Junior forward Mike Moher leads Amherst in scoring with 13 goals and 16 assists for 29 points, including six power-play goals. Senior forward Mark Colp has 10 goals and 14 assists for 24 points, while freshman defenseman Aaron Deutsch has four goals and

The power-play goal against St. Thomas snapped a streak of 41 consecutive penalties killed for the Tommies.

Jacobson Jottings:

St. Norbert freshman goaltender David Jacobson has enjoyed a banner rookie season between the pipes for the Green Knights, posting a record of 17-2-3 with a 1.58 goals against average and .933 save percentage.

Jacobson has posted four shutouts this season, including back-to-back shutouts of UW-Eau Claire and UW-Stevens Point in the NCHA Peters Cup Playoffs. His shutout total trails Amherst's Jonathon LaRose's five for the national lead.

Jacobson had a consecutive shutout sequence of 151 minutes 24 seconds end in the first-round NCAA Tournament win over St. Thomas, which is 14th best all-time in NCAA Division III history and sixth-best in St. Norbert history. Kyle Jones has five streaks longer, including the national record of 337:22.

Jacobson, a Janesville native, is the first Wisconsinite to play between the pipes for St. Norbert since Chippewa Falls' Neil Schimmel appeared in one game during the 2002-03 season.

Coghlin Count:

St. Norbert head coach Tim Coghlin brings a record of 409-113-45 into the national semifinal game against Norwich.

St. Norbert's 3-1 win over St. Thomas on March 7 moved him out of tie for 33rd on the all-time NCAA hockey coaching wins list with John "Gino" Gasparini of North Dakota, Mike Gilligan of Salem State and Vermont and Craig Dahl - most notably of St. Cloud State.

Retired St. Thomas coach Terry Skrypek is 32nd on the list with an

all-time record of 418-197-46 from 1988 to 2010.

POTY Parsings:

St. Norbert senior forward Johan Ryd was honored on Feb. 16 when he was named the 2012 Northern Collegiate Hockey Association Player of the Year.

Ryd's accolade marks the eighth time among seven players a St. Norbert skater has been so honored. Roby Gropp was the first St. Norbert NCHA Player of the Year in 1997. Rob Smillie followed in 1998, Adam Sedgwick in 2001, Maris Ziedins in 2002, Kyle Jones in both 2006 and 2008 and B.J. O'Brien in 2011.

Ryd, a Sodertalje, Sweden native, leads St. Norbert in goals (15), assists (23) and points (38). He also has taken just five penalties for 10 minutes this season. In 88 career games, Ryd has 37 goals and 59 assists for 96 points.

Bradshaw Banter:

St. Norbert freshman forward Cullen Bradshaw has enjoyed a banner freshman season, posting eight goals and 22 assists for 30 points.

Bradshaw is the first St. Norbert freshman to post 30 points in his rookie season since Matt Boyd totaled 31 points in 2007.

Bradshaw's 22 assists are the third most by a freshman in St. Norbert history. Adam Sedgwick (1998) and Jason Deitsch (2002) both had 25 assists their freshman seasons.

Bradshaw has posted nine multipoint games this season, second on the squad to Johan Ryd's 12. Bradshaw had two goals in last Saturday's 4-1 national quarterfinal win over Gustavus Adolphus, his only multi-goal game of the season.

UW-River Falls (21-8-4) in 1994, Middlebury (21-5-1) in 1999 and Neumann (21-9-2) in 2009 all finished with 21 wins and won the national title.

In the last 16 seasons (dating back to 1997), St. Norbert has won at least 21 games 13 times. The Green Knights have never won less than 18 games during that time period.

Tough After Two:

St. Norbert improved to 15-1-1 this season when leading after two periods following a 4-1 win over Gustavus Adolphus on March 10 at the Cornerstone Community Center.

Under Tim Coghlin, St. Norbert is an astounding 221-1-2 at home when up after two periods. The Green Knights were 13-0 at the Cornerstone Community Center last season when leading after 40 minutes.

St. Norbert had a home unbeaten streak when leading after two periods of 200 games (197-0-3) before it was snapped by UW-Stout in a 4-3 overtime loss on Feb. 7, 2009 - Coghlin's only home setback when leading after two.

At home, St. Norbert is 239-2-3 in school history when leading after two periods. The Green Knights' lone other loss when up after two periods on their own ice came on Nov. 18, 1989 in a 3-1 loss to Augsburg when St. Norbert lost a 1-0 lead.

are 10-6-2 all-time in the State of New York. St. Norbert has not played out east since finishing as the 2010 national runner-up in Lake Placid.

The Green Knights are 9-3-1 all-time against the State University of New York Athletic Conference, including a 2-0 mark against Plattsburgh State and an 1-2 ledger against Oswego State.

St. Norbert is 6-5-3 all-time against ECAC West opposition (including games against now-Division I RIT and Mercyhurst), and is 3-5 all-time against the NESCAC.

The Green Knights are 2-0 all-time against the ECAC Northeast, also beating Fitchburg State in the 1994-95 season.

St. Norbert is 3-3 against the ECAC East, going 2-3 against Norwich and 1-0 against Southern Maine.

Western Wonders:

The Northern Collegiate Hockey Association has placed a representative in the NCAA Division III championship game 18 out of a possible 28 times. St. Norbert has made five title game appearances, in 2004, 2006, 2008, 2010 and 2011. Bemijdi State did it twice (1985-86), UW-River Falls three times (1988, '93, '94), UW-Stevens Point six times (1989-93, '98), Mankato State once (1991) and UW-Superior four times (1994, '97, '99, 2002). NCHA teams have squared off for the national championship three times (1991 -Stevens Point vs. Mankato State, 1993 -Stevens Point vs. River Falls, 1994 -River Falls vs. Superior).

UW-Stevens Point (1989, '90, '91, '93), UW-River Falls (1988, '94), Bemidji State (1986), UW-Superior (2002) and St. Norbert (2008, '11) have all won Division III national titles while members of the NCHA.

In 29 NCAA Division III Frozen Fours, the NCHA has placed a team among the final four 27 years - the most of any league. The NCHA did not advance a team through to the Frozen Four in 1984 and 2005. River Falls lost to Union in the 1984 quarterfinals and St. Norbert lost to St. Thomas in the 2005 quarterfinals.

St. Norbert's 4-3 win over Adrian in the 2011 national championship game marked the first All-West Region final since 1994, when UW-River Falls beat UW-Superior 6-4.

Poll Position:

St. Norbert has been ranked in the USCHO.com Division III Poll for 189 consecutive weeks. The Green Knights have been ranked in 227 of 233 polls conducted since its inception at the start of the 1998-99 season - the most of any school in Division III.

Against ranked teams this season, St. Norbert had a loss and tie at UW-River Falls Nov. 11-12. St. Norbert swept UW-Eau Claire on Nov. 18-19. The Green Knights lost to River Falls on Jan. 27 4-3 but then beat St. Scholastica 3-1 on Feb. 4 and UW-Stevens Point 8-3 on Feb. 9 and 4-0 on March 3. The Green Knights then topped St. Thomas 3-1 on March 7 and Gustavus Adolphus 4-1 on March 10 to improve

to 7-2-1 against nationally ranked teams this season.

During the 189-week stretch of being ranked, St. Norbert has been No. 1 for 49 weeks - trailing Norwich's 61 for most all-time. St. Norbert was rated No. 1 in the 2003, 2004, 2005, 2007, 2008 and 2011 final polls. The Green Knights are 71-13-6 all-time when ranked No. 1.

St. Norbert is 98-38-14 against teams ranked in the USCHO.com Poll under Tim Coghlin. The Green Knights are 0-4 all-time against the No. 1-ranked team and are 4-5 all-time against the No. 2-ranked team.

Gimme Five:

St. Norbert is unbeaten in its last 244 games when scoring five goals or more with a 237-0-7 mark since a 7-5 loss to Bemidji State in De Pere on Jan. 12, 1996.

St. Norbert is 5-21-6 in its last 32 games when allowing five goals or more dating back to the 1996-97 season. The only five wins came in a 9-5 win over St. Scholastica on Feb. 20, 1999, a 7-5 win over UW-Stout on Nov. 30, 2001, an 8-5 win over UW-Stout on Jan. 14, 2005, a 7-5 win over UW-Stevens Point on Feb. 3, 2007 and a 7-5 win over Gustavus Adolphus on Oct. 31, 2008.

The Green Knights have allowed five goals just 18 times in their last 319 games.

St. Norbert has never allowed 10 goals in a game during Tim Coghlin's 567-game tenure.

Most NCAA Division III Frozen Four Appearances

Only nine programs have skated in at least six NCAA Division III Frozen Fours since the start of the NCAA Division III Tournament in 1984. Three of those nine will be participating this weekend in the 2012 Frozen Four in Lake Placid, N.Y., with Norwich (10), St. Norbert (8) and Oswego State (6) being the three. Those three schools have accounted for six national championships, all coming since the 2000 season.
