St. Norbert College Green Knights Hockey Preview NCAA DIVISION III FROZEN FOUR

Tournament Overview:

Historic Androscoggin Bank Colisee hosts the Frozen Four as four teams converge on Lewiston to determine the 2014 NCAA Division III champion. St. Norbert is aiming for its fourth national title in seven years, capturing the crown in Lake Placid in 2008 and 2012 and in 2011 in Minneapolis. UW-Stevens Point won the last of its four titles in 1993, while Oswego State won its only title in 2007. Geneseo State is making its first Frozen Four appearance.

The Series:

St. Norbert meets Geneseo State in men's ice hockey for the first time.

St. Norbert and Oswego State are tied 2-2 in the all-time series. The Lakers topped the Green Knights 4-3 in overtime in a NCAA Division III Frozen Four semifinal on March 17, 2007 at Wessman Arena in Superior. Oswego also topped St. Norbert 4-3 on Nov. 28, 2008 at the Cornerstone Community Center in De Pere. The Green Knights topped the Lakers for the first time in a thrilling 4-3 NCAA semifinal win on March 19, 2010 in Lake Placid, N.Y., on a goal by Cody Keefer with 39 seconds left. St. Norbert, behind a hat trick from Keefer, defeated Oswego State 4-1 on March 17, 2012 to win the NCAA national title, also in Lake Placid.

Fierce rivals for the last two decades, St. Norbert leads the series with UW-Stevens Point by a 44-19-6 margin. St. Norbert is 44-11-3 in the last 58 games against the Pointers after opening the series 0-8-3. St. Norbert is also 26-3-2 in the last 31 games in the series. The Green Knights and Pointers skated to a 2-2 tie earlier this season on Jan. 11 at K.B. Willett Arena in Stevens Point.

The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Tim Coghlin (UW-Stevens Point, 1989) is 460-122-47 in his 21st season in De Pere.

The Green Knights are 315-52-30 in the last 13-plus seasons. Coghlin's 450 wins as a coach in the NCHA is the league record, 80 more than Bemidji State's Bob Peters' 370 wins. Coghlin's six NCAA championship game appearances are the second most in Division III history. Coghlin was the captain of UW-Stevens Point's first national championship team in 1989.

Geneseo State coach Chris Schultz (Geneseo State, 1997) is 120-84-7 in his eighth season in Geneseo.

Oswego State coach Ed Gosek (Oswego State, 1983) is 234-62-18 in his 11th season in Oswego.

UW-Stevens Point coach Chris Brooks (Western Michigan, 1996) is 50-27-7 in his third season in Stevens Point.

NCAA Tournament Appearances:

St. Norbert is making its 15th overall NCAA Division III Tournament appearance, all coming within in the last 18 years. The Green Knights are 23-11-1 all-time in NCAA competition, have reached nine Frozen Fours, and have won 14 of their last 16 NCAA Tournament games. St. Norbert won national championships in 2008, 2011 and 2012, and was the national runner-up in 2004, 2006 and 2010. The Green Knights are just one of three programs in NCAA Division III history to have

NCAA Championship Coaching Appearances

Only eight coaches in NCAA Division III history have coached in at least three NCAA Division III championship games/series since the start of the NCAA Division III Tournament in 1984. St. Norbert head coach Tim Coghlin ranks second all-time on the list with six title game appearances, going 3-3 overall with two of the losses coming in overtime. St. Norbert assistant coach Mark Mazzoleni won three straight national titles at UW-Stevens Point from 1989-91.

won consecutive national championships (UW-Stevens Point 1989-91 and Middlebury 1995-99 and 2004-06).

Geneseo State is making its fourth NCAA Division III Tournament appearance and is making its first trip to the Frozen Four. The Knights are 2-2-2 all-time in the tournament. Geneseo State also qualified for the tournament in 1990, 2005 and 2006.

Oswego State is making its 13th NCAA Division III Tournament appearance and its eighth trip to the Frozen Four. The Lakers are 16-16 all-time in the tournament and won the national championship in 2007.

UW-Stevens Point is making its 10th NCAA Division III Tournament appearance and its seventh visit to the Frozen Four. The Pointers, who last made the tournament in 1998, won national titles in 1989, 1990, 1991 and 1993.

About the Green Knights:

St. Norbert, ranked No. 1 in both the USCHO.com and D3hockey.com Division III polls, enters the Frozen Four 26-3-1 overall. The Green Knights advanced to their ninth Frozen Four with a convincing 7-2 win over No. 5-ranked Adrian in De Pere on Saturday. The Green Knights, who have won nine straight games, are 16-1-1 since Jan. 4.

Junior forward Cullen Bradshaw leads the Green Knights with 15

goals and 25 assists for 40 points. Junior forward Mason Baptista has 11 goals and 26 assists for 37 points, while sophomore forward Erik Cooper has 15 goals and 20 assists for 35 points. Senior forward Joe Perry has a team-high 21 goals and 12 assists for 33 points, while sophomore forward Michael Hill has 18 goals and 13 assists for 31 points.

Junior goaltender David Jacobson, the NCHA Player of the Year, is 22-1-1 with a 1.24 goals against average and .935 save percentage. Freshman Tony Kujava is 3-2 with a 2.38 goals against average and .882 save percentage.

St. Norbert is 39-for-152 (25.7 percent) on the power play and is 108-for-118 (91.5 percent) on the penalty kill this season.

About the Knights:

Geneseo enters its first Frozen Four with a 23-6 overall record. The Knights, who won the SUNYAC regular-season title before falling to Oswego 7-6 in the playoff championship, advanced with a 3-2 win over Norwich on Sunday.

The Knights are led in scoring by junior forward Tyler Brickler, who has scored 18 goals and 14 assists for 32 points. Brickler scored all three goals in Geneseo's win over Norwich. Senior forward Zachary Vit, the SUNYAC Player of the Year, has 18 goals and 12 assists for 30 points. Junior forward Justin

Scharfe has 10 goals and 20 assists for 30 points, while junior forward Ryan Stanimir has 11 goals and 15 assists for 26 points.

Sophomore goaltender Nick Horrigan is 14-1 with a 2.19 goals against average and .930 save percentage. Junior Bryan Haude is 9-5 with a 3.04 goals against average and .897 save percentage.

Geneseo is 28-for-142 (19.7 percent) on the power play and is 110-for-138 (79.7 percent) on the penalty kill this season.

About the Lakers:

Oswego State enters the Frozen Four with a 22-6-2 overall record. The Lakers, winners of seven straight, finished 10-5-1 in the SUN-YAC before winning the league playoffs with a 7-6 win over Geneseo on March 8. Oswego advanced to Lewiston with a 3-0 win over Babson on Sunday.

Freshman forward Matt Galati, the SUNYAC Rookie of the Year, has 24 goals and 12 assists for 36 points. Freshman forward Alex Botten has 10 goals and 24 assists for 34 points. Junior forward Mike Montagna has 12 goals and 18 assists for 30 points, while junior defenseman Bobby Gertsakis has one goal and 26 assists for 27 points. Freshman forward Kenny Neil has 11 goals and 15 assists for 26 points.

Freshman goaltender Matt Zawadzki is 15-2-2 with a 2.16 goals against average and .922 save percentage. Sophomore Justin Gilbert is 7-4 with a 2.50 goals against average and .901 save percentage.

Oswego is 39-for-140 (27.9 percent) on the power play and is 85-for-106 (80.2 percent) on the penalty kill this season.

About the Pointers:

UW-Stevens Point enters the Frozen Four with a 21-5-2 record. The Pointers finished second in the WIAC with a 7-4-1 mark. Stevens Point, which was eliminated from the WIAC Playoffs in a mini-game by UW-Eau Claire, topped St. Thomas 3-0 this past Saturday to advance to Lewiston.

Senior forward Garrett Ladd, the

WIAC Player of the Year, has 19 goals and 22 assists for 41 points. Freshman forward Kyle Sharkey has 14 goals and 18 assists for 32 points, while sophomore forward Joe Kalisz has 14 goals and 12 assists for 26 points. Junior defenseman Kyle Brodie has eight goals and 17 assists for 25 points, while junior forward Scott Henegar has 12 goals and 12 assists for 24 points.

Junior goaltender Brandon Jaeger is 19-5-1 with a 1.92 goals against average and .924 save percentage. Freshman Spencer Viele is 2-0-1 with a 1.95 goals against average and .882 save percentage.

Stevens Point is 26-for-127 (20.5 percent) on the power play and is 115-for-128 (89.8 percent) on the penalty kill

this season.

Tourney Tidbits:

St. Norbert enters this year's NCAA Tournament with a glittering 14-2 record in its last 16 NCAA Tournament games. The stretch covers its last six NCAA Tournament appearances dating back to 2008.

The Green Knights went 3-0 in both 2008 and 2011 en route to winning NCAA Division III national championships both years. St. Norbert was 3-1 during the 2010 tournament, losing 2-1 in double overtime to Norwich in the national title game. St. Norbert went 4-0 in 2012 to finish its most recent "Run for the Roses."

St. Norbert, 23-11-1 all-time in the

tournament, has suffered overtime losses in two of its last three NCAA Tournament eliminations. Including the aforementioned Norwich game, St. Norbert lost to Oswego State 4-3 in overtime in a national semifinal game in the 2007 Frozen Four at UW-Superior.

The Green Knights lost 3-1 to eventual national champion UW-Eau Claire in the 2013 national quarterfinals at the Cornerstone Community Center.

Shutout Stuff:

St. Norbert's 6-0 win over Lake Forest on March 1 was the Green Knights' eighth shutout of the season.

season with 11 in 2001. St. Norbert posted 10 shutouts in its first national championship season of 2008, while UW-Eau Claire also posted 10 shutouts this season. The Green Knights of 2004 had eight shutouts, with those three squads as the only ones in Division III history to have at least eight shutouts in one season.

St. Norbert's 5-0 win over Lawrence on Feb. 21 marked the fifth time in school history it has posted at least three consecutive shutouts. The Green Knights own half of the 10 times a Division III hockey team has spun three consecutive shutouts.

Junior goaltender David Jacobson has seven shutouts this season, giving him 17 for his career. That total is second in Division III history behind Kyle Jones, who totaled 25 at St. Norbert from 2005-08. Jacobson's seven shutouts this season ties him with St. Thomas' Drew Fielding for the most in NCAA Division III.

Jacobson has consecutive shutout sequences of 177:15, 166:15 and

149:53 this season. His career high shutout sequence of 243:38 came March 17-Nov. 2, 2002.

Perry Patter:

St. Norbert senior forward Joe Perry became the 20th player in school history to reach 100 career points when he scored two goals and one assist in last Saturday's 7-2 win over Adrian.

Perry enters the NCAA Frozen Four with 47 goals and 55 assists for 102 points in 113 career games.

Perry leads the Green Knights this season with 21 goals, matching the seventh-best total in school history. It is the 15th time in program history a player has had a 20-goal season.

Perry's six game-winning goals this season are tied for the most in Division III with Trinity's Sean Orlando. Perry's 12 career game-winning goals are one short of the school record shared by Rob Smillie (1996-99) and Connor Hughes (2003-06).

post-season in 2014. The Green Knights swept four games in the NCHA Harris Cup Playoffs and then topped Adrian 7-2 in a NCAA Division III Tournament quarterfinal game.

The Green Knights have outscored their opposition 26-4 this post season, with three of the four allowed goals coming on the power play.

Junior forward Cullen Bradshaw has scored four goals and eight assists for 12 points in the post-season. Sophomore forward Erik Cooper has three goals and five assists for eight points, while senior forward Joe Perry has five goals and two assists for seven points.

Junior goaltender David Jacobson is 5-0 with a 0.80 goals against average and .945 save percentage. Jacobson was named the NCHA Harris Cup Playoffs MVP.

St. Norbert is 9-for-28 (32.1 percent) on the power play this post-season.

Offensive Observations:

St. Norbert heads into the Frozen Four ranked No. 1 nationally in scoring offense at 4.80 goals per game. The Green Knights have scored 144 goals in 30 games.

Trinity is second at 4.65 (121 in 26), while UW-Stevens Point is No. 3 at 4.64 goals per game (130 in 28 games). UMass-Boston is fourth at 4.22 (114 in 27), and Adrian is fifth at 4.10 (119 in 29).

The Green Knights have not averaged 4.50 goals per game since the 2005-06 season, when they scored 150 goals in 32 games for a 4.69 goals per game average.

Coghlin Count:

St. Norbert head coach Tim Coghlin brings a record of 460-122-47 in his 21st season into this weekend. Coghlin enters the Frozen Four tied for 26th all-time in NCAA hockey wins. Coghlin is tied with legendary Denver coach Murray Armstrong on the all-time list. Armstrong went 460-215-31 in 21 seasons (1957-77) with the Pioneers.

Current Mercyhurst coach Rick Gotkin is in 25th place, entering Friday's game with Canisius with a

474-335-72 mark in his 26th season. Joe Marsh is in 24th place after he posted a 482-417-76 mark in 27 seasons at St. Lawrence (1986-2012).

Eastern Eavesdroppings:

St. Norbert is 25-17-4 all-time against East Region opponents. The Green Knights played at least one game a season against an eastern foe for 18 years before not facing one in 2012-13 as well as this season until the Frozen Four.

St. Norbert is 16-8-3 all-time on East Region ice, which includes three neutral-site visits to the Frozen Four in 2008, 2010 and 2012 in Lake Placid, N.Y.

The Green Knights are 10-3-1 all-time against the State University of New York Athletic Conference, including a 2-0 mark against Plattsburgh State and a 2-2 ledger against Oswego State. St. Norbert is 4-1-1 all-time against Fredonia State and 2-0 against Buffalo State.

St. Norbert is 6-5-3 all-time against ECAC West opposition (including games against now-Division I RIT and Mercyhurst), and is 3-5 all-time against the NESCAC.

The Green Knights are 2-0 all-time against the ECAC Northeast, also beating Fitchburg State in the 1994-95 season.

St. Norbert is 4-3 against the ECAC East, going 3-3 against Norwich and 1-0 against Southern Maine.

Tough After Two:

St. Norbert had a 40-game winning streak when leading after two periods snapped in a 5-4 loss to Lawrence on Dec. 7. The Green Knights led the Vikings 3-1 after two periods and 4-1 early in the third period before yielding four unanswered goals down the stretch.

St. Norbert is 22-1 this season when leading after two periods.

Under Tim Coghlin, St. Norbert is an astounding 248-2-2 at home when up after two periods.

St. Norbert had a home unbeaten streak when leading after two periods of 200 games (197-0-3) before it was snapped by UW-Stout in a 4-3 overtime loss on Feb. 7, 2009 -

Coghlin's only other home setback when leading after two.

At home, St. Norbert is 266-3-3 in school history when leading after two periods. The Green Knights' lone other loss when up after two periods on their own ice came on Nov. 18, 1989 in a 3-1 loss to Augsburg when St. Norbert lost a 1-0 lead.

Western Wonders:

The Northern Collegiate Hockey Association has placed a representative in the NCAA Division III championship game 20 out of a possible 30 times. St. Norbert has made six title game appearances, in 2004, 2006, 2008, 2010, 2011 and 2012.

Bemidji State did it twice (1985-86), UW-River Falls three times (1988, '93, '94), UW-Stevens Point six times (1989-93, '98), Mankato State once (1991), UW-Superior four times (1994, '97, '99, 2002) and UW-Eau Claire once (2013). NCHA teams have squared off for the national championship three times (1991 - Stevens Point vs. Mankato State, 1993 - Stevens Point vs. River Falls, 1994 - River Falls vs. Superior).

UW-Stevens Point (1989, '90, '91, '93), UW-River Falls (1988, '94), Bemidji State (1986), UW-Superior (2002), St. Norbert (2008, '11, '12) and UW-Eau Claire (2013) have all won Division III national titles while playing under the NCHA banner.

In 31 NCAA Division III Frozen Fours, the NCHA has placed a team among the final four 29 years - the most of any league. The NCHA did not advance a team through to the Frozen Four in 1984 and 2005. River Falls lost to Union in the 1984 quarterfinals and

St. Norbert lost to St. Thomas in the 2005 quarterfinals.

St. Norbert's 4-3 win over Adrian in the 2011 national championship game marked the first All-West Region final since 1994, when UW-River Falls beat UW-Superior 6-4.

WIAC Wisdom:

St. Norbert is 4-0-1 this season against the former Northern Collegiate Hockey Association members that belong to the Wisconsin Intercollegiate Athletic Conference.

St. Norbert, which entered the NCHA in 1994-95, owns 14 NCHA regular-season championships and 12 Peters Cup titles, both NCHA records. Since the 2002-03 season, the first year the Green Knights advanced to the NCAA Division III Frozen Four, St. Norbert is 131-22-17 against the WIAC schools. In program history, St. Norbert is 206-75-29 all-time against the WIAC.

Since 2002-03, St. Norbert is 29-3-2 against UW-Stevens Point, 32-4-2 against UW-Eau Claire, 26-5-1 against UW-River Falls, 22-5-3 against UW-Stout and 21-5-8 against UW-Superior.

St. Norbert owns two wins over Eau Claire and one win each over River Falls and Stout this season. The Green Knights tied Stevens Point.

Poll Position:

St. Norbert has been ranked in the USCHO.com Division III Poll for 226 consecutive polls. The Green Knights have been ranked in 264 of 270 polls conducted since its inception at the start of the 1998-99 season - the most of

any school in Division III.

During the 226-week stretch of being ranked, St. Norbert has been No. 1 for 60 weeks - trailing Norwich's 71 for most all-time. St. Norbert was rated No. 1 in the 2003, 2004, 2005, 2007, 2008, 2011 and 2012 final polls. The Green Knights are 83-16-6 all-time when ranked No. 1 in the USCHO.com Poll.

St. Norbert is 111-44-16 against teams ranked in the USCHO.com Poll under Tim Coghlin. The Green Knights are 3-5 all-time against the No. 1-ranked team and are 5-5-1 all-time against the No. 2-ranked team.

The Green Knights are 7-2-1 against nationally ranked teams this season.

Gimme Five:

St. Norbert is unbeaten in its last 266 games when scoring five goals or more with a 259-0-7 mark since a 7-5 loss to Bemidji State in De Pere on Jan. 12, 1996.

St. Norbert is 5-24-6 in its last 35 games when allowing five goals or more dating back to the 1996-97 season. The only five wins came in a 9-5 win over St. Scholastica on Feb. 20, 1999, a 7-5 win over UW-Stout on Nov. 30, 2001, an 8-5 win over UW-Stout on Jan. 14, 2005, a 7-5 win over UW-Stevens Point on Feb. 3, 2007 and a 7-5 win over Gustavus Adolphus on Oct. 31, 2008.

The Green Knights have allowed five goals just 21 times in their last 377 games.

St. Norbert has never allowed 10 goals in a game during Tim Coghlin's 629-game tenure.

Most NCAA Division III Frozen Four Appearances

Only nine programs have skated in at least six NCAA Division III Frozen Fours since the start of the NCAA Division III Tournament in 1984. Three of those nine will be participating this weekend in the 2014 Frozen Four in Lewiston, Maine, with St. Norbert (9), Oswego State (8) and UW-Stevens Point (7) playing in the tournament. Those three schools have accounted for eight national championships.

Why the Green Knights?

The Green Knights...

They were once known as the "Juggernaut" or, sometimes, the "Green Juggernaut."

That was back in the early years of St. Norbert sports - the 1920s and before, when the sports program was a combination of high school and college teams and games.

Later, into the early 1930s, St. Norbert teams were known as the "Green and Gold Wave," then, sometimes, just the "Green Wave," or the "Goldmen."

In 1933, the college yearbook, the *Des Peres*, was built on a medieval theme with lots of references to gallant Knights.

And in 1934, the name "Green Knights" was pinned to the college varsity teams.

The late Rev. Dennis M. Burke, O. Praem., former president of St. Norbert College, said the Knights idea was promoted largely by the Rev. L.A.V. De Cleene, O. Praem., a mathematics professor at St. Norbert in those years.

Father DeCleene had been a cadet at the U.S. Military Academy at West Point before joining the Norbertine Order and was quite taken with the West Point nickname of "Black Knights of the Hudson."

Perhaps St. Norbert's location on the banks of the Fox River contributed to this memory and fondness for the nickname. While St. Norbert's athletes never did become Green Knights of the Fox, they did evolve into Green Knights.

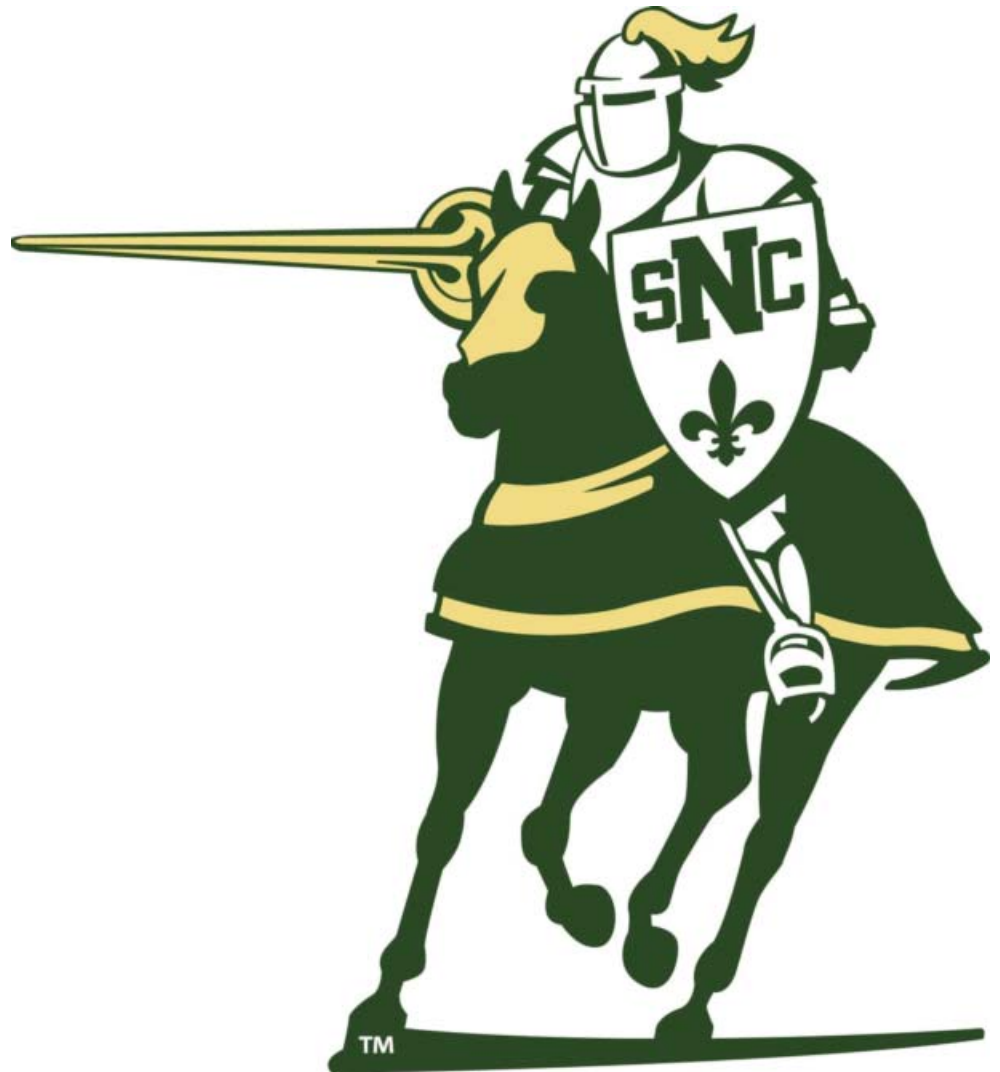
But why "Green?"

When the Norbertines, the Founding Fathers of St. Norbert College, originally from Berne Abbey in Holland, came to De Pere, they brought with them the Norbertine traditions that included a coat of arms primarily in red, white and blue. But being a descendant of the original abbey, the Norbertines in America kept the design but changed the colors to Dartmouth green and white with gold. The colors are said to have been suggested by an English professor originally from Dartmouth and seconded by the Rev. John A. Van Heertem, O. Praem., who had visited Dartmouth and came away favorably impressed.

In 1931, to differentiate between the high school and college departments, it was decided that the high school would retain the green and white colors while the college would adopt "Dartmouth green and light old gold" as its colors.

And that remains the official colors of today's Green Knights.

P.S. - Many out-of-town observers note the similarity between St. Norbert colors and those of the Green Bay Packers. The Packers donned blue and gold as their colors through the mid-1950s, and then switched to the current green and gold scheme shortly before the Lombardi era.
