The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Tim Coghlin (UW-Stevens Point, 1989) is 436-119-46 in his 21st season in De Pere. The Green Knights are 291-49-29 in the last 13-plus seasons. Coghlin's 426 wins as a coach in the NCHA is the league record, 56 more than Bemidji State's Bob Peters' 370 wins. Coghlin's six NCAA championship game appearances are the second most in Division III history. Coghlin became just the 37th coach in college hockey history (all divisions) to win 400 games when St. Norbert beat UW-Stout 4-2 on Jan. 20, 2012.

Finlandia coach John McCabe 17-59-1 in his fourth season in Hancock.

About the Green Knights:

St. Norbert, ranked No. 2 in the USCHO.com Division III poll and No. 1 in the D3hockey.com poll, is 2-0 after a hard-fought sweep of a home-and-home NCHA series against Marian this past weekend. The Green Knights topped the Sabres 2-1 in Fond du Lac on Friday before scoring four third-period goals to win at home 5-2 on Saturday.

Junior forward Mason Baptista leads the Green Knights in scoring with three assists for three points. Junior forward Chris Rial, junior forward Cullen Bradshaw, junior defenseman George Malliaras, sophomore forward Michael Hill and freshman forward Pijus Rulevicius all had one goal and one assist for two points. Junior defenseman Marian Fiala has two assists for two points.

Junior goaltender David Jacobson got both starts between the pipes last weekend and went 2-0 with a 1.50 goals against average and .925 save percentage. He improved to 41-8-4 in his career with a 1.57 goals against average and .933 save percentage.

St. Norbert is 3-for-15 (20.0 percent) on the power play and is 9-for-10 (90.0 percent) on the penalty kill this season.

About the Lions:

Finlandia enters the St. Norbert series at 0-2 overall. The Lions were swept in a non-conference series at UW-Stevens Point's Willett Arena, with the Pointers claiming wins of 6-1 and 11-0.

Sophomore forward Richard Young scored the Lions' lone goal, while sophomore forward Shigenobu Kakudate and senior defenseman Mike Montrose recorded assists.

Three goaltenders saw action for the Lions. Sophomore Troy Chandler started both games, and is 0-2 with a 6.99 goals against average and .871 save percentage. Junior Jordan Marr has a 10.65 goals against average and .800 save percentage, while freshman Andrew Brownlee has a 15.00 goals against average and .800 save percentage.

Finlandia is 1-for-4 (25.0 percent) on the power play and is 3-for-5 (60.0 percent) on the penalty kill.

Copper Country Chatter:

St. Norbert is making its first-ever trip to Finlandia, located in Michigan's Keweenaw Peninsula. The Green Knights will be heading just north of the Portage Lake Lift Bridge to Hancock to try and tame the Lions at the Houghton County Arena.

This trip also marks the first time the Green Knights have ever skated in the state of Michigan since the program moved to varsity status for the 1988-89 season.

In its 26 seasons of existence, the Green Knights have rostered just one "Yooper" in Marquette's John Donnelly. Donnelly played four seasons (1999, 2001-03) as a defenseman, scoring three goals and 24 assists for 27 points in 76 career games.

St. Norbert's most recent Michigander is Cody Keefer. The Grayling native finished his four-year career last season after scoring 62 goals and 52 assists for 114 points in 119 games from 2010-13.

Third Period Thunder:

St. Norbert scored four goals in the third period this past Saturday to rally to a 5-2 win over Marian at the Cornerstone Community Center.

The Green Knights scored at least four goals in the third period three times last season. St. Norbert last scored at least four goals in the third period in a 12-2 win over St. Mary's last Jan. 4. The Green Knights also scored four goals in the third in a 6-1 win at St. Scholastica last Dec. 7 and also put home five goals in the final 20 minutes in a 7-1 win over UW-River Falls on Nov. 9, 2012.

Power Play Patter:

St. Norbert pumped in three power-play goals in Saturday's 5-2 win over Marian, finishing the game 3-for-8 with the man advantage. Cullen Bradshaw, Joe Perry and Tyler Zepeda all scored power-play markers for the Green Knights. Bradshaw's power-play goal was the eighth of his career, the most on the squad.

The three power-play markers snapped a 16-game stretch where the Green Knights had gone without scoring three power-play goals in a game. St. Norbert last scored three power-play goals in a game on Jan. 5, 2013 when it scored four in a 6-3 win over St. Olaf.

The Green Knights had also gone 14 games without scoring at least two power-play goals in a game. St. Norbert had its last game with multiple power-play goals on Jan. 12, 2013 when it beat UW-Superior 3-1.

Coghlin Count:

St. Norbert head coach Tim Coghlin brings a record of 436-119-46 into this weekend, and two wins will move him up on the all-time NCAA coaching victories list

Coghlin, currently 30th on the all-time list with his 436 victories, is one win out of the 29th spot. Bill Wilkinson (Western Michigan 1983-99 and Wayne State 2000-08) is 29th on the list at 437-469-81 in 26 sea-

sons. Coghlin is six victories away from moving into 28th place, as Trinity's John Dunham (1975-2007) sits in 28th place with a record of 441-306-34 in 33 seasons.

The Green Knights' 5-0 win over UW-Superior on Jan. 11, 2013 moved Coghlin out of a tie with the late Shawn Walsh for 30th place on the all-time NCAA hockey coaches win list. Walsh went 423-188-47 in 17 years at Maine, coaching from 1985 to 2001.

Tough After Two:

St. Norbert currently has a 33-game winning streak overall when leading after two periods. The Green Knights were 22-0 last season when leading after 40 minutes, and also won their final 11 opportunities the previous season when up after two frames.

Under Tim Coghlin, St. Norbert is an astounding 234-1-2 at home when up after two periods.

St. Norbert had a home unbeaten streak when leading after two periods of 200 games (197-0-3) before it was snapped by UW-Stout in a 4-3 overtime loss on Feb. 7, 2009 - Coghlin's only home setback when leading after two.

At home, St. Norbert is 252-2-3 in school history when leading after two periods. The Green Knights' lone other loss when up after two periods on their own ice came on Nov. 18, 1989 in a 3-1 loss to Augsburg when St. Norbert lost a 1-0 lead.

Poll Position:

St. Norbert has been ranked in the USCHO.com Division III Poll for 210 consecutive polls. The Green Knights have been ranked in 248 of 254 polls conducted since its inception at the start of the 1998-99 season - the most of any school in Division III.

During the 210-week stretch of being ranked, St. Norbert has been No. 1 for 53 weeks - trailing Norwich's 71 for most all-time. St. Norbert was rated No. 1 in the 2003, 2004, 2005, 2007, 2008, 2011 and

St. Norbert is 105-42-15 against teams ranked in the USCHO.com Poll under Tim Coghlin. The Green Knights are 1-4 all-time against the No. 1-ranked team and are 5-5 all-time against the No. 2-ranked team.

Gimme Five:

St. Norbert is unbeaten in its last 253 games when scoring five goals or more with a 246-0-7 mark since a 7-5 loss to Bemidji State in De Pere on Jan. 12, 1996.

St. Norbert is 5-23-6 in its last 34 games when allowing five goals or more dating back to the 1996-97 season. The only five wins came in a 9-5 win over St. Scholastica on Feb. 20, 1999, a 7-5 win over UW-Stout on Nov. 30, 2001, an 8-5 win over UW-Stout on Jan. 14, 2005, a 7-5 win over UW-Stevens Point on Feb. 3, 2007 and a 7-5 win over Gustavus Adolphus on Oct. 31, 2008.

The Green Knights have allowed five goals just 20 times in their last 351 games.

St. Norbert has never allowed 10 goals in a game during Tim Coghlin's 601-game tenure.

Ice Chips:

* - St. Norbert, which fell behind to start both Marian games, is 2-0 on the young season when the opponent gets the first goal. The Green Knights were just 7-4 last season when falling behind 1-0.

* - St. Norbert outscored Marian 5-0 in the third period during the series, and also held a commanding 31-11 shots-on-goal edge in the final 20 minutes of both games.

* - St. Norbert has never lost a game to a member of what was then known as the Midwest Collegiate Hockey Association. The Green Knights are 60-0-2 all-time against the grouping. St. Norbert is 32-0 against Lawrence, 16-0-2 against Marian, 6-0 against MSOE and 2-0 each against Adrian, Concordia-Wis. and Lake Forest.
