St. Norbert travels to the Gopher State for a pair of games against Minnesota Intercollegiate Athletic Conference foes. The Green Knights face Augsburg Friday in Minneapolis before a big West Region matchup with No. 5-ranked Gustavus Adolphus Saturday in St. Peter.

The Series:

Augsburg leads St. Norbert in the all-time series 10-4-1. Augsburg is 9-3-1 in the last 13 meetings. The Green Knights are 3-1-1 against the Auggies under Tim Coghlin.

The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Tim Coghlin (UW-Stevens Point, 1989) is 414-113-45 in his 20th season in De Pere. The Green Knights are 270-44-28 in the last 12-plus seasons. Coghlin's 404 wins as a coach in the NCHA is the league record, 34 more than Bemidji State's Bob Peters' 370 wins. Coghlin's six NCAA championship game appearances are the second most in Division III history. Coghlin became just the 37th coach in college hockey history (all divisions) to win 400 games when St. Norbert beat UW-Stout 4-2 on Jan. 20, 2012.

Augsburg coach Chris Brown (UW-River Falls, 1994) is 68-77-12 in his eighth season in Minneapolis. He was 69-56-8 in five years combined at Marian and Hamline for a total record of 137-133-20.

Entering Friday's game with UW-Stevens Point, Gustavus Adolphus coach Brett Petersen (Denver, 1992) is 167-133-25 in his 13th season in St. Peter.

Last Year:

St. Norbert topped Augsburg 7-2 last Nov. 5 at the Cornerstone Community Center in De Pere. Kyle Stroh had a five-point night for the Green Knights, netting three goals and two assists. David Jacobson made 22 saves for St. Norbert. Justin Lochner made 24 stops for the Auggies.

St. Norbert went 1-0-1 against Gustavus Adolphus in a pair of meetings last season - both at the Cornerstone Community Center in De Pere. The two teams skated to a 2-2 tie on Nov. 4 at the Cornerstone before the Green Knights claimed a 4-1 win in the NCAA Division III Tournament quarterfinals on March 10. In the first game, the Gusties took a 2-0 lead on goals by Gustav Bengtson and Zach May before St. Norbert rallied for the tie with goals by Cody Keefer and Justin Favreau. St. Norbert outshot the Gusties 41-20. In the NCAA Tournament win, St. Norbert got two goals from Cullen Bradshaw as the Green Knights outshot Gustavus 39-14. David Jacobson made 13 saves for St. Norbert, while John McLean

made 35 stops for Gustavus.

About the Green Knights:

St. Norbert is coming off an impressive weekend sweep of UW-Stevens Point. The Green Knights opened NCHA play with a 7-0 win at home Friday before blanking the Pointers again 4-0 Saturday in Stevens Point. The Green Knights have yet to allow a goal this season en route to a 3-0 start.

Senior forward Kyle Stroh leads the Green Knights in scoring with four goals and two assists for six points. Senior defenseman Carl Ekstrom has two goals and two assists for four points, as does sophomore forward Cullen Bradshaw. Sophomore defenseman Sam Higgins has four assists for four points.

Sophomore goaltender David Jacobson is the only netminder to have played thus far for the Green Knights. Jacobson has not allowed a goal this season while facing 46 shots in his three shutouts.

St. Norbert is 8-for-23 (34.8 percent) on the power play and is 10for-10 (100.0 percent) on the penalty kill.

About the Auggies:

Augsburg entered Tuesday's exhibition with the Norway Under-18 national team with a 1-1 record. The Auggies split a pair of non-conference games against MIAC opposition this past weekend, losing 3-0 to St. Thomas on Friday before topping St. Olaf 3-2 on Saturday.

Junior forward B.J. McClellan led the Auggies with two goals and one assist for three points. Sophomore forward Ben McClellan tallied one goal, while senior defenseman Landon Olson was the only other Augsburg skater to get on the scoresheet with one assist.

Senior goaltender Justin Lochner played both games in net for Augsburg, fashioning a 1-1 record with a 2.50 goals against average and .926 save percentage.

Augsburg is 0-for-7 (0.0 percent) on the power play, and is 7-for-8 (87.5 percent) on the penalty kill.

About the Gusties:

Gustavus Adolphus won its two games at the MIAC Showcase last weekend with a 2-0 win on Friday over Hamline and a 5-1 triumph over Concordia-Moorhead on Saturday to stand at 2-0 overall.

Junior forward Gustav Bengtson leads the Gusties offensively with two goals and one assist for three points. Sophomore forward Andy Pearson has three assists for three points. Sophomore forward Jack Walsh has one goal and one assist for two points, while sophomore forward Tyler Lapic has two assists for two points.

Sophomore goaltender John McLean shutout Hamline with a 22save performance. Senior Tyler Venne made 28 stops to pick up the win against Concordia-Moorhead.

Gustavus is 3-for-9 (33.3 percent) on the power play and is 7-for-7 (100.0 percent) on the penalty kill.

Jacobson Jottings:

Sophomore goaltender David Jacobson has carried over his strong play from the end of last season into the start of the new one. Jacobson has been in net for all three games this season, spinning a shutout in each one. Jacobson has made 46 saves total in the three games.

Dating back to last year's national championship game, Jacobson has an active consecutive shutout sequence of 229 minutes 13 seasons. According to the NCAA Division III Ice Hockey Records Book, that mark is the fourth-best streak in Division III history. Former St. Norbert standout has the first- and third-best marks at 337:22 in 2006 and 234:49 in 2008, while Adam Hanna of St. John's had a 291:00 streak in 2004.

Jacobson's has seven shutouts in 26 lifetime starts, a total that already puts him tied for 13th in NCAA Division III history for career shutouts. Jones holds the NCAA Division III and St. Norbert records with 25 career shutouts.

Shutout Skinny:

St. Norbert's three shutouts to open the season is the best mark in school history. In fact, the Green Knights had never even opened a season with back-to-back shutouts.

Only seven times in NCAA Division III history has a team spun three consecutive shutouts, and St. Norbert now owns four of those occasions. The Green Knights share the Division III record of four with St. John's and Middlebury.

Middlebury owns the record with consecutive shutouts to start a season when it had its four-straight blankings from Nov. 17-25, 2000. The Panthers then allowed one goal at UW-Stevens Point and then shutout St. Norbert 1-0 on Dec. 2 at the Cornerstone Community Center to start that season allowing one goal in six games.

Dating back to the end of last season, St. Norbert has allowed just four goals in its last nine games. The Green Knights yielded just four goals in six post-season games a year ago.

Coghlin Count:

St. Norbert head coach Tim Coghlin brings a record of 414-113-45 into this weekend.

St. Norbert's 3-1 win over St. Thomas last March 7 moved him out of tie for 33rd on the all-time NCAA hockey coaching wins list with John "Gino" Gasparini of North Dakota, Mike Gilligan of Salem State and Vermont and Craig Dahl - most notably of St. Cloud State.

Retired St. Thomas coach Terry Skrypek is 32nd on the list with an all-time record of 418-197-46 from 1988 to 2010.

Tough After Two:

St. Norbert is 3-0 this season when leading after two periods. The Green Knights finished 17-1-1 last season when leading after two periods following a pair of 4-1 wins over Norwich and Oswego State, respectively, at the NCAA Division III Frozen Four.

Under Tim Coghlin, St. Norbert is an astounding 223-1-2 at home when up after two periods.

St. Norbert had a home unbeaten streak when leading after two periods of 200 games (197-0-3) before it was snapped by UW-Stout in a 4-3

At home, St. Norbert is 241-2-3 in school history when leading after two periods. The Green Knights' lone other loss when up after two periods on their own ice came on Nov. 18, 1989 in a 3-1 loss to Augsburg when St. Norbert lost a 1-0 lead.

Poll Position:

St. Norbert has been ranked in the USCHO.com Division III Poll for 191 consecutive weeks. The Green Knights have been ranked in 229 of 235 polls conducted since its inception at the start of the 1998-99 season - the most of any school in Division III.

During the 191-week stretch of being ranked, St. Norbert has been No. 1 for 51 weeks - trailing Norwich's 61 for most all-time. St. Norbert was rated No. 1 in the 2003, 2004, 2005, 2007, 2008, 2011 and 2012 final polls. The Green Knights are 71-13-6 all-time when ranked No. 1.

St. Norbert is 100-38-14 against teams ranked in the USCHO.com Poll under Tim Coghlin. The Green Knights are 1-4 all-time against the No. 1-ranked team and are 4-5 all-time against the No. 2-ranked team.

Gimme Five:

St. Norbert is unbeaten in its last 245 games when scoring five goals or more with a 238-0-7 mark since a 7-5 loss to Bemidji State in De Pere on Jan. 12, 1996.

St. Norbert is 5-21-6 in its last 32 games when allowing five goals or more dating back to the 1996-97 season. The only five wins came in a 9-5 win over St. Scholastica on Feb. 20, 1999, a 7-5 win over UW-Stout on Nov. 30, 2001, an 8-5 win over UW-Stout on Jan. 14, 2005, a 7-5 win over UW-Stevens Point on Feb. 3, 2007 and a 7-5 win over Gustavus Adolphus on Oct. 31, 2008.

The Green Knights have allowed five goals just 18 times in their last 324 games.

St. Norbert has never allowed 10 goals in a game during Tim Coghlin's 571-game tenure.
