St. Norbert College Green Knights Hockey 2011-12 Season Notes

No. 1 St. Norbert College (21-5-5)

NCAA Division III Champion

NCHA Peters Cup & Regular-Season Champion

Season Overview:

St. Norbert won its third NCAA Division III championship with a 4-1 win over Oswego State on March 17 at Herb Brooks Arena in Lake Placid, N.Y. The Green Knights, who defeated Norwich 4-1 a day earlier, became just the third program in NCAA Division III history to win consecutive national championships. St. Norbert finished the season with a 21-5-5 record. The Green Knights also won their 13th Northern Collegiate Hockey Association regular-season championship and their 10th NCHA Peters Cup title.

The Coach:

St. Norbert coach Tim Coghlin (UW-Stevens Point, 1989) is 411-113-45 in his 19th season in De Pere. The Green Knights are 267-44-28 in the last 11 seasons. Coghlin's 401 wins as a coach in the NCHA is the league record, 31 more than Bemidji State's Bob Peters' 370 wins. Coghlin's six NCAA championship game appearances are the second most in Division III history. Coghlin became just the 37th coach in college hockey history (all divisions) to win 400 games when St. Norbert beat UW-Stout 4-2 on Jan. 20.

NCAA Tournament Appearances:

St. Norbert made its 13th overall NCAA Division III Tournament appearance, all coming within in the last 16 years. The Green Knights are 22-10-1 all-time in NCAA competition and have made eight Frozen Fours, and have won 13 of their last 14 NCAA Tournament games. St. Norbert won national championships in 2008, 2011 and 2012, and was the national runner-up in 2004, 2006 and 2010.

The Green Knights are now just one of three programs in NCAA Division III history to have won consecutive national championships (UW-Stevens Point 1989-91 and Middlebury 1995-99 and 2004-06).

About the Green Knights:

St. Norbert finished the 2011-12 season repeating as NCAA Division III national champions. The Green Knights ended with a 21-5-5 overall record and a No. 1 ranking in the final USCHO.com Division III Poll. The Green Knights defeated Oswego State 4-1 on March 17 to claim their third national title in five years.. St. Norbert finished with a 14-1-1 charge down the stretch following a 7-4-4 start to the season. The Green Knights allowed just four goals in the post-season, outscoring its opponents 21-4 in six games.

Senior forward Johan Ryd, the

2012 NCHA Player of the Year, led the team in scoring with 15 goals and 25 assists for 40 points. Freshman forward Cullen Bradshaw had eight goals and 22 assists for 30 points. Junior forward Kyle Stroh had 11 goals and 18 assists for 29 points, while senior forward Seth Soley had 14 goals and 15 assists for 29 points. Junior forward Cody Keefer had 18 goals and nine assists for 27 points, with 10 power-play markers. Sophomore forward Joe Perry had 10 goals and 16 assists for 26 points. Senior forward Alain Joannette had eight goals and 17 assists for 25 points.

Freshman goaltender David Jacobson, the NCAA Division III Frozen Four's Most Outstanding Player, fashioned a 19-2-3 record this season with a 1.53 goals against average and .936 save percentage along with four shutouts. Sophomore Travis Bosch was 2-3-1 with a 3.61 GAA and .840 save percentage.

St. Norbert was 39-for-149 (26.2 percent) on the power play and is 125-for-140 (89.3 percent) on the penalty kill.

Tourney Tidbits:

St. Norbert finished this year's national championship run with a glittering 13-1 record in its last 14 NCAA Tournament games. The stretch covers its last four NCAA Tournament appearances dating

NCAA Championship Coaching Appearances

Only seven coaches in NCAA Division III history have coached in at least three NCAA Division III championship games/series since the start of the NCAA Division III Tournament in 1984. St. Norbert head coach Tim Coghlin ranks second all-time on the list with six title game appearances, going 3-3 overall with two of the losses coming in overtime. St. Norbert assistant coach Mark Mazzoleni won three straight national titles at UW-Stevens Point from 1989-91.

back to 2008.

The Green Knights went 3-0 in both 2008 and 2011 en route to winning NCAA Division III national championships both years. St. Norbert was 3-1 during the 2010 tournament, losing 2-1 in double overtime to Norwich in the national title game. St. Norbert went 4-0 in 2012 to finish its most recent "Run for the Roses."

St. Norbert, 22-10-1 all-time in the tournament, has suffered overtime losses in its last two NCAA Tournament eliminations. Including the aforementioned Norwich game, St. Norbert lost to Oswego State 4-3 in overtime in a national semifinal game in the 2007 Frozen Four at UW-Superior.

St. Norbert is 5-1 all-time at Herb Brooks Arena following three Frozen Four appearances at the venerable Lake Placid, N.Y., venue.

Power Play Ponderings:

St. Norbert's power play clicking in its last eight games of the season. The Green Knights connected for 16 goals in its last 41 power-play chances, a lusty percentage of 39.0 over that stretch.

The Green Knights were 5-for-9 against UW-Stevens Point on Feb. 9,

2-for-3 against UW-Stout on Feb. 10, 1-for-2 against UW-Eau Claire on Feb. 25, 3-for-5 against Stevens Point on March 3, 1-for-5 against St. Thomas on March 7 and 1-for-7 against Gustavus Adolphus on March 10. St. Norbert then went 2-for-5 against Norwich and 1-for-5 against Oswego State at the Frozen Four.

Jacobson Jottings:

St. Norbert freshman goaltender David Jacobson has enjoyed a banner rookie season between the pipes for the Green Knights, posting a record of 19-2-3 with a 1.53 goals against average and .936 save percentage.

Jacobson was named the NCAA Division III Frozen Four's Most Outstanding Player, and was tabbed the national Rookie of the Year by U.S. College Hockey Online. He was a second-team All-America selection by the AHCA.

Jacobson posted four shutouts this season, including back-to-back shutouts of UW-Eau Claire and UW-Stevens Point in the NCHA Peters Cup Playoffs. His shutout total trailed Amherst's Jonathon LaRose's five for the national lead.

Jacobson had a consecutive

shutout sequence of 151 minutes 24 seconds end in the first-round NCAA Tournament win over St. Thomas, which is 14th best all-time in NCAA Division III history and sixth-best in St. Norbert history. Kyle Jones has five streaks longer, including the national record of 337:22.

Jacobson, a Janesville native, is the first Wisconsinite to play between the pipes for St. Norbert since Chippewa Falls' Neil Schimmel appeared in one game during the 2002-03 season.

Coghlin Count:

St. Norbert head coach Tim Coghlin brings a record of 411-113-45 into next season.

St. Norbert's 3-1 win over St. Thomas on March 7 moved him out of tie for 33rd on the all-time NCAA hockey coaching wins list with John "Gino" Gasparini of North Dakota, Mike Gilligan of Salem State and Vermont and Craig Dahl - most notably of St. Cloud State.

Retired St. Thomas coach Terry Skrypek is 32nd on the list with an all-time record of 418-197-46 from 1988 to 2010.

POTY Parsings:

St. Norbert senior forward Johan Ryd was honored on Feb. 16 when he was named the 2012 Northern Collegiate Hockey Association Player of the Year.

Ryd's accolade marks the eighth time among seven players a St. Norbert skater has been so honored. Roby Gropp was the first St. Norbert NCHA Player of the Year in 1997. Rob Smillie followed in 1998, Adam Sedgwick in 2001, Maris Ziedins in 2002, Kyle Jones in both 2006 and 2008 and B.J. O'Brien in 2011.

Ryd, a Sodertalje, Sweden native, led St. Norbert in assists (25) and points (40). In 88 career games, Ryd has 37 goals and 59 assists for 96 points. He was named a first-team All-America selection by both the American Hockey Coaches Association and U.S. College

Hockey Online.

Following the season, Ryd signed a five-game contract with the ECHL's Chicago Express.

Bradshaw Banter:

St. Norbert freshman forward Cullen Bradshaw enjoyed a banner freshman season, posting eight goals and 22 assists for 30 points.

Bradshaw is the first St. Norbert freshman to post 30 points in his rookie season since Matt Boyd totaled 31 points in 2007.

Bradshaw's 22 assists are the third-most by a freshman in St. Norbert history. Adam Sedgwick (1998) and Jason Deutsch (2002) both had 25 assists their freshman seasons.

Bradshaw posted nine multi-point

games this season, second on the squad to Johan Ryd's 12. Bradshaw had two goals in a 4-1 national quarterfinal win over Gustavus Adolphus on March 10, his only multi-goal game of the season.

Blackjack:

St. Norbert's 21 wins this season matched the fewest wins ever by a Division III national champion.

UW-River Falls (21-8-4) in 1994, Middlebury (21-5-1) in 1999 and Neumann (21-9-2) in 2009 all finished with 21 wins and won the national title.

In the last 16 seasons (dating back to 1997), St. Norbert has won at least 21 games 14 times. The Green Knights have never won less than 18 games

during that time period.

Home Sweet Cornerstone:

St. Norbert enjoyed another banner season on its home ice at the Cornerstone Community Center. The Green Knights finished 12-2-1 at home this season, and also won their last seven games there.

St. Norbert is 145-9-7 in its last 161 games at the Cornerstone Community Center.

The Green Knights had a 25-game home winning streak - the second-longest in NCAA Division III history - snapped with a 2-2 tie to Gustavus Adolphus on Nov. 4. St. Norbert also owns the NCAA Division III record with a 36-game home winning streak set Oct. 25, 2002 to Oct. 29, 2004.

Tough After Two:

St. Norbert finished 17-1-1 this season when leading after two periods following a pair of 4-1 wins over Norwich and Oswego State, respectively, at the NCAA Division III Frozen Four.

Under Tim Coghlin, St. Norbert is an astounding 221-1-2 at home when up after two periods. The Green Knights were 13-0 at the Cornerstone Community Center

last season when leading after 40 minutes.

St. Norbert had a home unbeaten streak when leading after two periods of 200 games (197-0-3) before it was snapped by UW-Stout in a 4-3 overtime loss on Feb. 7, 2009 - Coghlin's only home setback when leading after two.

At home, St. Norbert is 239-2-3 in school history when leading after two periods. The Green Knights' lone other loss when up after two periods on their own ice came on Nov. 18, 1989 in a 3-1 loss to Augsburg when St. Norbert lost a 1-0 lead.

The Green Knights were 2-3-1 this season when trailing after two periods and 2-1-3 when tied after two periods. St. Norbert was 0-3 last season when trailing after two periods. It was 6-0 last season when tied after two after two periods.

2008, 2011 & 2012 NCAA DIVISION III NATIONAL CHAMPIONS

Green Knights have played at least one game a season against an eastern foe for the past 18 years.

St. Norbert is 16-8-3 all-time on East Region ice. The Green Knights are 12-6-2 all-time in the State of New York.

The Green Knights are 10-3-1 all-time against the State University of New York Athletic Conference, including a 2-0 mark against Plattsburgh State and a 2-2 ledger against Oswego State.

St. Norbert is 6-5-3 all-time against ECAC West opposition (including games against now-Division I RIT and Mercyhurst), and is 3-5 all-time against the NESCAC.

The Green Knights are 2-0 all-time against the ECAC Northeast, also beating Fitchburg State in the 1994-95 season.

St. Norbert is 4-3 against the ECAC East, going 3-3 against Norwich and 1-0 against Southern Maine.

Western Wonders:

The Northern Collegiate Hockey Association has placed a representative in the NCAA Division III championship game 19 out of a possible 29 times. St. Norbert has made six title game appearances, in 2004, 2006, 2008, 2010, 2011 and 2012.

Bemidji State did it twice (1985-86), UW-River Falls three times (1988, '93, '94), UW-Stevens Point six times (1989-93, '98), Mankato State once (1991) and UW-Superior four times (1994, '97, '99, 2002). NCHA teams have squared off for the national championship three times (1991 - Stevens Point vs. Mankato State, 1993 - Stevens Point vs. River Falls, 1994 - River Falls vs. Superior).

UW-Stevens Point (1989, '90, '91, '93), UW-River Falls (1988, '94), Bemidji State (1986), UW-Superior (2002) and St. Norbert (2008, '11, '12) have all won Division III national titles while members of the NCHA.

In 29 NCAA Division III Frozen Fours, the NCHA has placed a team

among the final four 27 years - the most of any league. The NCHA did not advance a team through to the Frozen Four in 1984 and 2005. River Falls lost to Union in the 1984 quarterfinals and St. Norbert lost to St. Thomas in the 2005 quarterfinals.

St. Norbert's 4-3 win over Adrian in the 2011 national championship game marked the first All-West Region final since 1994, when UW-River Falls beat UW-Superior 6-4.

Poll Position:

St. Norbert has been ranked in the USCHO.com Division III Poll for 190 consecutive weeks. The Green Knights have been ranked in 228 of 234 polls conducted since its inception at the start of the 1998-99 season - the most of any school in Division III.

Against ranked teams this season, St. Norbert had a loss and tie at UW-River Falls Nov. 11-12. St. Norbert swept UW-Eau Claire on Nov. 18-19. The Green Knights lost to River Falls on Jan. 27 4-3 but then beat St. Scholastica 3-1 on Feb. 4 and UW-Stevens Point 8-3 on Feb. 9 and 4-0 on March 3. The Green Knights then topped St. Thomas 3-1 on March 7 and Gustavus Adolphus 4-1 on March 10. St. Norbert then beat No. 1 Norwich 4-1 and No. 3 Oswego State 4-1 at the Frozen Four to improve to 9-2-1 against nationally ranked teams this season.

During the 190-week stretch of being ranked, St. Norbert has been No. 1 for 50 weeks - trailing Norwich's 61 for most all-time. St. Norbert was rated No. 1 in the 2003, 2004, 2005, 2007, 2008, 2011 and 2012 final polls. The Green Knights are 71-13-6 all-time when ranked No. 1.

St. Norbert is 100-38-14 against teams ranked in the USCHO.com Poll under Tim Coghlin. The Green Knights are 1-4 all-time against the No. 1-ranked team and are 4-5 all-time against the No. 2-ranked team.

St. Norbert is 5-21-6 in its last 32 games when allowing five goals or more dating back to the 1996-97 season. The only five wins came in a 9-5 win over St. Scholastica on Feb. 20, 1999, a 7-5 win over UW-Stout on Nov. 30, 2001, an 8-5 win over UW-Stout on Jan. 14, 2005, a 7-5 win over UW-Stevens Point on Feb. 3, 2007 and a 7-5 win over Gustavus Adolphus on Oct. 31, 2008.

The Green Knights have allowed five goals just 18 times in their last 321 games.

St. Norbert has never allowed 10 goals in a game during Tim Coghlin's 569-game tenure.

MIAC Minutiae:

St. Norbert has a solid 78-10-6 record against Minnesota Intercollegiate Athletic Conference competition since Tim Coghlin took over the Green Knights' helm in 1993. Two of the losses came in a sweep at St. Mary's in Coghlin's first year of 1993-94.

Since then, the Green Knights are 78-8-6 against the MIAC. The losses came in a 4-3 decision at St. John's on Nov. 24, 2000 and a pair of losses to St. Thomas in the 2004-05 season. The Green Knights also dropped a 7-4 contest to Augsburg during 2005-06, to Gustavus Adolphus in 2007-08, to St. Thomas in 2008-09, Hamline in 2010-11 and at St. Mary's in 2011-12. St. Norbert has tied St. Thomas twice and Augsburg and Hamline each once.

At home under Coghlin, St. Norbert is a remarkable 44-2-3 against MIAC foes. The losses came in a 3-2 defeat to St. Thomas in the 2005 NCAA Division III Tournament and to Gustavus Adolphus 4-2 on Nov. 3, 2007.

St. Norbert went 3-1-2 against the MIAC in 2011-12, including two wins in the NCAA Tournament.
