St. Norbert opens its final season in the Northern Collegiate Hockey Association with a home-and-home series against longtime rival UW-Stevens Point. The Green Knights host the Pointers on Friday at the Cornerstone Community Center before traveling to central Wisconsin for Saturday's contest at Willett Arena.

St. Norbert is also 23-3-1 in the last 27 games in the series. The Green Knights are 15-0-2 in their last 17 games against the Pointers at the Cornerstone Community Center.

The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Tim Coghlin (UW-Stevens Point, 1989) is 412-113-45 entering his 20th season in De Pere. The Green Knights are 268-44-28 in the last 12 seasons. Coghlin's 402 wins as a coach in the NCHA is the league record, 32 more than Bemidji State's Bob Peters' 370 wins. Coghlin's six championship NCAA game appearances are the second most in Division III history. Coghlin became just the 37th coach in college hockey history (all divisions) to win 400 games when St. Norbert beat UW-Stout 4-2 on Jan. 20, 2012.

UW-Stevens Point coach Chris Brooks (Western Michigan, 1996) is 15-11-4 in his second season in Stevens Point.

Last Year:

St. Norbert went 3-1 against UW-Stevens Point last season.

Stevens Point claimed a 5-1 win last Oct. 28 at Willett Arena in Stevens Point. Kyle Heck registered a hat trick and Nick Graves made 20 saves for the Pointers. Cullen Bradshaw scored for St. Norbert, which got 18 saves from Travis Bosch.

St. Norbert rebounded the next night at the Cornerstone Community Center with a 4-1 win. Bradshaw, Johan Ryd, Emil Haque and Kyle Stroh all scored for St. Norbert. Graves made 24 saves for the Pointers, while Bosch had 16 saves for the Green Knights.

The Green Knights claimed an 8-3 win over Stevens Point on Feb. 9 at the Cornerstone Community Center. St. Norbert cashed in five times on nine power-play opportunities. Eight different skaters pumped in a goal for St. Norbert. David Jacobson made 20 saves for the Green Knights, while Brandon Jaeger took the loss with 19 saves in 37:54 of action.

St. Norbert then captured its 10th NCHA Peters Cup championship with a 4-0 win last March 3 at the Cornerstone Community Center. St. Norbert scored three power-play goals. Jacobson made 21 saves to post his second-consecutive shutout. Jaeger made 23 saves for the Pointers.

About the Green Knights:

St. Norbert opened the 2012-13 season with a 4-0 win over Concordia-Wisconsin Tuesday at the Cornerstone Community Center. The win was the Green Knights' 10th consecutive win dating back to last season. It was St. Norbert's 13th consecutive win in a season opener.

The Green Knights received goals from four different players. Senior forward Kyle Stroh, senior defenseman Carl Ekstrom, sophomore forward Sam Dougherty and freshman forward Erik Cooper all found the back of the net. Ekstrom's goal came on a power play, while Stroh scored shorthanded.

Sophomore goaltender David Jacobson recorded his fifth career shutout by making 17 saves against Concordia. Jacobson has allowed only four goals in his last seven games.

St. Norbert is 1-for-6 (16.7 percent) on the power play and is 4-for-4 (100.0 percent) on the penalty kill.

About the Pointers:

UW-Stevens Point opened the season with a 5-0 win Tuesday at Willett Arena in Stevens Point.

Senior forward Nick Kenney scored one goal and one assist for two points, while sophomore defenseman Kevin Gibson has two assists for two points. Senior defenseman Jon Bockmann also added a goal. Kenney's and Bockmann's goals were both shorthanded scores.

Senior goaltender Nick Graves and sophomore goaltender Brandon Jaeger split time in the pipes for the Pointers against the Foresters. Jaeger made five saves in 29 minutes, while Graves turned away four shots in 31 minutes.

The Pointers are 1-for-9 (11.1 percent) on the power play, and are 8for-8 (100.0 percent) on the penalty kill.

Coghlin Count:

St. Norbert head coach Tim Coghlin brings a record of 412-113-45 into this weekend's series against UW-Stevens Point.

St. Norbert's 3-1 win over St. Thomas last March 7 moved him out of tie for 33rd on the all-time NCAA hockey coaching wins list with John "Gino" Gasparini of North Dakota, Mike Gilligan of Salem State and Vermont and Craig Dahl - most notably of St. Cloud State.

Retired St. Thomas coach Terry Skrypek is 32nd on the list with an all-time record of 418-197-46 from 1988 to 2010.

Home Sweet Cornerstone:

St. Norbert is 167-17-10 at the Cornerstone Community Center, which includes a 9-4-1 mark there its first season in the building in 2000-01. The Green Knights have 14 of their 25 regular-season games at the Cornerstone this season.

St. Norbert is 146-9-7 in its last 162 games at the Cornerstone Community Center.

The Green Knights had a 25-game home winning streak - the secondlongest in NCAA Division III history - snapped with a 2-2 tie to Gustavus Adolphus last Nov. 4. St. Norbert also owns the NCAA Division III record with a 36-game home winning streak set Oct. 25, 2002 to Oct. 29, 2004.

In the last 10-plus seasons, the Green Knights are a sparkling 159-12-9 at the Cornerstone, with three losses and one tie coming to national champion UW-Superior during the 2001-02 season.

Under Tim Coghlin, St. Norbert is 245-39-16 at home, which includes games at Brown County Arena,

Resch Center and De Pere Ice Arena.

Tough After Two:

St. Norbert is 1-0 this season when leading after two periods. The Green Knights finished 17-1-1 last season when leading after two periods following a pair of 4-1 wins over Norwich and Oswego State, respectively, at the NCAA Division III Frozen Four.

Under Tim Coghlin, St. Norbert is an astounding 222-1-2 at home when up after two periods.

St. Norbert had a home unbeaten streak when leading after two periods of 200 games (197-0-3) before it was snapped by UW-Stout in a 4-3 overtime loss on Feb. 7, 2009 -Coghlin's only home setback when leading after two.

At home, St. Norbert is 240-2-3 in school history when leading after two periods. The Green Knights' lone other loss when up after two periods on their own ice came on Nov. 18, 1989 in a 3-1 loss to Augsburg when St. Norbert lost a 1-0 lead.

Poll Position:

St. Norbert has been ranked in the USCHO.com Division III Poll for 190 consecutive weeks. The Green Knights have been ranked in 228 of 234 polls conducted since its inception at the start of the 1998-99 season - the most of any school in Division III.

Against ranked teams last season, St. Norbert had a loss and tie at UW-River Falls Nov. 11-12. St. Norbert swept UW-Eau Claire on Nov. 18-19. The Green Knights lost to River Falls on Jan. 27 4-3 but then beat St. Scholastica 3-1 on Feb. 4 and UW-Stevens Point 8-3 on Feb. 9 and 4-0 on March 3. The Green Knights then topped St. Thomas 3-1 on March 7 and Gustavus Adolphus 4-1 on March 10. St. Norbert then beat No. 1 Norwich 4-1 and No. 3 Oswego State 4-1 at the Frozen Four to improve to 9-2-1 against nationally ranked teams this season.

being ranked, St. Norbert has been No. 1 for 50 weeks - trailing Norwich's 61 for most all-time. St. Norbert was rated No. 1 in the 2003, 2004, 2005, 2007, 2008, 2011 and 2012 final polls. The Green Knights are 71-13-6 all-time when ranked No. 1.

St. Norbert is 100-38-14 against teams ranked in the USCHO.com Poll under Tim Coghlin. The Green Knights are 1-4 all-time against the No. 1-ranked team and are 4-5 alltime against the No. 2-ranked team.

Gimme Five:

St. Norbert is unbeaten in its last 244 games when scoring five goals or more with a 237-0-7 mark since a 7-5 loss to Bemidji State in De Pere on Jan. 12, 1996.

St. Norbert is 5-21-6 in its last 32 games when allowing five goals or more dating back to the 1996-97 season. The only five wins came in a 9-5 win over St. Scholastica on Feb. 20, 1999, a 7-5 win over UW-Stout on Nov. 30, 2001, an 8-5 win over UW-Stout on Jan. 14, 2005, a 7-5 win over UW-Stevens Point on Feb. 3, 2007 and a 7-5 win over Gustavus Adolphus on Oct. 31, 2008.

The Green Knights have allowed five goals just 18 times in their last 322 games.

St. Norbert has never allowed 10 goals in a game during Tim Coghlin's 569-game tenure.

Ice Chips:

* - St. Norbert has allowed just four goals in its last seven games dating back to the final six games of last season. That stretch matched the Green Knights' best defensive stretch in program history, when it allowed only four goals in the final seven games of the 2007-08 season. Five of those seven games were shutouts.

* - Freshman Erik Cooper's goal on Tuesday against Concordia was his first collegiate score, and came on his first shot on goal.
