St. Norbert leads St. John's 13-7 in a series dating back to 1988-89, with St. Norbert winning 11 of the last 12 games. The Johnnies' lone win in the last 23 years was on Nov. 24, 2000 at the National Hockey Center.

Forest 7, Suffolk 7, Hobart 5, Geneseo State 2, Neumann 2, St. Thomas 1. 91. The two teams have met only six times in the last 22 years, with St. Norbert winning all six of those meetings.

The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Tim Coghlin (UW-Stevens Point, 1989) is 472-123-48 in his 22nd season in De Pere. The Green Knights are 327-53-31 in the last 14-plus seasons. Coghlin's 462 wins as a coach in the NCHA is the league record, 92 more than Bemidji State's Bob Peters' 370 wins. Coghlin's seven championship NCAA game appearances and four national championships are the second most in Division III history. Coghlin was the captain of UW-Stevens Point's first national championship team in 1989.

St. John's coach Doug Scheuller (Bowling Green, 2001) is 74-77-16 in his seventh season in Collegeville.

Concordia coach Chris Howe (St. John's, 1999) is 62-81-24 in his seventh season in Moorhead.

Last Meetings:

St. Norbert defeated St. John's 6-0 on Jan. 7, 2011 at Cornerstone Community Center. The Green Knights scored five third-period goals to put the game away. Alain Joanette scored two goals for St. Norbert. Mike Martin made 14 saves to earn the shutout for the Green Knights, while J.D. Wells made 33 stops for the Johnnies.

St. Norbert topped Concordia 5-1 on Jan. 8, 2011 at Cornerstone Community Center. Cody Keefer scored two goals and Johan Ryd scored shorthanded for the Green Knights. B.J. O'Brien made 20 saves for St. Norbert, while Kelly Andrew made 36 stops for the Cobbers.

About the Green Knights:

St. Norbert enters the road trip at 10-1-1 overall. The Green Knights, ranked No. 2 in the USCHO.com Division III Poll, are coming off a 6-5 home loss to UW-Stevens Point this past Saturday in De Pere.

Junior forward Michael Hill has a team-high 12 goals with five assists for 17 points. Senior forward Mason Baptista has four goals and 13 assists for 17 points, while senior forward Cullen Bradshaw has five goals and 10 assists for 15 points. Senior defenseman Marian Fiala has two goals and 12 assists for 14 points, and junior forward Erik Cooper has nine goals and three assists for 12 points.

Senior goaltender David Jacobson is 8-0 with a 1.38 goals against average and .926 save percentage. Sophomore Tony Kujava is 2-1-1 with a 1.18 goals against average and .926 save percentage.

St. Norbert is 19-for-63 (30.2 percent) on the power play and is 45for-47 (95.7 percent) on the penalty kill this season.

About the Johnnies:

St. John's, ranked No. 15 in the USCHO.com Division III Poll, enters the game 6-3-3 overall. The Johnnies, who are in first place in the MIAC at 4-1-1, have been idle since a 4-0 loss at UW-River Falls on Dec. 9.

Junior forward Neal Smith has a team-high six goals with three assists for nine points. Freshman

forward Tyler Dunagan has five goals and four assists for nine points. Freshman forward Huba Sekesi has five goals and three assists for eight points, while senior forward John Haeg has two goals and six assists for eight points.

Junior goaltender Saxton Soley is 5-2-3 with a 2.05 goals against average and .930 save percentage. Junior Jason Dzurik is 1-1 with a 3.00 goals against average and .872 save percentage.

St. John's is 5-for-43 (11.6 percent) on the power play and is 39-for-48 (81.2 percent) on the penalty kill this season.

About the Cobbers:

Concordia enters Friday's game with a 6-4-3 overall record. The Cobbers have been idle since Dec. 13, when they topped Northland 4-2. Concordia also owns the championship of the Primelink Great Northern Shootout, tying Norwich 2-2 on Nov. 29 and then winning the tournament in a shootout 2-1.

Junior forward Jordie Bancroft leads the Cobbers in scoring with nine goals and six assists for 15 points. Sophomore forward Garrett Hendrickson has four goals and 11 assists for 15 points, while senior forward Andrew Deters has seven goals and seven assists for 14 points. Freshman forward Jon Grebosky has six goals and two assists for eight points, while sophomore forward Jeremy Johnson has three goals and five assists for eight points.

Sophomore goaltender Jordyn Kaufer is 2-2-2 with a 2.35 goals against average and .904 save percentage. Freshman Alex Reichle is 4-2-1 with a 2.33 goals against average and .918 save percentage.

Concordia is 6-for-47 (12.8 percent) on the power play and is 35for-46 (76.1 percent) on the penalty kill this season.

MIAC Minutiae:

St. Norbert has a solid 82-11-6 record against Minnesota Intercollegiate Athletic Conference competition since Tim Coghlin took over the Green Knights' helm in 1993. Two of the losses came in a sweep at St. Mary's in Coghlin's first year of 1993-94.

Since then, the Green Knights are 82-9-6 against the MIAC. St. Norbert has won six of its last seven games against the MIAC, with the only loss coming in a 2-1 setback at Gustavus Adolphus on Nov. 2, 2012.

At home under Coghlin, St. Norbert is a remarkable 47-2-3 against MIAC foes. The losses came in a 3-2 defeat to St. Thomas in the 2005 NCAA Division III Tournament and to Gustavus Adolphus 4-2 on Nov. 3, 2007.

Poll Position:

St. Norbert has been ranked in the USCHO.com Division III Poll for 236 consecutive polls. The Green Knights have been ranked in 274 of 280 polls conducted since its inception at the start of the 1998-99 season - the most of any school in Division III.

During the 236-week stretch of being ranked, St. Norbert has been No. 1 for 69 weeks - trailing Norwich's 72 for most all-time. St. Norbert was rated No. 1 in the 2003, 2004, 2005, 2007, 2008, 2011, 2012 and 2014 final polls. The Green Knights are 95-17-7 all-time when ranked No. 1 in the USCHO.com Poll.

St. Norbert is 113-45-16 against teams ranked in the USCHO.com Poll under Tim Coghlin. The Green Knights are 3-5 all-time against the No. 1-ranked team and are 5-5-1 all-time against the No. 2-ranked team.

The Green Knights are 1-1 against nationally ranked teams this season. St. Norbert claimed a 3-2 win over No. 9 UW-Eau Claire on Nov. 18, and lost 6-5 to No. 8 UW-Stevens Point on Jan. 3.

Tough After Two:

St. Norbert is 9-0-1 this season when leading after two periods.

St. Norbert had a home unbeaten streak when leading after two periods of 200 games (197-0-3) before it was snapped by UW-Stout in a 4-3 overtime loss on Feb. 7, 2009 -Coghlin's only other home setback when leading after two.

At home, St. Norbert is 273-3-4 in school history when leading after two periods. The Green Knights' lone other loss when up after two periods on their own ice came on Nov. 18, 1989 in a 3-1 loss to Augsburg when St. Norbert lost a 1-0 lead.

Gimme Five:

St. Norbert saw a 273-game unbeaten streak when scoring at least five goals spanning nearly 19 years end in a 6-5 loss to UW-Stevens Point on Jan. 3. The Green Knights were 266-0-7 when scoring five goals since a 7-5 loss to Bemidji State in De Pere on Jan. 12, 1996.

St. Norbert is 5-25-6 in its last 36 games when allowing five goals or more dating back to the 1996-97 season. The only five wins came in a 9-5 win over St. Scholastica on Feb. 20, 1999, a 7-5 win over UW-Stout on Nov. 30, 2001, an 8-5 win over UW-Stout on Jan. 14, 2005, a 7-5 win over UW-Stevens Point on Feb. 3, 2007 and a 7-5 win over Gustavus Adolphus on Oct. 31, 2008.

The Green Knights have allowed five goals just 22 times in their last 391 games.

St. Norbert has never allowed 10 goals in a game during Tim Coghlin's 639-game tenure.
