Series Overview:

St. Norbert opens Northern Collegiate Hockey Association play with a home-and-home series against longtime rival UW-Stevens Point. The Green Knights travel to Willett Arena on Friday before returning home Saturday, when the 2011 NCAA national championship banner will be raised in the Cornerstone Community Center.

St. Norbert coverage is on the WSNC radio Webcast with Tim Derozier on the call. The video Webcast is available at http://www.snc.edu/athletics/hockey/webcast.htm.

The Series:

St. Norbert leads the series with UW-Stevens Point by a 38-18-5 margin. St. Norbert is 38-10-2 in the last 50 games against the Pointers after opening the series 0-8-3. St. Norbert is also 20-2-1 in the last 23 games in the series. The Green Knights are 15-12-1 all-time at Willett Arena, but are 10-2 in their last 12 games there.

The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Tim Coghlin (UW-Stevens Point, 1989) is 391-108-40 entering his 19th season in De Pere. The Green Knights are 247-39-23 in the last ten-plus seasons. Coghlin's 381 wins as a coach in the NCHA is the league record, 11 more than Bemidji State's Bob Peters' 370 wins. Coghlin's five NCAA championship game appearances are the second most in Division III history.

UW-Stevens Point coach Chris Brooks (Western Michigan, 1996) is 0-1 in his first season in Stevens Point.

Last Year:

St. Norbert swept the season series last year from UW-Stevens Point. The Green Knights took the series in Stevens Point 3-2 and 2-0 last Nov. 12-13 at Willett Arena. St. Norbert then topped the Pointers 2-1 on Jan. 27 at the Cornerstone Community Center.

In the series at Stevens Point, Johan Ryd and Brandon Longley scored a goal in each game, and B.J. O'Brien made 19 and 25 saves, respectively. Stevens Point's Nick Graves made 17 and 24 stops, respectively.

At St. Norbert, Ryd's marker with 41 seconds left proved to be the difference. O'Brien made 24 saves for St. Norbert and Graves 20 stops for the Pointers.

About the Green Knights:

St. Norbert opened the season with an 8-0 win over Concordia-Wisconsin on Tuesday. It was the Green Knights' 12th straight win in a season opener.

Senior forward Seth Soley registered St. Norbert's first hat trick since January 2009 with a three-goal night. Senior forward Johan Ryd netted one goal and two assist for three points, while senior forward Alain Joanette tallied three assists for three points. Sophomore forward Brandon Hoogenboom and freshman defenseman Chris Rial both had one goal and one assist for

two points. Sophomore forwards Emil Haque and Ashton Reinboldt both had two assists apiece.

Sophomore goaltender Travis Bosch worked the first two periods to get the win for St. Norbert against Concordia and turned away nine shots, including a penalty-shot save. Freshman netminder David Jacobson made seven saves in the third period for the Green Knights.

St. Norbert was 0-for-4 (0.0 percent) on the power play and was 4-for-4 (100.0 percent) on the penalty kill

About the Pointers:

UW-Stevens Point enters the series with an 0-1 record. The Pointers opened the season last Friday with a 5-4 loss at Marian. Stevens Point trailed 2-0 after one period and 2-1 after two periods, and then drew even early in the third period. Marian answered with the next two goals 25 seconds apart to pull ahead.

Senior forward Harrison Niemann had one goal and one assist for two points, while senior forward Luke Nesper had a pair of assists for two points. Senior forward Jon Madden, sophomore forward Kyle Heck and junior forward Jerry Freismuth all had one goal apiece for the Pointers.

Junior goaltender Nick Graves went the distance in net for the Pointers, making 20 saves. Graves has a 5.00 goals against average and .800 save percentage.

Stevens Point is 1-for-10 (10 percent) on the power play and 6-for-7 (85.7 percent) on the penalty kill.

Pre-Season Prognostications:

St. Norbert was picked by the NCHA coaches to win its 13th regular-season in 16 years in the league's pre-season poll.

The Green Knights received five of seven first-place votes to total 64 points. The total easily outdistanced UW-Superior, picked for second with 52 points and one first-place vote.

UW-Eau Claire was tabbed for

third with 42 points and one firstplace vote. UW-Stout was picked for fourth (42 points), UW-Stevens Point fifth (28), UW-River Falls sixth (24) and St. Scholastica seventh (10).

Tough After Two:

St. Norbert was 20-1-1 last year when leading after the first 40 minutes of action. St. Norbert had a 1-0 lead turn into a 2-1 loss at on Dec. 4 at St. Scholastica and a 3-2 edge end in a 3-3 stalemate on Jan. 29 at UW-Eau Claire.

Under Tim Coghlin, St. Norbert is an astounding 212-1-2 at home when up after two periods. The Green Knights were 13-0 at the Cornerstone Community Center last season when leading after 40 minutes.

St. Norbert had a home unbeaten streak when leading after two periods of 200 games (197-0-3) before it was snapped by UW-Stout in a 4-3 overtime loss on Feb. 7, 2009 - Coghlin's only home setback when leading after two.

At home, St. Norbert is 230-2-3 in school history when leading after two periods. The Green Knights' lone other loss when up after two periods on their own ice came on Nov. 18, 1989 in a 3-1 loss to Augsburg when St. Norbert lost a 1-0 lead.

St. Norbert had an overall 247-game unbeaten streak (240-0-7) when leading after two periods stretching over almost 12 years until St. Scholastica beat the Green Knights 3-2 on Jan. 19, 2007. It was the Green Knights' first loss in such a situation since a 5-4 overtime loss at UW-Eau Claire on Jan. 21, 1995.

St. Norbert was 0-3 last season when trailing after two periods. It was 6-0 when tied after two.

Poll Position:

St. Norbert has been ranked in the USCHO.com Division III Poll for 172 consecutive weeks. The Green Knights have been ranked in 210 of 214 polls conducted since its inception at the start of the 1998-99 season - the most of any school in

Division III.

The Green Knights were 6-1 against ranked teams last season, and have a six-game winning streak against nationally ranked foes.

During the 172-week stretch of being ranked, St. Norbert has been No. 1 for 49 weeks - narrowly edging Norwich's 48 for most all-time. St. Norbert was rated No. 1 in the 2003, 2004, 2005, 2007, 2008 and 2011 final polls. The Green Knights are 68-12-5 all-time when ranked No. 1.

St. Norbert is 91-36-13 against teams ranked in the USCHO.com Poll under Tim Coghlin. The Green Knights are 0-4 all-time against the No. 1-ranked team and are 4-5 all-time against the No. 2-ranked team.

One-Goal Observations:

St. Norbert finished a glittering 10-2 in one-goal games in 2010-11 after a pair of one-goal triumphs at the NCAA Division III Frozen Four. The Green Knights topped Norwich 3-2 and Adrian 4-3 to win the national championship. Under Tim Coghlin, St. Norbert is 65-51 in one-goal games.

The Green Knights finished 4-2 in one-goal games in 2010, including going 2-1 in three nailbiters in the NCAA Division III Tournament.

St. Norbert had 11 one-goal games in 2008-09, going 6-5 in those situations en route to a 19-8-1 season. During the national championship season with a record of 27-1-4 in 2008, the Green Knights were an unblemished 8-0 in one-goal games.

Home Sweet Cornerstone:

St. Norbert continued its domination at the Cornerstone Community Center in 2010-11, going a perfect 14-0 on home ice. The Green Knights were the lone team in collegiate hockey at any level or in either gender who were unbeaten and untied at home.

St. Norbert is 132-8-6 in its last 146 games at the Cornerstone Community Center.

In the last nine seasons, the Green

All-time, St. Norbert is 154-15-9 at the Cornerstone Community Center, which includes a 9-4-1 mark there its first season in the building in 2000-01. Under Tim Coghlin, St. Norbert is 232-37-15 at home, which includes games at Brown County Arena, Resch Center and De Pere Ice Arena.

Gimme Five:

St. Norbert is unbeaten in its last 235 games when scoring five goals or more with a 230-0-5 mark since a 7-5 loss to Bemidji State in De Pere on Jan. 12, 1996.

St. Norbert is 5-19-4 in its last 28 games when allowing five goals or more dating back to the 1996-97 season. The only five wins came in a 9-5 win over St. Scholastica on Feb. 20, 1999, a 7-5 win over UW-Stout on Nov. 30, 2001, an 8-5 win over UW-Stout on Jan. 14, 2005, a 7-5 win over UW-Stevens Point on Feb. 3, 2007 and a 7-5 win over Gustavus Adolphus on Oct. 31, 2008.

The Green Knights have allowed five goals just 14 times in their last 291 games.

Ice Chips:

- * Senior forward Johan Ryd's game-winning goal against Concordia was the tenth of his career. Rob Smillie and Connor Hughes share the school record with 13.
- * St. Norbert's 8-0 shutout of Concordia was the 15th time in their last 31 games the Green Knights have held the opponent to one goal or less. The Green Knights allowed 54 goals in 30 games last season to lead Division III in scoring defense for the third time in the last five seasons.
- * Thirteen of the 18 skaters who dressed for Tuesday's game at Concordia scored at least one point.
