The Green Knights, who hold the tiebreaker with Adrian for first place in the NCHA, are tied with the Bulldogs atop the league with 24 points.

are 6-1-1 in their last eight games in Duluth and are 16-5-1 all-time on the road in the series.

The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Tim Coghlin (UW-Stevens Point, 1989) is 451-122-47 in his 21st season in De Pere. The Green Knights are 306-52-30 in the last 13-plus seasons. Coghlin's 441 wins as a coach in the NCHA is the league record, 71 more than Bemidji State's Bob Peters' 370 wins. Coghlin's six NCAA championship game appearances are the second most in Division III history. Coghlin became just the 37th coach in college hockey history (all divisions) to win 400 games when St. Norbert beat UW-Stout 4-2 on Jan. 20, 2012.

St. Scholastica coach Mark Wick (St. Scholastica, 1985) is 131-108-33 in his tenth season in Duluth.

Last Meeting:

St. Scholastica defeated St. Norbert 4-2 on Nov. 30, 2013 in a non-conference game at Marathon Park in Wausau. St. Norbert outshot St. Scholastica 41-27. The Saints took a 4-0 lead, with Chad Golanowski scoring twice - including a shorthanded marker. Cullen Bradshaw and Patrick McCadden both scored for St. Norbert. Colin Rundell made 39 saves for the Saints, while Tony Kujava made 23 stops for the Green Knights.

About the Green Knights:

St. Norbert, ranked No. 1 in both USCHO.com D3hockey.com Division III polls, is 17-3-1 overall and 12-2 in the Collegiate Northern Hockey Association. The Green Knights split a series with then-No. 1 Adrian past weekend at Cornerstone Community Center. St. Norbert won Friday's game by an 11-1 count before the Bulldogs salvaged a split with a 4-1 win on Saturday.

Junior forward Mason Baptista leads the Green Knights in scoring with six goals and 19 assists for 25 points. Junior forward Cullen Bradshaw has 10 goals and 14 assists for 24 points. Sophomore forward Erik Cooper owns 11 goals and 12 assists for 23 points. Senior forward Joe Perry has 13 goals and seven assists for 20 points, including six power-play goals. Sophomore forward Michael Hill has 10 goals and 10 assists for 20 points.

Junior goaltender David Jacobson is 14-1-1 with a 1.55 goals against average and .927 save percentage. Freshman Tony Kujava is 3-2 with a 2.62 goals against average and .870 save percentage.

St. Norbert is 25-for-107 (23.4 percent) on the power play and is 83-for-90 (92.2 percent) on the penalty kill this season.

About the Saints:

St. Scholastica enters the series at 12-5-4 overall and 9-2-3 in the Northern Collegiate Hockey Association. The Saints, who are 4-2-2 in their last eight games, swept a home-and-home series with Northland this past weekend. St. Scholastica topped Northland 9-2 on Friday in Duluth before taking Saturday's game in Ashland 5-0.

Senior forward Brandon Nowakowski leads the Saints in scoring with 12 goals and 10 assists for 22 points, including seven power-play goals. Sophomore forward Dylan Nowakowski has eight goals and 11 assists for 19 points. Senior forward Alex Valenti has five goals and 13 assists for 18 points, junior forward Williams has seven goals and 10 assists for 17 points. Senior forward Paul Marcoux has seven goals and nine assists for 16 points.

Sophomore goaltender Tyler Bruggeman is 9-4-2 with a 1.96 goals against average and .924 save percentage. Senior Colin Rundell, who owns a win over St. Norbert this season, is 3-1-2 with a 2.76 goals against average and .915 save percentage.

St. Scholastica is 19-for-73 (26.0

percent) on the power play and is 72-for-84 (85.7 percent) on the penalty kill.

Power Play Patter:

St. Norbert's power play had an efficient evening when it converted on 5 of 6 power-play opportunities in last Friday's 11-1 win over Adrian at the Cornerstone Community Center. It marked the sixth time in school history the Green Knights have scored at least five power-play goals in a game.

The Green Knights connected on an NCAA Division III-record eight power-play goals in an 11-1 rout of UW-Stevens Point on Jan. 27, 1996 at the De Pere Ice Center.

St. Norbert has scored six powerplay goals in a game twice. The Green Knights were 6-for-8 in a 9-3 home win over UW-Stevens Point on Nov. 13, 2009. St. Norbert scored a NCAA Division III Tournamentrecord six power-play goals in an 8-2 win over UW-Superior on March 11, 2006 at the Cornerstone Community Center.

In addition to last Friday's five power-play goals, St. Norbert scored five such markers in an 8-3 win over UW-Stevens Point on Feb. 9, 2012 and in a 5-1 win over UW-Eau Claire on Feb. 18, 2006. Both of those games were also at the Cornerstone Community Center.

The Green Knights' power-play percentage of 23.4 percent (25-for-107) currently ranks 14th out of 72 teams in Division III. Elmira is the national leader in power-play percentage at 28.8 percent.

Offensive Observations:

St. Norbert heads into the weekend at St. Scholastica ranked No. 2 nationally in scoring offense at 4.57 goals per game. The Green Knights have scored 96 goals in 21 games.

UW-Stevens Point is the national leader at 5.21 goals per game (99 in 19 games). Trinity is third at 4.56 (82 in 18), UMass-Boston is fourth at 4.33 (91 in 21) and Adrian is fifth at 4.29 (90 in 21).

The Green Knights have not aver-

aged 4.50 goals per game since the 2005-06 season, when they scored 150 goals in 32 games for a 4.69 goals per game average.

Coghlin Count:

St. Norbert head coach Tim Coghlin brings a record of 451-122-47 in his 21st season into this weekend. The Green Knights' 5-2 win over UW-Stout on Nov. 23 moved Coghlin into 28th on the NCAA hockey all divisions all-time victories list.

Coghlin moved past Trinity's John Dunham (1975-2007), who was previously in 28th place with a record of 441-306-34 in 33 seasons.

Currently sitting in 27th place is Doug Ross, who totaled a 457-294-43 mark in 27 seasons combined at Ohio, Kent State and Alabama-Huntsville.

Tough After Two:

St. Norbert had a 40-game winning streak when leading after two periods snapped in a 5-4 loss to Lawrence on Dec. 7. The Green Knights led the Vikings 3-1 after two periods and 4-1 early in the third period before yielding four unanswered goals down the stretch. St. Norbert is now 13-1 this season when leading after two periods.

Under Tim Coghlin, St. Norbert is an astounding 241-2-2 at home when up after two periods.

St. Norbert had a home unbeaten streak when leading after two periods of 200 games (197-0-3) before it was snapped by UW-Stout in a 4-3 overtime loss on Feb. 7, 2009 - Coghlin's only home setback when leading after two.

At home, St. Norbert is 259-3-3 in school history when leading after two periods. The Green Knights' lone other loss when up after two periods on their own ice came on Nov. 18, 1989 in a 3-1 loss to Augsburg when St. Norbert lost a 1-0 lead.

221 consecutive polls. The Green Knights have been ranked in 259 of 265 polls conducted since its inception at the start of the 1998-99 season - the most of any school in Division III.

During the 221-week stretch of being ranked, St. Norbert has been No. 1 for 55 weeks - trailing Norwich's 71 for most all-time. St. Norbert was rated No. 1 in the 2003, 2004, 2005, 2007, 2008, 2011 and 2012 final polls. The Green Knights are 74-16-6 all-time when ranked No. 1 in the USCHO.com Poll.

St. Norbert is 109-44-16 against teams ranked in the USCHO.com Poll under Tim Coghlin. The Green Knights are 3-5 all-time against the No. 1-ranked team and are 5-5-1 all-time against the No. 2-ranked team.

The Green Knights are 5-2-1 against nationally ranked teams this season.

Gimme Five:

St. Norbert is unbeaten in its last 260 games when scoring five goals or more with a 253-0-7 mark since a 7-5 loss to Bemidji State in De Pere on Jan. 12, 1996.

St. Norbert is 5-24-6 in its last 35 games when allowing five goals or more dating back to the 1996-97 season. The only five wins came in a 9-5 win over St. Scholastica on Feb. 20, 1999, a 7-5 win over UW-Stout on Nov. 30, 2001, an 8-5 win over UW-Stout on Jan. 14, 2005, a 7-5 win over UW-Stevens Point on Feb. 3, 2007 and a 7-5 win over Gustavus Adolphus on Oct. 31, 2008.

The Green Knights have allowed five goals just 21 times in their last 368 games.

St. Norbert has never allowed 10 goals in a game during Tim Coghlin's 620-game tenure.
