The Series:

St. Norbert leads Concordia-Wisconsin 2-0 in an all-time series dating back to the 2011-12 campaign. The Green Knights opened the series with an 8-0 win in Mequon on Oct. 25, 2011, and then took the return game in De Pere last season by a 4-0 score on Oct. 23, 2012.

The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Tim Coghlin (UW-Stevens Point, 1989) is 446-121-47 in his 21st season in De Pere. The Green Knights are 301-51-30 in the last 13-plus seasons. Coghlin's 436 wins as a coach in the NCHA is the league record, 66 more than Bemidji State's Bob Peters' 370 wins. Coghlin's six NCAA championship game appearances are the second most in Division III history. Coghlin became just the 37th coach in college hockey history (all divisions) to win 400 games when St. Norbert beat UW-Stout 4-2 on Jan. 20, 2012.

Concordia coach Jasen Wise (St. Thomas, 1996) is 15-22-3 in his second season in Mequon. Wise went 120-87-14 coaching at Marian for eight seasons for an overall record of 135-109-17 in ten seasons.

Last Meeting:

St. Norbert topped Concordia-Wisconsin 4-0 on Oct. 23, 2012 at the Cornerstone Community Center in De Pere. Erik Cooper, Kyle Stroh, Sam Dougherty and Carl Ekstrom all scored goals for the Green Knights. David Jacobson made 17 saves for St. Norbert, while Jake Hebda made 31 stops for the Falcons.

About the Green Knights:

St. Norbert, ranked No. 4 in both USCHO.com the and D3hockey.com Division III polls, is 12-2-1 overall and 7-1 in the Northern Collegiate Hockey Association. The Green Knights went on the road last weekend and topped No. 13-ranked UW-River Falls 3-2 in overtime last Friday before settling for a 2-2 tie at No. 2ranked UW-Stevens Point on Saturday.

Sophomore forward Michael Hill has nine goals and nine assists for 18 points, while junior forward Cullen Bradshaw has eight goals and 10 assists for 18 points. Sophomore forward Erik Cooper has eight goals and eight assists for 16 points. Junior forward Mason Baptista has three goals and 12 assists for 15 points, while senior forward Joe Perry has collected nine goals and five assists for 14 points.

Junior goaltender David Jacobson is 9-0-1 with a 1.67 goals against average and .918 save percentage. Freshman Tony Kujava is 3-2 with a 2.62 goals against average and .870 save percentage.

St. Norbert is 17-for-79 (21.5 percent) on the power play and is 61for-66 (92.4 percent) on the penalty kill this season.

About the Falcons:

Concordia-Wisconsin enters the series 8-4-3 overall and is 5-2-2 in the Northern Collegiate Hockey Association. The Falcons have won their last six games, including road wins last weekend of 5-1 over St. Mary's on Friday and 5-2 over Augsburg on Saturday.

Sophomore forward Devin Stuermer leads the Falcons in scoring with nine goals and nine assists for 18 points. Freshman forward Brett Penner and sophomore forard Chris Hughes both have seven goals and five assists for 12 points, with Penner scoring four powerplay goals. Freshman forward Dylan Hutton has five goals and six assists for 11 points, while freshman forward Riley Storzuk has three goals and eight assists for 11 points.

Sophomore goaltender Domingo Torrenueva is 6-0-1 with a 2.52 goals against average and .917 save percentage. Sophomore Jake Hebda is 2-1-2 with a 3.54 goals against average and .907 save percentage.

Concordia is 18-for-87 (20.7 percent) on the power play and is 62for-77 (80.5 percent) on the penalty kill.

January Joy:

The month of January continues to be a strong one for the St. Norbert College hockey team under coach Tim Coghlin, with the Green Knights going 2-0-1 this month all against nationally ranked opposition.

Under Coghlin, the Green Knights boast a 123-26-15 record in January. It's the best mark in any month for the Green Knights. St. Norbert is also 123-34-13 in November and 93-24-12 in February under Coghlin. The Green Knights are 37-15-1 under Coghlin in the "money month" of March, with all games being NCHA Peters Cup Playoffs or NCAA Division III Tournament action.

Overtime Observations:

St. Norbert pulled out a pulsating 3-2 overtime road win at UW-River Falls this past Friday when freshman forward Pijus Rulevicius pounded home a rebound with 2.7 seconds remaining in the extra session.

Remarkably, it was just the sixth overtime road win in school history, and only the third in the last 15 seasons.

The Green Knights last won on the road in overtime on Nov. 2, 2012 when it beat Augsburg 3-2 on a Tyler Zepeda goal. Prior to that, Matt Boyd lifted St. Norbert to a 4-3 win at UW-Eau Claire on Feb. 2, 2007.

St. Norbert got a 4-3 overtime win at UW-Stevens Point (Rob Smillie game-winning goal) on Jan. 29, 1999, a 4-3 win at St. Scholastica on Jan. 5, 1996 (Smillie) and a 4-3 win at Lake Forest on Feb. 4, 1995 (Mike Porcaro).

Home Sweet Cornerstone:

St. Norbert is 184-22-11 all-time at the Cornerstone Community Center, which includes a 9-4-1 mark there its first season in the building in 2000-01. The Green Knights were 13-4-1 at home last season.

St. Norbert is 163-14-8 in its last 185 games at the Cornerstone Community Center.

The Green Knights had a 25-game home winning streak - the secondlongest in NCAA Division III history - snapped with a 2-2 tie to Gustavus Adolphus on Nov. 4, 2011. St. Norbert also owns the NCAA Division III record with a 36-game home winning streak set Oct. 25, 2002 to Oct. 29, 2004.

In the last 12-plus seasons, the Green Knights are a sparkling 174-17-10 at the Cornerstone, with three losses and one tie coming to national champion UW-Superior during the 2001-02 season.

Under Tim Coghlin, St. Norbert is 262-44-17 at home, which includes games at Brown County Arena, Resch Center and De Pere Ice Arena.

Coghlin Count:

St. Norbert head coach Tim Coghlin brings a record of 446-121-47 in his 21st season into this weekend. The Green Knights' 5-2 win over UW-Stout on Nov. 23 moved Coghlin into 28th on the NCAA hockey all divisions all-time victories list.

Coghlin moved past Trinity's John Dunham (1975-2007), who was previously in 28th place with a record of 441-306-34 in 33 seasons.

Currently sitting in 27th place is Doug Ross, who totaled a 457-294-43 mark in 27 seasons combined at Ohio, Kent State and Alabama-Huntsville.

Tough After Two:

St. Norbert had a 40-game winning streak when leading after two periods snapped in a 5-4 loss to Lawrence on Dec. 7. The Green Knights led the Vikings 3-1 after two periods and 4-1 early in the third period before yielding four unanswered goals down the stretch. St. Norbert is now 7-1 this season when leading after two periods.

Under Tim Coghlin, St. Norbert is an astounding 238-2-2 at home when up after two periods.

St. Norbert had a home unbeaten streak when leading after two periods of 200 games (197-0-3) before it was snapped by UW-Stout in a 4-3 overtime loss on Feb. 7, 2009 -Coghlin's only home setback when leading after two.

At home, St. Norbert is 256-3-3 in school history when leading after

Poll Position:

St. Norbert has been ranked in the USCHO.com Division III Poll for 218 consecutive polls. The Green Knights have been ranked in 256 of 262 polls conducted since its inception at the start of the 1998-99 season - the most of any school in Division III.

During the 218-week stretch of being ranked, St. Norbert has been No. 1 for 54 weeks - trailing Norwich's 71 for most all-time. St. Norbert was rated No. 1 in the 2003, 2004, 2005, 2007, 2008, 2011 and 2012 final polls. The Green Knights are 74-16-6 all-time when ranked No. 1 in the USCHO.com Poll.

St. Norbert is 108-43-16 against teams ranked in the USCHO.com Poll under Tim Coghlin. The Green Knights are 2-4 all-time against the No. 1-ranked team and are 5-5-1 all-time against the No. 2-ranked team.

The Green Knights are 4-1-1 against nationally ranked teams this season.

Gimme Five:

St. Norbert is unbeaten in its last 258 games when scoring five goals or more with a 251-0-7 mark since a 7-5 loss to Bemidji State in De Pere on Jan. 12, 1996.

St. Norbert is 5-24-6 in its last 35 games when allowing five goals or more dating back to the 1996-97 season. The only five wins came in a 9-5 win over St. Scholastica on Feb. 20, 1999, a 7-5 win over UW-Stout on Nov. 30, 2001, an 8-5 win over UW-Stout on Jan. 14, 2005, a 7-5 win over UW-Stevens Point on Feb. 3, 2007 and a 7-5 win over Gustavus Adolphus on Oct. 31, 2008.

The Green Knights have allowed five goals just 21 times in their last 362 games.

St. Norbert has never allowed 10 goals in a game during Tim Coghlin's 614-game tenure.
