#### The Series:

St. Norbert leads Gustavus Adolphus in the all-time series 13-11, with the Green Knights a commanding 13-1 under Tim Coghlin. St. Norbert has outscored the Gusties 78-33 in the last 14 games. Gustavus handed St. Norbert its only loss in the 2007-08 national championship season with a 4-2 win on Nov. 3, 2007 at the Cornerstone Community Center.

Augsburg leads St. Norbert in the all-time series 10-3-1. Augsburg is 9-2-1 in the last 12 meetings. The Green Knights are 2-1-1 against the Auggies

#### The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Tim Coghlin (UW-Stevens Point, 1989) is 392-109-40 in his 19th season in De Pere. The Green Knights are 248-40-23 in the last ten-plus seasons. Coghlin's 382 wins as a coach in the NCHA is the league record, 12 more than Bemidji State's Bob Peters' 370 wins. Coghlin's five NCAA championship game appearances are the second most in Division III history.

Gustavus Adolphus coach Brett Petersen (Denver, 1992) is 148-127-21 in his 12th season in St. Peter.

Entering Friday's game at UW-Stevens Point, Augsburg coach Chris Brown (UW-River Falls, 1994) is 58-63-11 in his sixth season in Minneapolis. He was 69-56-8 in five years combined at Marian and Hamline for a combined record of 127-119-19.

#### **Last Meetings:**

St. Norbert beat Gustavus Adolphus 3-1 on March 13, 2010 in a NCAA Division III Tournament quarterfinal at the Cornerstone Community Center. Shane Wheeler, Tyler Allen and Brandon Longley all scored for St. Norbert, while James Leathers scored for the Gusties. B.J. O'Brien made 17 saves for St. Norbert, with Josh Swartout making 22 saves for Gustavus.

St. Norbert topped Augsburg 6-0 on Nov. 3, 2006 at the Cornerstone Community Center. Jeff Hazelwood scored twice for St. Norbert, with Ryan Petersen, Shane Wheeler, Peter Fylling and Matt Boyd also netting goals. Kyle Jones made 15 saves to earn the shutout for the Green Knights.

#### **About the Green Knights:**

St. Norbert enters the weekend at 2-1 overall after splitting a homeand-home NCHA series with UW-Stevens Point last weekend. The Green Knights lost 5-1 last Friday in Stevens Point before winning 4-1 on Saturday at the Cornerstone Community Center. Senior forward Johan Ryd enters the weekend with two goals and four assists for six points. Freshman forward Cullen Bradshaw has two goals and two assists for four points. Senior forward Alain Joanette has four assists for four points, while senior forward Seth Soley has three goals for three points.

Sophomore goaltender Travis Bosch has seen most of the action in net for the Green Knights, going 2-1 with a 2.25 goals against average and .878 save percentage.

St. Norbert is 2-for-17 (11.8 percent) on the power play and is 12-for-13 (92.3 percent) on the penalty kill.

#### **About the Gusties:**

Gustavus Adolphus enters the weekend with an 0-1-1 overall record. The Gusties played a pair of non-conference games in the MIAC Showcase last weekend, tying St. John's 3-3 before losing to Concordia-Moorhead 3-2.

Sophomore forward Zach May leads the Gusties with two goals for two points. Senior forward Ross Ring-Jarvi, junior defenseman Tim LaBombard and junior forward Brian White all have two assists for two points.

Junior Tyler Venne and freshman John McLean split the goaltending duties on opening weekend. Venne made 19 saves in the 3-3 tie with St. John's, while McLean made 21 stops in the 3-2 loss to the Cobbers.

Gustavus Adolphus is 4-for-12 (33.3 percent) on the power play and 8-for-10 (80.0 percent) on the penalty kill.

#### **About the Auggies:**

Augsburg enters Friday's game at UW-Stevens Point with a 1-1 overall record. The Auggies beat Bethel 3-2 and lost 3-2 in overtime to Hamline in a pair of non-conference games last weekend at the MIAC Showcase.

Senior forward Trevor Doden has two goals for two points. Senior defenseman David Hines and freshman forward Ben McClellan both have one goal and one assist for two points. Freshman forward George Jackson has the Auggies' other goal.

Junior goaltender Justin Lochner was between the pipes in both games. Lochner fashioned numbers of a 2.43 goals against average and a .911 save percentage.

Augsburg is 2-for-12 (16.7 percent) on the power play and 11-for-14 (78.6 percent) on the penalty kill.

#### **MIAC Minutiae:**

St. Norbert has a solid 75-9-4 record against Minnesota Intercollegiate Athletic Conference competition since Tim Coghlin took over the Green Knights' helm in 1993. Two of the losses came in a sweep at St. Mary's in Coghlin's first year of 1993-94.

Since then, the Green Knights are 75-7-4 against the MIAC. The losses came in a 4-3 decision at St. John's on Nov. 24, 2000 and a pair of losses to St. Thomas in the 2004-05 season. The Green Knights also dropped a 7-4 contest to Augsburg during 2005-06, to Gustavus Adolphus in 2007-08, to St. Thomas in 2008-09 and Hamline in 2010-11. St. Norbert has tied St. Thomas twice and Augsburg and Hamline each once.

At home under Coghlin, St. Norbert is a remarkable 41-2-2 against MIAC foes. The losses came in a 3-2 defeat to St. Thomas in the 2005 NCAA Division III Tournament and to Gustavus Adolphus 4-2 on Nov. 3, 2007.

#### **Home Sweet Cornerstone:**

Now bedecked with new championship banners in the arena as well as an impressive new NCAA Tournament historical display in the lobby, St. Norbert has continued to keep the Cornerstone Community Center a virtually impregnable fortress.

The Green Knights currently boast a 25-game home winning streak, the longest active skein in all of college hockey. St. Norbert won its last 10 home games in 2009-10, went 14-0 at home in 2010-11 and is

1-0 at "The Stone" this year.

The Green Knights, who last lost at the Cornerstone in a 4-3 overtime setback to St. Scholastica on Dec. 4, 2009, also own a NCAA Division III-record 36-game home winning streak set Oct. 30, 2001 to Oct. 29, 2004

St. Norbert is 133-8-6 in its last 147 games at the Cornerstone Community Center.

In the last nine-plus seasons, the Green Knights are a sparkling 146-11-8 at the Cornerstone, with three losses and one tie coming to national champion UW-Superior during the 2001-02 season.

All-time, St. Norbert is 155-15-9 at the Cornerstone Community Center, which includes a 9-4-1 mark there its first season in the building in 2000-01. Under Tim Coghlin, St. Norbert is 233-37-15 at home, which includes games at Brown County Arena, Resch Center and De Pere Ice Arena.

#### Gimme Five:

St. Norbert is unbeaten in its last 235 games when scoring five goals or more with a 230-0-5 mark since a 7-5 loss to Bemidji State in De Pere on Jan. 12, 1996.

St. Norbert is 5-20-4 in its last 29 games when allowing five goals or more dating back to the 1996-97 season. The only five wins came in a 9-5 win over St. Scholastica on Feb. 20, 1999, a 7-5 win over UW-Stout on Nov. 30, 2001, an 8-5 win over UW-Stout on Jan. 14, 2005, a 7-5 win over UW-Stevens Point on Feb. 3, 2007 and a 7-5 win over Gustavus Adolphus on Oct. 31, 2008.

The Green Knights have allowed five goals just 15 times in their last 293 games.

#### **Poll Position:**

St. Norbert has been ranked in the USCHO.com Division III Poll for 172 consecutive weeks. The Green Knights have been ranked in 210 of 214 polls conducted since its inception at the start of the 1998-99 season - the most of any school in Division III.

The Green Knights were 6-1 against ranked teams last season, and have a six-game winning streak against nationally ranked foes.

During the 172-week stretch of being ranked, St. Norbert has been No. 1 for 49 weeks - narrowly edging Norwich's 48 for most all-time. St. Norbert was rated No. 1 in the 2003, 2004, 2005, 2007, 2008 and 2011 final polls. The Green Knights are 70-13-5 all-time when ranked No. 1.

St. Norbert is 91-36-13 against teams ranked in the USCHO.com Poll under Tim Coghlin. The Green Knights are 0-4 all-time against the No. 1-ranked team and are 4-5 all-time against the No. 2-ranked team.

#### Ice Chips:

- \* St. Norbert's 4-1 win last Saturday over UW-Stevens Point was the 16th time in their last 33games the Green Knights have held the opponent to one goal or less. The Green Knights allowed 54 goals in 30 games last season to lead Division III in scoring defense for the third time in the last five seasons.
- \*-St. Norbert drew an attendance figure of 1,625 to last Saturday's 4-1 win over UW-Stevens Point. That was the largest figure to attend a regular-season home game since 1,629 took in a 3-0 win over Milwaukee School of Engineering on Jan. 2, 2009.
- \* In the 2011 NCHA Peters Cup Playoffs and NCAA Division III Tournament, St. Norbert was a combined 7-for-18 (38.9 percent) on the power play. The Green Knights' power play top open 2011-12 is 2-for-17 (11.8 percent).
- \* Last Friday's 5-1 loss at UW-Stevens Point marked the third consecutive year the Green Knights will have lost by that score in a road game during Northern Collegiate Hockey Association play. St. Norbert lost at UW-Eau Claire in 2009-10 and at UW-Stout in 2010-11 and went on to play in the national championship game both times.
