Series Overview:

St. Norbert opens the second half of the regular season with a tough home game against St. Thomas. The Green Knights enter the game ranked No. 4 in the USCHO.com Division III Poll, while the Tommies hold the No. 6 ranking.

The Series:

St. Norbert leads St. Thomas 6-3-2 in a series that dates back to the 1999-2000 season. The Green Knights are 5-1-1 all-time at home in the series, including a 3-0-1 mark at home during the regular season.

The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Tim Coghlin (UW-Stevens Point, 1989) is 444-121-46 in his 21st season in De Pere. The Green Knights are 299-51-29 in the last 13-plus seasons. Coghlin's 434 wins as a coach in the NCHA is the league record, 64 more than Bemidji State's Bob Peters' 370 wins. Coghlin's six NCAA championship game appearances are the second most in Division III history. Coghlin became just the 37th coach in college hockey history (all divisions) to win 400 games when St. Norbert beat UW-Stout 4-2 on Jan. 20, 2012.

St. Thomas coach Jeff Boeser (St. Thomas, 1975) is 53-28-8 in his fourth season in St. Paul.

Last Meeting:

St. Norbert topped St. Thomas 3-1 on March 7, 2012 in a NCAA Division III Tournament first-round game at the Cornerstone Community Center. Willi Rose opened the scoring with a first-period goal for the Tommies, but St. Norbert answered in the second period with goals by Zach McDonald and Cody Keefer. Keefer then added another marker midway through the third period to seal the win. David Jacobson turned in a 23-save effort for the Green Knights, while Drew Fielding made 21 stops for the Tommies.

About the Green Knights:

St. Norbert, ranked No. 4 in both the USCHO.com and D3hockey.com Division III polls, is 10-2 overall. The Green Knights have been idle since Dec. 7, when they allowed four third-period goals to lose 5-4 to Lawrence, the first loss to the Vikings in school history.

Sophomore forward Michael Hill has eight goals and eight assists for 16 points. Junior forward Cullen Bradshaw has six goals and 10 assists for 16 points, including five power-play markers. Sophomore forward Erik Cooper has eight goals and six assists for 14 points.

Junior forward Mason Baptista owns three goals and 10 assists for 13 points, while senior forward Joe Perry has seven goals and five assists for 12 points.

Junior goaltender David Jacobson is 7-0 with a 1.43 goals against average and .931 save percentage. Freshman Tony Kujava is 3-2 with a 2.62 goals against average and .870 save percentage.

St. Norbert is 14-for-66 (21.2 percent) on the power play and is 51-for-54 (94.4 percent) on the penalty kill this season.

About the Tommies:

St. Thomas enters the game ranked No. 6 in the USCHO.com Poll and No. 9 in the D3hockey.com Poll. The Tommies have been idle since Dec. 14, when they topped St. Scholastica 3-0 on the road. St. Thomas' lone loss this season came in a 3-0 setback at home to UW-Stevens Point on Nov. 15.

Junior forward Alex Altenbernd leads the Tommies in scoring with six goals and five assists for 11 points. Sophomore forward Nick Nielsen has two goals and nine assists for 11 points. Senior forward Tyler Gubb and freshman forward Thomas Williams both have two goals and five assists for seven points.

Junior goaltender Drew Fielding has seen all of the action in goal for the Tommies this season, fashioning an 8-1-2 record with a 1.34 goals against average and .951 save percentage.

St. Thomas is 5-for-46 (10.9 percent) on the power play and is 38-for-40 (95.0 percent) on the penalty kill.

Between the Pipes:

Saturday's game will likely feature two of the top goaltenders in Division III squaring off in St. Norbert junior David Jacobson and St. Thomas' Drew Fielding.

The two have met once previously, when they were freshmen playing in the 2012 NCAA Division

III Tournament. Jacobson made 23 saves to give the Green Knights a 3-1 win over the Tommies in a first-round game. Fielding made 21 stops in the loss.

Jacobson is the lone unbeaten and untied goaltender in Division III this season at 7-0 overall. His 1.43 goals against average is currently 10th in Division III, while his save percentage of .931 is 15th. In his career, Jacobson is 46-8-4 with a 1.56 goals against average and .933 save percentage with 11 shutouts.

Fielding owns an 8-1-2 mark this season with four shutouts. His 1.34 goals against average is eighth in Division III and his .951 save percentage is sixth. In his career, Fielding is 27-12-4 with a 1.71 goals against average and .932 save percentage with 10 shutouts.

Goal Gossip:

St. Norbert's scoring offense of 4.58 goals per game currently ranks fourth in the NCAA Division III national statistical rankings. The Green Knights have scored 55 goals in 12 games.

UW-Stevens Point currently has the top offense at 5.91 goals per game (65 goals in 11 games), while Adrian is second at 4.82 goals per game (53 in 11 games). UMass-Boston is third at 4.60 goals per game (46 goals in 10 games).

St. Norbert has had just one season in the last six when it has averaged at least four goals per game - when it averaged 4.10 goals per game in 2009-10.

Home Sweet Cornerstone:

St. Norbert is 183-22-11 all-time at the Cornerstone Community Center, which includes a 9-4-1 mark there its first season in the building in 2000-01. The Green Knights were 13-4-1 at home last season.

St. Norbert is 162-14-8 in its last 184 games at the Cornerstone Community Center.

The Green Knights had a 25-game home winning streak - the second-longest in NCAA Division III history - snapped with a 2-2 tie to

Gustavus Adolphus on Nov. 4, 2011. St. Norbert also owns the NCAA Division III record with a 36-game home winning streak set Oct. 25, 2002 to Oct. 29, 2004.

In the last 12-plus seasons, the Green Knights are a sparkling 173-17-10 at the Cornerstone, with three losses and one tie coming to national champion UW-Superior during the 2001-02 season.

Under Tim Coghlin, St. Norbert is 261-44-17 at home, which includes games at Brown County Arena, Resch Center and De Pere Ice Arena.

Coghlin Count:

St. Norbert head coach Tim Coghlin brings a record of 444-121-46 in his 21st season into this weekend. The Green Knights' 5-2 win over UW-Stout on Nov. 23 moved Coghlin into 28th on the NCAA hockey all divisions all-time victories list.

Coghlin moved past Trinity's John Dunham (1975-2007), who was previously in 28th place with a record of 441-306-34 in 33 seasons.

Currently sitting in 27th place is Doug Ross, who totaled a 457-294-43 mark in 27 seasons combined at Ohio, Kent State and Alabama-Huntsville.

Tough After Two:

St. Norbert had a 40-game winning streak when leading after two periods snapped in a 5-4 loss to Lawrence on Dec. 7. The Green Knights led the Vikings 3-1 after two periods and 4-1 early in the third period before yielding four unanswered goals down the stretch. St. Norbert is now 7-1 this season when leading after two periods.

Under Tim Coghlin, St. Norbert is an astounding 237-2-2 at home when up after two periods.

St. Norbert had a home unbeaten streak when leading after two periods of 200 games (197-0-3) before it was snapped by UW-Stout in a 4-3 overtime loss on Feb. 7, 2009 - Coghlin's only home setback when leading after two.

At home, St. Norbert is 255-3-3 in school history when leading after two periods. The Green Knights' lone other loss when up after two periods on their own ice came on Nov. 18, 1989 in a 3-1 loss to Augsburg when St. Norbert lost a 1-0 lead.

Poll Position:

St. Norbert has been ranked in the USCHO.com Division III Poll for 216 consecutive polls. The Green Knights have been ranked in 254 of 260 polls conducted since its inception at the start of the 1998-99 season - the most of any school in Division III.

During the 216-week stretch of being ranked, St. Norbert has been No. 1 for 54 weeks - trailing Norwich's 71 for most all-time. St. Norbert was rated No. 1 in the 2003, 2004, 2005, 2007, 2008, 2011 and 2012 final polls. The Green Knights are 74-16-6 all-time when ranked No. 1 in the USCHO.com Poll.

St. Norbert is 106-43-15 against teams ranked in the USCHO.com Poll under Tim Coghlin. The Green Knights are 2-4 all-time against the No. 1-ranked team and are 5-5 all-time against the No. 2-ranked team.

Gimme Five:

St. Norbert is unbeaten in its last 257 games when scoring five goals or more with a 250-0-7 mark since a 7-5 loss to Bemidji State in De Pere on Jan. 12, 1996.

St. Norbert is 5-24-6 in its last 35 games when allowing five goals or more dating back to the 1996-97 season. The only five wins came in a 9-5 win over St. Scholastica on Feb. 20, 1999, a 7-5 win over UW-Stout on Nov. 30, 2001, an 8-5 win over UW-Stout on Jan. 14, 2005, a 7-5 win over UW-Stevens Point on Feb. 3, 2007 and a 7-5 win over Gustavus Adolphus on Oct. 31, 2008.

The Green Knights have allowed five goals just 21 times in their last 361 games.

St. Norbert has never allowed 10 goals in a game during Tim Coghlin's 611-game tenure.
