Series Overview:

St. Norbert has already neared the semester break entering a two-game Northern Collegiate Hockey Association series against Lawrence. The Green Knights and Vikings tangle in a home-and-home series, with St. Norbert hosting Friday before traveling to Appleton to end the first half of the season on Saturday.

The Series:

The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Tim Coghlin (UW-Stevens Point, 1989) is 470-122-48 in his 22nd season in De Pere. The Green Knights are 325-52-31 in the last 14-plus seasons. Coghlin's 460 wins as a coach in the NCHA is the league record, 90 more than Bemidji State's Bob Peters' 370 wins. Coghlin's seven NCAA championship game appearances and four national championships are the second most in Division III history. Coghlin was the captain of UW-Stevens Point's first national championship team in 1989.

Lawrence coach Mike Szkodzinski (St. Norbert, 2000) is 95-118-19 in his ninth season in Appleton.

Last Season:

St. Norbert and Lawrence split its two games played during the regular season. The Green Knights won 4-0 in Appleton on Dec. 6, 2013, while the Vikings shocked St. Norbert 5-4 the next night at the Cornerstone Community Center. St. Norbert then swept Lawrence 5-0 and 3-1 in a NCHA Harris Cup Playoffs Quarterfinal Series on Feb. 21-22, 2014.

David Jacobson made 15 saves to post the shutout in St. Norbert's win. Brandon Hoogenboom, Marian Fiala, Cullen Bradshaw and Pijus Rulevicius scored goals for the Green Knights. Anton Olsson made 38 saves for the Vikings.

Lawrence scored four goals in the third period the next night to gain the series split and its first-ever win over St. Norbert. Matt Moore's goal

with 1:28 left tied the game, while Blake Roubos hit the game-winner with 22 seconds remaining. Erik Cooper scored two goals for St. Norbert. Olsson made 25 saves for Lawrence, while Tony Kujava made 14 stops for the Green Knights.

Hoogenboom scored two goals in the playoff series opener, while Joe Perry, Ross Pavsek and Michael Hill added goals. Jacobson made 12 saves, while Mattias Soderqvist made 41 stops.

Hill, Fiala and Sam Higgins then scored goals for St. Norbert in the second game of the playoff series. Jacobson had 14 saves, and Soderqvist had 34.

About the Green Knights:

St. Norbert enters the series at 8-0-1 overall and 5-0-1 in the Northern Collegiate Hockey Association. The Green Knights, ranked No. 1 in the USCHO.com and D3hockey.com polls, swept Buffalo State 7-0 and 8-0 at home this past weekend.

Senior forward Mason Baptista leads the Green Knights in scoring with four goals and 11 assists for 15 points. Senior forward Cullen Bradshaw has five goals and nine assists for 14 points. Junior forward Michael Hill has six goals and four assists for 10 points, while senior defenseman Marian Fiala has one goal and eight assists for nine points.

Senior goaltender David Jacobson is 6-0 with a 1.17 goals against average and .939 save percentage. Sophomore Tony Kujava is 2-0-1 with a 0.65 goals against average and .957 save percentage.

St. Norbert is 14-for-45 (31.1 percent) on the power play and is 32-for-34 (94.1 percent) on the penalty kill this season.

About the Vikings:

Lawrence enters the series 5-4-1 overall and 4-2 in the Northern Collegiate Hockey Association. The Vikings are coming off a win and a tie in the MIAC/NCHA Thanksgiving Showcase at Gustavus Adolphus. Lawrence tied Gustavus Adolphus 3-3 on Saturday before topping St. Olaf 4-3 on Sunday.

Junior forward Renato Engler and freshman defenseman Jake Kreutzer both have three goals and six assists for nine points. Sophomore forward Blake Roubos has four goals and four assists for eight points, while freshman defenseman Brendan Vetter has four goals and three assists for seven points.

Sophomore goaltender Mattias Soderqvist is 5-3-1 with a 2.76 goals against average and .924 save percentage. Senior Anton Olsson is 0-1 with a 2.05 goals against average and .926 save percentage.

Lawrence is 7-for-45 (15.6 percent) on the power play and is 36-for-44 (81.8 percent) on the penalty kill this season.

Home Sweet Cornerstone:

St. Norbert is 200-23-12 all-time at the Cornerstone Community Center, which includes a 9-4-1 mark there its first season in the building in 2000-01.

St. Norbert is 179-15-9 in its last 203 games at the Cornerstone Community Center.

The Green Knights had a 25-game home winning streak - the second-longest in NCAA Division III history - snapped with a 2-2 tie to Gustavus Adolphus on Nov. 4, 2011. St. Norbert also owns the NCAA Division III record with a 36-game home winning streak set Oct. 25, 2002 to Oct. 29, 2004.

In the last 13-plus seasons, the Green Knights are a sparkling 190-

18-11 at the Cornerstone, with three losses and one tie coming to national champion UW-Superior during the 2001-02 season.

Under Tim Coghlin, St. Norbert is 278-45-18 at home, which includes games at Brown County Arena, Resch Center and De Pere Ice Arena.

Streak Stuff:

St. Norbert will carry an active 20-game unbeaten streak (19-0-1) into its series with Lawrence. The current unbeaten streak, which began with a 3-0 win at St. Scholastica on Feb. 7, 2014, is the third-longest skein in school history.

St. Norbert posted a school record of 38 games without a loss from Nov. 10, 2007-Nov. 21, 2008. The Green Knights also had a 26-game streak from Nov. 4, 2004-March 5, 2005.

The Green Knights also had a pair of 19-game unbeaten streaks from Dec. 6, 2002-March 15, 2003 and Nov. 13, 1999-Feb. 11, 2000.

Poll Position:

St. Norbert has been ranked in the USCHO.com Division III Poll for 233 consecutive polls. The Green Knights have been ranked in 271 of 277 polls conducted since its inception at the start of the 1998-99 season - the most of any school in Division III.

During the 233-week stretch of being ranked, St. Norbert has been No. 1 for 67 weeks - trailing Norwich's 71 for most all-time. St. Norbert was rated No. 1 in the 2003, 2004, 2005, 2007, 2008, 2011, 2012 and 2014 final polls. The Green Knights are 93-16-7 all-time when ranked No. 1 in the USCHO.com Poll.

St. Norbert is 113-44-16 against teams ranked in the USCHO.com Poll under Tim Coghlin. The Green Knights are 3-5 all-time against the No. 1-ranked team and are 5-5-1 all-time against the No. 2-ranked team.

The Green Knights were 9-2-1 against nationally ranked teams last season.

Tough After Two:

St. Norbert is 7-0-1 this season when leading after two periods.

Under Tim Coghlin, St. Norbert is an astounding 254-2-3 at home when up after two periods.

St. Norbert had a home unbeaten streak when leading after two periods of 200 games (197-0-3) before it was snapped by UW-Stout in a 4-3 overtime loss on Feb. 7, 2009 - Coghlin's only other home setback when leading after two.

At home, St. Norbert is 272-3-4 in school history when leading after two periods. The Green Knights' lone other loss when up after two periods on their own ice came on Nov. 18, 1989 in a 3-1 loss to Augsburg when St. Norbert lost a 1-0 lead.

Gimme Five:

St. Norbert is unbeaten in its last 272 games when scoring five goals or more with a 265-0-7 mark since a 7-5 loss to Bemidji State in De Pere on Jan. 12, 1996.

St. Norbert is 5-24-6 in its last 35 games when allowing five goals or more dating back to the 1996-97 season. The only five wins came in a 9-5 win over St. Scholastica on Feb. 20, 1999, a 7-5 win over UW-Stout on Nov. 30, 2001, an 8-5 win over UW-Stout on Jan. 14, 2005, a 7-5 win over UW-Stevens Point on Feb. 3, 2007 and a 7-5 win over Gustavus Adolphus on Oct. 31, 2008.

The Green Knights have allowed five goals just 21 times in their last 388 games.

St. Norbert has never allowed 10 goals in a game during Tim Coghlin's 638-game tenure.

* - St. Norbert is second in Division III in both scoring offense and scoring defense. The Green Knights are averaging 5.67 goals per game and allowing 1.00 goals per game.
