St. Norbert has a two-game weekend against East Region opposition for the first time since 2007-08 when it hosts Buffalo State in a series at the Cornerstone Community Center.

#### The Series:

St. Norbert leads Buffalo State 2-0 in a series begun with a 6-1 Green Knights' win on Oct. 29, 2005 at the Cornerstone Community Center in De Pere. St. Norbert won the return game 8-1 on Oct. 27, 2006 in Buffalo, N.Y. The Green Knights are scheduled to return two games at Buffalo State in 2015-16.

### The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Tim Coghlin (UW-Stevens Point, 1989) is 468-122-48 in his 22nd season in De Pere. The Green Knights are 323-52-31 in the last 14-plus seasons. Coghlin's 458 wins as a coach in the NCHA is the league record, 88 more than Bemidji State's Bob Peters' 370 wins. Coghlin's seven NCAA championship game appearances and four national championships are the second most in Division III history. Coghlin was the captain of UW-Stevens Point's first national championship team in 1989.

Buffalo State coach Nick Carriere (Niagara, 2001) is 98-118-26 in his tenth season in Buffalo.

### Last Meeting:

St. Norbert defeated Buffalo State 8-1 in a non-conference game on Oct. 27, 2006 at Buffalo State Sports Arena in Buffalo, N.Y.

The Green Knights outshot the Bengals 43-18 in a game marred by 27 penalties for 65 minutes. St. Norbert was 6-for-12 on the power play, while Buffalo State was 1-for-11.

Current St. Norbert assistant Ryan Petersen scored two goals, while Andrew Derton and Troy Boisjoli both had three assists. Kyle Jones made 17 saves for St. Norbert.

Paul Michael Rivest scored the long Buffalo State goal, while Sean Sheehan made 35 saves for the Bengals.

### About the Green Knights:

St. Norbert enters the series at 6-0-1 overall. The Green Knights have been idle since Nov. 18 when they topped UW-Eau Claire 3-2 on a

Cullen Bradshaw goal with 25 seconds remaining.

Senior forward Mason Baptista leads the Green Knights in scoring with one goal and eight assists for nine points, while senior forward Cullen Bradshaw has three goals and five assists for eight points. Sophomore forward Noah Nelson has three goals and four assists for seven points. Senior defenseman Marian Fiala has seven assists for seven points.

Senior goaltender David Jacobson is 5-0 with a 1.40 goals against average and .929 save percentage. Sophomore Tony Kujava is 1-0-1 with a 0.96 goals against average and .941 save percentage.

St. Norbert is 7-for-34 (20.6 percent) on the power play and is 23-for-25 (92.0 percent) on the penalty kill this season.

### About the Bengals:

Buffalo State enters the series 1-3-2 overall and holds the same record in the SUNYAC. The Bengals have been idle since a 5-2 road loss to Potsdam State on Nov. 15. Buffalo State had a Nov. 21 game against Fredonia State postponed due to the recent heavy lake-effect snow-storm.

Junior forward Brett Hope has two goals and five assists for seven points. Junior forward Ryan Salkeld has two goals and four assists for six points, while sophomore forward Taylor Pryce has six assists for six points. Junior forward Nick Melligan has three goals and two assists for five points, while sophomore forward Anthony Beaumont has a team-high four goals for four points.

DeLaVergne is 1-2-2 with a 3.88 goals against average and .891 save percentage. Freshman Ian Sylves is 0-1 with a 4.48 goals against average and .900 save percentage.

Buffalo State is 9-for-31 (29.0 percent) on the power play and is 19-for-26 (73.1 percent) on the penalty kill this season.

**Streak Stuff:**

St. Norbert will carry an active 18-game unbeaten streak (17-0-1) into its series with Buffalo State. Remarkably, it is only the fifth longest unbeaten streak in school history.

St. Norbert posted a school record of 38 games without a loss from Nov. 10, 2007-Nov. 21, 2008. The Green Knights also had a 26-game streak from Nov. 4, 2004-March 5, 2005.

The Green Knights had a pair of 19-game unbeaten streaks from Dec. 6, 2002-March 15, 2003 and Nov. 13, 1999-Feb. 11, 2000.

**Eastern Eavesdroppings:**

St. Norbert is 26-17-4 all-time against East Region opponents. The Green Knights played at least one game a season against an eastern foe for 18 years before not facing one in 2012-13 as well as 2013-14 until beating Geneseo State 6-2 on March 21, 2014 at the NCAA Division III Frozen Four.

St. Norbert is 18-8-3 all-time on East Region ice, which includes three neutral-site visits to the Frozen Four in 2008, 2010 and 2012 in Lake Placid, N.Y., and in 2014 to Lewiston, Maine.

The Green Knights are 11-3-1 all-time against the State University of New York Athletic Conference, including a 2-0 mark against Plattsburgh State, 1-0 against Geneseo State and a 2-2 ledger against Oswego State. St. Norbert is 4-1-1 all-time against Fredonia State and 2-0 against Buffalo State.

St. Norbert is 6-5-3 all-time against ECAC West opposition (including games against now-Division I RIT and Mercyhurst), and is 3-5 all-time against the

NESCAC.

The Green Knights are 2-0 all-time against the ECAC Northeast, also beating Fitchburg State in the 1994-95 season.

St. Norbert is 4-3 against the ECAC East, going 3-3 against Norwich and 1-0 against Southern Maine.

**Poll Position:**

St. Norbert has been ranked in the USCHO.com Division III Poll for 232 consecutive polls. The Green Knights have been ranked in 270 of 276 polls conducted since its inception at the start of the 1998-99 season - the most of any school in Division III.

During the 232-week stretch of being ranked, St. Norbert has been No. 1 for 66 weeks - trailing Norwich's 71 for most all-time. St. Norbert was rated No. 1 in the 2003, 2004, 2005, 2007, 2008, 2011, 2012 and 2014 final polls. The Green Knights are 91-16-7 all-time when ranked No. 1 in the USCHO.com Poll.

St. Norbert is 113-44-16 against teams ranked in the USCHO.com Poll under Tim Coghlin. The Green Knights are 3-5 all-time against the No. 1-ranked team and are 5-5-1 all-time against the No. 2-ranked team.

The Green Knights were 9-2-1 against nationally ranked teams last season.

**Home Sweet Cornerstone:**

St. Norbert is 198-23-12 all-time at the Cornerstone Community Center, which includes a 9-4-1 mark there its first season in the building in 2000-01.

St. Norbert is 177-15-9 in its last 201 games at the Cornerstone Community Center.

The Green Knights had a 25-game home winning streak - the second-longest in NCAA Division III history - snapped with a 2-2 tie to Gustavus Adolphus on Nov. 4, 2011. St. Norbert also owns the NCAA Division III record with a 36-game home winning streak set Oct. 25, 2002 to Oct. 29, 2004.

Green Knights are a sparkling 188-18-11 at the Cornerstone, with three losses and one tie coming to national champion UW-Superior during the 2001-02 season.

Under Tim Coghlin, St. Norbert is 276-45-18 at home, which includes games at Brown County Arena, Resch Center and De Pere Ice Arena.

### Tough After Two:

St. Norbert is 5-0-1 this season when leading after two periods.

Under Tim Coghlin, St. Norbert is an astounding 252-2-3 at home when up after two periods.

St. Norbert had a home unbeaten streak when leading after two periods of 200 games (197-0-3) before it was snapped by UW-Stout in a 4-3 overtime loss on Feb. 7, 2009 - Coghlin's only other home setback when leading after two.

At home, St. Norbert is 270-3-4 in school history when leading after two periods. The Green Knights' lone other loss when up after two periods on their own ice came on Nov. 18, 1989 in a 3-1 loss to Augsburg when St. Norbert lost a 1-0 lead.

### Gimme Five:

St. Norbert is unbeaten in its last 270 games when scoring five goals or more with a 263-0-7 mark since a 7-5 loss to Bemidji State in De Pere on Jan. 12, 1996.

St. Norbert is 5-24-6 in its last 35 games when allowing five goals or more dating back to the 1996-97 season. The only five wins came in a 9-5 win over St. Scholastica on Feb. 20, 1999, a 7-5 win over UW-Stout on Nov. 30, 2001, an 8-5 win over UW-Stout on Jan. 14, 2005, a 7-5 win over UW-Stevens Point on Feb. 3, 2007 and a 7-5 win over Gustavus Adolphus on Oct. 31, 2008.

The Green Knights have allowed five goals just 21 times in their last 386 games.

St. Norbert has never allowed 10 goals in a game during Tim Coghlin's 636-game tenure.
