openers, having won its last 15 season lidlifters (over UW-Eau Claire in 2000 and three straight over Marian from 2001 to 2003, RIT and 2004, Marian in 2005-06, Lawrence in 2007-08, Lake Forest in 2009, UW-Stout in 2010, Concordia-Wis. in 2011-2012 and Marian in 2013-2014).

The Green Knights are 17-5 all-time in season openers under Tim Coghlin.

Coghlin Count:

St. Norbert head coach Tim Coghlin brings a record of 482-128-49 in his 23rd season into this weekend. Coghlin is currently tied for 25th all-time in wins for NCAA men's ice hockey coaches.

Coghlin is tied with Joe Marsh for 25th on the all-time list. Marsh compiled a 482-417-76 mark in 27 seasons at St. Lawrence from 1986 to 2012.

Current Fitchburg State coach Dean Fuller is 24th with a career mark of 495-284-49 in 31 seasons. Current Mercyhurst coach Rick Gotkin is 23rd on the list with a 498-355-76 mark in 28 seasons.

Poll Position:

St. Norbert has been ranked in the USCHO.com Division III Poll for 246 consecutive polls. The Green Knights have been ranked in 284 of 290 polls conducted since its inception at the start of the 1998-99 season - the most of any school in Division III.

During the 246-week stretch of being ranked, St. Norbert has been No. 1 for 71 weeks - trailing Norwich's 77 for most all-time. St. Norbert was rated No. 1 in the 2003, 2004, 2005, 2007, 2008, 2011, 2012 and 2014 final polls. The Green Knights are 98-18-7 all-time when ranked No. 1 in the USCHO.com Poll.

St. Norbert is 114-48-17 against teams ranked in the USCHO.com Poll under Tim Coghlin. The Green Knights are 3-5 all-time against the No. 1-ranked team and are 5-5-1 all-time against the No. 2-ranked team.

Home Sweet Cornerstone:

St. Norbert is 206-26-12 all-time at the Cornerstone Community Center, which includes a 9-4-1 mark there its first season in the building in 2000-01.

St. Norbert is 185-18-9 in its last 212 games at the Cornerstone Community Center.

The Green Knights had a 25-game home winning streak - the second-longest in NCAA Division III history - snapped with a 2-2 tie to Gustavus Adolphus on Nov. 4, 2011. St. Norbert also owns the NCAA Division III record with a 36-game home winning streak set Oct. 25, 2002 to Oct. 29, 2004.

In the last 14 seasons, the Green Knights are a sparkling 196-21-11 at the Cornerstone, with three losses and one tie coming to national champion UW-Superior during the 2001-02 season.

Under Tim Coghlin, St. Norbert is 284-48-18 at home, which includes games at Brown County Arena, Resch Center and De Pere Ice Arena.

Only two road teams have won at least two games at the Cornerstone in the same season. Superior won three times in 2001-02 and UW-Eau Claire won twice in 2012-13. Both of those teams won the NCAA Division III national championship.

Tough After Two:

St. Norbert was 17-0-1 this season when leading after two periods. The Green Knights were 3-0-1 when tied after two periods but were 0-6 when trailing after 40 minutes.

Under Tim Coghlin, St. Norbert is an astounding 260-2-3 at home when up after two periods.

St. Norbert had a home unbeaten streak when leading after two periods of 200 games (197-0-3) before it was snapped by UW-Stout in a 4-3 overtime loss on Feb. 7, 2009. The Green Knights also lost 5-4 to Lawrence on Dec. 7, 2013 when leading after two periods.

At home, St. Norbert is 278-3-4 in school history when leading after

two periods. The Green Knights' lone other loss when up after two periods on their own ice came on Nov. 18, 1989 in a 3-1 loss to Augsburg when St. Norbert lost a 1-0 lead.

Gimme Five:

St. Norbert saw a 273-game unbeaten streak when scoring at least five goals spanning nearly 19 years end in a 6-5 loss to UW-Stevens Point on Jan. 3. The Green Knights were 266-0-7 when scoring five goals since a 7-5 loss to Bemidji State in De Pere on Jan. 12, 1996.

St. Norbert is 5-26-6 in its last 37 games when allowing five goals or more dating back to the 1996-97 season. The only five wins came in a 9-5 win over St. Scholastica on Feb. 20, 1999, a 7-5 win over UW-Stout on Nov. 30, 2001, an 8-5 win over UW-Stout on Jan. 14, 2005, a 7-5 win over UW-Stevens Point on Feb. 3, 2007 and a 7-5 win over Gustavus Adolphus on Oct. 31, 2008.

The Green Knights have allowed five goals just 23 times in their last 405 games.

St. Norbert has never allowed 10 goals in a game during Tim Coghlin's 659-game tenure.

Ice Chips:

* - St. Norbert was picked to finish second in the regular season in the NCHA pre-season coaches' poll. The Green Knights were pegged to place behind Adrian for the Peters Cup title.

* - Only two of St. Norbert's first 11 games this season will be played at the friendly confines of Cornerstone Community Center. St. Norbert has an eight-game road trip scheduled from Nov. 7 through Dec. 4. That is the longest continuous time spent away from home for the Green Knights since Tim Coghlin's first 11 games as head coach in 1993-94. St. Norbert's last road trip of at least seven games came on Nov. 21, 2003 to Jan. 9, 2004.
