# St. Norbert College Green Knights Hockey Preview No. 1 St. Norbert College (5-0-1) vs. No. 9 UW-Eau Claire (3-0-1) Tuesday, November 18, 2014 - 7 p.m. Cornerstone Community Center (1,674) - De Pere, Wisconsin

#### Game Overview:

St. Norbert faces its first nationally ranked opponent of the season when it hosts UW-Eau Claire in a rare Tuesday game. The Green Knights (three) and Blugolds (one) have combined for the last four NCAA Division III national championships.

#### The Series:

St. Norbert leads the UW-Eau Claire series, begun in the 1993-94 season, by a 47-7-4 margin. St. Norbert is 47-4-4 in the series since Eau Claire topped the Green Knights 5-4 in overtime on Jan. 21, 1995 at Hobbs Ice Center. The Green Knights are 31-3-2 all-time at home in the series.

#### The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Tim Coghlin (UW-Stevens Point, 1989) is 467-122-48 in his 22nd season in De Pere. The Green Knights are 322-52-31 in the last 14-plus seasons. Coghlin's 457 wins as a coach in the NCHA is the league record, 87 more than Bemidji State's Bob Peters' 370 wins. Coghlin's seven NCAA championship game appearances and four national championships are the second most in Division III history. Coghlin was the captain of UW-Stevens Point's first national championship team in 1989.

UW-Eau Claire coach Matt Loen (UW-Eau Claire, 1995) is 106-80-14 in his eighth season in Eau Claire.

#### Last Season:

St. Norbert topped UW-Eau Claire 5-2 on Nov. 22, 2013 at the Cornerstone Community Center. The Green Knights then routed the Blugolds 8-2 five days later at Hobbs Ice Center in Eau Claire.

Pijus Rulevicius, Michael Hill, Erik Cooper, Brandon Hoogenboom and Mason Baptista all scored for the Green Knights in the first game. Jon Waggoner scored twice for the Blugolds. David Jacobson made 32 saves for the Green Knights, while Tyler Green made 27 stops for Eau Claire.

In game two, the Green Knights built a 5-0 second-period lead and cruised from there. Hill tallied a hat trick, while Cullen Bradshaw had a goal and three assists for four points. Jacobson made 27 saves in net for St. Norbert. Green had 18 saves and Cory Simons six stops for Eau Claire.

#### About the Green Knights:

St. Norbert enters the game at 5-0-1 overall and in the Northern Collegiate Hockey Association. The Green Knights picked up three league points this past weekend against Lake Forest, winning 3-1 Friday at Lake Forest before skating to a 2-2 tie Saturday in De Pere.

Sophomore forward Noah Nelson has three goals and four assists for seven points, while senior forward Cullen Bradshaw has two goals and five assists for seven points. Senior forward Mason Baptista has one goal and six assists for seven points. Senior defenseman Marian Fiala has six assists for six points, while junior forward Michael Hill has a team-high fourgoals with one assist for five points.

Senior goaltender David Jacobson is 4-0 with a 1.25 goals against average and .940 save percentage. Sophomore Tony Kujava is 1-0-1 with a 0.96 goals against average and .941 save percentage.

St. Norbert is 6-for-28 (21.4 percent) on the power play and is 19for-21 (90.5 percent) on the penalty kill this season.

#### About the Blugolds:

UW-Eau Claire enters the game at 3-0-1 overall. The Blugolds picked up a pair of non-conference home wins this past weekend, beating Hamline 5-2 on Friday and Bethel 6-3 on Saturday.

Senior forward Ross Andersen leads the Blugolds in scoring with four goals and three assists for seven points. Sophomore forward

Brandon Wahlin has three goals and three assists for six points. Junior forward Ethan Nauman has four goals and one assist for five points, while sophomore forward Patrick Moore has one goal and four assists for five points.

Junior goaltender Tyler Green is 2-0 with a 1.00 goals against average and .966 save percentage. Sophomore Jay Deo is 1-0-1 with a 2.88 goals against average and .893 save percentage.

Eau Claire is 3-for-17 (17.6 percent) on the power play and is 13for-16 (81.2 percent) on the penalty kill this season.

#### WIAC Wisdom:

St. Norbert faces its first Wisconsin Intercollegiate Athletic Conference foe of the year when it faces UW-Eau Claire Tuesday. The Green Knights went 5-0-1 last season against the former Northern Collegiate Hockey Association members that belong to the Wisconsin Intercollegiate Athletic Conference. The 2013-14 season was the first year those five schools played hockey solely under the WIAC banner.

St. Norbert, which entered the NCHA in 1994-95, owns 14 NCHA regular-season championships and 12 NCHA post-season titles, both NCHA records. Since the 2002-03 season, the first year the Green Knights advanced to the NCAA Division III Frozen Four, St. Norbert is 132-22-17 against the WIAC schools. In program history, St. Norbert is 207-75-29 all-time against the WIAC.

Since 2002-03, St. Norbert is 30-3-2 against UW-Stevens Point, 32-4-2 against UW-Eau Claire, 26-5-1 against UW-River Falls, 22-5-3 against UW-Stout and 21-5-8 against UW-Superior.

#### Streak Stuff:

St. Norbert will carry an active 17game unbeaten streak into its game with UW-Eau Claire. Remarkably, it is only the fifth longest unbeaten streak in school history.

St. Norbert posted a school record

of 38 games without a loss from Nov. 10, 2007-Nov. 21, 2008. The Green Knights also had a 26-game streak from Nov. 4, 2004-March 5, 2005.

The Green Knights had a pair of 19-game unbeaten streaks from Dec. 6, 2002-March 15, 2003 and Nov. 13, 19990-Feb. 11, 2000.

#### **Poll Position:**

St. Norbert has been ranked in the USCHO.com Division III Poll for 231 consecutive polls. The Green Knights have been ranked in 269 of 275 polls conducted since its inception at the start of the 1998-99 season - the most of any school in Division III.

During the 231-week stretch of being ranked, St. Norbert has been No. 1 for 65 weeks - trailing Norwich's 71 for most all-time. St. Norbert was rated No. 1 in the 2003, 2004, 2005, 2007, 2008, 2011, 2012 and 2014 final polls. The Green Knights are 90-16-7 all-time when ranked No. 1 in the USCHO.com Poll.

St. Norbert is 113-44-16 against teams ranked in the USCHO.com Poll under Tim Coghlin. The Green Knights are 3-5 all-time against the No. 1-ranked team and are 5-5-1 all-time against the No. 2-ranked team.

The Green Knights were 9-2-1 against nationally ranked teams last season.

#### Home Sweet Cornerstone:

St. Norbert is 197-23-12 all-time at the Cornerstone Community Center, which includes a 9-4-1 mark there its first season in the building in 2000-01.

St. Norbert is 176-15-9 in its last 200 games at the Cornerstone Community Center.

The Green Knights had a 25-game home winning streak - the secondlongest in NCAA Division III history - snapped with a 2-2 tie to Gustavus Adolphus on Nov. 4, 2011. St. Norbert also owns the NCAA Division III record with a 36-game home winning streak set Oct. 25, 2002 to Oct. 29, 2004.

Under Tim Coghlin, St. Norbert is 275-45-18 at home, which includes games at Brown County Arena, Resch Center and De Pere Ice Arena.

### **Tough After Two:**

St. Norbert is 3-0-1 this season when leading after two periods.

Under Tim Coghlin, St. Norbert is an astounding 250-2-3 at home when up after two periods.

St. Norbert had a home unbeaten streak when leading after two periods of 200 games (197-0-3) before it was snapped by UW-Stout in a 4-3 overtime loss on Feb. 7, 2009 -Coghlin's only other home setback when leading after two.

At home, St. Norbert is 268-3-4 in school history when leading after two periods. The Green Knights' lone other loss when up after two periods on their own ice came on Nov. 18, 1989 in a 3-1 loss to Augsburg when St. Norbert lost a 1-0 lead.

#### **Gimme Five:**

St. Norbert is unbeaten in its last 270 games when scoring five goals or more with a 263-0-7 mark since a 7-5 loss to Bemidji State in De Pere on Jan. 12, 1996.

St. Norbert is 5-24-6 in its last 35 games when allowing five goals or more dating back to the 1996-97 season. The only five wins came in a 9-5 win over St. Scholastica on Feb. 20, 1999, a 7-5 win over UW-Stout on Nov. 30, 2001, an 8-5 win over UW-Stout on Jan. 14, 2005, a 7-5 win over UW-Stevens Point on Feb. 3, 2007 and a 7-5 win over Gustavus Adolphus on Oct. 31, 2008.

The Green Knights have allowed five goals just 21 times in their last 385 games.

St. Norbert has never allowed 10 goals in a game during Tim Coghlin's 635-game tenure.
