The Series:

St. Norbert leads the UW-Eau Claire series, begun in the 1993-94 season, by a 45-7-4 margin. St. Norbert is 45-4-4 in the series since Eau Claire topped the Green Knights 5-4 in overtime on Jan. 21, 1995 at Hobbs Ice Center. The Green Knights are 30-3-2 all-time at home in the series.

St. Norbert leads the series with UW-Stout 40-10-4. The Green Knights

The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Tim Coghlin (UW-Stevens Point, 1989) is 440-119-46 in his 21st season in De Pere. The Green Knights are 295-49-29 in the last 13-plus seasons. Coghlin's 430 wins as a coach in the NCHA is the league record, 60 more than Bemidji State's Bob Peters' 370 wins. Coghlin's six NCAA championship game appearances are the second most in Division III history. Coghlin became just the 37th coach in college hockey history (all divisions) to win 400 games when St. Norbert beat UW-Stout 4-2 on Jan. 20, 2012.

UW-Eau Claire coach Matt Loen (UW-Eau Claire, 1995) is 88-72-13 in his seventh season in Eau Claire.

UW-Stout coach Terry Watkins (UW-Stout, 1972) is 209-237-28 in his 18th season in Menomonie.

Last Meetings:

UW-Eau Claire topped St. Norbert 3-0 in a NCAA Division III national quarterfinal on March 9 at the Cornerstone Community Center. Jon Waggoner and Chris Heineman scored for Eau Claire and Carl Ekstrom for St. Norbert in the first period. Kurt Weston's empty-netter locked up the game for the eventual national champions. Brandon Stephenson made 39 saves for Eau Claire, while David Jacobson made 18 for the Green Knights.

St. Norbert topped UW-Stout 3-2 last Feb. 16 to complete a NCHA Peters Cup Playoffs quarterfinal series sweep at the Cornerstone Community Center. Reid Campbell, Brett Bower and Cody Keefer all scored for the Green Knights. Mike Hartviksen and Charles Lechance both scored for the Blue Devils. David Jacobson made 25 saves for St. Norbert, and Nick Hopper made 18 saves for Stout.

About the Green Knights:

St. Norbert, ranked No. 2 in the USCHO.com Division III poll and No. 1 in the D3hockey.com poll, is 6-0 overall and in the Northern Collegiate Hockey Association. The Green Knights swept Lake Forest in a home-and-home series this past weekend by scores of 9-1 and 4-1.

Junior forward Mason Baptista leads the Green Knights in scoring with one goal and eight assists for nine points. Senior forward Joe Perry has five goals - with four on the power play - and two assists for seven points. Sophomore forward Michael Hill has three goals and four assists for seven points. Sophomore forward Erik Cooper has three goals and two assists for five points, while junior forward Cullen Bradshaw has two goals and three assists for five points.

Junior goaltender David Jacobson is 4-0 with a 1.50 goals against average and .929 save percentage. Freshman Tony Kujava is 2-0 with a 1.00 goals against average and .946 save percentage.

St. Norbert is 8-for-35 (22.9 percent) on the power play and is 30for-31 (96.8 percent) on the penalty kill this season.

About the Blugolds:

UW-Eau Claire, ranked No. 1 by USCHO.com and No. 2 by D3hockey.com, enters the weekend on an eight-game winning streak dating back to last season. The Blugolds are 4-0 this season, and beat Hamline 6-1 and Bethel 2-1 on the road last weekend.

Junior forward Joe Krause leads the Blugolds in points with two goals and four assists for six points. Senior defenseman David Donnellan has a team-high four goals with one assist for five points. Senior forward Daniel Olszewski has one goal and four assists for five points. Junior forward Ross Andersen has three goals for three points. Sophomore forward Ethan Nauman adds two goals and one assist for three points.

Sophomore goaltender Tyler Green is 3-0 with a 1.33 goals against average and .953 save percentage. Freshman Jay Deo is 1-0 with a 1.00 goals against average and .952 save percentage.

Eau Claire is 2-for-12 (16.7 percent) on the power play and is 15for-15 (100.0 percent) on the penalty kill.

About the Blue Devils:

UW-Stout enters Friday's game

with St. Scholastica at 2-4 overall. The Blue Devils are coming off a pair of one-goal losses last weekend, a 2-1 setback at Augsburg and a 1-0 defeat at St. Thomas.

Senior forward Kevin O'Donnell paces the Blue Devils scoring with three goals and four assists for seven points. Junior forward Matt Millis has two goals and two assists for four points. Freshman forward Craig Lindegard has three goals for three points, while junior defenseman Jordan Tredinnick has one goal and two assists for three points.

Freshman goaltender Corey Koop has seen most of the time in net this season, and is 2-4 with a 2.28 goals against average and .923 save percentage.

Stout is 5-for-26 (19.2 percent) on the power play and is 29-for-33 (87.9 percent) on the penalty kill.

WIAC Wisdom:

This weekend, St. Norbert faces its first Wisconsin Intercollegiate Athletic Conference opponents since the five WIAC schools who were members of the Northern Collegiate Hockey Association abandoned the league following the 2012-13 season.

St. Norbert, which entered the NCHA in 1994-95, owns 13 NCHA regular-season championships and 11 Peters Cup titles, both NCHA records. Since the 2002-03 season, the first year the Green Knights advanced to the NCAA Division III Frozen Four, St. Norbert is 126-22-16 against the WIAC schools. In program history, St. Norbert is 202-75-28 all-time against the WIAC.

Since 2002-03, St. Norbert is 29-3-1 against UW-Stevens Point, 30-4-2 against UW-Eau Claire, 25-5-1 against UW-River Falls, 21-5-3 against UW-Stout and 21-5-8 against UW-Superior.

Home Sweet Cornerstone:

St. Norbert is 181-21-11 all-time at the Cornerstone Community Center, which includes a 9-4-1 mark there its first season in the building in 2000-01. The Green Knights were 13-4-1 at home last season.

St. Norbert is 160-13-8 in its last 181 games at the Cornerstone Community Center.

The Green Knights had a 25-game

home winning streak - the secondlongest in NCAA Division III history - snapped with a 2-2 tie to Gustavus Adolphus on Nov. 4, 2011. St. Norbert also owns the NCAA Division III record with a 36-game home winning streak set Oct. 25, 2002 to Oct. 29, 2004.

In the last 12-plus seasons, the Green Knights are a sparkling 171-16-10 at the Cornerstone, with three losses and one tie coming to national champion UW-Superior during the 2001-02 season.

Under Tim Coghlin, St. Norbert is 259-43-17 at home, which includes games at Brown County Arena, Resch Center and De Pere Ice Arena.

Coghlin Count:

St. Norbert head coach Tim Coghlin brings a record of 440-119-46 into this weekend. The two wins against Lake Forest last weekend moved him to within one victory of tying for 28th on the NCAA hockey all-time victories list.

Coghlin has three more wins than Bill Wilkinson (Western Michigan 1983-99 and Wayne State 2000-08), who was 437-469-81 in 26 seasons. Coghlin is one win out of 28th place, as Trinity's John Dunham (1975-2007) sits in that spot with a record of 441-306-34 in 33 seasons.

Tough After Two:

St. Norbert currently has a 36game winning streak overall when leading after two periods. The Green Knights were 22-0 last season when leading after 40 minutes, and also won their final 11 opportunities the previous season when up after two frames. St. Norbert is 3-0 this season when leading after two periods.

Under Tim Coghlin, St. Norbert is an astounding 235-1-2 at home when up after two periods.

St. Norbert had a home unbeaten streak when leading after two periods of 200 games (197-0-3) before it was snapped by UW-Stout in a 4-3 overtime loss on Feb. 7, 2009 -Coghlin's only home setback when leading after two.

At home, St. Norbert is 253-2-3 in school history when leading after two periods. The Green Knights' lone other loss when up after two

Poll Position:

St. Norbert has been ranked in the USCHO.com Division III Poll for 212 consecutive polls. The Green Knights have been ranked in 250 of 256 polls conducted since its inception at the start of the 1998-99 season - the most of any school in Division III.

During the 212-week stretch of being ranked, St. Norbert has been No. 1 for 53 weeks - trailing Norwich's 71 for most all-time. St. Norbert was rated No. 1 in the 2003, 2004, 2005, 2007, 2008, 2011 and 2012 final polls. The Green Knights are 73-15-6 all-time when ranked No. 1 in the USCHO.com Poll.

St. Norbert is 105-42-15 against teams ranked in the USCHO.com Poll under Tim Coghlin. The Green Knights are 1-4 all-time against the No. 1-ranked team and are 5-5 alltime against the No. 2-ranked team.

Friday's game with UW-Eau Claire marks the first time the Green Knights are facing the No. 1ranked team in the USCHO.com Poll since a 4-1 drubbing of Norwich on March 16, 2012 in the semifinals of the NCAA Division III Frozen Four in Lake Placid, N.Y.

Gimme Five:

St. Norbert is unbeaten in its last 254 games when scoring five goals or more with a 247-0-7 mark since a 7-5 loss to Bemidji State in De Pere on Jan. 12, 1996.

St. Norbert is 5-23-6 in its last 34 games when allowing five goals or more dating back to the 1996-97 season. The only five wins came in a 9-5 win over St. Scholastica on Feb. 20, 1999, a 7-5 win over UW-Stout on Nov. 30, 2001, an 8-5 win over UW-Stout on Jan. 14, 2005, a 7-5 win over UW-Stevens Point on Feb. 3, 2007 and a 7-5 win over Gustavus Adolphus on Oct. 31, 2008.

The Green Knights have allowed five goals just 20 times in their last 355 games.

St. Norbert has never allowed 10 goals in a game during Tim Coghlin's 605-game tenure.
