Series Overview:

St. Norbert continues on its six-game homestand when it hosts UW-Eau Claire in another important Northern Collegiate Hockey Association series. The Green Knights enter the weekend ranked third nationally, while the Blugolds are ranked eighth.

The Series:

St. Norbert leads the UW-Eau Claire series by a 44-4-3 margin. St. Norbert is 44-1-3 in the series since Eau Claire topped the Green Knights 5-4 in overtime on Jan. 21, 1995 at Hobbs Ice Center. The Green Knights are 30-1-1 all-time at home in the series under Tim Coghlin.

The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Tim Coghlin (UW-Stevens Point, 1989) is 417-114-45 in his 20th season in De Pere. The Green Knights are 273-45-28 in the last 12-plus seasons. Coghlin's 407 wins as a coach in the NCHA is the league record, 37 more than Bemidji State's Bob Peters' 370 wins. Coghlin's six NCAA championship game appearances are the second most in Division III history. Coghlin became just the 37th coach in college hockey history (all divisions) to win 400 games when St. Norbert beat UW-Stout 4-2 on Jan. 20, 2012.

UW-Eau Claire coach Matt Loen (UW-Eau Claire, 1995) is 66-67-10 in his sixth season in Eau Claire.

Last Year:

St. Norbert went 4-0 against UW-Eau Claire last season.

The Green Knights won 3-2 last Nov. 18 at Hobbs Ice Center in Eau Claire. Cody Keefer scored twice for St. Norbert, while Seth Soley added a goal for the Green Knights. Tyler Jundt and Jon Waggoner scored for Eau Claire. David Jacobson made 24 saves for St. Norbert, while Brandon Stephenson made 25 for the Blugolds.

The Green Knights swept the series at Eau Claire with a 5-2 win the next day. The Blugolds led 2-0 after the first period behind goals from Andrew Wilcox and Jared Williams, but the Green Knights answered with two goals from Soley and one each from Keefer, Johan Ryd and Mason Baptista. Jacobson made 33 saves for St. Norbert, while Andrew Martin had 13 for Eau Claire.

St. Norbert rallied for a 5-4 win over Eau Claire on Jan. 28 at the Cornerstone Community Center. Eau Claire led 4-2 in the second period before Kyle Stroh's shorthanded marker pulled the Green Knights to within 4-3. Chris Rial tied the game early in the third period, and Joe Perry scored the gamewinner with 1:49 left. Jacobson made 11 saves for the Green Knights, while Stephenson made 24 stops for Eau Claire.

St. Norbert defeated Eau Claire 2-0 last Feb. 25 in the semifinals of the NCHA Peters Cup Playoffs at the Cornerstone. Marian Fiala scored a first-period power-play goal that held up until Ryd's empty-net goal with 7 seconds left. Stephenson made 28 saves for Eau Claire and Jacobson 19 for St. Norbert.

About the Green Knights:

St. Norbert enters the series with a 6-1 overall record and is unblemished at 4-0 in the Northern Collegiate Hockey Association. The Green Knights swept a home series with UW-River Falls this past weekend with wins of 7-1 and 4-0. St. Norbert is ranked No. 3 in this week's USCHO.com Division III Poll.

Six different players have scored at least three goals apiece so far this season. Senior forward Kyle Stroh leads the Green Knights in scoring with five goals and six assists for 11 points. Senior forward Cody Keefer, junior forward Joe Perry and sophomore forward Cullen Bradshaw all have three goals and four assists for seven points. Sophomore defenseman Sam Higgins has a team-high seven assists for seven points. Freshman forward Tyler Zepeda has three goals and three assists for six points, while freshman forward Erik Cooper has three goals and two assists for five points.

Sophomore goaltender David Jacobson is 5-1 with a 0.50 goals against average and .972 save percentage. Junior Travis Bosch is 1-0 with a 1.95 goals against average and .917 save percentage.

Eleven different players have scored St., Norbert's 15 power-play goals. St. Norbert is 15-for-39 (38.5 percent) on the power play and is 24-for-24 (100.0 percent) on the penalty kill.

About the Blugolds:

UW-Eau Claire enters the St. Norbert series unbeaten at 6-0 overall and 4-0 in the NCHA. The Blugolds went on the road to sweep St. Scholastica last weekend by scores of 5-1 and 7-5.

Senior forward Andrew McCabe

leads the Blugolds offensively with three goals and six assists for nine points. Senior forward Jordan Singer has four goals and four assists for eight points, with three of his goals coming on the power play. Junior defenseman David Donnellan has three goals and four assists for seven points, while senior forward Isaiah Bennis has four goals and two assists for six points.

Senior goaltender Brandon Stephenson is 5-0 with a 2.60 goals against average and .903 save percentage. Senior Alex Bjerk is 1-0 with a 2.00 goals against average and .917 save percentage.

Eau Claire is 9-for-25 (36.0 percent) on the power play, and is 18-for-22 (81.8 percent) on the penalty kill.

End of an Era:

St. Norbert will be hosting UW-Eau Claire this weekend at the Cornerstone Community Center. The Blugolds, along with UW-River Falls, UW-Stevens Point, UW-Stout and UW-Superior, are leaving the NCHA after this season to play exclusively in the WIAC.

The Green Knights went to their first NCAA Division III Frozen Four in 2002-03. Including that season to the present, St. Norbert is 114-18-15 against the five WIAC schools, a winning percentage of .827.

St. Norbert owns a 29-1-2 mark against Eau Claire in that stretch, and is 26-3-1 against Stevens Point. The Green Knights are also 24-5-1 against River Falls, 18-5-8 against Superior and 17-4-3 against Stout.

Overall, St. Norbert is 250-40-25 from the 2002-03 season to the present, a winning percentage of .833.

Home Sweet Cornerstone:

St. Norbert is 170-17-10 at the Cornerstone Community Center, which includes a 9-4-1 mark there its first season in the building in 2000-01. The Green Knights have 14 of their 25 regular-season games at the Cornerstone this season.

St. Norbert is 149-9-7 in its last 165 games at the Cornerstone Community Center.

The Green Knights had a 25-game

home winning streak - the secondlongest in NCAA Division III history - snapped with a 2-2 tie to Gustavus Adolphus last Nov. 4. St. Norbert also owns the NCAA Division III record with a 36-game home winning streak set Oct. 25, 2002 to Oct. 29, 2004.

In the last 10-plus seasons, the Green Knights are a sparkling 160-12-9 at the Cornerstone, with three losses and one tie coming to national champion UW-Superior during the 2001-02 season.

Under Tim Coghlin, St. Norbert is 248-39-16 at home, which includes games at Brown County Arena, Resch Center and De Pere Ice Arena.

Coghlin Count:

St. Norbert head coach Tim Coghlin brings a record of 417-114-45 into this weekend..

St. Norbert's 3-1 win over St. Thomas last March 7 moved him out of tie for 33rd on the all-time NCAA hockey coaching wins list with John "Gino" Gasparini of North Dakota, Mike Gilligan of Salem State and Vermont and Craig Dahl - most notably of St. Cloud State.

Retired St. Thomas coach Terry Skrypek is 31st on the list with an all-time record of 418-197-46 from 1988 to 2010.

Tough After Two:

St. Norbert is 5-0 this season when leading after two periods. The Green Knights finished 17-1-1 last season when leading after two periods following a pair of 4-1 wins over Norwich and Oswego State, respectively, at the NCAA Division III Frozen Four.

Under Tim Coghlin, St. Norbert is an astounding 225-1-2 at home when up after two periods.

St. Norbert had a home unbeaten streak when leading after two periods of 200 games (197-0-3) before it was snapped by UW-Stout in a 4-3 overtime loss on Feb. 7, 2009 - Coghlin's only home setback when leading after two.

At home, St. Norbert is 243-2-3 in school history when leading after

Poll Position:

St. Norbert has been ranked in the USCHO.com Division III Poll for 193 consecutive weeks. The Green Knights have been ranked in 231 of 237 polls conducted since its inception at the start of the 1998-99 season - the most of any school in Division III.

During the 193-week stretch of being ranked, St. Norbert has been No. 1 for 51 weeks - trailing Norwich's 61 for most all-time. St. Norbert was rated No. 1 in the 2003, 2004, 2005, 2007, 2008, 2011 and 2012 final polls. The Green Knights are 72-14-6 all-time when ranked No. 1.

St. Norbert is 102-39-14 against teams ranked in the USCHO.com Poll under Tim Coghlin. The Green Knights are 1-4 all-time against the No. 1-ranked team and are 4-5 all-time against the No. 2-ranked team.

Gimme Five:

St. Norbert is unbeaten in its last 246 games when scoring five goals or more with a 239-0-7 mark since a 7-5 loss to Bemidji State in De Pere on Jan. 12, 1996.

St. Norbert is 5-21-6 in its last 32 games when allowing five goals or more dating back to the 1996-97 season. The only five wins came in a 9-5 win over St. Scholastica on Feb. 20, 1999, a 7-5 win over UW-Stout on Nov. 30, 2001, an 8-5 win over UW-Stout on Jan. 14, 2005, a 7-5 win over UW-Stevens Point on Feb. 3, 2007 and a 7-5 win over Gustavus Adolphus on Oct. 31, 2008.

The Green Knights have allowed five goals just 18 times in their last 328 games.

St. Norbert has never allowed 10 goals in a game during Tim Coghlin's 576-game tenure.
