Series Overview:

St. Norbert opens a six-game road trip with a Northern Collegiate Hockey Association series at UW-River Falls. The Green Knights and Falcons are both nationally ranked in this week's U.S. College Hockey Online Division III Poll.

The Series:

St. Norbert leads the series with UW-River Falls 36-16-2. The Green Knights are 32-4-1 against River Falls in their last 37 meetings. St. Norbert is 20-0 against the Falcons at home during that stretch. River Falls is 1-21 all-time at the Cornerstone Community Center, and is 0-18 all-time there against St. Norbert. The Falcons' last road win against St. Norbert came in a 2-1 overtime triumph on Feb. 7, 1998 at the De Pere Ice Arena.

The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Tim Coghlin (UW-Stevens Point, 1989) is 393-109-41 in his 19th season in De Pere. The Green Knights are 249-40-24 in the last ten-plus seasons. Coghlin's 383 wins as a coach in the NCHA is the league record, 13 more than Bemidji State's Bob Peters' 370 wins. Coghlin's five NCAA championship game appearances are the second most in Division III history.

UW-River Falls coach Steve Freeman (UW-Stevens Point, 1981) is 280-135-31 in his 16th season in River Falls.

Last Year:

St. Norbert went 4-0 last season against UW-River Falls.

The Green Knights swept a series last Nov. 19-20 at the Cornerstone Community Center with wins of 3-1 and 2-1. Mike Bernardy scored a goal in each game, and B.J. O'Brien made games of 23 and 16 saves, respectively.

St. Norbert then topped the Falcons 3-1 at Hunt Arena on Feb. 11. Joe Perry, Taylor Langford and Seth Soley all scored for the Green Knights, and O'Brien made 22 stops.

The Green Knights won a 5-3 decision over the Falcons in the semifinals of the NCHA Peters Cup Playoffs on Feb. 26 at the Cornerstone Community Center. Kyle Stroh scored two goals in the game and O'Brien made 12 saves.

About the Green Knights:

St. Norbert enters the series with UW-River Falls at 3-1-1 overall after tying Gustavus Adolphus 2-2 last Friday and beating Augsburg 7-2 on Saturday in a non-conference weekend at the Cornerstone Community Center.

Junior forward Kyle Stroh moved into the team scoring lead with four goals, and also has five assists for nine points. Senior forward Johan Ryd has three goals and six assists for nine points. Senior forward Alain Joannette has a team-high seven assists for seven points.

Freshman forward Cullen Bradshaw has two goals and four assists for six points.

Sophomore goaltender Travis Bosch is 2-1-1 with a 2.13 goals against average and .884 save percentage. Freshman netminder David Jacobson is 1-0 with a 1.50 goals against average and .935 save percentage.

St. Norbert is 5-for-25 (20.0 percent) on the power play and is 19-for-20 (95.0 percent) on the penalty kill.

About the Falcons:

UW-River Falls has opened the 2011-12 season with a 4-0 overall record. The Falcons have yet to face a Northern Collegiate Hockey Association foe. River Falls swept Finlandia 4-0 and 6-0 on Oct. 28-29, and then topped Hamline 8-1 last Friday and Bethel 7-5 on Saturday. River Falls' first eight games of the season are at home.

Sophomore forward Alec Hagaman leads the Falcons in scoring with three goals and five assists for eight points. Senior forward Justin Brossman has three goals and four assists for seven points. Junior forward Geoff Shewmake has a team-high five goals with one assist for six points. Senior forward Jason Yuel has two goals and four assists for six points, while freshman defenseman George Malliaras has a team-high six assists for six points.

Sophomore goaltender Scott Lewan has been used exclusively in net for the Falcons this season. Lewan is 4-0 with a 1.50 goals against average and .917 save percentage.

River Falls is 8-for-25 (32.0 percent) on the power play and 15-for-18 (83.3 percent) on the penalty kill.

Pass Me a Stroh's:

Junior forward Kyle Stroh enjoyed a seven-point weekend last weekend in the Green Knights 2-2 tie with Gustavus Adolphus and 7-2 win over Augsburg.

Stroh netted a rare five-point per-

formance against Augsburg, scoring three goals with two assists. The game was Stroh's first collegiate hat trick and also matched a career high in assists.

It was the first five-point game for a St. Norbert skater since Cody Keefer scored two goals and three assists in his first collegiate game on Oct. 27, 2009 in an 8-1 win over Lake Forest. The only other five-point game by a St. Norbert skater in the last 10 seasons was a two-goal, three-assist game from Jason Deutsch in an 11-2 win over St. John's on Jan. 3, 2003.

In five career games against UW-River Falls, Stroh has three goals and three assists for six points.

Tough After Two:

St. Norbert is 3-0 this season when leading after two periods.

Under Tim Coghlin, St. Norbert is an astounding 214-1-2 at home when up after two periods. The Green Knights were 13-0 at the Cornerstone Community Center last season when leading after 40 minutes.

St. Norbert had a home unbeaten streak when leading after two periods of 200 games (197-0-3) before it was snapped by UW-Stout in a 4-3 overtime loss on Feb. 7, 2009 - Coghlin's only home setback when leading after two.

At home, St. Norbert is 232-2-3 in school history when leading after two periods. The Green Knights' lone other loss when up after two periods on their own ice came on Nov. 18, 1989 in a 3-1 loss to Augsburg when St. Norbert lost a 1-0 lead.

St. Norbert had an overall 247-game unbeaten streak (240-0-7) when leading after two periods stretching over almost 12 years until St. Scholastica beat the Green Knights 3-2 on Jan. 19, 2007. It was the Green Knights' first loss in such a situation since a 5-4 overtime loss at UW-Eau Claire on Jan. 21, 1995.

The Green Knights are 0-1 this season when trailing after two periods and 0-0-1 when tied after two

periods. St. Norbert was 0-3 last season when trailing after two periods. It was 6-0 when tied after two.

Home Sweet Cornerstone:

Now bedecked with new championship banners in the arena as well as an impressive new NCAA Tournament historical display in the lobby, St. Norbert has continued to keep the Cornerstone Community Center a virtually impregnable fortress.

The Green Knights currently boast a 27-game home unbeaten streak. St. Norbert had a 25-game home winning streak - the second-longest in NCAA Division III history - snapped with a 2-2 tie to Gustavus Adolphus on Nov. 4.

The Green Knights, who last lost at the Cornerstone in a 4-3 overtime setback to St. Scholastica on Dec. 4, 2009, also own a NCAA Division III-record 36-game home winning streak set Oct. 25, 2002 to Oct. 29, 2004.

St. Norbert is 134-8-7 in its last 149 games at the Cornerstone Community Center.

In the last nine-plus seasons, the Green Knights are a sparkling 147-11-9 at the Cornerstone, with three losses and one tie coming to national champion UW-Superior during the 2001-02 season.

All-time, St. Norbert is 156-15-10 at the Cornerstone Community Center, which includes a 9-4-1 mark there its first season in the building in 2000-01. Under Tim Coghlin, St. Norbert is 234-37-16 at home, which includes games at Brown County Arena, Resch Center and De Pere Ice Arena.

Gimme Five:

St. Norbert is unbeaten in its last 236 games when scoring five goals or more with a 231-0-5 mark since a 7-5 loss to Bemidji State in De Pere on Jan. 12, 1996.

St. Norbert is 5-20-4 in its last 29 games when allowing five goals or more dating back to the 1996-97 season. The only five wins came in a 9-5 win over St. Scholastica on Feb. 20,

Poll Position:

St. Norbert has been ranked in the USCHO.com Division III Poll for 173 consecutive weeks. The Green Knights have been ranked in 211 of 215 polls conducted since its inception at the start of the 1998-99 season - the most of any school in Division III.

The Green Knights were 6-1 against ranked teams last season, and currently have a six-game winning streak against nationally ranked foes.

During the 173-week stretch of being ranked, St. Norbert has been No. 1 for 49 weeks - narrowly edging Norwich's 48 for most all-time. St. Norbert was rated No. 1 in the 2003, 2004, 2005, 2007, 2008 and 2011 final polls. The Green Knights are 71-13-6 all-time when ranked No. 1.

St. Norbert is 91-36-13 against teams ranked in the USCHO.com Poll under Tim Coghlin. The Green Knights are 0-4 all-time against the No. 1-ranked team and are 4-5 all-time against the No. 2-ranked team.

Ice Chips:

* - A total of 12 different skaters have scored at least one goal this season despite the Green Knights having played only five games. A total of 18 skaters have scored at least one point.

* - St. Norbert is 3-0 this season when scoring the game's first goal. The Green Knights are 0-1-1 when their opponent scores first.
