St. Norbert and Adrian engage in a No. 1 vs. No. 2 matchup this weekend in a two-game Northern Collegiate Hockey Association series. The Green Knights trail the Bulldogs by three points in the league standings with two games in hand.

The Series:

St. Norbert and Adrian are tied 4-4 in an all-time series that began during the 2009-10 season. The Bulldogs have won four of the last five meetings in the series.

The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Tim Coghlin (UW-Stevens Point, 1989) is 495-129-50 in his 23rd season in De Pere. The Green Knights are 350-59-33 in the last 15-

State 13, Neumann 10, Univ. of New England 7, Augsburg 5, UW-Stout 5, Marian 3, Salve Regina 2, New England College 1. plus seasons. Coghlin's 485 wins as a coach in the NCHA is the league record, 115 more than Bemidji State's Bob Peters' 370 wins. Coghlin's seven NCAA championship game appearances and four national championships are the second most in Division III history. Coghlin was the captain of UW-Stevens Point's first national championship team in 1989.

Adrian coach Adam Krug (Adrian, 2012) is 38-5-4 in his second season in Adrian.

Last Season:

Adrian swept St. Norbert 3-0 in the season series, with all three games coming at Arrington Ice Arena in Adrian, Mich.

The Bulldogs won 4-2 on Jan. 30, 2015 behind two goals from Kyle Brothers. Ross Pavek and Pijus Rulevicius scored for St. Norbert. David Jacobson made 22 saves for the Green Knights, while Scott Shackell had 35 for the Bulldogs.

Adrian then won 6-4 the next day. Kevin Balas had two goals for the Bulldogs, while Cullen Bradshaw had a goal and an assist for St. Norbert. Shackell made 27 saves for Adrian, while Tony Kujava made 31 saves for St. Norbert.

The two teams met again for the NCHA Harris Cup Championship on March 7 with Adrian claiming a 4-2 win. Chris Leone's empty-net goal sealed the win. Rulevicius and Marian Fiala scored for St. Norbert. Kujava made 24 saves for the Green Knights and Shackell made 22 stops for Adrian

About the Green Knights:

St. Norbert enters the series with Adrian at 13-1-1 overall and 9-1 in

the Northern Collegiate Hockey Association. The Green Knights, unbeaten in their last 13 games at 12-0-1, swept Finlandia 7-1 and 8-0 this past weekend at the Cornerstone Community Center.

Senior forward Erik Cooper leads the Green Knights in scoring with five goals and 11 assists for 16 points. Junior forward Pijus Rulevicius had a five-point weekend against Finlandia to move to a team-high nine goals with six assists for 15 points. Junior forward Noah Nelson has six goals and seven assists for 13 points, while senior forward Michael Hill has eight goals and three assists for 11 points.

Junior goaltender Tony Kujava is 10-0 with a 1.07 goals against average and .944 save percentage. Freshman T.J. Black is 3-1-1 with a 1.68 goals against average and .911 save percentage.

St. Norbert is 15-for-78 (19.2 percent) on the power play and is 59for-67 (88.1 percent) on the penalty kill this season.

About the Bulldogs:

Adrian enters the series 14-1-1 overall and 10-1-1 in the Northern Collegiate Hockey Association. The Bulldogs lost their season opener to MSOE by a 5-1 score but are 14-0-1 since. Adrian swept Lake Forest 5-1 and 8-3 at home this past weekend.

Sophomore forward Mathew Thompson leads the Bulldogs in scoring with 14 goals and 14 assists for 28 points. Freshman forward Connor Armour has three goals and 19 assists for 22 points, while sophomore forward Kyle Brothers has eight goals and 13 assists for 21 points. Junior forward Jeremy

Olinyk has eight goals and 12 assists for 20 points.

Freshman goaltender Kevin Entmaa has a 9-0 record with a 1.64 goals against average and .941 save percentage. Junior Tyler Parks is 4-1-1 with a 1.65 goals against average and .930 save percentage.

Adrian is 20-for-76 (26.3 percent) on the power play and is 59-for-67 (88.1 percent) on the penalty kill this season.

Kujava Komments:

St. Norbert junior goaltender Tony Kujava has enjoyed a strong start to the 2015-16 season, opening the campaign 10-0.

Kujava is sporting a 1.07 goals against average in 11 games, which currently leads Division III. He has allowed 11 goals in just shy of 618 minutes.

Kujava's save percentage of .944 is currently seventh in Division III.

Coghlin Count:

St. Norbert head coach Tim Coghlin brings a record of 495-129-50 in his 23rd season into this weekend. Coghlin is currently 25th alltime in wins for NCAA men's ice hockey coaches.

Coghlin moved past Joe Marsh for 25th on the all-time list with a 4-1 win over Marian on Oct. 30. Marsh compiled a 482-417-76 mark in 27 seasons at St. Lawrence from 1986 to 2012.

Current Fitchburg State coach Dean Fuller is 23rd with a career mark of 502-291-50 in 31 seasons. Longtime Boston College coach is John "Snooks" Kelley is 24th alltime in wins. He was 501-249-15 in 36 seasons (1933-42, 1947-72)

Steady Study:

St. Norbert coach Tim Coghlin has directed the Green Knights to 19 consecutive seasons with at least 18 wins, dating back to the 1996-97 season. That streak is the longest such mark in NCAA Division III hockey history.

Only five coaches in Division III hockey history have posted at least 11 consecutive seasons with at least 18 wins.

Plattsburgh State's Bob Emery had 17 consecutive seasons reaching the 18-win plateau from 1990 to 2006. Middlebury's Bill Beaney had 15 consecutive seasons with at least 18 wins from 1995 to 2010. Oswego State coach Ed Gosek currently has a 12-season streak with at least 18 wins going from 2004 to the present. St. Thomas' Terry Skrypek had 11 consecutive seasons at the 18-win mark from 1988 to 1998.

Poll Position:

St. Norbert has been ranked in the USCHO.com Division III Poll for 257 consecutive polls. The Green Knights have been ranked in 295 of 301 polls conducted since its inception at the start of the 1998-99 season - the most of any school in Division III.

During the 257-week stretch of being ranked, St. Norbert has been No. 1 for 76 weeks - trailing Norwich's 77 for most all-time. St. Norbert was rated No. 1 in the 2003, 2004, 2005, 2007, 2008, 2011, 2012 and 2014 final polls. The Green Knights are 101-18-7 all-time when ranked No. 1 in the USCHO.com Poll.

St. Norbert is 115-48-17 against teams ranked in the USCHO.com Poll under Tim Coghlin. The Green Knights are 3-5 all-time against the No. 1-ranked team and are 6-5-1 all-time against the No. 2-ranked team.

Home Sweet Cornerstone:

St. Norbert is 209-27-12 all-time at the Cornerstone Community Center, which includes a 9-4-1 mark there its first season in the building in 2000-01.

St. Norbert is 189-19-9 in its last 217 games at the Cornerstone Community Center.

The Green Knights had a 25-game home winning streak - the secondlongest in NCAA Division III history - snapped with a 2-2 tie to Gustavus Adolphus on Nov. 4, 2011. St. Norbert also owns the NCAA Division III record with a 36-game home winning streak set Oct. 25, 2002 to Oct. 29, 2004.

In the last 14-plus seasons, the Green Knights are a sparkling 200-22-11 at the Cornerstone, with three losses and one tie coming to national champion UW-Superior during the 2001-02 season.

Under Tim Coghlin, St. Norbert is 288-49-18 at home, which includes games at Brown County Arena, Resch Center and De Pere Ice Arena.

Only two visiting teams have won at least two games at the

Cornerstone Community Center in the same season. Superior won three times in 2001-02 and UW-Eau Claire won twice in 2012-13. Both of those teams went on to win the NCAA Division III national championship.

Tough After Two:

St. Norbert is 11-0 this season when leading after two periods, and was 17-0-1 last season when leading after 40 minutes.

Under Tim Coghlin, St. Norbert is an astounding 263-2-3 at home when up after two periods.

St. Norbert had a home unbeaten streak when leading after two periods of 200 games (197-0-3) before it was snapped by UW-Stout in a 4-3 overtime loss on Feb. 7, 2009. The Green Knights also lost 5-4 to Lawrence on Dec. 7, 2013 when leading after two periods.

At home, St. Norbert is 281-3-4 in school history when leading after two periods. The Green Knights' lone other loss when up after two periods on their own ice came on Nov. 18, 1989 in a 3-1 loss to Augsburg when St. Norbert lost a 1-0 lead.

Gimme Five:

St. Norbert saw a 273-game unbeaten streak when scoring at least five goals spanning nearly 19 years end in a 6-5 loss to UW-Stevens Point on Jan. 3, 2015. The Green Knights were 266-0-7 when scoring five goals since a 7-5 loss to Bemidji State in De Pere on Jan. 12, 1996.

St. Norbert is 5-26-6 in its last 37 games when allowing five goals or more dating back to the 1996-97 season. The only five wins came in a 9-5 win over St. Scholastica on Feb. 20, 1999, a 7-5 win over UW-Stout on Nov. 30, 2001, an 8-5 win over UW-Stout on Jan. 14, 2005, a 7-5 win over UW-Stevens Point on Feb. 3, 2007 and a 7-5 win over Gustavus Adolphus on Oct. 31, 2008.

The Green Knights have allowed five goals just 23 times in their last 420 games.

St. Norbert has never allowed 10 goals in a game during Tim Coghlin's 674-game tenure.

2015-2016 St. Norbert Hockey Game Summaries
