St. Norbert plays its final home games before the holiday break when it hosts the NCHA/MCHA Thanksgiving Classic. The Green Knights, along with St. Scholastica, will face Marian and Lawrence in a "classic" style format. All four teams will be a part of the MCHA next season.

The Series:

St. Norbert leads Marian 13-0-2 in a series which began in the 1996-97 season. St. Norbert is 5-0-1 at home all-time in the series.

St. Norbert holds a 31-0 lead in the all-time series with Lawrence. The two schools met four times a season from 1988-89 to Tim Coghlin's first

year in 1993-94, and have met seven times since the 1994-95 season.

The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Tim Coghlin (UW-Stevens Point, 1989) is 417-115-46 in his 20th season in De Pere. The Green Knights are 273-46-29 in the last 12-plus seasons. Coghlin's 407 wins as a coach in the NCHA is the league record, 37 more than Bemidji State's Bob Peters' 370 wins. Coghlin's six NCAA championship game appearances are the second most in Division III history. Coghlin became just the 37th coach in college hockey history (all divisions) to win 400 games when St. Norbert beat UW-Stout 4-2 on Jan. 20, 2012.

Marian coach A.J. Aitken (Michigan Tech, 2000) is 4-3-1 in his first season in Fond du Lac.

Lawrence coach Mike Szkodzinski (St. Norbert, 2000) 78-83-13 in his seventh year in Appleton.

Last Year:

St. Norbert rallied from a 5-3 deficit after two periods to forge a 5-5 tie with Marian last Nov. 26 in Fond du Lac. Cody Keefer and Brandon Hoogenboom scored in the third period for St. Norbert, while Tom Glomski scored twice for Marian. David Jacobson made 22 saves in almost 37 minutes of relief, and Josh Baker made 42 saves for Marian.

St. Norbert topped Lawrence 5-1 last Nov. 25 in Fond du Lac. Alain Joannette scored two goals for the Green Knights. David Jacobson made 30 saves for the Green Knights, and Peter Emery had 34 stops for the Vikings.

About the Green Knights:

St. Norbert enters the weekend at 6-2-1 overall after getting one point at home in a two-game series with UW-Eau Claire this past weekend. The Green Knights lost the opener 5-3 before rallying for a 3-3 tie to drop to 4-1-1 in the NCHA.

Senior forward Kyle Stroh leads

the Green Knights in scoring with six goals and seven assists for 13 points. Senior forward Cody Keefer and sophomore forward Cullen Bradshaw both have four goals and five assists for nine points. Junior forward Joe Perry has three goals and five assists for eight points.

Sophomore goaltender David Jacobson is 5-2-1 with a 1.24 goals against average and .935 save percentage. Junior Travis Bosch is 1-0 with a 1.95 goals against average and .917 save percentage.

St. Norbert is 19-for-51 (37.3 percent) on the power play and is 26-for-29 (89.7 percent) on the penalty kill.

About the Sabres:

Marian enters the weekend with a 4-3-1 overall record and is 4-2 in the MCHA. The Sabres come into Friday's game with a three-game winning streak, which includes a sweep of Lawrence last week. Marian topped the Vikings 3-2 and 4-3 in overtime.

Junior forward Tyler Klein leads the Sabres in goals with four and has two assists for six points. Sophomore forward Brian Berger has two goals and four assists for six points. Senior forward Brendan Roberts and sophomore forward Aaron Leonard both have two goals and three assists for five points.

Junior goaltender Josh Baker is 3-1-1 with a 1.77 goals against average and .931 save percentage. Sophomore Randy Willis is 1-2 with a 3.02 goals against average and .917 save percentage.

Marian is 3-for-38 (7.9 percent) on the power play and is 28-for-36 (77.8 percent) on the penalty kill.

About the Vikings:

Lawrence enters Friday's game against St. Scholastica with a 2-4 overall and MCHA record. The Vikings picked up their lone two wins this season with a sweep of Northland by scores of 10-1 and 8-6 on Nov. 9-10.

A pair of freshmen leads

Lawrence in scoring. Defenseman Brandon Boelter has three goals and six assists for nine points, and forward Rudi Pino has two goals and seven assists for nine points. Senior forward Brad Scurfield has five goals and three assists for eight points, while senior forward Phil Bushbacher has four goals and four assists for eight points.

Sophomore goaltender Peter Emery is 1-4 with a 3.23 goals against average and .891 save percentage. Senior Michael Baldino is 1-0 with a 4.17 goals against average and .842 save percentage.

Lawrence is 7-for-26 (26.9 percent) on the power play and is 28-for-35 (80.0 percent) on the penalty kill.

Home Sweet Cornerstone:

St. Norbert is 170-18-11 at the Cornerstone Community Center, which includes a 9-4-1 mark there its first season in the building in 2000-01. The Green Knights have 14 of their 25 regular-season games at the Cornerstone this season.

St. Norbert is 149-10-8 in its last 167 games at the Cornerstone Community Center.

The Green Knights had a 25-game home winning streak - the second-longest in NCAA Division III history - snapped with a 2-2 tie to Gustavus Adolphus last Nov. 4. St. Norbert also owns the NCAA Division III record with a 36-game home winning streak set Oct. 25, 2002 to Oct. 29, 2004.

In the last 10-plus seasons, the Green Knights are a sparkling 160-13-10 at the Cornerstone, with three losses and one tie coming to national champion UW-Superior during the 2001-02 season.

Under Tim Coghlin, St. Norbert is 248-40-17 at home, which includes games at Brown County Arena, Resch Center and De Pere Ice Arena.

Coghlin Count:

St. Norbert head coach Tim Coghlin brings a record of 417-115-46 into this weekend.

St. Norbert's 3-1 win over St. Thomas last March 7 moved him out of tie for 33rd on the all-time NCAA hockey coaching wins list with John "Gino" Gasparini of North Dakota, Mike Gilligan of Salem State and Vermont and Craig Dahl - most notably of St. Cloud State.

Retired St. Thomas coach Terry Skrypek is 31st on the list with an all-time record of 418-197-46 from 1988 to 2010.

Tough After Two:

St. Norbert is 5-0 this season when leading after two periods. The Green Knights finished 17-1-1 last season when leading after two periods following a pair of 4-1 wins over Norwich and Oswego State, respectively, at the NCAA Division III Frozen Four.

Under Tim Coghlin, St. Norbert is an astounding 225-1-2 at home when up after two periods.

St. Norbert had a home unbeaten streak when leading after two periods of 200 games (197-0-3) before it was snapped by UW-Stout in a 4-3 overtime loss on Feb. 7, 2009 - Coghlin's only home setback when leading after two.

At home, St. Norbert is 243-2-3 in school history when leading after two periods. The Green Knights' lone other loss when up after two periods on their own ice came on Nov. 18, 1989 in a 3-1 loss to Augsburg when St. Norbert lost a 1-0 lead.

Poll Position:

St. Norbert has been ranked in the USCHO.com Division III Poll for 194 consecutive weeks. The Green Knights have been ranked in 232 of 238 polls conducted since its inception at the start of the 1998-99 season - the most of any school in Division III.

During the 194-week stretch of being ranked, St. Norbert has been No. 1 for 51 weeks - trailing Norwich's 61 for most all-time. St. Norbert was rated No. 1 in the 2003, 2004, 2005, 2007, 2008, 2011 and

St. Norbert is 102-40-15 against teams ranked in the USCHO.com Poll under Tim Coghlin. The Green Knights are 1-4 all-time against the No. 1-ranked team and are 4-5 all-time against the No. 2-ranked team.

Gimme Five:

St. Norbert is unbeaten in its last 246 games when scoring five goals or more with a 239-0-7 mark since a 7-5 loss to Bemidji State in De Pere on Jan. 12, 1996.

St. Norbert is 5-22-6 in its last 33 games when allowing five goals or more dating back to the 1996-97 season. The only five wins came in a 9-5 win over St. Scholastica on Feb. 20, 1999, a 7-5 win over UW-Stout on Nov. 30, 2001, an 8-5 win over UW-Stout on Jan. 14, 2005, a 7-5 win over UW-Stevens Point on Feb. 3, 2007 and a 7-5 win over Gustavus Adolphus on Oct. 31, 2008.

The Green Knights have allowed five goals just 19 times in their last 330 games.

St. Norbert has never allowed 10 goals in a game during Tim Coghlin's 578-game tenure.

Ice Chips:

* - St. Norbert has never lost a game to a Midwest Collegiate Hockey Association school. The Green Knights are 56-0-2 all-time against the MCHA. St. Norbert is 31-0 against Lawrence, 13-0-2 against Marian, 6-0 against MSOE, 2-0 against Adrian, Lake Forest and Concordia-Wis.

* - St. Norbert's loss and tie against UW-Eau Claire last weekend marked the first time in nearly 11 years a visiting team walked out of the Cornerstone Community Center with at least three points. Eventual national champion UW-Superior tied 4-4 and then won 4-2 on March 9-10, 2002 in a NCAA Division III Tournament quarterfinal series.
