tage in a series begun in the 1988-89 season. Lake Forest won the first 14 games in the series, with St. Norbert posting a 45-6-5 ledger since.

The only team St. Norbert has played more often than Lake Forest is UW-Stevens Point. The Green Knights have met the Pointers 70 times.

The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Tim Coghlin (UW-Stevens Point, 1989) is 483-129-49 in his 23rd season in De Pere. The Green Knights are 338-59-32 in the last 15-plus seasons. Coghlin's 473 wins as a coach in the NCHA is the league record, 103 more than Bemidji State's Bob Peters' 370 wins. Coghlin's seven NCAA championship game appearances and four national championships are the second most in Division III history. Coghlin was the captain of UW-Stevens Point's first national championship team in 1989.

Lake Forest coach Patrick Kelliher (St. Lawrence, 2010) is 16-7-5 in his second season in Lake Forest.

Last Season:

St. Norbert took three points from Lake Forest in a home-and-home series on Nov. 14-15, 2014.

The Green Knights beat the Foresters 3-1 on Nov. 14 in Lake Forest, Ill. Michael Hill, Erik Cooper and Ross Pavek all scored for the Green Knights, while Luke Swardenski scored for the Foresters. David Jacobson made 31 saves for St. Norbert, while Leo Podolsky made 37 stops for Lake Forest.

The two teams skated to a 2-2 tie the next night at the Cornerstone Community Center. Podolsky made 42 saves for Lake Forest, while Tony Kujava made 24 saves for St. Norbert. Hill and Kyle Lee scored for the Green Knights, while Billy Kent and Charlie Stein scored for the Foresters.

About the Green Knights:

St. Norbert enters the weekend 1-1 overall and in the Northern Collegiate Hockey Association. The Green Knights split with Marian last weekend, winning 4-1 in Fond du Lac before falling at home 4-2.

Junior forward Noah Nelson leads the Green Knights in scoring with two goals and one assist for three points. Senior forwards Erik Cooper and Michael Hill both have one goal and one assist for two points. Sophomore defenseman Chris Rygus and freshman forward Steven Phillips both have one goal for one point.

Junior goaltender Tony Kujava is 1-0 with a 0.77 goals against average and .952 save percentage. Freshman T.J. Black is 0-1 with a 6.00 goals against average and .750 save percentage.

St. Norbert is 0-for-4 (0.0 percent) on the power play and is 5-for-7 (71.4 percent) on the penalty kill this season.

About the Foresters:

Lake Forest enters the weekend 1-1 overall and the Northern Collegiate Hockey Association. The Foresters split a home-and-home series with Concordia-Wisconsin last weekend, winning at home 3-2 before losing on the road 4-1.

Sophomore forward Billy Kent leads the Foresters with two goals for two points. Sophomore forward Shawn Nelson has two assists for two points. Freshmen forwards Cody Guidorzi and Drew Cleereman both have one goal for one point.

Senior goaltender Leo Podolsky is 1-1 with a 2.51 goals against average and .911 save percentage.

Lake Forest is 0-for-12 (0.0 percent) on the power play and is 9-for-9 (100.0 percent) on the penalty kill this season.

Schedule Snippets:

Only two of St. Norbert's first 11 games this season will be played at the friendly confines of Cornerstone Community Center. St. Norbert has an eight-game road trip scheduled from Nov. 7 through Dec. 4. That is the longest continuous time spent

away from home for the Green Knights since Tim Coghlin's first 11 games as head coach in 1993-94. St. Norbert's last road trip of at least seven games came on Nov. 21, 2003 to Jan. 9, 2004.

St. Norbert is also playing six consecutive league games to start the season for the second straight year. It is the only two times since the Green Knights joined the NCHA in 1994-95 they have played six straight "counters" to open the season.

Coghlin Count:

St. Norbert head coach Tim Coghlin brings a record of 483-129-49 in his 23rd season into this weekend. Coghlin is currently 25th all-time in wins for NCAA men's ice hockey coaches.

Coghlin moved past Joe Marsh for 25th on the all-time list with a 4-1 win over Marian on Oct. 30. Marsh compiled a 482-417-76 mark in 27 seasons at St. Lawrence from 1986 to 2012.

Current Fitchburg State coach Dean Fuller is 24th with a career mark of 496-285-49 in 31 seasons. Current Mercyhurst coach Rick Gotkin is 23rd on the list with a 499-356-76 mark in 28 seasons.

Poll Position:

St. Norbert has been ranked in the USCHO.com Division III Poll for 248 consecutive polls. The Green Knights have been ranked in 286 of 292 polls conducted since its inception at the start of the 1998-99 season - the most of any school in Division III.

During the 248-week stretch of being ranked, St. Norbert has been No. 1 for 71 weeks - trailing Norwich's 77 for most all-time. St. Norbert was rated No. 1 in the 2003, 2004, 2005, 2007, 2008, 2011, 2012 and 2014 final polls. The Green Knights are 98-18-7 all-time when ranked No. 1 in the USCHO.com Poll.

St. Norbert is 114-48-17 against teams ranked in the USCHO.com Poll under Tim Coghlin. The Green

Knights are 3-5 all-time against the No. 1-ranked team and are 5-5-1 all-time against the No. 2-ranked team.

Home Sweet Cornerstone:

St. Norbert is 206-27-12 all-time at the Cornerstone Community Center, which includes a 9-4-1 mark there its first season in the building in 2000-01.

St. Norbert is 185-19-9 in its last 213 games at the Cornerstone Community Center.

The Green Knights had a 25-game home winning streak - the second-longest in NCAA Division III history - snapped with a 2-2 tie to Gustavus Adolphus on Nov. 4, 2011. St. Norbert also owns the NCAA Division III record with a 36-game home winning streak set Oct. 25, 2002 to Oct. 29, 2004.

In the last 14-plus seasons, the Green Knights are a sparkling 196-22-11 at the Cornerstone, with three losses and one tie coming to national champion UW-Superior during the 2001-02 season.

Under Tim Coghlin, St. Norbert is 284-49-18 at home, which includes games at Brown County Arena, Resch Center and De Pere Ice Arena.

Only two road teams have won at least two games at the Cornerstone in the same season. Superior won three times in 2001-02 and UW-Eau Claire won twice in 2012-13. Both of those teams won the NCAA Division III national championship.

Tough After Two:

St. Norbert was 17-0-1 this season when leading after two periods. The Green Knights were 3-0-1 when tied after two periods but were 0-6 when trailing after 40 minutes.

Under Tim Coghlin, St. Norbert is an astounding 260-2-3 at home when up after two periods.

St. Norbert had a home unbeaten streak when leading after two periods of 200 games (197-0-3) before it was snapped by UW-Stout in a 4-3 overtime loss on Feb. 7, 2009. The Green Knights also lost 5-4 to Lawrence on Dec. 7, 2013 when

At home, St. Norbert is 278-3-4 in school history when leading after two periods. The Green Knights' lone other loss when up after two periods on their own ice came on Nov. 18, 1989 in a 3-1 loss to Augsburg when St. Norbert lost a 1-0 lead.

Gimme Five:

St. Norbert saw a 273-game unbeaten streak when scoring at least five goals spanning nearly 19 years end in a 6-5 loss to UW-Stevens Point on Jan. 3, 2015. The Green Knights were 266-0-7 when scoring five goals since a 7-5 loss to Bemidji State in De Pere on Jan. 12, 1996.

St. Norbert is 5-26-6 in its last 37 games when allowing five goals or more dating back to the 1996-97 season. The only five wins came in a 9-5 win over St. Scholastica on Feb. 20, 1999, a 7-5 win over UW-Stout on Nov. 30, 2001, an 8-5 win over UW-Stout on Jan. 14, 2005, a 7-5 win over UW-Stevens Point on Feb. 3, 2007 and a 7-5 win over Gustavus Adolphus on Oct. 31, 2008.

The Green Knights have allowed five goals just 23 times in their last 407 games.

St. Norbert has never allowed 10 goals in a game during Tim Coghlin's 661-game tenure.

Ice Chips:

- * St. Norbert's 4-2 loss to Marian this past Saturday at the Cornerstone Community Center was the first loss in its home opener in 19 years. The Green Knights last dropped their home opener in a 2-1 loss to UW-Stevens Point on Nov. 1, 1996.
- * Of goaltenders who have played more than 60 minutes this season, junior Tony Kujava leads Division III in goals against average at 0.77. He has allowed one goal in 78 minutes of work this season and owns a .952 save percentage.
