Series Overview:

St. Norbert opens the post-season with a quarterfinal series in the NCHA Harris Cup Playoffs. The Green Knights have won the last four NCHA post-season titles and have claimed NCHA playoff championship in nine of the last 11 seasons. The series is a best-of-two-game set with a mini-game to take place Saturday night after the regularly scheduled contest if the two games are split.

The Series:

St. Norbert holds a 33-1 lead in the all-time series with Lawrence. The two schools met four times a season from 1988-89 to Tim Coghlin's first year in 1993-94, and have met 10 times since the 1994-95 season.

The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Tim Coghlin (UW-Stevens Point, 1989) is 455-122-47 in his 21st season in De Pere. The Green Knights are 310-52-30 in the last 13-plus seasons. Coghlin's 445 wins as a coach in the NCHA is the league record, 75 more than Bemidji State's Bob Peters' 370 wins. Coghlin's six NCAA championship game appearances are the second most in Division III history. Coghlin became just the 37th coach in college hockey history (all divisions) to win 400 games when St. Norbert beat UW-Stout 4-2 on Jan. 20, 2012.

Lawrence coach Mike Szkodzinski (St. Norbert, 2000) is 90-112-18 in his eighth season in Appleton.

This Season:

St. Norbert and Lawrence split its two games played during the regular season. The Green Knights won 4-0 in Appleton on Dec. 6, while the Vikings shocked St. Norbert 5-4 the next night at the Cornerstone Community Center.

David Jacobson made 15 saves to post the shutout in St. Norbert's win. Brandon Hoogenboom, Marian Fiala, Cullen Bradshaw and Pijus Rulevicius scored goals for the Green Knights. Anton Olsson made 38 saves for the Vikings.

Lawrence scored four goals in the third period the next night to gain the series split and its first-ever win over St. Norbert. Matt Moore's goal with 1:28 left tied the game, while Blake Roubos hit the game-winner with 22 seconds remaining. Erik Cooper scored two goals for St. Norbert. Olsson made 25 saves for Lawrence, while Tony Kujava made 14 stops for the Green Knights.

About the Green Knights:

St. Norbert, unanimously ranked No. 1 in both the USCHO.com and D3hockey.com Division III polls, enters the post-season at 21-3-1 overall and won the Northern Collegiate Hockey Association regular-season title with a 16-2 mark. The Green Knights swept Northland by scores of 10-0 and 7-0 at home this past weekend to lock up the No. 1 seeding for the NCHA Harris Cup Playoffs.

Junior forward Mason Baptista leads the Green Knights in scoring with nine goals and 22 assists for 31 points. Junior forward Cullen Bradshaw has 11 goals and 17 assists for 28 points. Sophomore forward Erik Cooper has 12 goals and 15 assists for 27 points, while sophomore forward Michael Hill has 15 goals and 12 assists for 27 points. Senior forward Joe Perry has a team-high 16 goals with 10 assists for 26 points.

Junior goaltender David Jacobson is 17-1-1 with a 1.36 goals against average and .934 save percentage. Freshman Tony Kujava is 3-2 with a 2.38 goals against average and .882 save percentage.

St. Norbert is 30-for-124 (24.2 percent) on the power play and is 94for-101 (93.1 percent) on the penalty kill this season.

About the Vikings:

Lawrence enters the NCHA Harris Cup Playoffs at 6-17-2 overall. The Vikings finished in eighth place in the NCHA with a 5-12-1 ledger. Lawrence is coming off a home split with last-place Finlandia last weekend, losing 4-3 in overtime before rebounding to win the second game 4-2.

Freshman forward Blake Roubos leads the Vikings in scoring with 10 goals and 16 assists for 26 points. Senior forward Huck Saunders has a team-high 13 goals with nine assists for 22 points. Sophomore forward Logan Lemirande has five goals and 10 assists for 15 points, while sophomore defenseman Brandon Boelter has one goal and 13 assists for 14 points.

Freshman goaltender Mattias Soderqvist is 2-9-1 with a 3.56 goals against average and .904 save percentage. Junior Anton Olsson, who owns a win over St. Norbert this season, is 3-6-1 with a 4.35 goals against average and .891 save percentage.

Lawrence is 21-for-117 (17.9 per-

cent) on the power play and is 103for-129 (79.8 percent) on the penalty kill.

Cup Clamor:

Including this weekend's NCHA Harris Cup Playoffs quarterfinal series with Lawrence, St. Norbert has played 42 of the last 45 NCHA Playoffs rounds it has played in on home ice. The Green Knights are 56-12-1 all-time in the NCHA Playoffs, and are 54-7 at home all-time in the tournament. St. Norbert is 2-5-1 on the road.

Since the 1996-97 season, St. Norbert has played just three NCHA Playoff series/rounds on the road. The Green Knights, after a third-place finish in the NCHA in 2000-01, played at UW-River Falls in the semifinal round and were eliminated 1-0 in an overtime minigame. St. Norbert's 3-0 loss at UW-Superior in the NCHA Semifinals in 2009. St. Norbert won the final Peters Cup Playoffs championship with a 3-0 win at UW-Eau Claire in 2013.

St. Norbert finished second in 1999-2000 but was eliminated in the semifinals at the De Pere Ice Arena in a mini-game by UW-Superior. The Green Knights were seeded second in 2007 but hosted the championship after top-seeded River Falls lost in the semifinals.

Offensive Observations:

St. Norbert heads into the weekend series against Northland ranked No. 2 nationally in scoring offense at 4.72 goals per game. The Green Knights have scored 118 goals in 25 games.

UW-Stevens Point is the national leader at 5.00 goals per game (115 in 23 games). Trinity is third at 4.45 (98 in 22). Adrian is fourth at 4.28 (107 in 25), while UMass-Boston is fifth at 4.20 (105 in 25).

The Green Knights have not averaged 4.50 goals per game since the 2005-06 season, when they scored 150 goals in 32 games for a 4.69 goals per game average.

Home Sweet Cornerstone:

St. Norbert is 189-23-11 all-time at the Cornerstone Community Center, which includes a 9-4-1 mark there its first season in the building in 2000-01. The Green Knights are 10-2 at home this season. St. Norbert is 168-15-8 in its last 191 games at the Cornerstone Community Center.

The Green Knights had a 25-game home winning streak - the secondlongest in NCAA Division III history - snapped with a 2-2 tie to Gustavus Adolphus on Nov. 4, 2011. St. Norbert also owns the NCAA Division III record with a 36-game home winning streak set Oct. 25, 2002 to Oct. 29, 2004.

In the last 12-plus seasons, the Green Knights are a sparkling 179-18-10 at the Cornerstone, with three losses and one tie coming to national champion UW-Superior during the 2001-02 season.

Under Tim Coghlin, St. Norbert is 267-45-17 at home, which includes games at Brown County Arena, Resch Center and De Pere Ice Arena.

Coghlin Count:

St. Norbert head coach Tim Coghlin brings a record of 455-122-47 in his 21st season into this weekend. The Green Knights' 5-2 win over UW-Stout on Nov. 23 moved Coghlin into 28th on the NCAA hockey all divisions all-time victories list.

Coghlin moved past Trinity's John Dunham (1975-2007), who was previously in 28th place with a record of 441-306-34 in 33 seasons.

Coghlin is three wins shy of moving into 27th place. Currently sitting in 27th place is Doug Ross, who totaled a 457-294-43 mark in 27 seasons combined at Ohio, Kent State and Alabama-Huntsville. Legendary Denver coach Murray Armstrong is 26th on the list, going 460-215-31 in 21 seasons (1957-77).

Tough After Two:

St. Norbert had a 40-game winning streak when leading after two periods snapped in a 5-4 loss to Lawrence on Dec. 7. The Green Knights led the Vikings 3-1 after two periods and 4-1 early in the third period before yielding four unanswered goals down the stretch. St. Norbert is now 15-1 this season when leading after two periods.

Under Tim Coghlin, St. Norbert is an astounding 243-2-2 at home when up after two periods.

St. Norbert had a home unbeaten streak when leading after two periods of 200 games (197-0-3) before it

At home, St. Norbert is 261-3-3 in school history when leading after two periods. The Green Knights' lone other loss when up after two periods on their own ice came on Nov. 18, 1989 in a 3-1 loss to Augsburg when St. Norbert lost a 1-0 lead.

Poll Position:

St. Norbert has been ranked in the USCHO.com Division III Poll for 223 consecutive polls. The Green Knights have been ranked in 261 of 267 polls conducted since its inception at the start of the 1998-99 season - the most of any school in Division III.

During the 223-week stretch of being ranked, St. Norbert has been No. 1 for 57 weeks - trailing Norwich's 71 for most all-time. St. Norbert was rated No. 1 in the 2003, 2004, 2005, 2007, 2008, 2011 and 2012 final polls. The Green Knights are 78-16-6 all-time when ranked No. 1 in the USCHO.com Poll.

St. Norbert is 109-44-16 against teams ranked in the USCHO.com Poll under Tim Coghlin. The Green Knights are 3-5 all-time against the No. 1-ranked team and are 5-5-1 all-time against the No. 2-ranked team.

The Green Knights are 5-2-1 against nationally ranked teams this season.

Gimme Five:

St. Norbert is unbeaten in its last 262 games when scoring five goals or more with a 255-0-7 mark since a 7-5 loss to Bemidji State in De Pere on Jan. 12, 1996.

St. Norbert is 5-24-6 in its last 35 games when allowing five goals or more dating back to the 1996-97 season. The only five wins came in a 9-5 win over St. Scholastica on Feb. 20, 1999, a 7-5 win over UW-Stout on Nov. 30, 2001, an 8-5 win over UW-Stout on Jan. 14, 2005, a 7-5 win over UW-Stevens Point on Feb. 3, 2007 and a 7-5 win over Gustavus Adolphus on Oct. 31, 2008.

The Green Knights have allowed five goals just 21 times in their last 372 games.

St. Norbert has never allowed 10 goals in a game during Tim Coghlin's 624-game tenure.
