Game Overview:

St. Norbert and Augsburg meet in the quarterfinal round of the NCAA Division III Tournament. The Green Knights seek their tenth Frozen Four trip. The Auggies are hunting for their third Frozen Four appearance. The winner advances to the NCAA Division III Frozen Four on March 25-26 in Lake Placid, N.Y.

The Series:

Augsburg leads St. Norbert 10-5-1 in an all-time series begun during the 1988-89 season. The Green Knights are 4-1-1 against the Auggies since Tim Coghlin took over in 1993-94.

The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Tim Coghlin (UW-Stevens Point, 1989) is 505-131-51 in his 23rd season in De Pere. The Green Knights are 360-61-34 in the last 15-plus seasons. Coghlin's seven NCAA championship game appearances and four national championships are the second most in Division III history. Coghlin was the captain of UW-Stevens Point's first national championship team in 1989.

Augsburg coach Chris Brown (UW-River Falls, 1994) is 117-121-20 in his tenth season in Minneapolis. He was 69-56-8 in five years combined at Marian and Hamline for a total record of 186-177-28.

Last Meeting:

St. Norbert defeated Augsburg 3-2 in overtime on Nov. 2, 2012 at the Augsburg Ice Arena in Minneapolis.

Tyler Zepeda scored the game-winning goal 1:31 into overtime to lift the Green Knights to victory. Brandon Hoogenboom scored a power-play goal with 8:27 remaining in regulation to force overtime. Cullen Bradshaw also scored for St. Norbert, which got 22 saves from Travis Bosch.

Tim Serratore and Loren Egan scored for Augsburg, which received 25 saves from Justin Lochner.

NCAA Tournament Appearances:

St. Norbert is making its 16th overall NCAA Division III Tournament appearance, all coming within in the last 20 years. The Green Knights are 25-11-1 all-time in NCAA competition, have reached nine Frozen Fours, and have won 16 of their last 18 NCAA Tournament games. St. Norbert won national championships in 2008, 2011, 2012 and 2014 and was the national runner-up in 2004, 2006 and 2010. The Green Knights are just one of three programs in NCAA Division III history to have won consecutive national championships (UW-Stevens Point 1989-91 and Middlebury 1995-99 and 2004-06).

Augsburg is making its third NCAA Division III Tournament appearance. The Auggies, 3-4-1 all-time in the tournament, received

bids in 1984 and 1998. Augsburg advanced to the Frozen Four in both of those season, placing fourth both times.

About the Green Knights:

St. Norbert enters the NCAA Tournament 23-3-2 overall. The Green Knights, ranked No. 2 in the USCHO.com Division III and D3hockey.com polls, lost the NCHA Harris Cup Playoffs championship game to Adrian 4-1 on March 5.

Senior forward Erik Cooper, tops the Green Knights in scoring with 12 goals and 20 assists for 32 points. Senior forward Michael Hill has 15 goals and 10 assists for 25 points, while junior forward Pijus Rulevicius has 13 goals and nine assists for 22 points. Freshman forward Riley Christensen has 11 goals and 11 assists for 22 points. Freshman forward Roman Uchyn has 13 goals and six assists for 19 points.

Junior goaltender Tony Kujava is 14-1-1 with a 1.28 goals against average and .934 save percentage. Freshman T.J. Black is 9-2-1 with a 1.45 goals against average and .934 save percentage.

St. Norbert is 32-for-146 (21.9 percent) on the power play and is 118-for-131 (90.1 percent) on the penalty kill this season.

About the Auggies:

Augsburg enters the NCAA Tournament 17-8-2 overall. The Auggies, ranked No. 13 in the USCHO.com Division III Poll, won the Minnesota Intercollegiate Athletic Conference Tournament with a 5-4 triple-overtime thriller over St. John's on March 5.

Sophomore forward Nate Flynn leads the Auggies in scoring with 16 goals and 14 assists for 30 points. Junior forward Corbin Chapman has 11 goals and 11 assists for 22 points. Sophomore defenseman Eli May has nine goals and 10 assists for 19 points, while junior defenseman Rory Vesel has two goals and 16 assists for 18 points.

Junior goaltender Jordyn Kaufer is 16-5-1 with a 2.01 goals against average and .929 save percentage. Senior Brandon Jones is 1-3-1 with a 2.75

goals against average and .914 save percentage.

Augsburg is 17-for-73 (23.3 percent) on the power play and is 80-for-92 (87.0 percent) on the penalty kill this season.

Tourney Tidbits:

St. Norbert enters this year's NCAA Tournament with a glittering 16-2 record in its last 18 NCAA Tournament games. The stretch covers its last six NCAA Tournament appearances dating back to 2008.

The Green Knights went 3-0 in 2008, 2011 and 2014 en route to winning NCAA Division III national championships all three years. St. Norbert was 3-1 during the 2010 tournament, losing 2-1 in double overtime to Norwich in the national title game. St. Norbert went 4-0 in 2012 to win its third national title.

St. Norbert, 25-11-1 all-time in the tournament, has suffered overtime losses in two of its last three NCAA Tournament eliminations. Including the aforementioned Norwich game, St. Norbert lost to Oswego State 4-3 in overtime in a national semifinal game in the 2007 Frozen Four at UW-Superior.

The Green Knights lost 3-1 to eventual national champion UW-Eau Claire in the 2013 national quarterfinals at the Cornerstone Community Center.

MIAC Minutiae:

St. Norbert has a solid 84-11-7 record against Minnesota

Intercollegiate Athletic Conference competition since Tim Coghlin took over the Green Knights' helm in 1993. Two of the losses came in a sweep at St. Mary's in Coghlin's first year of 1993-94.

Since then, the Green Knights are 84-9-7 against the MIAC. St. Norbert is 8-1-1 in its last 10 games against the MIAC, with the only loss coming in a 2-1 setback at Gustavus Adolphus on Nov. 3, 2012.

At home under Coghlin, St. Norbert is a remarkable 47-2-3 against MIAC foes. The losses came in a 3-2 defeat to St. Thomas in the 2005 NCAA Division III Tournament and to Gustavus Adolphus 4-2 on Nov. 3, 2007.

Dynamic Duo:

St. Norbert boasts the top two goal-tenders nationally in goals against average in the NCAA Division III national statistics as of Tuesday, March 15.

Junior Tony Kujava is the national leader with a 1.28 goals against average, while freshman T.J. Black is second with a 1.45 goals against average.

St. Norbert's goals against average record was set by Kyle Jones, who turned in a lusty 1.09 mark during the 2007-08 season, which included 10 shutouts.

St. Norbert also leads the nation in scoring defense at a meager 1.39 goals per game, allowing just 39 goals in 28 games this season. The Green Knights' best season defen-

sively came in 2007-08 when they allowed 43 goals in 32 games for a 1.43 goals per game mark.

Cooper Chatter:

St. Norbert senior forward Erik Cooper had a school-record streak of 19 consecutive games with at least one point snapped in a 4-1 loss to Adrian on March 5.

Cooper passed Maris Ziedins for the St. Norbert record for scoring in consecutive games. Ziedins scored in 17 straight games from Jan. 5-Oct. 30, 2001.

Cooper, recently named NCHA Player of the Year, scored eight goals and 16 assists for 24 points over that 19-game stretch.

Cooper has scored at least one point in 26 of 28 games this season. He was also kept off the scoresheet in a 5-2 win over UW-Stevens Point on Nov. 21.

Coghlin Count:

St. Norbert head coach Tim Coghlin brings a record of 505-131-51 in his 23rd season into this weekend. Coghlin is in 23rd place all-time in wins for NCAA men's ice hockey coaches.

Coghlin moved past longtime Boston College coach John "Snooks" Kelley in wins. He was 501-249-15 in 36 seasons (1933-42, 1947-72) to now sit alone in 24th place. Current Fitchburg State coach Dean Fuller is 22nd with a career mark of 506-297-51 in 31 seasons.

Coghlin earned his 500 career wins in just 680 games. That mark is the third-fastest to 500 wins in NCAA hockey history. Only UMass-Dartmouth's John Rolli (658 games) and Bemidji State's Bob Peters (677 games) have reached 500 games more quickly. According to research by the St. Norbert sports information office, no other NCAA hockey coaches have ever reached 500 wins in less than 700 games.

Steady Study:

St. Norbert coach Tim Coghlin has directed the Green Knights to 20 consecutive seasons with at least 18 wins, dating back to the 1996-97 season. That streak is the longest such mark in NCAA Division III hockey

Only five coaches in Division III hockey history have posted at least 11 consecutive seasons with at least 18 wins.

Plattsburgh State's Bob Emery had 17 consecutive seasons reaching the 18-win plateau from 1990 to 2006. Middlebury's Bill Beaney had 15 consecutive seasons with at least 18 wins from 1995 to 2010.

Oswego State coach Ed Gosek had a 12-season streak with at least 18 wins begun in 2004 snapped this season with a 14-11-2 record. St. Thomas' Terry Skrypek had 11 consecutive seasons at the 18-win mark from 1988 to 1998.

Poll Position:

St. Norbert has been ranked in the USCHO.com Division III Poll for 264 consecutive polls. The Green Knights have been ranked in 302 of 308 polls conducted since its inception at the start of the 1998-99 season - the most of any school in Division III.

During the 264-week stretch of being ranked, St. Norbert has been No. 1 for 81 weeks - surpassing

Norwich's 77 for most all-time. St. Norbert was rated No. 1 in the 2003, 2004, 2005, 2007, 2008, 2011, 2012 and 2014 final polls. The Green Knights are 109-20-8 all-time when ranked No. 1 in the USCHO.com Poll.

St. Norbert is 119-50-18 against teams ranked in the USCHO.com Poll under Tim Coghlin. The Green Knights are 3-5 all-time against the No. 1-ranked team and are 7-7-1 all-time against the No. 2-ranked team.

Home Sweet Cornerstone:

St. Norbert is 214-28-12 all-time at the Cornerstone Community Center, which includes a 9-4-1 mark there its first season in the building in 2000-01.

St. Norbert is 194-20-9 in its last 223 games at the Cornerstone Community Center.

The Green Knights had a 25-game home winning streak - the second-longest in NCAA Division III history - snapped with a 2-2 tie to Gustavus Adolphus on Nov. 4, 2011. St. Norbert also owns the NCAA Division III record with a 36-game home winning streak set Oct. 25,

In the last 14-plus seasons, the Green Knights are a sparkling 205-23-11 at the Cornerstone, with three losses and one tie coming to national champion UW-Superior during the 2001-02 season.

Under Tim Coghlin, St. Norbert is 293-50-18 at home, which includes games at Brown County Arena, Resch Center and De Pere Ice Arena.

Only two visiting teams have won at least two games at the Cornerstone Community Center in the same season. Superior won three times in 2001-02 and UW-Eau Claire won twice in 2012-13. Both of those teams went on to win the NCAA Division III national championship.

Tough After Two:

St. Norbert is 20-0 this season when leading after two periods, and was 17-0-1 last season when leading after 40 minutes.

Under Tim Coghlin, St. Norbert is an astounding 267-2-3 at home when up after two periods.

St. Norbert had a home unbeaten streak when leading after two periods of 200 games (197-0-3) before it was snapped by UW-Stout in a 4-3 overtime loss on Feb. 7, 2009. The Green Knights also lost 5-4 to Lawrence on Dec. 7, 2013 when leading after two periods.

At home, St. Norbert is 285-3-4 in school history when leading after two periods. The Green Knights' lone other loss when up after two periods on their own ice came on Nov. 18, 1989 in a 3-1 loss to Augsburg when St. Norbert lost a 1-0 lead.

Gimme Five:

St. Norbert saw a 273-game unbeaten streak when scoring at least five goals spanning nearly 19 years end in a 6-5 loss to UW-Stevens Point on Jan. 3, 2015. The Green Knights were 266-0-7 when scoring five goals since a 7-5 loss to Bemidji State in De Pere on Jan. 12, 1996.

St. Norbert is 5-27-6 in its last 38 games when allowing five goals or more dating back to the 1996-97 season. The only five wins came in a 9-5 win over St. Scholastica on Feb. 20, 1999, a 7-5 win over UW-Stout on Nov. 30, 2001, an 8-5 win over UW-

Stout on Jan. 14, 2005, a 7-5 win over UW-Stevens Point on Feb. 3, 2007 and a 7-5 win over Gustavus Adolphus on Oct. 31, 2008.

The Green Knights have allowed five goals just 24 times in their last 433 games.

St. Norbert has never allowed 10 goals in a game during Tim Coghlin's 687-game tenure.

Western Wonders:

The Northern Collegiate Hockey Association placed a representative in the NCAA Division III championship game 21 out of a possible 32 times. St. Norbert has made seven title game appearances, coming in 2004, 2006, 2008, 2010, 2011, 2012 and 2014.

Bemidji State did it twice (1985-86), UW-River Falls three times (1988, '93, '94), UW-Stevens Point six times (1989-93, '98), Mankato State once (1991), UW-Superior four times (1994, '97, '99, 2002) and UW-Eau Claire once (2013). NCHA teams have squared off for the national championship three times (1991 - Stevens Point vs. Mankato State, 1993 - Stevens Point vs. River Falls, 1994 - River Falls vs. Superior).

UW-Stevens Point (1989, '90, '91, '93), UW-River Falls (1988, '94), Bemidji State (1986), UW-Superior (2002), St. Norbert (2008, '11, '12, '14) and UW-Eau Claire (2013) have all won Division III national titles while playing under the NCHA banner.

In 32 NCAA Division III Frozen Fours, the NCHA has placed a team among the final four 30 years - the most of any league. The NCHA did not advance a team through to the Frozen Four in 1984 and 2005. River Falls lost to Union in the 1984 quarterfinals and St. Norbert lost to St. Thomas in the 2005 quarterfinals.

St. Norbert's 4-3 win over Adrian in the 2011 national championship game marked the first All-West Region final since 1994, when UW-River Falls beat UW-Superior 6-4 for the title. St. Norbert also defeated UW-Stevens Point 3-1 for the 2014 national title in the most recent All-West Region championship game.
