#### Series Overview:

St. Norbert plays its final series before the holiday break when it travels to the Twin Ports to face St. Scholastica at Mars Lakeview Arena. The weekend marks the final time during the regular season the Green Knights will play outside of Wisconsin.

#### The Series:

St. Norbert is 42-10-3 all-time against St. Scholastica. St. Norbert holds a slim 6-4-1 series edge in its last 11 meetings with the Saints. The Green Knights are 4-1-1 in their last six games in Duluth and are 14-5-1 all-time on the road in the series.

## The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Tim Coghlin (UW-Stevens Point, 1989) is 419-115-46 in his 20th season in De Pere. The Green Knights are 275-46-29 in the last 12-plus seasons. Coghlin's 409 wins as a coach in the NCHA is the league record, 39 more than Bemidji State's Bob Peters' 370 wins. Coghlin's six NCAA championship game appearances are the second most in Division III history. Coghlin became just the 37th coach in college hockey history (all divisions) to win 400 games when St. Norbert beat UW-Stout 4-2 on Jan. 20, 2012.

St. Scholastica coach Mark Wick (St. Scholastica, 1985) is 109-96-28 in his ninth season in Duluth.

## Last Year:

St. Norbert took the season series last year from St. Scholastica by a 2-1 count. The Green Knights split a two-game series at the Cornerstone Community Center, losing 3-2 on Dec. 9 before rallying for a 6-3 win the next day. St. Norbert then claimed an important 3-1 win on Feb. 4 at Mars Lakeview Arena in Duluth, Minn.

Jeremy Dawes snapped a 2-2 tie midway through the third period to win the opener for the Saints. Chris Rial and Johan Ryd scored for St. Norbert. Colin Rundell made 33 saves for St. Scholastica, while David Jacobson made 16 for St. Norbert.

St. Norbert trailed the second game 3-1 in the second period before closing out the game with five unanswered goals from five different skaters. Alain Joannette's goal at 6:09 of the third period snapped a 3-3 tie. Rundell made 18 saves for St. Scholastica, and Jacobson made 22 stops for the Green Knights.

St. Norbert jumped out to a 3-0 lead in the game at Duluth to take control and cruise to the win. Ryd, Joannette and Derek Donahue all scored for St. Norbert. Jacobson made 28 saves for St. Norbert, and Rundell 25 for the Saints.

## About the Green Knights:

St. Norbert enters the series at 8-2-1 overall and 4-1-1 in the NCHA. The Green Knights, who were idle last week, last played Thanksgiving weekend when they topped Marian 3-1 and Lawrence 6-3.

Senior forward Kyle Stroh had a six-point weekend during Thanksgiving, and leads the Green Knights in scoring with 10 goals and nine assists for 19 points. Senior forward Cody Keefer has five goals and seven assists for 12 points. Freshman forward Tyler Zepeda has five goals and six assists for 11 points, while junior forward Joe Perry has four goals and seven assists for 11 points.

Sophomore goaltender David Jacobson is 6-2-1 with a 1.22 goals against average and .938 save percentage. Junior Travis Bosch is 2-0 with a 2.47 goals against average and .902 save percentage.

St. Norbert is 22-for-60 (36.7 percent) on the power play and is 31-for-35 (88.6 percent) on the penalty kill.

## About the Saints:

St. Scholastica enters the series with a 3-7 overall record and a 1-5 mark in the NCHA. The Saints were swept this past weekend in a league series at UW-Stout, falling 2-1 in overtime and 5-2. This weekend's series mark just the third and fourth home games of the year for the Saints, but marks the opening of a seven-game homestand.

Senior forward Brett Corcoran leads the Saints in scoring with six goals and seven assists for 13 points. Junior forward Brandon Nowakowski has six goals and six assists for 12 points. Freshman defenseman Brenden Kotyk has four goals and five assists for nine points.

Junior goaltender Colin Rundell has seen most of the action between the pipes for the Saints. Rundell is 3-6 with a 2.93 goals against average and .911 save percentage. Freshman Tyler Bruggeman is 0-1

with a 5.39 goals against average and .857 save percentage.

St. Scholastica is 10-for-53 (18.9 percent) on the power play and is 40-for-53 (75.5 percent) on the penalty kill.

**Power Play Ponderings:**

St. Norbert enters its series with St. Scholastica with a power play that has been red hot since last February.

Dating back through the last eight games of last season - a total of 19 games overall - St. Norbert is 38-for-101 (37.6 percent) on the power play. The Green Knights are just a shade below that this season, going 22-for-60 (36.7 percent), which is currently the third-best power play in Division III. St. Norbert was 16-for-41 (39.0 percent) in its last eight games last season.

St. Norbert has not had a power play percentage above 30 percent since 2003-04, when it was 32.1 percent.(54-for-168).

St. Norbert's school record is 35.1 percent, set in 1998-99 when the Green Knights cashed in 54 times in 154 opportunities.

**Fast Four:**

St. Norbert got out to a big early lead in its last game, a 6-3 win over Lawrence on Nov. 24 at the Cornerstone Community Center.

The Green Knights scored four goals in the first period en route to taking a 4-1 lead. Two of the goals came in the first two minutes, with markers by Tyler Zepeda at 1:18 and Cody Keefer at 1:34.

St. Norbert last scored four goals in a first period in a 6-3 win over UW-Stout on Oct. 30, 2010 at the Cornerstone Community Center. The Blue Devils held a 2-1 lead before the Green Knights closed out the period with three straight goals.

**Keefer Komments:**

With his goal on Nov. 24 against Lawrence, St. Norbert senior forward Cody Keefer became the 13th player in school history to score 50 career goals.

Keefer is tied with Chris Bodnar (2000-02) for 12th on the all-time list with 50 goals. Shane Dickson is 11th on the list with 52 goals from 1998 to 2001.

Keefer has 50 goals and 42 assists for 92 points in 101 career games. Only three other players in St. Norbert history with at least 50 career goals have more lifetime goals than assists. Maris Ziedins was 74-71-145 from 2000 to 2003, Bruce Henderson was 62-49-109 from 1989 to 1991, and Spencer Carbery was 55-45-100 from 2004 to 2006.

**Coghlin Count:**

St. Norbert head coach Tim Coghlin brings a record of 419-115-46 into this weekend.

The Green Knights' 6-3 win over Lawrence on Nov. 24 moved Coghlin past retired St. Thomas coach Terry Skrypek for 31st on the all-time list. Skrypek had an all-time record of 418-197-46 from 1988 to 2010.

Coghlin now trails the late Shawn Walsh for 30th place on the all-time list. Walsh went 423-188-47 in 17 years at Maine, coaching from 1985 to 2001.

**Tough After Two:**

St. Norbert is 7-0 this season when leading after two periods. The Green Knights finished 17-1-1 last season when leading after two periods following a pair of 4-1 wins over Norwich and Oswego State, respectively, at the NCAA Division III Frozen Four.

Under Tim Coghlin, St. Norbert is an astounding 227-1-2 at home when up after two periods.

St. Norbert had a home unbeaten streak when leading after two periods of 200 games (197-0-3) before it was snapped by UW-Stout in a 4-3 overtime loss on Feb. 7, 2009 - Coghlin's only home setback when leading after two.

At home, St. Norbert is 245-2-3 in school history when leading after two periods. The Green Knights' lone other loss when up after two

periods on their own ice came on Nov. 18, 1989 in a 3-1 loss to Augsburg when St. Norbert lost a 1-0 lead.

### Poll Position:

St. Norbert has been ranked in the USCHO.com Division III Poll for 196 consecutive weeks. The Green Knights have been ranked in 234 of 240 polls conducted since its inception at the start of the 1998-99 season - the most of any school in Division III.

During the 196-week stretch of being ranked, St. Norbert has been No. 1 for 51 weeks - trailing Norwich's 62 for most all-time. St. Norbert was rated No. 1 in the 2003, 2004, 2005, 2007, 2008, 2011 and 2012 final polls. The Green Knights are 72-14-6 all-time when ranked No. 1.

St. Norbert is 102-40-15 against teams ranked in the USCHO.com Poll under Tim Coghlin. The Green Knights are 1-4 all-time against the No. 1-ranked team and are 4-5 all-time against the No. 2-ranked team.

### Gimme Five:

St. Norbert is unbeaten in its last 247 games when scoring five goals or more with a 240-0-7 mark since a 7-5 loss to Bemidji State in De Pere on Jan. 12, 1996.

St. Norbert is 5-22-6 in its last 33 games when allowing five goals or more dating back to the 1996-97 season. The only five wins came in a 9-5 win over St. Scholastica on Feb. 20, 1999, a 7-5 win over UW-Stout on Nov. 30, 2001, an 8-5 win over UW-Stout on Jan. 14, 2005, a 7-5 win over UW-Stevens Point on Feb. 3, 2007 and a 7-5 win over Gustavus Adolphus on Oct. 31, 2008.

The Green Knights have allowed five goals just 19 times in their last 332 games.

St. Norbert has never allowed 10 goals in a game during Tim Coghlin's 580-game tenure.
