The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Tim Coghlin (UW-Stevens Point, 1989) is 443-120-46 in his 21st season in De Pere. The Green Knights are 298-50-29 in the last 13-plus seasons. Coghlin's 433 wins as a coach in the NCHA is the league record, 63 more than Bemidji State's Bob Peters' 370 wins. Coghlin's six NCAA championship game appearances are the second most in Division III history. Coghlin became just the 37th coach in college hockey history (all divisions) to win 400 games when St. Norbert beat UW-Stout 4-2 on Jan. 20, 2012.

Lawrence coach Mike Szkodzinski (St. Norbert, 2000) is 86-100-17 in his eighth season in Appleton.

Last Meeting:

St. Norbert defeated Lawrence 6-3 on Nov. 24, 2012 at the Cornerstone Community Center, the Green Knights' 32nd consecutive win in the series. Kyle Stroh scored three goals and added an assist for a four-point game to lead St. Norbert, while Tyler Zepeda added one goal and two assists. Travis Bosch made 24 saves for the Green Knights, while Anton Olsson made 31 saves for the Vikings.

About the Green Knights:

St. Norbert, ranked No. 2 in both the USCHO.com poll and No. 3 in the D3hockey.com Division III poll, is 9-1 overall and 6-0 in the Northern Collegiate Hockey Association. The Green Knights topped UW-Eau Claire 8-2 last Wednesday before suffering their first loss of the season with a 4-2 non-conference setback to St. Scholastica Saturday in Wausau.

Sophomore forward Michael Hill leads the Green Knights in scoring with seven goals and six assists for 13 points. Junior forward Mason Baptista has three goals and nine assists for 12 points. Senior forward Joe Perry has seven goals and four assists for 11 points, while junior forward Cullen Bradshaw has four goals and seven assists for 11 points. Sophomore forward Erik Cooper has six goals and four assists for 10 points.

Junior goaltender David Jacobson is 6-0 with a 1.67 goals against average and .923 save percentage. Freshman Tony Kujava is 3-1 with a 2.02 goals against average and .901 save percentage.

St. Norbert is 11-for-54 (20.4 percent) on the power play and is 42for-45 (93.3 percent) on the penalty kill this season.

About the Vikings:

Lawrence enters the series 2-5-1 overall and 2-4 in the Northern Collegiate Hockey Association. The Vikings hosted a pair of Minnesota Intercollegiate Athletic Conference foes this past weekend, tying Gustavus Adolphus 6-6 on Friday before losing to St. Olaf 5-1 on Saturday.

Freshman forward Blake Roubos leads the Vikings in scoring with five goals and eight assists for 13 points. Senior forward Huck Saunders has five goals and five assists for 10 points, while sophomore forward Logan Lemirande has three goals and seven assists for 10 points. Sophomore defenseman Brandon Boelter has one goal and eight assists for nine points.

Junior goaltender Anton Olsson is 1-3-1 with a 3.88 goals against average and .904 save percentage. Junior Peter Emery is 1-2 with a 4.82 goals against average and .835 save percentage.

Lawrence is 7-for-44 (15.9 percent) on the power play and is 34for-41 (82.9 percent) on the penalty kill.

Four Fun:

St. Norbert's four goals in the second period of the Nov. 27 8-2 win at UW-Eau Claire marked the fifth time this season the Green Knights have scored at least four goals in one period. The Green Knights scored four goals in the third period in a 5-2 win over Marian on Nov. 2, in both the first and third periods of a 9-1 win over Lake Forest on Nov. 15 and in the second period of a 5-2 win over UW-Eau Claire on Nov. 22.

St. Norbert had six periods last season when it scored at least four goals in a period. The Green Knights final four-goal period in 2012-13 came with five goals in the second period of a 6-3 win over St. Olaf on Jan. 5, 2013. St. Norbert then finished the season with 15 consecutive games without a period with at least four goals scored.

Goal Gossip:

St. Norbert's scoring offense of 4.7 goals per game currently ranks third in the NCAA Division III national statistical rankings. The Green Knights have scored 47 goals in 10 games.

UW-Stevens Point currently has the top offense at 6.25 goals per game (50 goals in eight games), while Adrian is second at 5.00 goals per game (45 in nine games).

St. Norbert has had just one season in the last six when it has averaged at least four goals per game when it averaged 4.10 goals per game in 2009-10.

Home Sweet Cornerstone:

St. Norbert is 183-21-11 all-time at the Cornerstone Community Center, which includes a 9-4-1 mark there its first season in the building in 2000-01. The Green Knights were 13-4-1 at home last season.

St. Norbert is 162-13-8 in its last 183 games at the Cornerstone Community Center.

The Green Knights had a 25-game home winning streak - the secondlongest in NCAA Division III history - snapped with a 2-2 tie to Gustavus Adolphus on Nov. 4, 2011. St. Norbert also owns the NCAA Division III record with a 36-game home winning streak set Oct. 25, 2002 to Oct. 29, 2004. In the last 12-plus seasons, the Green Knights are a sparkling 173-16-10 at the Cornerstone, with three losses and one tie coming to national champion UW-Superior during the 2001-02 season.

Under Tim Coghlin, St. Norbert is 261-43-17 at home, which includes games at Brown County Arena, Resch Center and De Pere Ice Arena.

Coghlin Count:

St. Norbert head coach Tim Coghlin brings a record of 443-120-46 in his 21st season into this weekend. The Green Knights' 5-2 win over UW-Stout on Nov. 23 moved Coghlin into 28th on the NCAA hockey all divisions all-time victories list.

Coghlin moved past Trinity's John Dunham (1975-2007), who was previously in 28th place with a record of 441-306-34 in 33 seasons.

Currently sitting in 27th place is Doug Ross, who totaled a 457-294-43 mark in 27 seasons combined at Ohio, Kent State and Alabama-Huntsville.

Tough After Two:

St. Norbert currently has a 39game winning streak overall when leading after two periods. The Green Knights were 22-0 last season when leading after 40 minutes, and also won their final 11 opportunities the previous season when up after two frames. St. Norbert is 6-0 this season when leading after two periods.

Under Tim Coghlin, St. Norbert is an astounding 237-1-2 at home when up after two periods.

St. Norbert had a home unbeaten streak when leading after two periods of 200 games (197-0-3) before it was snapped by UW-Stout in a 4-3 overtime loss on Feb. 7, 2009 -Coghlin's only home setback when leading after two.

At home, St. Norbert is 255-2-3 in school history when leading after two periods. The Green Knights'

Poll Position:

St. Norbert has been ranked in the USCHO.com Division III Poll for 214 consecutive polls. The Green Knights have been ranked in 252 of 258 polls conducted since its inception at the start of the 1998-99 season - the most of any school in Division III.

During the 213-week stretch of being ranked, St. Norbert has been No. 1 for 54 weeks - trailing Norwich's 71 for most all-time. St. Norbert was rated No. 1 in the 2003, 2004, 2005, 2007, 2008, 2011 and 2012 final polls. The Green Knights are 74-16-6 all-time when ranked No. 1 in the USCHO.com Poll.

St. Norbert is 106-43-15 against teams ranked in the USCHO.com Poll under Tim Coghlin. The Green Knights are 2-4 all-time against the No. 1-ranked team and are 5-5 alltime against the No. 2-ranked team.

Gimme Five:

St. Norbert is unbeaten in its last 257 games when scoring five goals or more with a 250-0-7 mark since a 7-5 loss to Bemidji State in De Pere on Jan. 12, 1996.

St. Norbert is 5-23-6 in its last 34 games when allowing five goals or more dating back to the 1996-97 season. The only five wins came in a 9-5 win over St. Scholastica on Feb. 20, 1999, a 7-5 win over UW-Stout on Nov. 30, 2001, an 8-5 win over UW-Stout on Jan. 14, 2005, a 7-5 win over UW-Stevens Point on Feb. 3, 2007 and a 7-5 win over Gustavus Adolphus on Oct. 31, 2008.

The Green Knights have allowed five goals just 20 times in their last 359 games.

St. Norbert has never allowed 10 goals in a game during Tim Coghlin's 609-game tenure.
