The Series:

St. Norbert leads the series with UW-Stout 37-10-4. The Green Knights are 35-5-3 in the last 43 games with the Blue Devils.

St. Norbert leads the series with UW-Stevens Point by a 43-19-5 margin. St. Norbert is 43-11-2 in the last 55 games against the Pointers after opening the series 0-8-3. St. Norbert is also 25-3-1 in the last 29 games in the series.

The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Tim Coghlin (UW-Stevens Point, 1989) is 428-118-46 in his 20th season in De Pere. The Green Knights are 283-48-29 in the last 12-plus seasons. Coghlin's 418 wins as a coach in the NCHA is the league record, 48 more than Bemidji State's Bob Peters' 370 wins. Coghlin's six NCAA championship game appearances are the second most in Division III history. Coghlin became just the 37th coach in college hockey history (all divisions) to win 400 games when St. Norbert beat UW-Stout 4-2 on Jan. 20, 2012.

UW-Stout coach Terry Watkins (UW-Stout, 1972) is 207-229-28 in his 17th season in Menomonie.

UW-Stevens Point coach Chris Brooks (Western Michigan, 1996) is 27-20-5 in his second season in Stevens Point.

This Year:

St. Norbert swept UW-Stevens Point 7-0 in De Pere and 4-0 in Stevens Point in a home-and-home series on Oct. 26-27.

The Green Knights split with UW-Stout on Jan. 18-19 at the Cornerstone Community Center in De Pere, losing the opener 4-3 before winning 4-1.

About the Green Knights:

St. Norbert, ranked No. 6 in the USCHO.com Division III Poll, enters the weekend 17-5-1 overall and 10-4-1 in the NCHA. The Green Knights split their pair of home games last weekend, falling 5-2 to St. Scholastica on Friday before topping UW-Superior 4-1 on Saturday.

Senior forward Kyle Stroh leads St. Norbert in scoring with 17 goals and 18 assists for 35 points. Senior forward Cody Keefer has 12 goals and 15 assists for 27 points, while junior forward Joe Perry has 11 goals and 16 assists for 27 points. Sophomore forward Cullen Bradshaw has 13 goals and 12 assists for 25 points.

Sophomore goaltender David Jacobson is 14-5-1 with a 1.73 goals against average and .924 save percentage with a Division III-leading five shutouts. Junior Travis Bosch is 2-0 with a 2.02 goals against average and .906 save percentage.

St. Norbert is 38-for-126 (30.2 percent) on the power play and is 74for-82 (90.2 percent) on the penalty kill.

About the Blue Devils:

UW-Stout enters Thursday's game with UW-Stevens Point at 10-11-2 overall and 5-11 in the NCHA. The Blue Devils lost a pair of games last week, falling 3-0 at UW-River Falls last Thursday before dropping a 4-3 decision to UW-Eau Claire last Friday.

Junior forward Kevin O'Donnell leads the Blue Devils in scoring with 11 goals and 10 assists for 21 points. Senior forward Garrett Grimstad has seven goals and 13 assists for 20 points. Senior defenseman Jason Cohen has five goals and 12 assists for 17 points, while sophomore foward Zach Vierling has eight goals and seven assists for 15 points.

Senior goaltender Nick Hopper owns a 9-7-2 record with a 2.65 goals against average and .916 save percentage.

Stout is 16-for-92 (17.4 percent) on the power play and is 98-for-115 (85.2 percent) on the penalty kill.

About the Pointers:

UW-Stevens Point enters its game Thursday with UW-Stout at 13-9-1 overall and 7-8-1 in the NCHA. The Pointers split a pair of home games last weekend, defeating UW-Superior 2-1 on Friday before falling to St. Scholastica 6-3 on Saturday.

Junior forward Garrett Ladd owns the team lead in scoring with four goals and 14 assists for 18 points. Junior forward Kyle Heck has 10 goals and seven assists for 17 points. Sophomore forward SCott Henegar has 10 goals and six assists for 16 points, while senior forward Johnny Meo has eight goals and eight assists for 16 points.

Sophomore goaltender Brandon Jaeger is 9-4-1 with a 2.74 goals against average and .875 save percentage. Senior goaltender Nick Graves is 4-5 with a 2.47 goals against average and .905 save percentage.

Stevens Point is 13-for-90 (14.4 percent) on the power play and is 96-for-124 (77.4 percent) on the penalty kill.

Frightful Fridays:

St. Norbert has uncharacteristically lost its last three Friday games, but has rebounded the following day each time to salvage a split on the weekend.

Since the start of the 2002-03 season, the Green Knights have lost the first game of a two-game weekend 18 times. St. Norbert has responded well to avoid getting swept, going 14-0-4 the next day following a loss.

St. Norbert is 3-0-1 this season the day after a loss, and was also 3-0-1 in 2011-12.

The Green Knights have not lost two games in a weekend since losing 5-4 in overtime to Elmira and 6-1 to Williams on Nov. 24-25, 2001 at the Elmira East-West Classic.

St. Norbert has not gotten swept at home since NCAA Division III powerhouses Norwich and Middlebury paid the Cornerstone Community Center a visit on Dec. 1-2, 2000, respectively. The Cadets won 5-2 and the Panthers won 1-0.

The Green Knights have not gotten swept in a NCHA regular-season weekend since playing Bemidji State on Jan. 12-13, 1996 at the De Pere Ice Center. The Beavers claimed wins of 7-5 and 5-4 in overtime.

Keefer Komments:

With his goal on Nov. 24 against Lawrence, St. Norbert senior forward Cody Keefer became the 13th player in school history to score 50 career goals. Keefer moved into sole possession of eighth place on the St. Norbert career goals list with two goals in a 4-1 win over UW-Superior on Feb. 2. Keefer, who has 57 career goals, trails Connor Hughes for seventh place. Hughes had 60 career goals from 2003-06.

Keefer has 107 points (57-50-107) in 112 career games. Only three other players in St. Norbert history with at least 50 career goals have more lifetime goals than assists. Maris Ziedins was 74-71-145 from 2000 to 2003, Bruce Henderson was 62-49-109 from 1989 to 1991, and Spencer Carbery was 55-45-100 from 2004 to 2006.

Tough After Two:

St. Norbert is 16-0 this season when leading after two periods. The Green Knights finished 17-1-1 last season when leading after two periods following a pair of 4-1 wins over Norwich and Oswego State, respectively, at the NCAA Division III Frozen Four.

Under Tim Coghlin, St. Norbert is an astounding 231-1-2 at home when up after two periods.

St. Norbert had a home unbeaten streak when leading after two periods of 200 games (197-0-3) before it was snapped by UW-Stout in a 4-3 overtime loss on Feb. 7, 2009 -Coghlin's only home setback when leading after two.

At home, St. Norbert is 249-2-3 in school history when leading after two periods. The Green Knights' lone other loss when up after two periods on their own ice came on Nov. 18, 1989 in a 3-1 loss to Augsburg when St. Norbert lost a 1-0 lead.

Poll Position:

St. Norbert has been ranked in the USCHO.com Division III Poll for 203 consecutive weeks. The Green Knights have been ranked in 241 of 247 polls conducted since its inception at the start of the 1998-99 season - the most of any school in Division III.

St. Norbert is 104-41-15 against teams ranked in the USCHO.com Poll under Tim Coghlin. The Green Knights are 1-4 all-time against the No. 1-ranked team and are 4-5 alltime against the No. 2-ranked team.

Gimme Five:

St. Norbert is unbeaten in its last 252 games when scoring five goals or more with a 245-0-7 mark since a 7-5 loss to Bemidji State in De Pere on Jan. 12, 1996.

St. Norbert is 5-23-6 in its last 34 games when allowing five goals or more dating back to the 1996-97 season. The only five wins came in a 9-5 win over St. Scholastica on Feb. 20, 1999, a 7-5 win over UW-Stout on Nov. 30, 2001, an 8-5 win over UW-Stout on Jan. 14, 2005, a 7-5 win over UW-Stevens Point on Feb. 3, 2007 and a 7-5 win over Gustavus Adolphus on Oct. 31, 2008.

The Green Knights have allowed five goals just 20 times in their last 342 games.

St. Norbert has never allowed 10 goals in a game during Tim Coghlin's 592-game tenure.

Ice Chips:

* - St. Norbert is a meager 61st out of 72 NCAA Division III teams in penalty minutes at 10.8 per game. The total is the lowest among the seven teams in the NCHA.

* - St. Norbert is 11-2-1 this season when scoring the first goal, and is 6-3 this season when it does not.

* - St. Norbert is 1-2 in one-goal games this season. The Green Knights' lone one-goal win came in a 3-2 overtime win at Augsburg on Nov. 2.
