#### Game Overview:

St. Norbert and Adrian square off in the quarterfinal round of the NCAA Division III Tournament. The Green Knights, winners of the NCHA Peters Cup championship and Harris Cup Playoffs, seek their ninth Frozen Four trip. The Bulldogs, the NCHA regular-season runner-up, is hunting for their second Frozen Four appearance. The winner advances to the NCAA Division III Frozen Four on March 21-22 in Lewiston, Maine.

2009-10 season. The first two meetings in the series came in the NCAA Division III Tournament. St. Norbert topped Adrian 4-3 on March 10, 2010 in a first-round game at the Cornerstone Community Center. The Green Knights then defeated the Bulldogs 4-3 on March 26, 2011 to win the national championship.

### The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Tim Coghlin (UW-Stevens Point, 1989) is 459-122-47 in his 21st season in De Pere. The Green Knights are 314-52-30 in the last 13-plus seasons. Coghlin's 449 wins as a coach in the NCHA is the league record, 79 more than Bemidji State's Bob Peters' 370 wins. Coghlin's six NCAA championship game appearances are the second most in Division III history.

Adrian coach Ron Fogarty (Colgate, 1995) is 167-22-10 in his seventh season in Adrian.

### This Season:

St. Norbert and Adrian split its NCHA regular-season series on Jan. 31 and Feb. 1 at the Cornerstone Community Center.

The Green Knights claimed an 11-1 win in the opener. Cullen Bradshaw and Marian Fiala scored goals for St. Norbert in the first 1:40 of the game, and the Green Knights rolled from there. Tyler Zepeda had three goals and one assist, while Mason Baptista had one goal and three assists. David Jacobson made 27 saves for the Green Knights.

Adrian won the second game by a 4-1 score. Brandon Hoogenboom scored in the first period for St. Norbert, but Adrian countered with a four-goal second period. Brett Pinkerton, Ryan Lowe, Josh Cousineau and Duston Hebebrand all had goals for the Bulldogs. Scott Shackell made 35 saves for Adrian, while Jacobson had 13 stops.

### NCAA Tournament Appearances:

St. Norbert is making its 15th overall NCAA Division III

Tournament appearance, all coming within in the last 18 years. The Green Knights are 22-11-1 all-time in NCAA competition, have reached eight Frozen Fours, and have won 13 of their last 15 NCAA Tournament games. St. Norbert won national championships in 2008, 2011 and 2012, and was the national runner-up in 2004, 2006 and 2010. The Green Knights are just one of three programs in NCAA Division III history to have won consecutive national championships (UW-Stevens Point 1989-91 and Middlebury 1995-99 and 2004-06).

Adrian is making its fourth NCAA Tournament appearance. The Bulldogs, 2-3 all-time in the tournament, were national runner-up to St. Norbert in 2011. Adrian lost 3-2 in overtime to Oswego State in the 2013 quarterfinals.

### About the Green Knights:

St. Norbert, ranked No. 1 in both the USCHO.com and D3hockey.com Division III polls, enters the NCAA Tournament 25-3-1 overall. The Green Knights won their fifth consecutive NCHA Playoffs championship this past Saturday with a 5-1 win over St. Scholastica. St. Norbert is 15-1-1 in 2014.

Junior forward Cullen Bradshaw leads the Green Knights with 14 goals and 23 assists for 37 points. Junior forward Mason Baptista has 11 goals and 25 assists for 36 points, while sophomore forward Erik Cooper has 14 goals and 17 assists for 31 points. Senior forward Joe Perry has a team-high 19 goals and 11 assists for 30 points, while sophomore forward Michael Hill has 17 goals and 13 assists for 30 points.

Junior goaltender David Jacobson, the NCHA Player of the Year, is 21-1-1 with a 1.21 goals against average and .938 save percentage. Freshman Tony Kujava is 3-2 with a 2.38 goals against average and .882 save percentage.

St. Norbert is 36-for-144 (25.0 per-

cent) on the power play and is 105-for-114 (92.1 percent) on the penalty kill this season.

### About the Bulldogs:

Adrian enters the NCAA Tournament with a 22-2-4 record. The Bulldogs have been idle since March 1, when they dropped a 4-3 decision to St. Scholastica in a NCHA Harris Cup Playoffs semifinal game. Adrian received one of three at-large berths available into the NCAA Tournament.

Junior forward Duston Hebebrand leads the Bulldogs in scoring with 18 goals and 16 assists for 34 points. Junior forward Josh Ranalli has a team-high 21 goals and 12 assists for 33 points. Junior forward Justin Basso has eight goals and 23 assists for 31 points. Senior forward Josh Cousineau has seven goals and 22 assists for 29 points, while junior forward Ryan Lowe has six goals and 23 assists for 29 points.

Junior goaltender James Hamby is 11-2-3 this season with a 2.11 goals against average and .917 save percentage. Junior Scott Shackell is 11-0-1 with a 2.03 goals against average and .926 save percentage.

Adrian is 34-for-145 (23.4 percent) on the power play and is 112-for-134 (83.6 percent) on the penalty kill.

### Tourney Tidbits:

St. Norbert enters this year's NCAA Tournament with a glittering 13-2 record in its last 15 NCAA Tournament games. The stretch covers its last five NCAA Tournament appearances dating back to 2008.

The Green Knights went 3-0 in both 2008 and 2011 en route to winning NCAA Division III national championships both years. St. Norbert was 3-1 during the 2010 tournament, losing 2-1 in double overtime to Norwich in the national title game. St. Norbert went 4-0 in 2012 to finish its most recent "Run for the Roses."

St. Norbert, 22-11-1 all-time in the tournament, has suffered overtime losses in two of its last three NCAA Tournament eliminations. Including the aforementioned Norwich game, St. Norbert lost to Oswego State 4-3 in overtime in a national semifinal game in the 2007 Frozen Four at UW-Superior.

The Green Knights lost 3-1 to eventual national champion UW-Eau Claire in the 2013 national quarterfinals at the Cornerstone Community Center.

### Shutout Stuff:

St. Norbert's 6-0 win over Lake Forest on March 1 was the Green Knights' eighth shutout of the season.

Middlebury holds the NCAA Division III record for shutouts in a season with 11 in 2001. St. Norbert posted 10 shutouts in its first national championship season of 2008, while UW-Eau Claire also posted 10 shutouts this season. The Green Knights of 2004 had eight shutouts, with those three squads joining this year's St. Norbert team as the only ones in Division III history to have at least eight shutouts in one season.

St. Norbert's 5-0 win over Lawrence on Feb. 21 marked the fifth time in school history it has posted at least three consecutive shutouts. The Green Knights own half of the 10 times a Division III hockey team has spun three consecutive shutouts.

Junior goaltender David Jacobson has seven shutouts this season, giving him 17 for his career. That total is second in Division III history behind Kyle Jones, who totaled 25 at St. Norbert from 2005-08. Jacobson's seven shutouts this season ties him with St. Thomas' Drew Fielding for the most in NCAA Division III.

Jacobson has consecutive shutout sequences of 177:15, 166:15 and 149:53 this season. His career high shutout sequence of 243:38 came March 17-Nov. 2, 2002.

### Perry Patter:

St. Norbert senior forward Joe Perry sits one point away from becoming the 20th player in school history to reach 100 career points.

Perry enters the NCAA Tournament with 45 goals and 54 assists for 99 points in 112 career games.

Perry leads the Green Knights this season with 19 goals. Should he reach the 20-goal plateau, it would be the 15th time in program history a player has reached that mark.

Perry's six game-winning goals this season are tied for the most in Division III with Trinity's Sean Orlando.

### Offensive Observations:

St. Norbert heads into the game against Adrian ranked No. 1 nationally in scoring offense at 4.72 goals per game. The Green Knights have scored 137 goals in 29 games.

UW-Stevens Point is No. 2 at 4.70 goals per game (127 in 27 games). Trinity is third at 4.65 (121 in 26). UMass-Boston is fourth at 4.22 (114 in 27), and Adrian is fifth at 4.18 (117 in 28).

The Green Knights have not averaged 4.50 goals per game since the 2005-06 season, when they scored 150 goals in 32 games for a 4.69 goals per game average.

### Home Sweet Cornerstone:

St. Norbert is 193-23-11 all-time at the Cornerstone Community Center, which includes a 9-4-1 mark there its first season in the building in 2000-01. The Green Knights are 14-2 at home this season.

St. Norbert is 172-15-8 in its last 195 games at the Cornerstone Community Center.

The Green Knights had a 25-game home winning streak - the second-longest in NCAA Division III history - snapped with a 2-2 tie to Gustavus Adolphus on Nov. 4, 2011. St. Norbert also owns the NCAA Division III record with a 36-game home winning streak set Oct. 25, 2002 to Oct. 29, 2004.

In the last 12-plus seasons, the Green Knights are a sparkling 183-18-10 at the Cornerstone, with three losses and one tie coming to national champion UW-Superior during the 2001-02 season.

Under Tim Coghlin, St. Norbert is 271-45-17 at home, which includes games at Brown County Arena, Resch Center and De Pere Ice Arena.

The Green Knights are 10-3-1 all-time in the NCAA Tournament at the Cornerstone.

#### Coghlin Count:

St. Norbert head coach Tim Coghlin brings a record of 459-122-47 in his 21st season into this weekend. Coghlin

enters the Adrian game 27th all-time in NCAA hockey wins after surpassing Doug Ross on March 1, who totaled a 457-294-43 mark in 27 seasons combined at Ohio, Kent State and Alabama-Huntsville.

Coghlin is one win shy of moving into 26th place. Legendary Denver coach Murray Armstrong is 26th on the all-time list, going 460-215-31 in 21 seasons (1957-77).

#### Tough After Two:

St. Norbert had a 40-game winning streak when leading after two periods snapped in a 5-4 loss to Lawrence on Dec. 7. The Green Knights led the Vikings 3-1 after two periods and 4-1

early in the third period before yielding four unanswered goals down the stretch.

St. Norbert is 21-1 this season when leading after two periods.

Under Tim Coghlin, St. Norbert is an astounding 247-2-2 at home when up after two periods.

St. Norbert had a home unbeaten streak when leading after two periods of 200 games (197-0-3) before it was snapped by UW-Stout in a 4-3 overtime loss on Feb. 7, 2009 - Coghlin's only home setback when leading after two.

At home, St. Norbert is 265-3-3 in school history when leading after two periods. The Green Knights' lone other

During the 226-week stretch of being ranked, St. Norbert has been No. 1 for 60 weeks - trailing Norwich's 71 for most all-time. St. Norbert is 110-44-16 against teams ranked in the USCHO.com Poll under Tim Coghlin. The Green Knights are 3-5 all-time against the No. 1-ranked team and are 5-5-1 all-

The Green Knights are 6-2-1 against nationally ranked teams this season.

### Gimme Five:

St. Norbert is unbeaten in its last 265 games when scoring five goals or more with a 258-0-7 mark since a 7-5 loss to Bemidji State in De Pere on Jan. 12, 1996.

St. Norbert is 5-24-6 in its last 35 games when allowing five goals or more dating back to the 1996-97 season. The only five wins came in a 9-5 win over St. Scholastica on Feb. 20, 1999, a 7-5 win over UW-Stout on Nov. 30, 2001, an 8-5 win over UW-Stout on Jan. 14, 2005, a 7-5 win over UW-Stevens Point on Feb. 3, 2007 and a 7-5 win over Gustavus Adolphus on Oct. 31, 2008.

The Green Knights have allowed five goals just 21 times in their last 376 games.

St. Norbert has never allowed 10 goals in a game during Tim Coghlin's 628-game tenure.
