St. Norbert makes its second visit to the Twin Ports this season when it faces St. Scholastica in a key Northern Collegiate Hockey Association series. The Green Knights hold a one-point lead on second-place Adrian and Marian with four games remaining.

The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Tim Coghlin (UW-Stevens Point, 1989) is 500-130-50 in his 23rd season in De Pere. The Green Knights are 355-60-33 in the last 15-plus seasons. Coghlin's 490 wins as a coach in the NCHA is the league record, 120 more than Bemidji State's Bob Peters' 370 wins. Coghlin's seven NCAA championship game appearances and four national championships are the second most in Division III history. Coghlin was the captain of UW-Stevens Point's first national championship team in 1989.

St. Scholastica coach Mark Wick (St. Scholastica, 1985) is 161-130-38 in his 12th season in Duluth.

Last Season:

St. Norbert and St. Scholastica split its two games last season on Feb. 6-7 at the Cornerstone Community Center in De Pere.

St. Scholastica scored the final two goals to win the opener 3-1. Matt Malenstyn and Kyle Beaulieu scored for the Saints, who got 42 saves from Tyler Bruggeman. Tony Kujava made 15 saves for the Green Knights.

St. Norbert responded the next day with a 4-3 win. Erik Cooper's goal at 17:21 of the third period snapped a 3-3 tie. It was Cooper's second goal of the game. Kujava made 15 saves while Bruggeman made 33 stops.

About the Green Knights:

St. Norbert enters the series 18-2-1 overall and 14-2 in the Northern Collegiate Hockey Association. The Green Knights, ranked No. 1 in the USCHO.com Division III and D3hockey.com polls, swept Northland this past weekend by scores of 4-1 and 3-0.

Senior forward Erik Cooper leads the Green Knights in scoring with eight goals and 16 assists for 24 points. Freshman forward Riley Christensen has 10 goals and eight assists for 18 points. Junior forward Pijus Rulevicius and senior forward Michael Hill both have 11 goals and six assists for 17 points, while junior forward Noah Nelson has six goals and 11 assists for 17 points.

Junior goaltender Tony Kujava is 11-1 with a 1.30 goals against average and .935 save percentage.

Freshman T.J. Black is 7-1-1 with a 1.26 goals against average and .936 save percentage.

St. Norbert is 25-for-108 (23.1 percent) on the power play and is 85-for-95 (89.5 percent) on the penalty kill this season.

About the Saints:

St. Scholastica enters the series with a 14-5-2 overall record and a 12-4 mark in the Northern Collegiate Hockey Association. The Saints split a pair of games at Concordia-Wisconsin last weekend, losing 3-2 in overtime before winning the second game 5-1. St. Scholastica is 8-2-1 in its last 11 games.

Senior forward Dylan Nowakowski leads the Saints in scoring with 12 goals and 20 assists for 32 points. Junior forward Brandon Millin has 13 goals and 13 assists for 26 points, while senior forward Keegan Bruce has seven goals and 17 assists for 24 points. Junior forward Derek Sutcliffe has four goals and 12 assists for 16 points.

Senior goaltender Tyler Bruggeman is 12-4-2 with a 2.03 goals against average and .923 save percentage. Junior Peter Megariotis is 1-0 with a 3.00 goals against average and .800 save percentage.

St. Scholastica is 27-for-94 (28.7 percent) on the power play and is 71-for-78 (91.4 percent) on the penalty kill this season.

Dynamic Duo:

St. Norbert boasts the top two goaltenders nationally in goals against average in the NCAA Division III statistics as of Monday, Feb. 8.

Freshman T.J. Black is the current national leader with a 1.26 goals against average, while junior Tony Kujava is second with a 1.30 goals against average.

St. Norbert's goals against average record was set by Kyle Jones, who turned in a lusty 1.09 mark during the 2007-08 season.

Not surprisingly, St. Norbert also leads the nation in scoring defense at a scant 1.29 goals per game. The Green Knights' best season defensively came in 2007-08 when they allowed 43 goals in 32 games for a 1.43 goals per game mark.

Freshmen Facts:

St. Norbert has two of the top nine goal scorers among NCAA Division III freshmen this season.

Forward Roman Uchyn has 11 goals this season while fellow forward Riley Christensen has 10 markers.

Morrisville State's Danny Liscio is the national leader among freshmen with goals scored at 14. Two skaters have 12 goals. Three players, including Uchyn, have 11 goals. Three more players, including Christensen, have 10 goals.

Cody Keefer was the last freshman to have a double-digit goal total in his inaugural campaign, posting 13 goals in 2009-10.

St. Norbert has not had two freshmen reach double digits in goals in the same season since Andy Cote scored 21 goals and Orrin Hergott added 10 goals in 2003-04.

Cooper Chatter:

St. Norbert senior forward Erik Cooper enters the St. Scholastica series having scored at least one point in each of his last 13 games.

Maris Ziedins holds the St. Norbert record for scoring in consecutive games. He scored in 17 straight games from Jan. 5-Oct. 30, 2001.

Cooper has scored four goals and 12 assists for 16 points over that 13-game stretch. He had one assist in last Friday's 4-1 win over Northland and then added two assists in Saturday's 3-0 win over the Lumberjacks.

Cooper has scored at least one point in 20 of 21 games this season. He was kept off the scoresheet in a 5-2 win over UW-Stevens Point on Nov. 21.

Coghlin Count:

St. Norbert head coach Tim Coghlin brings a record of 500-130-50 in his 23rd season into this weekend. Coghlin is currently 25th all-time in wins for NCAA men's ice hockey coaches.

Coghlin earned his 500th career win in just 680 games. That mark is the third-fastest to 500 wins in NCAA hockey history. Only UMass-Dartmouth's John Rolli (658 games) and Bemidji State's Bob Peters (677 games) have reached 500 games more quickly. According

to research by the St. Norbert sports information office, no other NCAA hockey coaches have ever reached 500 wins in less than 700 games.

Coghlin moved past Joe Marsh for 25th on the all-time wins list with a 4-1 win over Marian on Oct. 30. Marsh compiled a 482-417-76 mark in 27 seasons at St. Lawrence from 1986 to 2012.

Current Fitchburg State coach Dean Fuller is 23rd with a career mark of 505-293-50 in 31 seasons. Longtime Boston College coach is John "Snooks" Kelley is 24th all-time in wins. He was 501-249-15 in 36 seasons (1933-42, 1947-72)

Steady Study:

St. Norbert coach Tim Coghlin has directed the Green Knights to 20 consecutive seasons with at least 18 wins, dating back to the 1996-97 season. That streak is the longest such mark in NCAA Division III hockey history.

Only five coaches in Division III hockey history have posted at least 11 consecutive seasons with at least 18 wins.

Plattsburgh State's Bob Emery had 17 consecutive seasons reaching the 18-win plateau from 1990 to 2006. Middlebury's Bill Beaney had 15 consecutive seasons with at least 18 wins from 1995 to 2010.

Oswego State coach Ed Gosek currently has a 12-season streak with at least 18 wins going from 2004 to the present. St. Thomas' Terry Skrypek had 11 consecutive seasons at the 18-win mark from 1988 to 1998.

Poll Position:

St. Norbert has been ranked in the USCHO.com Division III Poll for 260 consecutive polls. The Green Knights have been ranked in 298 of 304 polls conducted since its inception at the start of the 1998-99 season - the most of any school in Division III.

During the 260-week stretch of being ranked, St. Norbert has been No. 1 for 78 weeks - surpassing Norwich's 77 for most all-time. St. Norbert was rated No. 1 in the 2003, 2004, 2005, 2007, 2008, 2011, 2012 and 2014 final polls. The Green Knights are 104-19-7 all-time when ranked No. 1 in the USCHO.com Poll.

St. Norbert is 116-49-17 against teams ranked in the USCHO.com Poll under Tim Coghlin. The Green Knights are 3-5 all-time against the No. 1-ranked team and are 7-6-1 all-time against the No. 2-ranked team.

Tough After Two:

St. Norbert is 15-0 this season when leading after two periods, and was 17-0-1 last season when leading after 40 minutes.

Under Tim Coghlin, St. Norbert is an astounding 264-2-3 at home when up after two periods.

St. Norbert had a home unbeaten streak when leading after two periods of 200 games (197-0-3) before it was snapped by UW-Stout in a 4-3 overtime loss on Feb. 7, 2009. The Green Knights also lost 5-4 to Lawrence on Dec. 7, 2013 when leading after two periods.

At home, St. Norbert is 282-3-4 in school history when leading after two periods. The Green Knights' lone other loss when up after two periods on their own ice came on Nov. 18, 1989 in a 3-1 loss to Augsburg when St. Norbert lost a 1-0 lead.

Gimme Five:

St. Norbert saw a 273-game unbeaten streak when scoring at least five goals spanning nearly 19 years end in a 6-5 loss to UW-Stevens Point on Jan. 3, 2015. The Green Knights were 266-0-7 when scoring five goals since a 7-5 loss to Bemidji State in De Pere on Jan. 12, 1996.

St. Norbert is 5-27-6 in its last 38 games when allowing five goals or more dating back to the 1996-97 season. The only five wins came in a 9-5 win over St. Scholastica on Feb. 20, 1999, a 7-5 win over UW-Stout on Nov. 30, 2001, an 8-5 win over UW-Stout on Jan. 14, 2005, a 7-5 win over UW-Stevens Point on Feb. 3, 2007 and a 7-5 win over Gustavus Adolphus on Oct. 31, 2008.

The Green Knights have allowed five goals just 24 times in their last 426 games.

St. Norbert has never allowed 10 goals in a game during Tim Coghlin's 680-game tenure.
