Series Overview:

St. Norbert skates in a Northern Collegiate Hockey Association series for the third consecutive weekend when it faces Lake Forest in a home-andhome series.

The Series:

St. Norbert has played Lake Forest 67 times, and holds a 44-20-3 advantage in a series begun in the 1988-89 season. Lake Forest won the first 14 games in the series, with St. Norbert posting a 44-6-3 ledger since.

The only team St. Norbert has played more often than Lake Forest is UW-Stevens Point. The Green Knights have met the Pointers 69 times.

The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Tim Coghlin (UW-Stevens Point, 1989) is 466-122-47 in his 22nd season in De Pere. The Green Knights are 321-52-30 in the last 14-plus seasons. Coghlin's 456 wins as a coach in the NCHA is the league record, 86 more than Bemidji State's Bob Peters' 370 wins. Coghlin's seven NCAA championship appearances and four national championships are the second most in Division III history. Coghlin was the captain of UW-Stevens Point's first national championship team in 1989.

Lake Forest coach Patrick Kelliher (St. Lawrence, 2010) is 2-1 in his first season in Lake Forest.

Last Season:

St. Norbert swept Lake Forest in a home-and-home series and then won a NCHA Harris Cup Playoffs semifinal game. The Green Knights won 9-1 on Nov. 15, 2013 at the Cornerstone Community Center, and then claimed a 4-1 win the next night at Alumni Memorial Fieldhouse. St. Norbert won the NCHA Semifinal 6-0 on March 1 at Community the Cornerstone Center.

Joe Perry and Erik Cooper both scored two goals to lead St. Norbert in the series opener. The Green Knights, who led 4-1 13:27 into the game, outshot the Foresters 37-17. Tony Kujava made 16 saves for St. Norbert. Leo Podolsky made five saves in 13:27, while Billy Cooper made 23 saves in 46:33 of relief.

Reid Campbell, Mason Baptista,

Patrick McCadden and Erik Cooper all scored in the win at Lake Forest. Justin Pelock scored for the Foresters. David Jacobson made 25 saves for the Green Knights. Billy Cooper made 20 stops for the Foresters.

In the post-season matchup, Joe Perry and Cullen Bradshaw scored two goals each and David Jacobson made 14 saves for the Green Knights.

About the Green Knights:

St. Norbert enters the weekend with a 4-0 overall record as well as in the Northern Collegiate Hockey Association. The Green Knights remained unblemished with a series sweep of Finlandia by scores of 7-1 and 12-0 this past weekend at the Cornerstone Community Center.

Senior forward Mason Baptista has one goal and six assists for seven points to lead the Green Knights in scoring. Sophomore forward Noah Nelson has three goals and three assists for six points, while senior forward Cullen Bradshaw has two goals and four assists for six points. Sophomore defenseman Blake Thompson has three goals and two assists for five points, while senior defenseman Marian Fiala has five assists fo five points.

Senior goaltender David Jacobson is 3-0 with a 1.33 goals against average and .922 save percentage. Sophomore Tony Kujava is 1-0 with a 0.00 goals against average and 1.000 save percentage.

cent) on the power play and is 12-for-13 (92.3 percent) on the penalty kill this season.

About the Foresters:

Lake Forest enters the weekend at 2-1 overall and 1-1 in the Northern Collegiate Hockey Association. The Foresters split a league series at Northland this past weekend, winning the opener 6-1 before dropping the second game 4-3.

Senior forward Bobby Barrett leads the Foresters in scoring with two goals and four assists for six points. Senior forward Luke Swardenski has four goals and one assist for five points. Sophomore forward Jack Lewis has three goals and two assists for five points, and junior defenseman Ben Certo has two goals and three assists for five points.

Junior goaltender Leo Podolsky is 2-1 with a 1.93 goals against average and .921 save percentage. Sophomore Billy Cooper is 0-0 with a 5.11 goals against average and .857 save percentage.

Lake Forest is 4-for-15 (26.7 percent) on the power play and is 12-for-13 (92.3 percent) on the penalty kill this season.

Poll Position:

St. Norbert has been ranked in the USCHO.com Division III Poll for 230 consecutive polls. The Green Knights have been ranked in 268 of 274 polls conducted since its inception at the start of the 1998-99 season - the most of any school in Division III.

During the 230-week stretch of

being ranked, St. Norbert has been No. 1 for 64 weeks - trailing Norwich's 71 for most all-time. St. Norbert was rated No. 1 in the 2003, 2004, 2005, 2007, 2008, 2011, 2012 and 2014 final polls. The Green Knights are 89-16-6 all-time when ranked No. 1 in the USCHO.com Poll.

St. Norbert is 113-44-16 against teams ranked in the USCHO.com Poll under Tim Coghlin. The Green Knights are 3-5 all-time against the No. 1-ranked team and are 5-5-1 all-time against the No. 2-ranked team.

The Green Knights were 9-2-1 against nationally ranked teams last season.

Home Sweet Cornerstone:

St. Norbert is 197-23-11 all-time at the Cornerstone Community Center, which includes a 9-4-1 mark there its first season in the building in 2000-01. The Green Knights went 15-2 at home last season.

St. Norbert is 176-15-8 in its last 199 games at the Cornerstone Community Center.

The Green Knights had a 25-game home winning streak - the second-longest in NCAA Division III history - snapped with a 2-2 tie to Gustavus Adolphus on Nov. 4, 2011. St. Norbert also owns the NCAA Division III record with a 36-game home winning streak set Oct. 25, 2002 to Oct. 29, 2004.

In the last 13-plus seasons, the Green Knights are a sparkling 187-18-10 at the Cornerstone, with three losses and one tie coming to national champion UW-Superior during the 2001-02 season.

St. Norbert Hockey Winning Streaks

St. Norbert's current 15-game winning streak is one win shy of a school record and is just the fifth of at least 13 games in school history. The Green Knights' school record of 16 spanned the 2007-08 and 2008-09 seasons.

Tough After Two:

St. Norbert is 3-0 this season when leading after two periods.

Under Tim Coghlin, St. Norbert is an astounding 250-2-2 at home when up after two periods.

St. Norbert had a home unbeaten streak when leading after two periods of 200 games (197-0-3) before it was snapped by UW-Stout in a 4-3 overtime loss on Feb. 7, 2009 - Coghlin's only other home setback when leading after two.

At home, St. Norbert is 268-3-3 in school history when leading after two periods. The Green Knights' lone other loss when up after two periods on their own ice came on Nov. 18, 1989 in a 3-1 loss to Augsburg when St. Norbert lost a 1-0 lead.

Gimme Five:

St. Norbert is unbeaten in its last 270 games when scoring five goals or more with a 263-0-7 mark since a 7-5 loss to Bemidji State in De Pere on Jan. 12, 1996.

St. Norbert is 5-24-6 in its last 35 games when allowing five goals or more dating back to the 1996-97 season. The only five wins came in a 9-5 win over St. Scholastica on Feb. 20, 1999, a 7-5 win over UW-Stout on Nov. 30, 2001, an 8-5 win over UW-Stout on Jan. 14, 2005, a 7-5 win over UW-Stevens Point on Feb. 3, 2007 and a 7-5 win over Gustavus Adolphus on Oct. 31, 2008.

The Green Knights have allowed five goals just 21 times in their last 383 games.

St. Norbert has never allowed 10 goals in a game during Tim Coghlin's 633-game tenure.

Ice Chip:
