St. Norbert College Green Knights Hockey Preview NCAA DIVISION III FROZEN FOUR

Tournament Overview:

Historic Herb Brooks Arena hosts the Frozen Four as four teams converge on Lake Placid to determine the 2016 NCAA Division III champion. St. Norbert is aiming for its fifth national title in nine years, capturing the crown in Lake Placid in 2008 and 2012, in 2011 in Minneapolis and in 2014 in Lewiston, Maine. UW-Stevens Point won the last of its four titles in 1993, while UMass-Boston and SUNY Geneseo are both looking for its first national championships.

The Series:

St. Norbert meets UMass-Boston in men's ice hockey for the first time.

Fierce rivals for the last two decades, St. Norbert leads the series with UW-Stevens Point by a 46-20-6 margin in a series begun in the 1991-92 season. St. Norbert is 46-12-3 in the last 61 games against the Pointers after opening the series 0-8-3. St. Norbert is also 28-4-2 in the last 34 games in the series.

St. Norbert leads Geneseo 1-0 in the all-time series, which dates back to the 2013-14 season. The Green Knights topped the Knights 6-2 in the semifinals of the 2014 Frozen Four in Lewiston, Maine.

The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Tim Coghlin (UW-Stevens Point, 1989) is 506-131-51 in his 23rd season in De Pere. The Green Knights are 361-61-34 in the last 15-plus seasons. Coghlin's seven NCAA championship game appearances and four national championships are the second most in Division III history. Coghlin was the captain of UW-Stevens Point's first national championship team in 1989.

UMass-Boston coach Peter Belisle (Connecticut, 1995) is 145-104-20 in his tenth season in Boston.

UW-Stevens Point coach Chris Brooks (Western Michigan, 1996) is 96-40-10 in his fifth season in Stevens Point.

Geneseo coach Chris Schultz (Geneseo, 1997) is 152-97-17 in his

tenth season in Geneseo.

NCAA Tournament Appearances:

St. Norbert is making its 16th overall NCAA Division III Tournament appearance, all coming within in the last 20 years. The Green Knights are 26-11-1 all-time in NCAA competition, have reached 10 Frozen Fours, and have won 17 of their last 19 NCAA Tournament games. St. Norbert won national championships in 2008, 2011, 2012 and 2014 and was the national runner-up in 2004, 2006 and 2010. The Green Knights are just one of three programs in NCAA Division III history to have won consecutive national championships (UW-Stevens Point 1989-91 and Middlebury 1995-99 and 2004-06).

UMass-Boston is making its first NCAA Division III Tournament appearance and is 2-0 all-time in the tournament.

UW-Stevens Point is making its 12th NCAA Division III Tournament appearance and its ninth visit to the Frozen Four. The Pointers, who are 24-14-3 all-time in the tournament, won national titles in 1989, 1990, 1991 and 1993.

SUNY Geneseo is making its fifth NCAA Division III Tournament appearance and is 4-3-2 all-time. The Knights are in their second Frozen Four in three years.

NCAA Championship Coaching Appearances

Only eight coaches in NCAA Division III history have coached in at least three NCAA Division III championship games/series since the start of the NCAA Division III Tournament in 1984. St. Norbert head coach Tim Coghlin ranks second all-time on the list with seven title game appearances, going 4-3 overall with two of the losses coming in overtime.

Division III Frozen Four 24-3-2 overall. The Green Knights, ranked No. 2 in the USCHO.com Division III and D3hockey.com polls, advanced to the Frozen Four with a 6-1 quarterfinal-round win over Augsburg this past Saturday in De Pere.

Senior forward Erik Cooper, leads the Green Knights in scoring with 12 goals and 21 assists for 33 points. Freshman forward Riley Christensen, who had two points and two assists against Augsburg, is now second on the team in scoring with 13 goals and 13 assists for 26 points. Senior forward Michael Hill has 15 goals and 10 assists for 25 points, while junior forward Pijus Rulevicius has 15 goals and nine assists for 24 points.

Junior goaltender Tony Kujava is 15-1-1 with a 1.27 goals against average and .934 save percentage. Freshman T.J. Black is 9-2-1 with a 1.45 goals against average and .934 save percentage.

St. Norbert is 34-for-152 (22.4 percent) on the power play and is 122-for-135 (90.4 percent) on the penalty kill this season.

About the Beacons:

UMass-Boston enters the NCAA Division III Frozen Four 23-4-3 overall. The Beacons, playing out of the New England Hockey Conference, have won both of their NCAA Tournament games by shutout. UMass-Boston beat Trinity 4-0 on

March 12 and then blanked Hobart on the road 2-0 in a quarterfinal this past Saturday.

UMass-Boston is led in scoring by senior forward Matt Lemire, who has 15 goals and 29 assists for 44 points. Senior forward Frankie DeAugustine has 15 goals and 21 assists for 36 points, while sophomore forward Colin Larkin has 10 goals and 25 assists for 35 points. Senior forward Derek Colucci has nine goals and 14 assists for 23 points.

Senior goaltender Billy Faust is 16-4-3 with a 1.95 goals against average and .934 save percentage. Senior Zach Andrews is 7-0 with a 2.18 goals against average and .913 save percentage.

UMass-Boston is 25-for-100 (25.0 percent) on the power play and is 84-for-95 (88.4 percent) on the penalty kill this season.

About the Pointers:

UW-Stevens Point enters the NCAA Division III Frozen Four 22-5-2 overall. The Pointers, 16-2-1 over their last 19 games, defeated Adrian 5-2 on the road this past Saturday to advance to Lake Placid.

Senior forward Joe Kalisz leads the Pointers in scoring with 13 goals and 27 assists for 40 points. Junior forward Kyle Sharkey has 18 goals and 17 assists for 35 points. Junior forward Lawrence Cornellier has 22 goals and 12 assists for 34 points, while senior defenseman Alex

Sophomore goaltender Max Milosek is 17-4-2 with a 2.08 goals against average and .915 save percentage. Freshman Jesse Gordichuk is 5-1 with a 2.78 goals against average and .890 save percentage.

Stevens Point is 31-for-125 (24.8 percent) on the power play and is 81-for-91 (89.0 percent) on the penalty kill this season.

About the Knights:

SUNY Geneseo enters the NCAA Division III Frozen Four with a 20-4-6 overall record. The Knights are 12-1-4 in their last 17 games. Geneseo beat Salve Regina 7-1 in the NCAA Tournament's first round on March 12 and then followed up with a 2-1 win over Williams in the quarterfinals this past Saturday.

Junior forward Stephen Collins leads Geneseo in scoring with 22 goals and 25 assists for 47 points. Junior forward Trevor Hills has 22 goals and 18 assists for 40 points, while freshman forward Anthony Marra has nine goals and 27 assists for 36 points. Senior forward David Ripple has 10 goals and 24 assists for 34 points.

Freshman goaltender Devin McDonald is 17-2-5 this season with a 2.35 goals against average and .925 save percentage. Junior Matt Leon is 3-1-1 with a 2.88 goals against average and .909 save percentage.

Geneseo is 36-for-145 (24.8 percent) on the power play and is 99-for-123 (80.5 percent) on the penalty kill this season.

Tourney Tidbits:

St. Norbert enters this year's Frozen Four with a glittering 17-2 record in its last 19 NCAA Tournament games. The stretch covers its last seven NCAA Tournament appearances dating back to 2008.

The Green Knights went 3-0 in 2008, 2011 and 2014 en route to winning NCAA Division III national championships all three years. St. Norbert was 3-1 during the 2010 tournament, losing 2-1 in double

overtime to Norwich in the national title game. St. Norbert went 4-0 in 2012 to win its third national title.

St. Norbert, 26-11-1 all-time in the tournament, has suffered overtime losses in two of its last three NCAA Tournament eliminations. Including the aforementioned Norwich game, St. Norbert lost to Oswego State 4-3 in overtime in a national semifinal game in the 2007 Frozen Four at UW-Superior.

The Green Knights lost 3-1 to eventual national champion UW-Eau Claire in the 2013 national quarterfinals at the Cornerstone Community Center.

Dynamic Duo:

St. Norbert boasts the top two goal-tenders nationally in goals against average in the NCAA Division III national statistics as of Tuesday, March 22.

Junior Tony Kujava is the national leader with a 1.27 goals against average, while freshman T.J. Black is second with a 1.45 goals against average.

St. Norbert's goals against average record was set by Kyle Jones, who turned in a lusty 1.09 mark during the 2007-08 season, which included 10 shutouts.

St. Norbert also leads the nation in scoring defense at a meager 1.38 goals per game, allowing just 40 goals in 29 games this season. The Green Knights' best season defensively came in 2007-08 when they allowed 43 goals in 32 games for a 1.43 goals per game mark.

Cooper Chatter:

St. Norbert senior forward Erik Cooper had a school-record streak of 19 consecutive games with at least one point snapped in a 4-1 loss to Adrian on March 5.

Cooper passed Maris Ziedins for the St. Norbert record for scoring in consecutive games. Ziedins scored in 17 straight games from Jan. 5-Oct. 30, 2001.

Cooper, recently named NCHA Player of the Year, scored eight goals and 16 assists for 24 points over that 19-game stretch.

Cooper has scored at least one point in 27 of 29 games this season. He was also kept off the scoresheet in a 5-2 win over UW-Stevens Point on Nov. 21.

Freshmen Facts:

St. Norbert has two of the top seven goal scorers among NCAA Division III freshmen this season.

Forwards Riley Christiansen and Roman Uchyn both have 13 goals this season for the Green Knights, which ties them for third-most in Division III among first-year players.

Adrian's Trevor Boyd is currently the national leader among freshmen with goals scored at 16. Morrisville State's Danny Liscio is second with 15. Five skaters, including Christensen and Uchyn, currently have 13 goals.

Cody Keefer was the last St. Norbert freshman to have a double-digit goal total in his inaugural campaign, posting 13 goals in 2009-10.

St. Norbert has not had two freshmen reach double digits in goals in the same season since Andy Cote scored 21 goals and Orrin Hergott added 10 goals in 2003-04.

Eastern Eavesdroppings:

St. Norbert is 29-17-5 all-time against East Region opponents. The Green Knights played at least one game a season against an eastern foe for 18 years before not facing one in 2012-13 as well as 2013-14

until beating Geneseo State 6-2 on March 21, 2014 at the NCAA Division III Frozen Four. St. Norbert then resumed facing an East Region foe with home-and-home series with Buffalo State in 2014-15 and 2015-16.

St. Norbert is 19-8-4 all-time on East Region ice, which includes four neutral-site visits to the Frozen Four in 2008, 2010 and 2012 in Lake Placid, N.Y., and in 2014 to Lewiston, Maine.

The Green Knights are 14-3-2 all-time against the State University of New York Athletic Conference, including a 2-0 mark against Plattsburgh State, 1-0 against Geneseo State and a 2-2 ledger against Oswego State. St. Norbert is 4-1-1 all-time against Fredonia State and 5-0-1 against Buffalo State.

St. Norbert is 6-5-3 all-time against ECAC West opposition (including games against now-Division I RIT and Mercyhurst), and is 3-5 all-time against the NESCAC.

The Green Knights are 2-0 all-time against the ECAC Northeast, also beating Fitchburg State in the 1994-95 season.

St. Norbert is 4-3 against the conference formerly known as ECAC East, going 3-3 against Norwich and 1-0 against Southern Maine.

Coghlin Count:

St. Norbert head coach Tim Coghlin brings a record of 506-131-51 in his 23rd season into this weekend.

Coghlin is tied for 22nd place all-time in wins for NCAA men's ice hockey coaches in all divisions.

Current Fitchburg State coach Dean Fuller is tied with Coghlin for 22nd with a career mark of 506-297-51 in 31 seasons.

Coghlin earned his 500 career wins in just 680 games. That mark is the third-fastest to 500 wins in NCAA hockey history. Only UMass-Dartmouth's John Rolli (658 games) and Bemidji State's Bob Peters (677 games) have reached 500 games more quickly. According to research by the St. Norbert sports information office, no other NCAA hockey coaches have ever reached 500 wins in less than 700 games.

Steady Study:

St. Norbert coach Tim Coghlin has directed the Green Knights to 20 consecutive seasons with at least 18 wins, dating back to the 1996-97 season. That streak is the longest such record in NCAA Division III hockey history.

Coghlin is one of five coaches in Division III hockey history have posted at least 11 consecutive seasons with at least 18 wins.

Plattsburgh State's Bob Emery had 17 consecutive seasons reaching the 18-win plateau from 1990 to 2006. Middlebury's Bill Beaney had 15 consecutive seasons with at least 18 wins from 1995 to 2010.

Oswego State coach Ed Gosek had a 12-season streak with at least 18 wins begun in 2004 snapped this season with a 14-11-2 overall record. St. Thomas' Terry Skrypek had 11 consecutive seasons at the 18-win mark from 1988 to 1998.

Poll Position:

St. Norbert has been ranked in the USCHO.com Division III Poll for 264 consecutive polls. The Green Knights have been ranked in 302 of 308 polls conducted since its inception at the start of the 1998-99 season - the most of any school in Division III.

During the 264-week stretch of being ranked, St. Norbert has been No. 1 for 81 weeks - surpassing Norwich's 77 for most all-time. St. Norbert was rated No. 1 in the 2003, 2004, 2005, 2007, 2008, 2011, 2012 and 2014 final polls. The Green Knights are 109-20-8 all-time when ranked No. 1 in the USCHO.com Poll.

St. Norbert is 120-50-18 against teams ranked in the USCHO.com Poll under Tim Coghlin. The Green Knights are 3-5 all-time against the No. 1-ranked team and are 7-7-1 all-time against the No. 2-ranked team.

Tough After Two:

St. Norbert is 21-0 this season when leading after two periods, and was 17-0-1 last season when leading after 40 minutes.

Under Tim Coghlin, St. Norbert is an astounding 268-2-3 at home when up after two periods.

St. Norbert had a home unbeaten streak when leading after two periods of 200 games (197-0-3) before it was snapped by UW-Stout in a 4-3 overtime loss on Feb. 7, 2009. The Green Knights also lost 5-4 to Lawrence on Dec. 7, 2013 when leading after two periods.

At home, St. Norbert is 286-3-4 in school history when leading after two periods. The Green Knights' lone other

loss when up after two periods on their own ice came on Nov. 18, 1989 in a 3-1 loss to Augsburg when St. Norbert lost a 1-0 lead.

Gimme Five:

St. Norbert saw a 273-game unbeaten streak when scoring at least five goals spanning nearly 19 years end in a 6-5 loss to UW-Stevens Point on Jan. 3, 2015. The Green Knights were 266-0-7 when scoring five goals since a 7-5 loss to Bemidji State in De Pere on Jan. 12, 1996.

The Green Knights are 14-0 since that loss to Stevens Point, making them 280-1-7 over their last 288 games when scoring at least five goals in a game.

St. Norbert is 5-27-6 in its last 38 games when allowing five goals or more dating back to the 1996-97 season. The only five wins came in a 9-5 win over St. Scholastica on Feb. 20, 1999, a 7-5 win over UW-Stout on Nov. 30, 2001, an 8-5 win over UW-Stout on Jan. 14, 2005, a 7-5 win over UW-Stevens Point on Feb. 3, 2007 and a 7-5 win over Gustavus Adolphus on Oct. 31, 2008.

The Green Knights have allowed five goals just 24 times in their last 434 games.

St. Norbert has never allowed 10 goals in a game during Tim Coghlin's 688-game tenure.

WIAC Wisdom:

St. Norbert could play its third game against a Wisconsin Intercollegiate Athletic Conference foes this season should it meet UW-Stevens Point this weekend.

Since 2002-03, St. Norbert is 31-4-2 against UW-Stevens Point, 33-4-2 against UW-Eau Claire, 26-5-1 against UW-River Falls, 22-5-3 against UW-Stout and 22-5-8 against UW-Superior.

Western Wonders:

The Northern Collegiate Hockey Association placed a representative in the NCAA Division III championship game 21 out of a possible 32 times. St. Norbert has made seven title game appearances, coming in 2004, 2006, 2008, 2010, 2011, 2012 and 2014.

Bemijdi State did it twice (1985-86), UW-River Falls three times (1988, '93, '94), UW-Stevens Point six times (1989-93, '98), Mankato State once (1991), UW-Superior four times (1994, '97, '99, 2002) and UW-Eau Claire once (2013). NCHA teams have squared off for the national championship three times (1991 - Stevens Point vs. Mankato State, 1993 - Stevens Point vs. River Falls, 1994 - River Falls vs. Superior).

UW-Stevens Point (1989, '90, '91, '93), UW-River Falls (1988, '94), Bemidji State (1986), UW-Superior (2002), St. Norbert (2008, '11, '12, '14) and UW-Eau Claire (2013) have all won Division III national titles while playing under the NCHA banner.

In 33 NCAA Division III Frozen Fours, the NCHA has placed a team among the final four 31 years - the most of any league. The NCHA did not advance a team through to the Frozen Four in 1984 and 2005. River Falls lost to Union in the 1984 quarterfinals and St. Norbert lost to St. Thomas in the 2005 quarterfinals.

St. Norbert's 4-3 win over Adrian in the 2011 national championship game marked the first All-West Region final since 1994, when UW-River Falls beat UW-Superior 6-4 for the title. St. Norbert also defeated UW-Stevens Point 3-1 for the 2014 national title in the most recent All-West Region championship game.
