Series Overview:

St. Norbert opens the post-season with a semifinal series in the NCHA Harris Cup Playoffs. The Green Knights have won five of the last six NCHA post-season titles and have claimed NCHA playoff championship in 10 of the last 13 seasons. The series is a best-of-two-game set with a mini-game to take place Saturday night after the regularly scheduled contest if the two games are split.

The Series:

St. Norbert leads Marian 19-1-2 in a series which began in the 1996-97 season. The Green Knights are 8-1-1 at home all-time in the series.

The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Tim Coghlin (UW-Stevens Point, 1989) is 503-130-51 in his 23rd season in De Pere. The Green Knights are 358-60-34 in the last 15-plus seasons. Coghlin's seven NCAA championship game appearances and

four national championships are the second most in Division III history. Coghlin was the captain of UW-Stevens Point's first national championship team in 1989.

Marian coach Erik Largen (Alaska-Fairbanks, 2008) is 18-5-3 in his first season in Fond du Lac.

This Season:

St. Norbert and Marian split its two games against each other on Oct. 30-31, 2015. The visiting team won each game.

St. Norbert won 4-1 on Oct. 30 in Fond du Lac, scoring two first-period goals by Michael Hill and Chris Rygus. Tony Kujava made 14 saves for St. Norbert and Mike Baldwin made 28 stops for the Sabres.

Marian won 4-2 on Halloween behind three second-period goals to take a 4-1 lead. Scott Milnthorp, Devin Stuermer and James Mathias all scored during the uprising for the Sabres. Mike Gudmandson made 23 saves for Marian.

About the Green Knights:

St. Norbert enters the series 21-2-2 overall. The Green Knights, ranked No. 1 in the USCHO.com Division III and D3hockey.com polls, completed the regular-season with a series sweep of MSOE by scores of 4-1 and 4-0 last week.

Senior forward Erik Cooper, named NCHA Player of the Year earlier this week, leads the Green Knights in scoring with 11 goals and 17 assists for 28 points. Senior forward Michael Hill has 14 goals and nine assists for 23 points, while junior forward Pijus Rulevicius has 13 goals and eight assists for 21 points. Freshman forward Riley Christensen has 11 goals and 10 assists for 21 points.

Junior goaltender Tony Kujava is 12-1-1 with a 1.25 goals against average and .937 save percentage. Freshman T.J. Black is 9-1-1 with a 1.30 goals against average and .937 save percentage.

St. Norbert is 31-for-130 (23.8 percent) on the power play and is 100-for-112 (89.3 percent) on the penalty kill this season.

About the Sabres:

Marian, ranked No. 12 in the USCHO.com Division III Poll, enters the series 18-5-3 overall. The Sabres, who finished the NCHA regular season 15-4-1, won their first-round game in the Harris Cup Playoffs by a 3-0 score over Concordia-Wis. on Wednesday.

Sophomore forward Derek Thorogood has nine goals and 25 assists for 34 points, while senior forward Devin Stuermer has 17 goals and 17 assists for 34 points. Sophomore forward Hunter Stewart has three goals and 28 assists for 31 points, while freshman defenseman Gianni Mangone has 11 goals and 12 assists for 23 points.

Junior goaltender Mike Baldwin is 13-2-3 with a 1.37 goals against average and .940 save percentage. Sophomore Mike Gudmandson is 5-3 with a 2.16 goals against average and .904 save percentage.

Marian is 22-for-90 (24.4 percent) on the power play and is 71-for-81 (87.7 percent) on the penalty kill this season

Cup Clamor:

This weekend's NCHA Harris Cup Playoffs semifinal series marks the 47th time in the last 51 rounds it has played in St. Norbert at home in the league playoffs.

The Green Knights are 63-13-1 alltime in the NCHA Playoffs, and are 61-7 at home all-time in the tournament. St. Norbert is 2-6-1 on the road.

Since the 1996-97 season, St. Norbert has played just four other NCHA Playoff series/rounds on the road. The Green Knights, after a third-place finish in the NCHA in 2000-01, played at UW-River Falls in the semifinal round and were eliminated 1-0 in an overtime mini-game. St. Norbert's 3-0 loss at UW-Superior in the NCHA Semifinals in 2009. St. Norbert won the final Peters Cup Playoffs championship with a 3-0 win at UW-Eau Claire in 2013. The Green Knights lost in the Harris Cup championship at Adrian in 2015.

St. Norbert finished second in 1999-2000 but was eliminated in the semifinals at the De Pere Ice Arena in a mini-game of a two-game series by UW-Superior. The Green Knights were seeded second in 2007 but hosted the championship after top-seeded River Falls lost in the semifinals.

Dynamic Duo:

St. Norbert boasts the top two goaltenders nationally in goals against average in the NCAA Division III statistics as of Wednesday, Feb. 24.

Junior Tony Kujava is the national leader with a 1.25 goals against average, while freshman T.J. Black is second with a 1.30 goals against average. Marian's Mike Baldwin is third

nationally with a 1.37 goals against average.

St. Norbert's goals against average record was set by Kyle Jones, who turned in a lusty 1.09 mark during the 2007-08 season.

St. Norbert also leads the nation in scoring defense at a meager 1.28 goals per game. The Green Knights' best season defensively came in 2007-08 when they allowed 43 goals in 32 games for a 1.43 goals per game mark.

Cooper Chatter:

St. Norbert senior forward Erik Cooper enters the Marian series having scored at least one point in each of his last 17 games.

Cooper tied Maris Ziedins for the St. Norbert record for scoring in consecutive games. Ziedins scored in 17 straight games from Jan. 5-Oct. 30, 2001.

Cooper, recently named NCHA Player of the Year, has scored seven goals and 13 assists for 20 points over that 17-game stretch. Cooper scored one goal in each of St. Norbert's 4-1 and 4-0 wins over MSOE last week.

Cooper has scored at least one point in 24 of 25 games this season. He was kept off the scoresheet in a 5-2 win over UW-Stevens Point on Nov. 21.

Coghlin Count:

St. Norbert head coach Tim Coghlin brings a record of 503-130-51 in his 23rd season into this weekend. Coghlin moved in to 23rd place all-time in wins for NCAA men's ice hockey coaches.

Coghlin moved past longtime Boston College coach John "Snooks" Kelley all-time in wins. He was 501-249-15 in 36 seasons (1933-42, 1947-72) to now sit alone in 24th place. Current Fitchburg State coach Dean Fuller is 22nd with a career mark of 505-296-51 in 31 seasons.

Coghlin earned his 500 career wins in just 680 games. That mark is the third-fastest to 500 wins in NCAA hockey history. Only UMass-Dartmouth's John Rolli (658 games) and Bemidji State's Bob Peters (677 games) have reached 500 games more quickly. According to research by the St. Norbert sports information office, no other NCAA hockey coaches have ever reached 500 wins in less than 700 games.

Steady Study:

St. Norbert coach Tim Coghlin has directed the Green Knights to 20

consecutive seasons with at least 18 wins, dating back to the 1996-97 season. That streak is the longest such mark in NCAA Division III hockey history

Only five coaches in Division III hockey history have posted at least 11 consecutive seasons with at least 18 wins.

Plattsburgh State's Bob Emery had 17 consecutive seasons reaching the 18-win plateau from 1990 to 2006. Middlebury's Bill Beaney had 15 consecutive seasons with at least 18 wins from 1995 to 2010.

Oswego State coach Ed Gosek currently has a 12-season streak with at least 18 wins going from 2004 to the present. St. Thomas' Terry Skrypek had 11 consecutive seasons at the 18-win mark from 1988 to 1998.

Poll Position:

St. Norbert has been ranked in the USCHO.com Division III Poll for 262 consecutive polls. The Green Knights have been ranked in 300 of 306 polls conducted since its inception at the start of the 1998-99 season - the most of any school in Division III

During the 262-week stretch of being ranked, St. Norbert has been No. 1 for 80 weeks - surpassing Norwich's 77 for most all-time. St. Norbert was rated No. 1 in the 2003, 2004, 2005, 2007, 2008, 2011, 2012 and 2014 final polls. The Green Knights are 107-19-8 all-time when ranked No. 1 in the USCHO.com Poll.

St. Norbert is 117-49-18 against teams ranked in the USCHO.com Poll under Tim Coghlin. The Green Knights are 3-5 all-time against the No. 1-ranked team and are 7-6-1 all-time against the No. 2-ranked team.

Home Sweet Cornerstone:

St. Norbert is 212-28-12 all-time at the Cornerstone Community Center, which includes a 9-4-1 mark there its first season in the building in 2000-01.

St. Norbert is 192-20-9 in its last 221 games at the Cornerstone Community Center.

The Green Knights had a 25-game home winning streak - the second-longest in NCAA Division III history - snapped with a 2-2 tie to Gustavus Adolphus on Nov. 4, 2011. St. Norbert also owns the NCAA Division III record with a 36-game home winning streak set Oct. 25, 2002 to Oct. 29, 2004.

In the last 14-plus seasons, the Green Knights are a sparkling 203-

Under Tim Coghlin, St. Norbert is 291-50-18 at home, which includes games at Brown County Arena, Resch Center and De Pere Ice Arena.

Only two visiting teams have won at least two games at the Cornerstone Community Center in the same season. Superior won three times in 2001-02 and UW-Eau Claire won twice in 2012-13. Both of those teams went on to win the NCAA Division III national championship.

Tough After Two:

St. Norbert is 18-0 this season when leading after two periods, and was 17-0-1 last season when leading after 40 minutes.

Under Tim Coghlin, St. Norbert is an astounding 265-2-3 at home when

up after two periods.

St. Norbert had a home unbeaten streak when leading after two periods of 200 games (197-0-3) before it was snapped by UW-Stout in a 4-3 overtime loss on Feb. 7, 2009. The Green Knights also lost 5-4 to Lawrence on Dec. 7, 2013 when leading after two periods.

At home, St. Norbert is 283-3-4 in school history when leading after two periods. The Green Knights' lone other loss when up after two periods on their own ice came on Nov. 18, 1989 in a 3-1 loss to Augsburg when St. Norbert lost a 1-

0 lead.

Gimme Five:

St. Norbert saw a 273-game unbeaten streak when scoring at least five goals spanning nearly 19 years end in a 6-5 loss to UW-Stevens Point on Jan. 3, 2015. The Green Knights were 266-0-7 when scoring five goals since a 7-5 loss to Bemidji State in De Pere on Jan. 12, 1996.

St. Norbert is 5-27-6 in its last 38 games when allowing five goals or more dating back to the 1996-97 season. The only five wins came in a 9-5 win over St. Scholastica on Feb. 20, 1999, a 7-5 win over UW-Stout on Nov. 30, 2001, an 8-5 win over UW-Stout on Jan. 14, 2005, a 7-5 win over UW-Stevens Point on Feb. 3, 2007 and a 7-5 win over Gustavus Adolphus on Oct. 31, 2008.

The Green Knights have allowed five goals just 24 times in their last

430 games.

St. Norbert has never allowed 10 goals in a game during Tim Coghlin's 684-game tenure.
