St. Norbert battles for first place this weekend when it faces co-leader UW-Eau Claire Friday. The Green Knights complete the two-game road trip to western Wisconsin when it plays UW-River Falls Saturday at Hunt Arena.

The Series:

St. Norbert leads the UW-Eau Claire series by a 44-5-4 margin. St. Norbert is 44-2-4 in the series since Eau Claire topped the Green Knights 5-4 in overtime on Jan. 21, 1995 at Hobbs Ice Center.

St. Norbert leads the series with UW-River Falls 38-18-3. The Green Knights are 34-6-2 against River Falls in their last 42 meetings, including a 12-5-2 mark at Hunt Arena.

The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Tim Coghlin (UW-Stevens Point, 1989) is 426-116-46 in his 20th season in De Pere. The Green Knights are 282-47-29 in the last 12-plus seasons. Coghlin's 416 wins as a coach in the NCHA is the league record, 46 more than Bemidji State's Bob Peters' 370 wins. Coghlin's six NCAA championship game appearances are the second most in Division III history. Coghlin became just the 37th coach in college hockey history (all divisions) to win 400 games when St. Norbert beat UW-Stout 4-2 on Jan. 20, 2012.

UW-Eau Claire coach Matt Loen (UW-Eau Claire, 1995) is 74-70-12 in his sixth season in Eau Claire.

UW-River Falls coach Steve Freeman (UW-Stevens Point, 1981) is 302-151-36 in his 17th season in River Falls.

This Year:

UW-Eau Claire took three points from St. Norbert with a 5-3 win and 3-3 tie on Nov. 16-17 at the Cornerstone Community Center.

St. Norbert swept UW-River Falls at the Cornerstone Community Center with wins of 7-1 and 4-0 on Nov 9-10

About the Green Knights:

St. Norbert, ranked No. 2 in the USCHO.com and D3hockey.com Division III polls, enters the weekend 15-3-1 overall and 9-2-1 in the NCHA. The Green Knights split their series with UW-Stout last weekend, losing the opener 4-3 before salvaging the back end by a 4-1 score.

Senior forward Kyle Stroh leads St. Norbert in scoring with 15 goals and 15 assists for 30 points. Stroh's 15 goals are currently the secondhighest total in Division III. Junior forward Joe Perry has 10 goals and 15 assists for 25 points. Sophomore forward Cullen Bradshaw has 12 goals and 12 assists for 24 points, while senior forward Cody Keefer has 10 goals and 14 assists for 24 points.

Sophomore goaltender David Jacobson is 12-3-1 with a 1.49 goals against average and .931 save percentage with a Division III-leading five shutouts. Junior Travis Bosch is 2-0 with a 2.47 goals against average and .902 save percentage.

St. Norbert is 36-for-103 (35.0 percent) on the power play and is 60-for-66 (91.4 percent) on the penalty kill. The Green Knights possess the top power-play and penalty-kill percentages in Division III.

About the Blugolds:

UW-Eau Claire enters the series ranked No. 6 in the USCHO.com poll and is 14-3-2 overall. The Blugolds are tied with St. Norbert atop the NCHA standings with a 9-2-1 record following a 5-2 and 3-1 series sweep of UW-Superior this past weekend.

Senior forward Jordan Singer leads the Blugolds in scoring with 12 goals and 12 assists for 24 points. Junior forward Mark Pustin has seven goals and 14 assists for 21 points. Senior forward Andrew McCabe follows with six goals and 11 assists for 17 points, while sophomore defenseman Jack Callahan has one goals and 15 assists for 16 points.

Senior goaltender Brandon Stephenson has a 12-2-2 record with a 2.27 goals against average and .921 save percentage. Senior Alex Bjerk is 2-1 with a 2.31 goals against average and .901 save percentage.

Eau Claire is 17-for-69 (24.6 percent) on the power play and is 53-for-66 (80.3 percent) on the penalty kill.

About the Falcons:

UW-River Falls enters its game on Friday with UW-Stevens Point with a 10-6-3 overall record and a 3-6-3 ledger in the NCHA. The Falcons took just one point at home from St. Scholastica last weekend with a 5-2 loss and 3-3 tie.

Senior forward Adam Cardwell leads the Falcons in scoring with 11 goals and 10 assists for 21 points. Freshman forward Zach Schrotenboer has eight goals and six assists for 14 points. Sophomore forward Blake Huppert has four goals and eight assists for 12 points, while sophomore defenseman George Malliaras has 11 assists for 11 points.

Junior goaltender Scott Lewan has made all 19 starts this season for the Falcons. Lewan is 10-6-3 with a 2.72 goals against average and .910 save percentage.

River Falls is 9-for-73 (12.3 percent) on the power play and is 74-for-87 (85.1 percent) on the penalty kill.

Power Play Ponderings:

St. Norbert enters the weekend series with a power play that has been red hot since last February.

Dating back through the last eight games of last season - a total of 27 games overall - St. Norbert is 52-for-144 (36.1 percent) on the power play. The Green Knights are just a shade below that this season, going 36-for-103 (35.0 percent), which is currently the best power play in Division III. St. Norbert was 16-for-41 (39.0 percent) in its last eight games last season.

St. Norbert has not had a power play percentage above 30 percent since 2003-04, when it was 32.1 percent.(54-for-168).

St. Norbert's school record is 35.1 percent, set in 1998-99 when the Green Knights cashed in 54 times in 154 opportunities.

Keefer Komments:

With his goal on Nov. 24 against Lawrence, St. Norbert senior forward Cody Keefer became the 13th player in school history to score 50 career goals.

Keefer moved into a tie for eighth place on the all-time list with a goal in Jan. 11th's 5-0 win over UW-Superior. Keefer is now tied with Spencer Carbery (2004-06) with 55 career goals. Connor Hughes sits in

seventh place with 60 career goals from 2003-06.

Keefer has 104 points (55-49-104) in 106 career games. Only three other players in St. Norbert history with at least 50 career goals have more lifetime goals than assists. Maris Ziedins was 74-71-145 from 2000 to 2003, Bruce Henderson was 62-49-109 from 1989 to 1991, and Carbery was 55-45-100 from 2004 to 2006.

Coghlin Count:

St. Norbert head coach Tim Coghlin brings a record of 426-116-46 into this weekend.

The Green Knights' 5-0 win over UW-Superior on Jan. 11 moved Coghlin out of a tie with the late Shawn Walsh for 30th place on the all-time NCAA hockey coaches win list. Walsh went 423-188-47 in 17 years at Maine, coaching from 1985 to 2001.

Bill Wilkinson (Western Michigan 1983-99 and Wayne State 2000-08) is 29th on the list at 437-469-81 in 26 seasons. Trinity's John Dunham (1975-2007) sits in 28th place with a record of 441-306-34 in 33 seasons.

Tough After Two:

St. Norbert is 14-0 this season when leading after two periods. The Green Knights finished 17-1-1 last season when leading after two periods following a pair of 4-1 wins over Norwich and Oswego State, respectively, at the NCAA Division III Frozen Four.

Under Tim Coghlin, St. Norbert is an astounding 230-1-2 at home when up after two periods.

St. Norbert had a home unbeaten streak when leading after two periods of 200 games (197-0-3) before it was snapped by UW-Stout in a 4-3 overtime loss on Feb. 7, 2009 - Coghlin's only home setback when leading after two.

At home, St. Norbert is 248-2-3 in school history when leading after two periods. The Green Knights' lone other loss when up after two periods on their own ice came on Nov. 18, 1989 in a 3-1 loss to

Poll Position:

St. Norbert has been ranked in the USCHO.com Division III Poll for 201 consecutive weeks. The Green Knights have been ranked in 239 of 245 polls conducted since its inception at the start of the 1998-99 season - the most of any school in Division III.

During the 201-week stretch of being ranked, St. Norbert has been No. 1 for 52 weeks - trailing Norwich's 66 for most all-time. St. Norbert was rated No. 1 in the 2003, 2004, 2005, 2007, 2008, 2011 and 2012 final polls. The Green Knights are 73-15-6 all-time when ranked No. 1.

St. Norbert is 104-40-15 against teams ranked in the USCHO.com Poll under Tim Coghlin. The Green Knights are 1-4 all-time against the No. 1-ranked team and are 4-5 all-time against the No. 2-ranked team.

Gimme Five:

St. Norbert is unbeaten in its last 252 games when scoring five goals or more with a 245-0-7 mark since a 7-5 loss to Bemidji State in De Pere on Jan. 12, 1996.

St. Norbert is 5-22-6 in its last 33 games when allowing five goals or more dating back to the 1996-97 season. The only five wins came in a 9-5 win over St. Scholastica on Feb. 20, 1999, a 7-5 win over UW-Stout on Nov. 30, 2001, an 8-5 win over UW-Stout on Jan. 14, 2005, a 7-5 win over UW-Stevens Point on Feb. 3, 2007 and a 7-5 win over Gustavus Adolphus on Oct. 31, 2008.

The Green Knights have allowed five goals just 19 times in their last 340 games.

St. Norbert has never allowed 10 goals in a game during Tim Coghlin's 588-game tenure.

Ice Chip:

* - St. Norbert is a meager 61st out of 72 NCAA Division III teams in penalty minutes at 11.2 per game. The total is the lowest among the seven teams in the NCHA.
