#### The Series:

St. Mary's leads the all-time series with St. Norbert 12-9 begun in the 1988-89 season. St. Norbert is 8-1 in the last nine games in the series.

St. Norbert and St. Olaf are tied 9-9-1 in a series begun in 1988-89, but St. Norbert is 8-0-1 against the Oles under Tim Coghlin. The Green Knights hold the scoring advantage in those games by a 46-19 margin.

his 20th season in De Pere. The Green Knights are 277-46-29 in the last 12-plus seasons. Coghlin's 411 wins as a coach in the NCHA is the league record, 41 more than Bemidji State's Bob Peters' 370 wins. Coghlin's six NCAA championship game appearances are the second most in Division III history. Coghlin became just the 37th coach in college hockey history (all divisions) to win 400 games when St. Norbert beat UW-Stout 4-2 on Jan. 20, 2012.

St. Mary's coach Bill Moore (St. Mary's, 1985) is 36-94-7 in his sixth season in Winona.

St. Olaf coach Sean Goldsworthy (St. Olaf, 1994) is 166-186-50 in his 17th season in Northfield.

#### **Last Meetings:**

St. Mary's stunned St. Norbert 3-2 last Jan. 7 at the St. Mary's Ice Arena in Winona, Minn., but from there the Green Knights would finish out the season on a 14-1-1 tear culminating in their third national title. The Cardinals rallied from a 2-1 deficit with two third-period goals. Jason Horstman made 32 saves for the Cardinals, while Travis Bosch made 26 stops for St. Norbert.

St. Norbert and St. Olaf skated to a 2-2 tie last Jan. 6 at the Northfield Ice Arena in Northfield, Minn. Dylan Porter's power-play goal late in the second period was the gametying score. David Jacobson made 26 saves for St. Norbert, while Steve Papciak made 41 saves for the Oles.

#### **About the Green Knights:**

St. Norbert enters the weekend 10-2-1 overall and 6-1-1 in the NCHA. The Green Knights, who currently own a modest four-game winning streak, are coming off a 6-1 and 6-2 NCHA series sweep of St. Scholastica on Dec. 7-8 in Duluth, Minn

Senior forward Kyle Stroh paces the Green Knights' offense with 11 goals and 12 assists for 23 points, and currently standings fourth nationally in scoring at 1.92 points per game. Senior forward Cody Keefer has six goals and 10 assists for 16 points. Freshman forward Tyler Zepeda claimed his first collegiate hat trick on Dec. 7 at St. Scholastica and has eight goals and seven assists for 15 points. Junior forward Joe Perry has six goals and eight assists for 14 points, while sophomore forward Cullen Bradshaw has six goals and seven assists for 13 points.

Sophomore goaltender David Jacobson is 8-2-1 with a 1.27 goals against average and .937 save percentage with four shutouts. Junior Travis Bosch is 2-0 with a 2.47 goals against average and .902 save percentage.

St. Norbert is 25-for-70 (35.7 percent) on the power play and is 40-for-44 (90.9 percent) on the penalty kill.

#### **About the Cardinals:**

St. Mary's enters the game at 5-6 overall and 3-1 in the Minnesota Intercollegiate Athletic Conference. The Cardinals have been idle since getting swept by Lake Forest 5-3 and 2-0 in a road series on Dec. 7-8.

Freshman forward Mike Hill leads the Cardinals in scoring with six goals and nine assists for 14 points. Junior forward Bobby Thompson has a team-high seven goals with six assists for 13 points. Sophomore defenseman Bob Marx has four goals and seven assists for 11 points, while junior forward Austin Balko has six goals and four assists for 10 points. Senior forward Kevin Wentland has four goals and six assists for 10 points.

Senior goaltender Andy Scheib has a 4-3 record with a 2.97 goals against average and .886 save percentage. Senior Jason Horstman is 0-2 with a 7.25 goals against average and .807 save percentage.

St. Mary's is 13-for-70 (18.6 percent) on the power play and is 49-for-63 (77.8 percent) on the penalty

#### **About the Oles:**

St. Olaf enters Friday's game with UW-Stevens Point at 5-6-1 overall and 4-2 in the Minnesota Intercollegiate Athletic Conference. The Oles have been off for over a

month, last taking the ice in a 5-1 win over St. Mary's on Dec. 1.

Junior forward Dan Cecka leads St. Olaf with a team-high six goals, and has four assists for 10 points. Junior forward Jeff Harris has five goals and five assists for 10 points, while junior forward Kevin Harris has three goals and seven assists for 10 points. Senior forward Ross Trousdale has four goals and three assists for seven points.

Junior goaltender Henrik Wood is 3-2-1 overall and with a 1.65 goals against average and .941 save percentage. Sophomore Steve Papciak is 2-4 with a 3.02 goals against average and .905 save percentage.

St. Olaf is 10-for-50 (20.0 percent) on the power play and is 36-for-42 (85.7 percent) on the penalty kill.

#### **Power Play Ponderings:**

St. Norbert enters the weekend against St. Mary's and St. Olaf with a power play that has been red hot since last February.

Dating back through the last eight games of last season - a total of 21 games overall - St. Norbert is 41-for-111 (36.9 percent) on the power play. The Green Knights are just a shade below that this season, going 25-for-70 (35.7 percent), which is currently the third-best power play in Division III. St. Norbert was 16-for-41 (39.0 percent) in its last eight games last season.

The two teams ahead of the Green Knights in power-play percentage have had just over half the opportunities St. Norbert has, with Middlebury at 39.0 percent (16-for-41) and UMass-Boston at 38.9 percent (14-for-36).

St. Norbert has not had a power play percentage above 30 percent since 2003-04, when it was 32.1 percent.(54-for-168).

St. Norbert's school record is 35.1 percent, set in 1998-99 when the Green Knights cashed in 54 times in 154 opportunities.

#### **Keefer Komments:**

With his goal on Nov. 24 against Lawrence, St. Norbert senior forward Cody Keefer became the 13th player in school history to score 50 career goals.

Keefer moved into sole possession of 12th place on the all-time list with his 51st career goal on Dec. 8 at St. Scholastica. Shane Dickson is 11th on the list with 52 goals from 1998 to 2001. Adam Sedgwick (1998-2001) is tenth with 53 goals, and Faron Duthie (2001-04) is ninth with 54 goals.

Keefer has 51 goals and 45 assists for 96 points in 102 career games. Only three other players in St. Norbert history with at least 50 career goals have more lifetime goals than assists. Maris Ziedins was 74-71-145 from 2000 to 2003, Bruce Henderson was 62-49-109 from 1989 to 1991, and Spencer Carbery was 55-45-100 from 2004 to 2006.

#### **Coghlin Count:**

St. Norbert head coach Tim Coghlin brings a record of 421-115-46 into this weekend.

The Green Knights' 6-3 win over Lawrence on Nov. 24 moved Coghlin past retired St. Thomas coach Terry Skrypek for 31st on the all-time list. Skrypek had an all-time record of 418-197-46 from 1988 to 2010.

Coghlin now trails the late Shawn Walsh for 30th place on the all-time list. Walsh went 423-188-47 in 17 years at Maine, coaching from 1985 to 2001.

#### **Tough After Two:**

St. Norbert is 9-0 this season when leading after two periods. The Green Knights finished 17-1-1 last season when leading after two periods following a pair of 4-1 wins over Norwich and Oswego State, respectively, at the NCAA Division III Frozen Four.

Under Tim Coghlin, St. Norbert is an astounding 227-1-2 at home when up after two periods.

St. Norbert had a home unbeaten streak when leading after two periods of 200 games (197-0-3) before it was snapped by UW-Stout in a 4-3 overtime loss on Feb. 7, 2009 -Coghlin's only home setback when

At home, St. Norbert is 245-2-3 in school history when leading after two periods. The Green Knights' lone other loss when up after two periods on their own ice came on Nov. 18, 1989 in a 3-1 loss to Augsburg when St. Norbert lost a 1-0 lead.

#### **Poll Position:**

St. Norbert has been ranked in the USCHO.com Division III Poll for 198 consecutive weeks. The Green Knights have been ranked in 236 of 242 polls conducted since its inception at the start of the 1998-99 season - the most of any school in Division III.

During the 198-week stretch of being ranked, St. Norbert has been No. 1 for 51 weeks - trailing Norwich's 64 for most all-time. St. Norbert was rated No. 1 in the 2003, 2004, 2005, 2007, 2008, 2011 and 2012 final polls. The Green Knights are 72-14-6 all-time when ranked No. 1.

St. Norbert is 102-40-15 against teams ranked in the USCHO.com Poll under Tim Coghlin. The Green Knights are 1-4 all-time against the No. 1-ranked team and are 4-5 all-time against the No. 2-ranked team.

#### Gimme Five:

St. Norbert is unbeaten in its last 249 games when scoring five goals or more with a 242-0-7 mark since a 7-5 loss to Bemidji State in De Pere on Jan. 12, 1996.

St. Norbert is 5-22-6 in its last 33 games when allowing five goals or more dating back to the 1996-97 season. The only five wins came in a 9-5 win over St. Scholastica on Feb. 20, 1999, a 7-5 win over UW-Stout on Nov. 30, 2001, an 8-5 win over UW-Stout on Jan. 14, 2005, a 7-5 win over UW-Stevens Point on Feb. 3, 2007 and a 7-5 win over Gustavus Adolphus on Oct. 31, 2008.

The Green Knights have allowed five goals just 19 times in their last 334 games.

St. Norbert has never allowed 10 goals in a game during Tim Coghlin's 582-game tenure.
