Game Overview:

St. Norbert plays in the championship game of the NCHA Playoffs for the 13th time in the last 14 seasons when it travels to Adrian. The Green Knights have won the last five NCHA post-season titles as well as 10 of the last 12. The winner of the game will receive an automatic berth into the NCAA Division III Tournament.

The Series:

St. Norbert leads Adrian 4-3 in an all-time series that began during the 2009-10 season. This game is the first time the two teams have met in the NCHA Playoffs.

The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Tim Coghlin (UW-Stevens Point, 1989) is 482-127-49 in his 22nd season in De Pere. The Green Knights are 337-57-32 in the last 14-plus seasons. Coghlin's 472 wins as a coach in the NCHA is the league record, 102 more than Bemidji State's Bob Peters' 370 wins. Coghlin's seven NCAA championship game appearances and four national championships are the second most in Division III history. Coghlin was the captain of UW-Stevens Point's first national championship team in 1989.

Adrian coach Adam Krug (Adrian, 2012) is 22-3-3 in his first season in Adrian.

This Season:

Adrian swept St. Norbert in a NCHA series on Jan. 30-31, 2015 at Arrington Ice Arena in Adrian, Mich.

The Bulldogs won the opener 4-2 behind two goals from Kyle Brothers. Ross Pavcek and Pijus Rulevicius scored for St. Norbert. David Jacobson made 22 saves for the Green Knights, while Scott Shackell had 35 for the Bulldogs.

Adrian then swept the series with a 6-4 win the next day. Kevin Balas had two goals for the Bulldogs, while Cullen Bradshaw had a goal and an assist for St. Norbert. Shackell made 27 saves for Adrian, while Tony Kujava made 31 saves for St. Norbert.

About the Green Knights:

St. Norbert enters the game with a 20-5-2 overall record and ranked No. 5 in the USCHO.com Division III and D3hockey.com polls. The Green Knights, who are playing in the NCHA Playoffs championship for the 13th time in the last 14 seasons, advanced with a 3-1 win over Milwaukee School of Engineering in a semifinal game last Saturday.

Senior forward Mason Baptista leads the Green Knights in scoring with eight goals and 26 assists for 34 points. Junior forward Michael Hill leads St. Norbert in goals with 20 and also has 13 assists for 33 points. Senior forward Cullen

Bradshaw has 11 goals and 20 assists for 31 points. Senior defenseman Marian Fiala has seven goals and 15 assists for 22 points, while junior forward Erik Cooper has 11 goals and eight assists for 19 points.

Sophomore Tony Kujava is 8-3-1 with a 1.67 goals against average and .911 save percentage, and has five shutouts this season. Senior goaltender David Jacobson, who will miss the rest of the season, is 12-2-1 with a 1.59 goals against average and .924 save percentage.

St. Norbert is 37-for-139 (26.6 percent) on the power play and is 98-for-110 (89.1 percent) on the penalty kill this season.

About the Bulldogs:

Adrian enters the game 22-3-3 overall. The Bulldogs have won 10 consecutive games since a 3-0 loss at Finlandia on Jan. 23. Adrian advanced to the Harris Cup championship game with a 4-3 overtime win over St. Scholastica this past Saturday.

Freshman forward Kyle Brothers leads the Bulldogs in scoring with 22 goals and 24 assists for 46 points, including eight game-winning goals. Senior forward Josh Ranali has 17 goals and 25 assists for 42 points, while freshman forward Mathew Thompson has 20 goals and 19 assists for 38 points. Sophomore forward Jeremy Olinyk has 11 goals and 17 assists for 28 points, while senior forward Duston Hebebrand has 13 goals and 13 assists for 27 points.

Senior goaltender Scott Shackell is 16-1-3 with a 1.88 goals against average and .933 save percentage. Senior James Hamby is 4-2 with a 3.12 goals against average and .892 save percentage.

Adrian is 39-for-148 (26.4 percent) on the power play and is 100-for-116 (86.2 percent) on the penalty kill this season.

Cup Clamor:

This Saturday's NCHA Harris Cup Playoffs championship game marks just the fourth time in the last 50 rounds St. Norbert will be on the road in the league playoffs.

Including this weekend's title

game at Adrian, St. Norbert has played 46 of the last 50 NCHA Playoffs rounds it has played in on home ice. The Green Knights are 63-12-1 all-time in the NCHA Playoffs, and are 61-7 at home all-time in the tournament. St. Norbert is 2-5-1 on the road.

Since the 1996-97 season, St. Norbert has played just three other NCHA Playoff series/rounds on the road. The Green Knights, after a third-place finish in the NCHA in 2000-01, played at UW-River Falls in the semifinal round and were eliminated 1-0 in an overtime mini-game. St. Norbert's 3-0 loss at UW-Superior in the NCHA Semifinals in 2009. St. Norbert won the final Peters Cup Playoffs championship with a 3-0 win at UW-Eau Claire in 2013.

St. Norbert finished second in 1999-2000 but was eliminated in the semifinals at the De Pere Ice Arena in a mini-game of a two-game series by UW-Superior. The Green Knights were seeded second in 2007 but hosted the championship after top-seeded River Falls lost in the semifinals.

Senior Summary:

St. Norbert senior forward Cullen Bradshaw is in sole possession of eighth place in career scoring for the Green Knights.

Bradshaw currently has 47 goals and 83 assists for 130 points in 119 career games. Bradshaw is two points behind Marc Belanger for seventh place. Belanger had 132 points from 2005-08.

Bradshaw's 83 career assists are ties for fourth time. Matt Boyd shares the mark with 83 career helpers from 2007-10.

Senior forward Mason Baptista has 29 goals and 75 assists for 104 points in 116 career games. His 75 career assists are tied for eighth in school history.

Goalie Gossip:

St. Norbert sophomore goaltender Tony Kujava enters Saturday's game with five shutouts on the season. His five shutouts are tied for third-most in Division III this season with UW-Stevens Point's

Brandon Jaeger. St. Thomas' Drew Fielding and Babson's Jamie Murray both have six.

Kujava had a consecutive shutout sequence of 239 minutes 42 seconds end in the third period of a 3-1 win over MSOE on Feb. 28. That stretch is the fourth-longest shutout streak in Division III history. St. Norbert's Kyle Jones holds the record at 337:22 from Jan. 13-28, 2006.

Coghlin Count:

St. Norbert head coach Tim Coghlin brings a record of 482-127-49 in his 22nd season into this weekend. Coghlin is currently tied for 25th all-time in wins for NCAA men's ice hockey coaches.

Coghlin is tied with Joe Marsh for 25th on the all-time list. Marsh compiled a 482-417-76 mark in 27 seasons at St. Lawrence from 1986 to 2012.

Current Mercyhurst coach Rick Gotkin is 24th on the list with a 490-350-76 mark in 27 seasons. Current Fitchburg State coach Dean Fuller is 23rd with a career mark of 495-284-49 in 31 seasons.

Poll Position:

St. Norbert has been ranked in the USCHO.com Division III Poll for 244 consecutive polls. The Green Knights have been ranked in 282 of 288 polls conducted since its inception at the start of the 1998-99 season - the most of any school in Division III.

During the 244-week stretch of being ranked, St. Norbert has been No. 1 for 71 weeks - trailing Norwich's 77 for most all-time. St. Norbert was rated No. 1 in the 2003, 2004, 2005, 2007, 2008, 2011, 2012 and 2014 final polls. The Green Knights are 98-18-7 all-time when ranked No. 1 in the USCHO.com Poll.

St. Norbert is 114-47-17 against teams ranked in the USCHO.com Poll under Tim Coghlin. The Green Knights are 3-5 all-time against the No. 1-ranked team and are 5-5-1 all-time against the No. 2-ranked team.

The Green Knights are 2-3-1 against nationally ranked teams this season. St. Norbert claimed a 3-2 win over No. 9 UW-Eau Claire on

Nov. 18, and lost 6-5 to No. 8 UW-Stevens Point on Jan. 3. The Green Knights skated to a scoreless draw with No. 15 St. John's on Jan. 8. St. Norbert was swept at No. 10 Adrian 4-2 and 6-4 on Jan. 30-31. St. Norbert topped No. 15 MSOE 3-1 on Feb. 28.

Tough After Two:

St. Norbert is 17-0-1 this season when leading after two periods. The Green Knights are 3-0-1 when tied after two periods but are 0-5 when trailing after 40 minutes.

Under Tim Coghlin, St. Norbert is an astounding 260-2-3 at home when up after two periods.

St. Norbert had a home unbeaten streak when leading after two periods of 200 games (197-0-3) before it was snapped by UW-Stout in a 4-3 overtime loss on Feb. 7, 2009. The Green Knights also lost 5-4 to Lawrence on Dec. 7, 2013 when leading after two periods.

At home, St. Norbert is 278-3-4 in school history when leading after two periods. The Green Knights' lone other loss when up after two periods on their own ice came on Nov. 18, 1989 in a 3-1 loss to Augsburg when St. Norbert lost a 1-0 lead.

Gimme Five:

St. Norbert saw a 273-game unbeaten streak when scoring at least five goals spanning nearly 19 years end in a 6-5 loss to UW-Stevens Point on Jan. 3. The Green Knights were 266-0-7 when scoring five goals since a 7-5 loss to Bemidji State in De Pere on Jan. 12, 1996.

St. Norbert is 5-26-6 in its last 37 games when allowing five goals or more dating back to the 1996-97 season. The only five wins came in a 9-5 win over St. Scholastica on Feb. 20, 1999, a 7-5 win over UW-Stout on Nov. 30, 2001, an 8-5 win over UW-Stout on Jan. 14, 2005, a 7-5 win over UW-Stevens Point on Feb. 3, 2007 and a 7-5 win over Gustavus Adolphus on Oct. 31, 2008.

The Green Knights have allowed five goals just 23 times in their last 404 games.

St. Norbert has never allowed 10 goals in a game during Tim Coghlin's 658-game tenure.
