St. Norbert College Green Knights Hockey Preview

No. 1 St. Norbert College (10-0-1) vs. No. 8 UW-Stevens Point (9-2)

Saturday, January 3, 2015 - 7 p.m.

Game Overview:

It's a rematch of the 2014 NCAA Division III national championship game as St. Norbert hosts UW-Stevens Point at the Cornerstone Community Center. The Green Knights claimed a 3-1 win over the Pointers last March in Lewiston, Maine, to earn their fourth national title in seven years.

The Series:

Fierce rivals for the last two decades, St. Norbert leads the series with UW-Stevens Point by a 45-19-6 margin. St. Norbert is 45-11-3 in the last 59 games against the Pointers after opening the series 0-8-3. St. Norbert is also 27-3-2 in the last 32 games in the series.

The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Tim Coghlin (UW-Stevens Point, 1989) is 472-122-48 in his 22nd season in De Pere. The Green Knights are 327-52-31 in the last 14-plus seasons. Coghlin's 462 wins as a coach in the NCHA is the league record, 92 more than Bemidji State's Bob Peters' 370 wins. Coghlin's seven NCAA championship game appearances and four national championships are the second most in Division III history. Coghlin was the captain of UW-Stevens Point's first national championship team in 1989.

UW-Stevens Point coach Chris Brooks (Western Michigan, 1996) is 60-30-7 in his fourth season in Stevens Point.

Last Season:

The teams met twice in 2013-14, with St. Norbert holding a 1-0-1 series edge.

St. Norbert and UW-Stevens Point skated to a 2-2 tie on Jan. 11, 2014 at Willett Arena in Stevens Point. Blake Thompson's score for St. Norbert with 2:48 remaining in regulation was the game-tying goal. David Jacobson made 25 saves for the Green Knights, while Brandon Jaeger made 31 stops for Stevens Point.

The two teams met again on March 22, this time for all the marbles as St. Norbert claimed a 3-1 over the Pointers in the NCAA Division III Tournament championship at Androscoggin Bank Colisee in Lewiston, Maine. Joe Perry and Erik Cooper scored 11 seconds apart in the first period for

a 2-0 St. Norbert lead. Garrett Ladd scored early in the third period, but Marian Fiala scored at 5:47 of the frame to seal the win. Jacobson made 23 saves for St. Norbert, while Jaeger had 26 stops for the Pointers.

About the Green Knights:

Unbeaten in its last 22 games, St. Norbert enters the game at 10-0-1 overall. The Green Knights, ranked No. 1 in the USCHO.com and D3hockey.com polls, swept Lawrence 3-1 and 9-0 in a home-and-home series on Dec. 5-6.

Senior forward Mason Baptista leads the Green Knights in scoring with four goals and 12 assists for 16 points. Senior forward Cullen Bradshaw has five goals and 10 assists for 15 points. Junior forward Michael Hill has a team-high 10 goals with four assists for 14 points. Senior defenseman Marian Fiala has two goals and 11 assists for 13 points, while junior forward Erik Cooper has nine goals and three assists for 12 points.

Senior goaltender David Jacobson is 8-0 with a 1.00 goals against average and .946 save percentage. Sophomore Tony Kujava is 2-0-1 with a 0.65 goals against average and .957 save percentage.

St. Norbert is 18-for-59 (30.5 percent) on the power play and is 41-for-43 (95.3 percent) on the penalty kill this season.

About the Pointers:

UW-Stevens Point, ranked No. 8 in the USCHO.com Division III Poll, enters the game 9-2 overall. The Pointers have won their last three games, including a 2-1 triumph on

Senior defenseman Kevin Gibson is leading the Pointers in scoring with three goals and nine assists for 12 points. Junior forward Joe Kalisz has seven goals and four assists for 11 points, while senior forward Garrett Ladd has three goals and eight assists for 11 points. Junior defenseman Alex Brooks has three goals and seven assists for 10 points, and sophomore forward Kyle Sharkey has six goals and four assists for 10 points.

Senior goaltender Brandon Jaeger has played exclusively in net for the Pointers this season. Jaeger is 9-2 with a 2.01 goals against average and .915 save percentage.

Stevens Point is 8-for-42 (19.0 percent) on the power play and is 32-for-43 (74.4 percent) on the penalty kill this season.

WIAC Wisdom:

St. Norbert faces its second Wisconsin Intercollegiate Athletic Conference foe of the year when it hosts UW-Stevens Point Saturday.

St. Norbert, which entered the NCHA in 1994-95, owns 14 NCHA regular-season championships and 12 NCHA post-season titles, both NCHA records. Since the 2002-03 season, the first year the Green Knights advanced to the NCAA Division III Frozen Four, St. Norbert is 133-22-17 against the WIAC schools. In program history, St. Norbert is 208-75-29 all-time against the WIAC.

Since 2002-03, St. Norbert is 30-3-2 against UW-Stevens Point, 33-4-2 against UW-Eau Claire, 26-5-1 against UW-River Falls, 22-5-3 against UW-Stout and 21-5-8 against UW-Superior.

Home Sweet Cornerstone:

St. Norbert is 201-23-12 all-time at the Cornerstone Community Center, which includes a 9-4-1 mark there its first season in the building in 2000-01.

St. Norbert is 180-15-9 in its last 204 games at the Cornerstone Community Center.

The Green Knights had a 25-game home winning streak - the second-longest in NCAA Division III history - snapped with a 2-2 tie to Gustavus Adolphus on Nov. 4, 2011. St. Norbert also owns the NCAA Division III record with a 36-game home winning streak set Oct. 25, 2002 to Oct. 29, 2004.

In the last 13-plus seasons, the Green Knights are a sparkling 191-18-11 at the Cornerstone, with three losses and one tie coming to national champion UW-Superior during the 2001-02 season.

Under Tim Coghlin, St. Norbert is 279-45-18 at home, which includes games at Brown County Arena, Resch Center and De Pere Ice Arena.

Streak Stuff:

St. Norbert will carry an active 22-game unbeaten streak (21-0-1) into its game with Uw-Stevens Point. The current unbeaten streak, which began with a 3-0 win at St. Scholastica on Feb. 7, 2014, is the third-longest skein in school history.

St. Norbert posted a school record of 38 games without a loss from Nov. 10, 2007-Nov. 21, 2008. The Green Knights also had a 26-game streak from Nov. 4, 2004-March 5, 2005.

Poll Position:

St. Norbert has been ranked in the USCHO.com Division III Poll for 235 consecutive polls. The Green Knights have been ranked in 273 of 279 polls conducted since its inception at the start of the 1998-99 season - the most of any school in Division III.

During the 235-week stretch of being ranked, St. Norbert has been No. 1 for 69 weeks - trailing Norwich's 71 for most all-time. St. Norbert was rated No. 1 in the 2003, 2004, 2005, 2007, 2008, 2011, 2012 and 2014 final polls. The Green Knights are 95-16-7 all-time when ranked No. 1 in the USCHO.com Poll.

The Green Knights are 1-0 against nationally ranked teams this season. St. Norbert claimed a 3-2 win over No. 9 UW-Eau Claire on Nov. 18.

Tough After Two:

St. Norbert is 9-0-1 this season when leading after two periods.

Under Tim Coghlin, St. Norbert is an astounding 255-2-3 at home when up after two periods.

St. Norbert had a home unbeaten streak when leading after two periods of 200 games (197-0-3) before it was snapped by UW-Stout in a 4-3 overtime loss on Feb. 7, 2009 - Coghlin's only other home setback when leading after two.

At home, St. Norbert is 273-3-4 in school history when leading after two periods. The Green Knights' lone other loss when up after two periods on their own ice came on Nov. 18, 1989 in a 3-1 loss to Augsburg when St. Norbert lost a 1-0 lead.

Gimme Five:

St. Norbert is unbeaten in its last 273 games when scoring five goals or more with a 265-0-7 mark since a 7-5 loss to Bemidji State in De Pere on Jan. 12, 1996.

St. Norbert is 5-24-6 in its last 35 games when allowing five goals or more dating back to the 1996-97 season. The only five wins came in a 9-5 win over St. Scholastica on Feb. 20, 1999, a 7-5 win over UW-Stout on Nov. 30, 2001, an 8-5 win over UW-Stout on Jan. 14, 2005, a 7-5 win over UW-Stevens Point on Feb. 3, 2007 and a 7-5 win over Gustavus Adolphus on Oct. 31, 2008.

The Green Knights have allowed five goals just 21 times in their last 390 games.

St. Norbert has never allowed 10 goals in a game during Tim Coghlin's 638-game tenure.
