The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Tim Coghlin (UW-Stevens Point, 1989) is 501-130-51 in his 23rd season in De Pere. The Green Knights are 356-60-34 in the last 15-plus seasons. Coghlin's seven NCAA championship game appearances and four national championships are the second most in Division III history. Coghlin was the captain of UW-Stevens Point's first national championship team in 1989.

MSOE coach Mark Ostapina (Wisconsin, 1979) is 226-168-16 in his 15th season in Milwaukee. Including six seasons at New England College, Ostapina is 289-253-24 in 21 seasons.

Last Season:

St. Norbert won two of three games against MSOE last season. The Green Knights won 4-1 on Jan. 22, 2015 in Milwaukee before MSOE won 2-1 two days later in De Pere. St. Norbert then defeated MSOE 3-1 on Feb. 28 in a NCHA Harris Cup Playoffs semifinal game in De Pere.

In the first game, Tyler Zepeda, Michael Hill, Ross Pavcek and Mason Baptista all scored for St. Norbert, while Omar Mullen scored for the Raiders. David Jacobson made 21 saves for the Green Knights, while Nick Kohn had 35 stops for MSOE.

MSOE earned its first win in the series in the second game. Cody Ganchar and Nick LaRue had goals for the Raiders, while Cullen Bradshaw scored for St. Norbert. Kohn made 35 saves in the win, while Jacobson made 14 stops in the loss.

Chris Rial scored twice while Pavcek added a goal for St. Norbert in the post-season encounter. Zach Simpson scored for the Raiders. Tony Kujava made 16 saves for St. Norbert and Kohn 28 saves for MSOE.

About the Green Knights:

St. Norbert enters the series 19-2-2 overall and 15-2-1 in the Northern Collegiate Hockey Association. The Green Knights, ranked No. 1 in the USCHO.com Division III and D3hockey.com polls, earned three points at St. Scholastica with a 3-2 win and 2-2 tie this past weekend.

Senior forward Erik Cooper tops the Green Knights in scoring with nine goals and 17 assists for 26

points. Junior forward Pijus Rulevicius and senior forward Michael Hill both have 12 goals and seven assists for 19 points. Freshman forward Riley Christensen has 10 goals and eight assists for 18 points.

Junior goaltender Tony Kujava is 11-1-1 with a 1.35 goals against average and .934 save percentage. Freshman T.J. Black is 8-1-1 with a 1.33 goals against average and .935 save percentage.

St. Norbert is 28-for-116 (24.1 percent) on the power play and is 95-for-107 (88.8 percent) on the penalty kill this season.

About the Raiders:

Milwaukee School of Engineering enters the series 14-8-1 overall and 9-8-1 in the Northern Collegiate Hockey Association. The Raiders are coming off a series sweep of Aurora by scores of 5-2 and 5-1 this past weekend in Milwaukee.

Junior forward Gage Christianson leads the Raiders in scoring with three goals and 19 assists for 22 points. Sophomore forward Omar Mullan has nine goals and nine assists for 18 points. Sophomore forward Conner Enciso has seven goals and five assists for 12 points while junior forward Jordan Guth has five goals and six assists for 11 points.

Senior goaltender Nick Kohn is 12-7-1 this season with a 2.03 goals against average and .926 save percentage.

MSOE is 10-for-89 (11.2 percent) on the power play and is 81-for-91 (89.0 percent) on the penalty kill this season.

Dynamic Duo:

St. Norbert boasts the top two goaltenders nationally in goals against average in the NCAA Division III statistics as of Monday, Feb. 15.

Freshman T.J. Black is the current national leader with a 1.33 goals against average, while junior Tony Kujava is second with a 1.35 goals against average.

St. Norbert's goals against average record was set by Kyle Jones, who turned in a lusty 1.09 mark during the 2007-08 season.

St. Norbert also leads the nation in scoring defense at a meager 1.35 goals per game. The Green Knights' best season defensively came in

2007-08 when they allowed 43 goals in 32 games for a 1.43 goals per game mark.

Cooper Chatter:

St. Norbert senior forward Erik Cooper enters the St. Scholastica series having scored at least one point in each of his last 15 games.

Maris Ziedins holds the St. Norbert record for scoring in consecutive games. He scored in 17 straight games from Jan. 5-Oct. 30, 2001.

Cooper has scored five goals and 13 assists for 18 points over that 15-game stretch. Cooper had one assist in last Friday's 3-2 win over St. Scholastica and scored one goal in a 2-2 tie Saturday with the Saints.

Cooper has scored at least one point in 22 of 23 games this season. He was kept off the scoresheet in a 5-2 win over UW-Stevens Point on Nov. 21.

Coghlin Count:

St. Norbert head coach Tim Coghlin brings a record of 501-130-51 in his 23rd season into this weekend. Coghlin is currently tied for 24th all-time in wins for NCAA men's ice hockey coaches.

Longtime Boston College coach is John "Snooks" Kelley is tied for 24th all-time in wins. He was 501-249-15 in 36 seasons (1933-42, 1947-72). Current Fitchburg State coach Dean Fuller is 23rd with a career mark of 505-295-50 in 31 seasons.

Coghlin earned his 500th career win in just 680 games. That mark is the third-fastest to 500 wins in NCAA hockey history. Only UMass-Dartmouth's John Rolli (658 games) and Bemidji State's Bob Peters (677 games) have reached 500 games more quickly. According to research by the St. Norbert sports information office, no other NCAA hockey coaches have ever reached 500 wins in less than 700 games.

Steady Study:

St. Norbert coach Tim Coghlin has directed the Green Knights to 20 consecutive seasons with at least 18 wins, dating back to the 1996-97 season. That streak is the longest such mark in NCAA Division III hockey history.

Only five coaches in Division III hockey history have posted at least 11 consecutive seasons with at least 18 wins.

Plattsburgh State's Bob Emery

had 17 consecutive seasons reaching the 18-win plateau from 1990 to 2006. Middlebury's Bill Beaney had 15 consecutive seasons with at least 18 wins from 1995 to 2010.

Oswego State coach Ed Gosek currently has a 12-season streak with at least 18 wins going from 2004 to the present. St. Thomas' Terry Skrypek had 11 consecutive seasons at the 18-win mark from 1988 to 1998.

Poll Position:

St. Norbert has been ranked in the USCHO.com Division III Poll for 261 consecutive polls. The Green Knights have been ranked in 299 of 305 polls conducted since its inception at the start of the 1998-99 season - the most of any school in Division III.

During the 261-week stretch of being ranked, St. Norbert has been No. 1 for 79 weeks - surpassing Norwich's 77 for most all-time. St. Norbert was rated No. 1 in the 2003, 2004, 2005, 2007, 2008, 2011, 2012 and 2014 final polls. The Green Knights are 105-19-8 all-time when ranked No. 1 in the USCHO.com Poll.

St. Norbert is 117-49-18 against teams ranked in the USCHO.com Poll under Tim Coghlin. The Green Knights are 3-5 all-time against the No. 1-ranked team and are 7-6-1 all-time against the No. 2-ranked team.

Home Sweet Cornerstone:

St. Norbert is 211-28-12 all-time at the Cornerstone Community Center, which includes a 9-4-1 mark there its first season in the building in 2000-01.

St. Norbert is 191-20-9 in its last 220 games at the Cornerstone Community Center.

The Green Knights had a 25-game home winning streak - the second-longest in NCAA Division III history - snapped with a 2-2 tie to Gustavus Adolphus on Nov. 4, 2011. St. Norbert also owns the NCAA Division III record with a 36-game home winning streak set Oct. 25, 2002 to Oct. 29, 2004.

In the last 14-plus seasons, the Green Knights are a sparkling 202-23-11 at the Cornerstone, with three losses and one tie coming to national champion UW-Superior during the 2001-02 season.

Under Tim Coghlin, St. Norbert is 290-50-18 at home, which includes games at Brown County Arena,

Only two visiting teams have won at least two games at the Cornerstone Community Center in the same season. Superior won three times in 2001-02 and UW-Eau Claire won twice in 2012-13. Both of those teams went on to win the NCAA Division III national championship.

Tough After Two:

St. Norbert is 16-0 this season when leading after two periods, and was 17-0-1 last season when leading after 40 minutes.

Under Tim Coghlin, St. Norbert is an astounding 264-2-3 at home when up after two periods.

St. Norbert had a home unbeaten streak when leading after two periods of 200 games (197-0-3) before it was snapped by UW-Stout in a 4-3 overtime loss on Feb. 7, 2009. The Green Knights also lost 5-4 to Lawrence on Dec. 7, 2013 when leading after two periods.

At home, St. Norbert is 282-3-4 in school history when leading after two periods. The Green Knights' lone other loss when up after two periods on their own ice came on Nov. 18, 1989 in a 3-1 loss to Augsburg when St. Norbert lost a 1-0 lead.

Gimme Five:

St. Norbert saw a 273-game unbeaten streak when scoring at least five goals spanning nearly 19 years end in a 6-5 loss to UW-Stevens Point on Jan. 3, 2015. The Green Knights were 266-0-7 when scoring five goals since a 7-5 loss to Bemidji State in De Pere on Jan. 12, 1996.

St. Norbert is 5-27-6 in its last 38 games when allowing five goals or more dating back to the 1996-97 season. The only five wins came in a 9-5 win over St. Scholastica on Feb. 20, 1999, a 7-5 win over UW-Stout on Nov. 30, 2001, an 8-5 win over UW-Stout on Jan. 14, 2005, a 7-5 win over UW-Stevens Point on Feb. 3, 2007 and a 7-5 win over Gustavus Adolphus on Oct. 31, 2008.

The Green Knights have allowed five goals just 24 times in their last 428 games.

St. Norbert has never allowed 10 goals in a game during Tim Coghlin's 682-game tenure.
