#### The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Tim Coghlin (UW-Stevens Point, 1989) is 475-123-49 in his 22nd season in De Pere. The Green Knights are 330-53-32 in the last 14-plus seasons. Coghlin's 465 wins as a coach in the NCHA is the league record, 95 more than Bemidji State's Bob Peters' 370 wins. Coghlin's seven NCAA championship game appearances and four national championships are the second most in Division III history. Coghlin was the captain of UW-Stevens Point's first national championship team in 1989.

MSOE coach Mark Ostapina (Wisconsin, 1979) is 205-156-15 in his 14th season in Milwaukee. Including six seasons at New England College, Ostapina is 268-241-23 in 20 seasons.

#### Last Season:

St. Norbert swept MSOE in a home-and-home series last season. The Green Knights topped the Raiders 3-0 on Jan. 24, 2014 at the Cornerstone Community Center, and then won 2-0 the next night at Kern Center in Milwaukee.

Erik Cooper, Chris Rial and Joe Perry all scored for St. Norbert in the opener. David Jacobson made 15 saves for St. Norbert, while Austin Campbell made 29 stops for MSOE.

Blake Thompson and Tyler Zepeda scored the two goals in the second game. Jacobson made 25 saves for the Green Knights, while Nick Kohn made 36 saves for the Raiders.

#### About the Green Knights:

St. Norbert enters the series at 13-1-2 overall and 9-0-1 in the Northern Collegiate Hockey Association. The Green Knights, ranked No. 1 in the USCHO.com and D3hockey.com Division III polls, swept Concordia-Wis. this past weekend with wins of 7-1 and 4-2.

Senior forward Mason Baptista leads the Green Knights in scoring with 23 points, totaling five goals and 18 assists. Junior forward Michael Hill has 15 goals and six assists for 21 points, while senior forward Cullen Bradshaw has seven goals and 13 assists for 20 points. Senior defenseman Marian Fiala has three goals and 13 assists for 16 points, while senior defenseman Sam Higgins has 13 assists for 13 points. Junior forward Erik Cooper has nine goals and four assists for 13 points.

Senior goaltender David Jacobson is 11-0-1 with a 1.41 goals against average and .932 save percentage. Sophomore Tony Kujava is 2-1-1 with a 1.18 goals against average and .926 save percentage.

St. Norbert is 23-for-75 (30.7 percent) on the power play and is 60for-64 (93.8 percent) on the penalty kill this season.

#### About the Raiders:

Milwaukee School of Engineering is 10-7 overall and 5-5 in the Northern Collegiate Hockey Association. The Raiders split their series this past weekend with Lawrence, winning 5-2 Friday in Appleton before dropping Saturday's game in Milwaukee 3-2.

Freshman forward Omar Mullen leads the Raiders in scoring with 11 goals and 16 assists for 27 points. Freshman defenseman James Ring has five goals and 11 assists for 16 points, while sophomore forward Gage Christianson has four goals and 11 assists for 15 points.

Freshman forward Jerad Tafoya has nine goals and five assists for 14 points.

Junior goaltender Nick Kohn is 7-3 with a 2.38 goals against average and .910 save percentage. Sophomore Austin Campbell is 3-3 with a 2.86 goals against average and .890 save percentage.

MSOE is 16-for-89 (18.0 percent) on the power play and is 62-for-73 (84.9 percent) on the penalty kill this season.

#### **Bradshaw Bullets:**

St. Norbert senior forward Cullen Bradshaw is nearing the Top 10 in career scoring for the Green Knights.

Bradshaw currently has 43 goals and 76 assists for 119 points in 108 career games. Bradshaw is two points shy of matching Rob Garofolo for tenth place, who had 121 points from 1990-93. Shane Dickson is in ninth place with 123 points from 1998-2001.

Bradshaw's 76 career assists are currently seventh all time. Connor Hughes (2003-06) and Scott Jewitt (1996-99) are tied for fifth all-time with 77.

#### **Jacobson Jottings:**

St. Norbert senior goaltender David Jacobson reached another career milestone with a shutout in a 0-0 tie at St. John's on Jan. 8.

Jacobson's shutout was the 20th of his career, making him only the second netminder in NCAA Division III history to reach that mark. Kyle Jones had 25 shutouts from 2005-08 for St. Norbert.

Jacobson, featured in the trading cards of the most recent issue of SI Kids, earned his 74th career win in a 4-2 triumph over Concordia-Wis. on Jan. 17. Jacobson is currently third in career goaltender wins in Division III history (see info box on Page 2 of notes).

#### **Experience Counts:**

St. Norbert currently has five seniors who have played in at least 100 collegiate games.

Forward Cullen Bradshaw has played the most with 108 games, while defenseman Marian Fiala has played in 107. Forward Mason Baptista has played in 105 games, followed by forward Chris Rial's 102 games. Defenseman George Malliaras has played in 100 games.

This year's St. Norbert senior class currently owns a record of 85-15-9 (.821) with NCAA Division III championships in 2012 and 2014.

#### **Poll Position:**

St. Norbert has been ranked in the USCHO.com Division III Poll for 238 consecutive polls. The Green Knights have been ranked in 276 of 282 polls conducted since its inception at the start of the 1998-99 season - the most of any school in Division III.

During the 238-week stretch of being ranked, St. Norbert has been No. 1 for 71 weeks - trailing Norwich's 72 for most all-time. St. Norbert was rated No. 1 in the 2003, 2004, 2005, 2007, 2008, 2011, 2012 and 2014 final polls. The Green Knights are 97-17-7 all-time when ranked No. 1 in the USCHO.com Poll.

St. Norbert is 113-45-17 against teams ranked in the USCHO.com Poll under Tim Coghlin. The Green Knights are 3-5 all-time against the No. 1-ranked team and are 5-5-1 all-time against the No. 2-ranked team.

The Green Knights are 1-1-1 against nationally ranked teams this season. St. Norbert claimed a 3-2 win over No. 9 UW-Eau Claire on Nov. 18, and lost 6-5 to No. 8 UW-Stevens Point on Jan. 3. The Green Knights skated to a scoreless draw with No. 15 St. John's on Jan. 8.

#### Home Sweet Cornerstone:

St. Norbert is 202-24-12 all-time at the Cornerstone Community Center, which includes a 9-4-1 mark there its first season in the building in 2000-01.

St. Norbert is 181-16-9 in its last 206 games at the Cornerstone Community Center.

The Green Knights had a 25-game home winning streak - the secondlongest in NCAA Division III history - snapped with a 2-2 tie to Gustavus Adolphus on Nov. 4, 2011. St. Norbert also owns the NCAA Division III record with a 36-game home winning streak set Oct. 25, 2002 to Oct. 29, 2004.

In the last 13-plus seasons, the Green Knights are a sparkling 192-

#### **Tough After Two:**

St. Norbert is 10-0-1 this season when leading after two periods.

Under Tim Coghlin, St. Norbert is an astounding 256-2-3 at home when up after two periods.

St. Norbert had a home unbeaten streak when leading after two periods of 200 games (197-0-3) before it was snapped by UW-Stout in a 4-3 overtime loss on Feb. 7, 2009 -Coghlin's only other home setback when leading after two.

At home, St. Norbert is 274-3-4 in school history when leading after two periods. The Green Knights' lone other loss when up after two periods on their own ice came on Nov. 18, 1989 in a 3-1 loss to Augsburg when St. Norbert lost a 1-0 lead.

#### **Gimme Five:**

St. Norbert saw a 273-game unbeaten streak when scoring at least five goals spanning nearly 19 years end in a 6-5 loss to UW-Stevens Point on Jan. 3. The Green Knights were 266-0-7 when scoring five goals since a 7-5 loss to Bemidji State in De Pere on Jan. 12, 1996.

St. Norbert is 5-25-6 in its last 36 games when allowing five goals or more dating back to the 1996-97 season. The only five wins came in a 9-5 win over St. Scholastica on Feb. 20, 1999, a 7-5 win over UW-Stout on Nov. 30, 2001, an 8-5 win over UW-Stout on Jan. 14, 2005, a 7-5 win over UW-Stevens Point on Feb. 3, 2007 and a 7-5 win over Gustavus Adolphus on Oct. 31, 2008.

The Green Knights have allowed five goals just 22 times in their last 393 games.

St. Norbert has never allowed 10 goals in a game during Tim Coghlin's 647-game tenure.
